**THE TWINS:** Have gone 1-2 through three games on their current six-game, seven-day roadtrip, taking the third game in Seattle on Wednesday night after dropping the first two games on Monday and Tuesday...tonight they will make their first visit to Globe Life Field, playing three games vs. the Rangers over the weekend...the Twins have gone 14-21 at home this season and 13-20 on the road. games vs. the Rangers and 13-20 on the road

TWINS TAKE GAME THREE IN SEATTLE: The Twins beat the Mariners on Wednesday night by a score of 7-2...Bailey Ober made his fourth career start, pitching 4.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, no walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Jorge Polanco and two from Ryan Jeffers...Jeffers hit his fourth home run of the season...Nelson Cruz added a home run, his 14th of the season and 431st of his career, tying Cal Ripken Jr. for 49th on Major League Baseball's all-time list.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have returned outfielder Max Kepler from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Kepler, who missed the Twins' last 17 games with a left hamstring strain, played in three games on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul, going 1-for-11 (.091)...in 37 games for the Twins this season, Kepler has hit .212 (28-for-132) with nine doubles, two triples, five home runs, 22 RBI, 20 runs scored, 16 walks and a .727 OPS...to make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Gilberto Celestino to Triple-A St. Paul...Celestino has played in 10 games for the Twins this season across two stints, going 4-for-32 (.125) with one double, one home run, one RBI, two runs scored and one walk.

© Additionally, right-handed pitcher Shaun Anderson was claimed off waivers by Texas.

TWINS AND TEXAS: The Twins and Rangers are playing each other tonight for the fifth of seven meetings this season...the Twins went 1-3 in their last series with Texas from May 3-6 at Target Field, winning just the first game of the four-game series...the Twins have won five of their last eight games vs. the Rangers and nine of their last 15, dating back to June of 2018.

The Nelson Cruz played for the Rangers from 2006-13, hitting .268 (773-for-2886) with 170 doubles, 157 home runs and 489 RBI in 796 games...he still ranks seventh on the Rangers all-time list in home runs...Cruz is 3-for-3 with a home run lifetime off Mike Foltynewicz.

Jorge Polanco recorded his first career hit against the Rangers at Globe Life Park in his second career game on June 27, 2014, tripling off Joakim Soria...he became the third player in Twins history (now 4 players) to record a triple as his first major league hit and the first since Jimmie Hall on April 16, 1963; the first was Bernie Allen on April 10, 1962 vs. the Kansas City A's.

Miguel Sanó is hitting. 330 (32-for-97) with five doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 18 RBI, 18 walks and a 1.054 OPS in 26 career games against the Rangers.

Williams Astudillo is hitting .357 (5-for-14) in four career games against texas.

**CRUZ CRUSH:** Nelson Cruz has four home runs in his last seven games...he has 431 career home runs (homers by team in the right margin below), needing one to pass Cal Ripken Jr. and move into sole possession of 49th on baseball's all-time list...below are his ranks on MLB's all-time list (left) and all-time among active Dominican-born players:

WINDOWS DOWN AND CRUZ: Nelson Cruz has a 12-game on-base streak, dating back to June 1...he's hitting .390 (16-for-41) with three doubles, four home runs, nine RBI, eight walks, a .480 on-base percentage and a 1.236 OPS during the streak...Cruz's career-high for an on-base streak is 42, done April 22-July 31, 2010 with Texas...his .480 on-base percentage is fourth in the American League in June (minimum 50 plate appearances), trailing Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.492), Baltimore's Cedric Mullins (.492) and Oakland's Matt Olson (.483).

**RED HOT JORGE:** Jorge Polanco is hitting .352 (19-for-54) with four doubles, four home runs, nine RBI and a 1.017 OPS in his last 13 games...as a second baseman, Polanco has posted a .457 slugging percentage, ranking third in the American League, trailing Marcus Semien (.547) and Jose Altuve (.530).

LAST START: Earned his team-leading seventh win of the season last Saturday night vs. Houston...pitched 7.0 innings of two-run ball, allowing five hits (2 HR) and one walk while striking out eight...worked 6.1 scoreless innings before allowing back-to-back solo home runs to Kyle Tucker and Robel García...gave way to Hansel Robles and Taylor Rogers, who each pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief to seal the Twins' 5-2 victory...marked Berríos' 32nd career win at Target Field, matching former Twin (and current Ranger) Kyle Gibson for the most in the history of the ballpark...extended his win streak to five games, matching his career long, also April 14-May 7, 2019.

START PRIOR: Earned his sixth win of the season in a 5-4 Twins victory June 5 at Kansas City... tied his season-high with four runs on six hits (1 HR) over 6.0 innings, with two walks...fanned four batters, improving his career total to 726 strikeouts and moving into sole possession of 13th place on the Twins all-time strikeout list (since 1961)...surrendered a two-run home run to Andrew Benintendi, giving the Royals the lead in the fifth, but pitched a scoreless sixth after Miguel Sanó's two-run shot in the top half of the inning put the Twins ahead.

- GOING STREAKING: His current five-game win streak matches the longest of his career, previously done April 14-May 7, 2019.

  ₱ Is 5-0, 3.73 ERA (50.2 IP, 21 ER) with 12 walks and 48 strikeouts in eight starts since May 2...has completed at least 5.0 innings in all eight of those games (Twins are 7-1).

  ₱ Twins hitters have supported Berríos with 34 runs during that stretch (6.04 run support average), tied for the fourth-highest total among all American League starters in that span.

  ₱ His last losing decision came in the second game of the doubleheader at Oakland on April 20, when he surrendered one run on four hits with one walk and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings in a 1-0 A's victory.

**700 CLUB:** This season, Berríos has surpassed both 700 strikeouts and 700.0 innings pitched for his career...his 700th strikeout came in the fifth inning on May 15 vs. Oakland, fanning Seth Brown...became the 15th Twin to reach 700 strikeouts and the 28th Twin to reach 700.0 innings pitched.

◆ He needs 36 strikeouts to tie Scott Baker (770) for 12th on the Twins all-time strikeout list

MESSIN' WITH TEXAS: Is making his fifth career start against the Rangers...owns a 2-1, 5.75 ERA (20.1 IP, 13 ER) with nine walks and 30 strikeouts in four prior starts against Texas...last faced the Rangers on August 17, 2019 in Arlington, allowing seven runs (3 ER) on seven hits (2 HR), with three walks and six strikeouts in 4.1 innings.

◆ Has never won in Arlington, going 0-1, 8.64 ERA (8.1 IP, 8 ER) with six walks and 12 strikeouts in two prior starts at Globe Life Park...exited the game prior to completing 5.0 innings in both starts...tonight marks his (and the Twins') first-ever game at the newlyconstructed Globe Life Field

**SLICK LEATHER:** He has four defensive runs saved this season, tied with San Francisco's Kevin Gausman for second best among all pitchers in baseball, trailing only Chicago-AL's Dallas Keuchel (6)...Berríos finished tied for fifth in baseball among pitchers in DRS in 2020 with one...since 2019, he ranks tied for seventh in DRS with five.

RIGHTY TIGHTY: Berríos is holding right-handed hitters to a .168 (26-for-155) average with five doubles, three home runs, eight walks and 46 strikeouts, compared to lefties hitting .292 (38-for-130) with 12 doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 12 walks and 35 strikeouts against him...his right-handed opponent batting average ranks second in the AL (min. 130 opp. AB), behind only HOU's Luis Garcia (.146).

RISP IT TO GET THE BISCUIT: Berríos is holding hitters to a .212 (14-for-66) opponent batting average with runners in scoring position this season, the seventh-best mark among AL pitchers (min. 75.0 IP)...his average stays consistent in lower-leverage situations as he is also holding batters to a .217 (38-for-175) opponent batting average with no runners on base.

This .225 (64-for-285) overall opponent batting average ranks seventh among American League pitchers (min. 75.0 IP).

The 64 hits he has allowed this season are tied for fifth fewest among American League pitchers (min. 75.0 IP).

**TOP OF THE CLASS:** Berríos has 52 wins since the start of 2017, second most in the American League in that span, trailing only Justin Verlander (53)...MLB-wide in that time frame, 52 wins is seventh in the majors, trailing Gerrit Cole (62), Zack Greinke (60), Clayton Kershaw (57), Max Scherzer (55), Charlie Morton (53) and Verlander (53)...his 685 strikeouts are fourth in the AL, trailing Verlander (816), Cole (813) and Chris Sale (763).
