LAST TIME OUT: Dobnak's last appearance came in relief on June 13 vs. Houston, when he worked the fifth and sixth innings of a 14-3 Twins loss...pitched 2.0 innings, permitting six runs on seven hits (1 HR) with no walks and two strikeouts...allowed five extra-base hits, his most in a relief outing in his career and second most in any outing (7 on June 9 vs. NYY)...also marked his 11th career outing with no walks allowed, fifth this season

TWO APPEARANCES AGO: Dobnak's most recent starting nod came on June 9 vs. New York-AL at **IWU APPEARANCES AGU:** Uobnak's most recent starting nod came on June 9 vs. New York-AL at Target Field...faceed the Yankees for the first time in the regular season, after previously starting at Yankee Stadium in the 2019 American League Division Series...shouldered his sixth loss of the season after pitching 4.2 innings and allowing a career-high eight runs on 11 hits (4 HR), with three walks and no strikeouts; the Twins fell 9-6...marked his first career start in which he did not record a strikeout...his seven extra-base hits and four home runs allowed set career highs; became just the third starting pitcher in Twins history to allow at least four home runs and no strikeouts in a start, joining Brad Radke (August 10, 1999 vs. Toronto; 4 HR) and Carlos Silva (August 22, 2006 at Baltimore; 5 HR)...was his second career start allowing at least three extra-base hits, also doing so on lune 2 at Baltimore. so on June 2 at Baltimore.

RANDY, MEET THE RANGERS: This afternoon marks Dobnak's first career start and appearance against Texas...he's 0-1, 18.56 ERA (5.1 IP, 11 ER) with no walks, six strikeouts and a .464 opponent batting average in three career relief appearances against the American League West division; all three outings have occurred this season, against Los Angeles-AL (April 16), Oakland (April 21) and the season of the June 13 (Houston)

THE ARSENAL: Dobnak has thrown four pitches throughout his major league career, with his primary weapon choice being his sinker...below is a breakdown of his 2021 offerings.

 Dobnak has thrown his slider 35.4 percent of the time so far this season, the 16th-highest percentage of the pitch among qualified pitchers.

WELL GROUNDED: Dobnak's primary pitch is his sinker, which is the ideal tool for inducing ground-ball contact...since the start of 2019, Dobnak ranks among the major league leaders (min. 400 BF) in ground ball/fly ball ratio (5th, 3.17), ground ball percentage (9th, 57.2) and double plays-per-9.0 IP (6th, 1.35).

UNBALANCED LEVERAGE: Last season, Dobnak held opposing hitters to a .205 (9-for-44) batting average with three doubles and 13 RBI with runners in scoring position, and held an equally-impressive mark of .143 (3-for-21) with two doubles and three RBI with runners in scoring position and two uts...by contrast, he's struggled in high-leverage situations this season, with opponents batting .405 (15-for-37) against him with RISP and .357 (5-for-14) with RISP and two outs.

START ME UP: Dobnak enters today's game 9-8, 4.28 ERA (88.1 IP, 42 ER) in 19 career major league starts...was 7-2, 1.81 (49.2 IP, 10 ER) in his first 11 starts (through August 22, 2020), but is just 2-6, 7.45 ERA (38.2 IP, 32 ER) in his eight starts since. Thas an opponent slash line of .273/.338/.390 as a starter, with opposing batters going 94-for-344

with 16 doubles and eight home runs...has issued 26 walks, while striking out 54. Between September 3, 2019 (his first major league start, as an opener) and the end of the 2020 season, Dobnak's .336 opponent slugging percentage in 16 outings (one relief ap-pearance) ranked second in the American League (min. 15 starts), behind only Cleveland's Shane Bieber (.326). **₱** Bet

SEASON SUMMARY: Dobnak began the season with Minnesota and was named to his second career **SCASUN SUMMART:** LODDAK began the season with Minnesota and was named to his second career Opening Day roster in 2021 (both with Minnesota)...he was optioned on May 3 (Brandon Waddell recalled) following a rough start to his campaign (0-3, 8.16 ERA, 1 save in 7 relief appearances), and to get stretched out for potential starting opportunities at the major league vel...is making his fifth start of the season this afternoon, all coming within his last six outings; his relief appearance on June 13 vs. Houston snapped a streak of four consecutive starts...see the note below for how his tenure went with Triple-A St. Paul.

SAINTLY STARTS: Dobnak made three starts in May for Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-1, 3.38 ERA (13.1 IP, 5 ER), six walks, 11 strikeouts and a .213 opponent batting average (10-for-47)...nine of the 10 hits he allowed were singles...his pitch count slowly climbed, from 59 in his first outing May 6, to 81 in his second and topping out at 87 in his final Triple-A start on May 16, prior to his recall on May 21.
♥ His first and third starts with the Saints were scoreless – a 4.0-inning, two-hit effort May 6 at Omaha (0 BB, 5 K) and a 5.0-inning, four-hit outing May 16 vs. lowa (1 BB, 5 K)...sandwiched in between was a tough start May 11 vs. the I-Cubs in which he tied a career high at any level by issuing five walks in just 4.1 innings (4 H, 5 R/ER, 1 K).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP KENTA MAEDA [2021 SEASON: 2-2, S.OI ERA // CAREER: 55-38, 3.83 ERA]

Maeda is due to toe the rubber in tomorrow afternoon's finale in Arlington...was returned from rehab and reinstated from the 10-day Injured List on June 14 and made the start that night in Seattle... did not factor into the decision in the outing after yielding just one run on three hits, with three walks and seven strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...the one earned run marked just the third time he's allowed one run-or-fewer this season, first since May 3 vs. Texas...his strikeout of Shed Long Jr. in the fourth inning was the 2,000th of his career combined between Nippon Professional Baseball (1,233) and Major League Baseball (767)...Maeda earned the win over the Rangers on May 3 at Target Field, yielding just two hits and two walks over 5.1 scoreless innings, with a season-high eight strikeouts...he's 1-0, 2.38 ERA (11.1 IP, 3 ER) with seven walks and 10 strikeouts in three career appearances (2 starts) against Texas.
