THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2 (3-0 against
Baltimore and 1-2 against Kansas City), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip by
splitting the first two games in Baltimorétonight they will play the three-game series finale
at Camden Yardsafter the game, the Twins will travel to Kansas City to play the Royals four
times from Thursday-Sundaythe Twins have gone 12-17 at home this season and 10-15 on
the roadTwins are 4-2 in their last six road games.

Twins have won eight of their last 12 overall and nine of their last 15.

TWINS FINALLY FALL TO ORIOLES: The Twins lost to the Orioles last night by a score of 7-4, snapping their 16-game winning streak against Baltimore and losing to them for the first time since March 29, 2018...Michael Pineda (3-3) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on seven hits in 3.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded 10 hits, including two hits apiece from Alex Kirilloff, Willians Astudillo and Andrelton Simmons...Astudillo hit his fourth home run of the season and Kyle Garlick hit his fourth as well.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins announced today that they have placed catcher Mitch Garver on the 10-day Injured List with a groin contusion and outfielder Rob Refsnyder on the 7-day Injured List with a concussion (retroactive to June 1)...Garver sustained the injury last night on a foul tip and Refsnyder suffered his injury after colliding with the centerfield wall on Monday afternoon...Garver has batted .224 (26-for-116) with eight doubles, eight home runs, 17 RBI, 19 walks, 17 runs scored and an .833 OPS in 41 games this season...he was hitting .346 (9-for-26) with five doubles, two home runs, four RBI, 11 walks, a .541 on-base percentage and a 1.310 OPS in his last 11 games at the time of his injury...Refsnyder has batted .320 (16-for-50) with three doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, four walks, 10 runs scored and an .864 OPS in 16 games this season...to replace both Garver and Refsnyder on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled catcher Ryan Jeffers and outfielder Gilberto Celestino from Triple-A St. Paul...Jeffers will be making his second maior league stint this season. after earning a the Twins have recalled catcher Ryan Jeffers and outfielder Gilberfo Celestino from Triple-A St. Paul...Jeffers will be making his second major league stint this season, after earning a spot on the Opening Day roster and being optioned on April 29...he batted .147 (5-for-34) with one double, one RBI, three walks and three runs scored in 11 games for the Twins prior to his option, and has since posted a .217/.340/.446 (18-for-83) slash line with four doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, 16 walks and 13 runs scored in 24 games for the Saints...Celestino, who was just promoted from Double-A Wichita to St. Paul yesterday, hit .250 (21-for-84) with five doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, 11 walks and 10 runs scored in 21 games for the Wind Surge...the 22-year-old was ranked as the 10th-best prospect, best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm in the Twins' minor league system by Baseball America and 14th-best prospect by MLB.com...the Santo Domingo, DR native was acquired by the Twins from Houston, along with right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcala, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Ryan Pressly on July 27, 2018.

TWINS AND BIRDS: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the sixth of six scheduled meetings this season...since the start of 2018, the Iwins are 16-2 vs. the Orioles.

♣ The Twins are 32-13 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.

♣ Since the start of 2018, the Twins have hit 44 home runs in 18 games against Baltimore, including 21 homers in eight games at Camden Yards.

♣ Nelson Cruz is hitting .348 (95-for-273) with 22 doubles, 17 home runs, 58 RBI, a .623 slugging percentage and a 1.051 OPS in 74 career games vs. the O's...Cruz spent 2014 with Baltimore, hitting .271 (166-for-613) with 32 doubles, an MLB-best 40 homers and 108 RBI in 159 games...since Cruz landed in Baltimore, he has 270 home runs, best in baseball since that season...additionally. Cruz has 22 career homers in 116 games at Camden Yards. since that season...additionally, Cruz has 22 career homers in 116 games at Camden Yards.

AK IS OK: Since April 30, Alex Kirilloff ranks second among major league rookies (min. 40 at-bats) with a .924 OPS (Adolis García - .945)...overall this season, he's batting .500 (17-for-34) with runners on base, tied for first in the majors (min. 30 AB) and .455 (10-for-22) with runners in scoring position, tops among all major league hitters (min. 20 AB).

SERIES NOTES: Twins are 5-10-2 in series play this season, going 2-7-0 in home series and 3-3-2 in road series...their five series wins are: April 1-4 at Milwaukee (2-1), April 5-7 at Detroit (2-1), April 30-May 2 vs. Kansas City (2-1), May 21-23 at Cleveland (2-1) and May 24-26 vs. Baltimore (3-0)...they are seeking their sixth-straight series victory over the 0's tonight.

LOU GEHRIG DAY: The Twins, in partnership with the ALS Association's Minnesota, North Dakota and South Dakota Chapter, will share the stories of two members of the extended Twins family...the Giovanelli family story and Kent Hrbek's in-game discussion with Twins broadcasters will each be shared across the club's social media platforms, on Bally Sports North, and in-ballpark at Target Field when the Twins return home to host the New York Yankees on June 8...first, the Twins will debut a documentary-style video spotlighting the Giovanelli family of St. Louis Park, Minnesota...when Lynn Giovanelli was diagnosed with ALS, her community rallied around her — especially those associated with St. Louis Park High School, where the youngest of her three sons, Stefano, is a sophomore pitcher on the baseball team; in front of a season-high crowd of more than 250 people at the school's first-ever "Strike Out ALS" night on May 19, Lynn threw out the ceremonial first pitch and shared the Orioles' "Big Dawg" player of the game award with Stefano, who struck out four batters over five innings to earn the win...tomorrow night, Twins Hall-of-Famer Kent Hrbek — the 1991 Lou Gehrig Memorial Award winner — will join the Bally Sports North live television broadcast...since losing his father to ALS at the age of 53 in 1982 (Kent's rookie season), "Hrbie" has passionately worked to raise awareness of the disease and advocate for those afflicted, along with their families; Kent and his wife, Jeanie, helped form the Minnesota chapter of the ALS Association and have raised hundreds of thousands of dollars for the cause. of thousands of dollars for the cause.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1986, Rod Carew announced his retirement from baseball at the age of 40...Carew retired with a .328 career batting average, compiled over 19 major league seasons...he was elected into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1991.

MINOR MATTER: Triple-A St. Paul looks to win their eighth-straight game tonight at Louisville (first pitch 6:00 CT)...their seven-game winning streak is the third-longest active winning streak in Triple-A...left-handed pitcher Charlie Barnes (2-0, 3.05) will take the mound, opposite right-handed pitcher Riley O'Brien (0-1, 2.86).

LAST TIME OUT: Dobnak shouldered the loss last Friday night vs. Kansas City, as the Twins fell to the Royals 8-3 at Target Field...sailed through the first 4.2 innings, allowing only a pair of singles, before yielding three runs with two outs in the fifth and the first three batters to reach base in the seventh before departing in favor of Cody Stashak (all 3 inherited runners later scored)...matched his career high with six runs allowed, and paired with his start on May 21, worked at least 6.0 innings in back-to-back starts for the first time in his career.

TWO STARTS AGO: Dobnak was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 21 and started that night in Cleveland, his first start of the season after beginning the year in the bullpen...he scattered just five base runners (3 hits, 2 walks) across 6.0 shutout innings as the Twins blew out the Indians, 10-0, in the series opener en route to a series win by the end of the weekend...recorded his third career quality start and first since August 5, 2020 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 K)...also marked his seventh career start (out of 17) in which he did not allow an extra-base hit.

Dobnak hails from the Pittsburgh area, just a few hours' drive to Cleveland, and had several family members in attendance that night...this included his grandfather, who had yet to see him pitch in the majors prior to that night.

SEASON SUMMARY: Dobnak began the season with Minnesota and was named to his second career Opening Day roster in 2021 (both with Minnesota)...he was optioned on May 3 (Brandon Waddell recalled) following a rough start to his campaign (0-3, 8.16 ERA, 1 save in 7 relief appearances), and to get stretched out for potential starting opportunities at the major league level...see the note below for how his tenure went with Triple-A St. Paul.

SAINTLY STARTS: Dobnak made three starts in May for Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-1, 3.38 ERA (13.1 IP, 5 ER), six walks, 11 strikeouts and a .213 opponent batting average (10-for-47)...nine of the 10 his he allowed were singles...his pitch count slowly climbed, from 59 in his first outing May 6, to 81 in his second and topping out at 87 in his final Triple-A start on May 16, prior to his recall on May 21.

The His first and third starts with the Saints were scoreless — a 4.0-inning, two-hit effort May 6 at 0 maha (0 BB, 5 K) and a 5.0-inning, four-hit outing May 16 vs. lowa (1 BB, 5 K)...sandwiched in between was a tough start May 11 vs. the I-Cubs in which he tied a career high at any level by issuing five walks in just 4.1 innings (4 H, 5 R/ER, 1 K).

WELL GROUNDED: Dobnak's primary pitch is his sinker, which is the ideal tool for inducing ground-ball contact...since the start of 2019, Dobnak ranks among the major league leaders (min. 400 BF) in ground ball/fly ball ratio (4th, 3.20), fewest extra-base hits allowed (4th, 23), double plays-per-9.0 IP (5th, 1.42) and ground ball percentage (9th, 57.4).

AGAINST THE EAST: Tonight represents Dobnak's first career start and appearance against Balti-more...owns just two career outings vs. the American League East division, both against the Boston Red Sox — a start as an "Opener" on September 3, 2019 at Fenway Park and a relief appearance on April 13 at Target Field...has posted an 0-1 record, 2.25 ERA (4.0 IP, 1 ER), two walks, two strikeouts and a .154 opponent batting average (2-for-13) across the outings...worked 1.0 scoreless inning as the Opener; took the loss in his relief appearance in April, after allowing a go-ahead RBI double to Bobby Dalbec in the top of the eighth inning of an eventual 4-2 Twins loss to the Red Sox.

Dobnak and his wife, Aerial, make their offseason home in Falling Waters, WV, approximately 90

minutes and roughly 85 miles northwest of Oriole Park at Camden Yards...given this proximity, he has hosted a plethora of family and friends in the stands during this series.

RANDY ON THE ROAD: Dobnak has performed marginally better on the road than at home this season, going 1-2, 6.28 ERA (14.1 IP, 10 ER) in six appearances (1 GS) on the road compared to 0-2, 6.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 9 ER) in three appearances (1 GS) at Target Field...his career numbers as a starter at home and on the road are strikingly similar, though — he's 5-4, 3.65 ERA (49.1 IP, 20 ER), 13 walks and 31 strikeouts in 11 career road starts, and 4-2, 3.45 ERA (28.2 IP, 11 ER), eight walks and 20 strikeouts in six career starts at home strikeouts in six career starts at home

START ME UP: Dobnak enters tonight's game 9-6, 3.58 ERA (78.0 IP, 31 ER) in 17 career major league starts...was 7-2, 1.81 (49.2 IP, 10 ER) in his first 11 starts (through August 22, 2020), but went 1-3, 8.27 (16.1 IP, 15 ER) over his final four outings of 2020.

- ₱ Has an opponent slash line of .253/.316/.320 as a starter, with opposing batters going 75 297 with 11 doubles and just three home runs...has issued 21 walks, while striking out 51
- Between September 3, 2019 (his first major league start, as an opener) and the end of the 2020 season, Dobnak's .336 opponent slugging percentage in 16 outings (one relief ap-pearance) ranked second in the American League (min. 15 starts), behind only Cleveland's Shane Bieber (.326).

THE ARSENAL: Dobnak has thrown four pitches throughout his major league career, with his primary

weapon of choice being his sinker...below is the breakdown of his 2021 offerings.
