THE TWINS: Have gone 3-2 through five games on their current six-game, seven-day roadtrip, going 1-2 in Seattle and 2-0 in Texas...today they will play the three-game series finale with the Rangers at Globe Life Field...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Minneapolis to begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with two against Cincinnati on Monday-Tuesday, followed by an off-day on Wednesday, then four against Cleveland from Thursday-Sunday... the Twins have gone 14-21 at home this season and 15-20 on the road.
 ☞ Twins have won three straight and looking to tie their season-long winning streak of four, previously done from May 23-26, when they took one from Cleveland and three from Baltimore.

TWINS SECURE SERIES IN TEXAS: The Twins beat the Rangers yesterday afternoon by a score of 3-2, winning their sixth series this season (6-14-3) and fourth on the road (4-5-3)...Randy Dobnak was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined for 4.0 scoreless innings of relief as Caleb Thielbar earned his second win and Taylor Rogers earned his seventh save...the offense recorded just four hits, highlighted by a Nelson Cruz home run, his 15th of the season and 432nd of his career.

THE BOOMSTICK: Nelson Cruz's home run yesterday passed Cal Ripken Jr. as he moved into sole possession of 49th on baseball's all-time list...Cruz has hit 275 home runs since 2014, the most in baseball ahead of Mike Trout's 248...he is on pace for 34 homers this season...below is Cruz's rankings on the all-time home run list:

NOTE: Cruz now has 31 home runs since turning 40-years-old, tying Dave Winfield for most by a Twin after turning 40...next are Jim Thome (19), Paul Molitor (15) and Torii Hunter (8)...Cruz turns 41 on July 1.

TWINS AND TEXAS: The Twins and Rangers are playing each other today for the seventh and final time this season...the Twins have gone 3-3 against the Rangers in 2021, going 1-3 at Target Field and 2-0 at Globe Life Field...all six games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while three of the six have gone extra innings...the Twins have won seven of their last 10 games vs. the Rangers and 11 of their last 17, dating back to June of 2018.

- ☞ Nelson Cruz played for the Rangers from 2006-13, hitting .268 (773-for-2886) with 170 doubles, 157 home runs and 489 RBI in 796 games...he still ranks seventh on the Rangers all-time list in home runs...he has 101 career homers at Globe Life Park and one at Globe Life Field.
- ☞ Miguel Sanó is hitting .327 (33-for-101) with five doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 18 RBI, 18 walks and a 1.034 OPS in 27 career games against the Rangers.
- ☞ Byron Buxton made his major league debut at Globe Life Park on June 14, 2015, going 0-for-4 with a run scored and two strikeouts.
- ☞ After sweeping a four-game series August 15-18, 2019 in their last appearance at Globe Life Park and winning the first two games of the series, the Twins have won six straight in Arlington, marking their longest win streak in Texas.
- ☞ A win today would secure the season series for the second-straight season after going 6-1 against the Rangers in 2019.

NELLY'S ON BASE...AGAIN: Nelson Cruz has a 14-game on-base streak, dating back to June 1...he's hitting .388 (19-for-49) with three doubles, five home runs, 12 RBI, nine walks, a .475 on-base percentage and a 1.230 OPS during the streak...his .475 on-base percentage is second in baseball for June, trailing only Baltimore's Cedric Mullins (.507).

SWEEPS WEEK: The Twins are looking for their second sweep of the season this afternoon...their only sweep of 2021 came against Baltimore in three games from May 24-26 at Target Field...their last sweep of the Rangers came in four games from August 15-18, 2019 in Texas...their last road sweep of any kind came in a three-game series in Detroit from September 24-26, 2019.

MIKE BELL TRIBUTE MONDAY: The Twins yesterday announced plans to honor the life and legacy of former bench coach Mike Bell, who passed away on March 26 at the age of 46 from cancer, prior to the club's home game tomorrow at Target Field vs. the Cincinnati Reds, managed by Mike's brother, David Bell...the game will also serve as the Twins' annual Cancer Awareness Night, as part of the club's theme nights lineup...members of the Bell family that will be in attendance on Monday include David, Mike's wife Kelly and their children Madeline, Mikayla, Luke; Luke's girlfriend, Emily; Mike's sister Kristi, her husband Bobby and their children Hayes, Baker and Bode; and Mike's mother Gloria...Mike Bell's 29 years in professional baseball, including his two with the Twins, left an indelible impact upon all those whom he met, an influence of positivity and kindness that will forever resonate both on and off the field...away from the ballpark, Mike's passionate work on behalf of GiGi's Playhouse helped further efforts to realize their vision of a world in which individuals with Down syndrome are accepted and embraced in their families, schools and communities.

☞ Fans who purchase a ticket through the special Cancer Awareness Night theme night package will receive an exclusive Twins Cancer Awareness cap, available in 10 different colors corresponding to the most prevalent cancers seen in Twins Territory...additionally, as part of the Twins' longstanding efforts to strike out cancer, a portion of each ticket purchased through this special ticket package will be donated back to the American Cancer Society to support further research and awareness.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul catcher/first baseman Tomás Telis and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Jordan Balazovic the club's minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Telis played in six games for the Saints this week, hitting .391 (9-for-23) with one double, three home runs, five RBI, three walks and a 1.288 OPS...the 30-year-old has played in 39 games for the Saints this season, hitting .271 (42-for-155) with four doubles, one triple, six home runs and 21 RBI.

☞ Balazovic made one start for the Wind Surge on Tuesday vs. Springfield, pitching 4.1 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, one walk and eight strikeouts...the 22-year-old was drafted by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of St. Martin Secondary School in Mississauga, Ontario, and is currently listed as the No. 3 prospect in the organization per MLB.com

DID YOU KNOW?: Today's Bally Sports North analyst Glen Perkins went 6-1, 3.15 ERA (34.1 IP, 12 ER) with just two home runs allowed, eight walks, 26 strikeouts and five saves in 21 career games (3 starts) against the Texas Rangers...Perk's first career win came against the Rangers in a start on May 20, 2008 at the Metrodome, allowing three runs (2 earned) on six hits in 6.1 innings pitched in a Twins 11-4 victory...in 12 career games at Globe Life Park, 10 were scoreless.

LAST TIME OUT: Maeda returned from rehab and was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List to start on June 14 against the Mariners in Seattle...facing the Mariners for the first time in his professional career, he held Seattle to one run on three hits in 4.0 innings, with a season-high three walks and seven strikeouts – his second-highest single-start total this season...maneuvered out of a jam in the opening frame after walking the bases loaded with one out; induced a popout by Dylan Moore before striking out Jake Bauers to end the inning.

- ✎ Maeda missed 20 games with a right adductor strain, his fourth career trip to the IL and first with the Twins...made one rehab start for Triple-A St. Paul on June 9 vs. Omaha, permitting just one run on a solo homer, while striking out five batters and walking one in 4.0 innings of work...threw 54 pitches, 33 for strikes in the appearance...the Storm Chasers scored three runs in the ninth to win 5-2.

START PRIOR: Maeda was not part of the decision on May 22 at Cleveland, his last start prior to his Injured List stint...allowed three runs on three hits (1 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...was removed from the game with the right adductor injury and was placed on the 10-day Injured List the following day; went on to miss 20 games...the Twins tied the game in the sixth inning but ultimately fell to the Indians 5-3 in 10 innings.

MILESTONE MAN: Maeda surpassed two career milestones in his last start against the Mariners on June 14...at the end of his second inning of work he reached 700 career MLB innings, becoming the 10th Japanese-born pitcher to hit that plateau in the majors...the others are: Hideo Nomo (1,976.1 IP), Hiroki Kuroda (1,319.0 IP), Yu Darvish (1,211.0 IP), Tomo Ohka (1,070.0 IP), Masahiro Tanaka (1,054.1 IP), Hisashi Iwakuma (883.2 IP), Daisuke Matsuzaka (790.1 IP), Masato Yoshii (757.1 IP) and Shigetoshi Hasegawa (720.1 IP)...**additionally, Maeda's** **strikeout of Shed Long Jr. in the fourth inning was the 2,000th of his career combined between Nippon Professional Baseball (1,233) and Major League Baseball (767).**

RANGER REVIEW: Maeda faced the Rangers earlier this season on May 3 at Target Field...earned the win after shutting out Texas for 5.1 innings, allowing just two hits and two walks with a season-high eight strikeouts...he's 1-0-1, 2.38 ERA (11.1 IP, 3 ER) with seven walks, 10 strikeouts and a .195 opponent batting average (8-for-41) in three career appearances (2 starts) against the Rangers...both of his starts occurred as the home pitcher, while his relief appearance came in Arlington.

GO WEST: This afternoon marks Maeda's fifth start of the season against the American League West division, going 1-0, 6.06 ERA (16.1 IP, 11 ER) with six walks and 18 strikeouts in his four prior starts...is 3-4-1, 5.40 ERA (53.1 IP, 32 ER) in 13 career appearances (11 starts) vs. the AL West, his highest ERA against a single division in his career...has also made at least 10 career starts against all six divisions.

ON THE ROAD: Maeda is making his eighth road start of the season, going 1-1, 5.73 ERA (33.0 IP, 21 ER) in his seven prior outings...this compares to his 3.29 ERA (13.2 IP, 5 ER) in three starts at Target Field this season...all nine of the home runs and 16 of the 20 extra-base hits he's allowed so far this season have come on the road.

2021 ARSENAL: Maeda's slider has surpassed his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch over the last several seasons...he threw them equally in his rookie 2016 campaign and his four-seamer was his most frequent offering from 2017-19...however, his slider has been his top pitch since the start of 2020, followed by his split finger...here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:

OPPOSING COUNTS: Opponents are hitting .476 (10-for-21) off Maeda's first offering of an at-bat...his opponent batting average on the first pitch is the 10th highest among all major league pitchers (min. 20 opp. at-bats).

- ✎ Opponents are batting .212 (21-for-99) off Maeda with two strikes, far above the .087 (13-for-150) mark he held them to in 2020 and his career mark of .147 (224-for-1526)...the league average mark this season with two strikes is .161.
- ✎ When the count goes full, Maeda is holding opposing hitters to just 1-for-20 (.050), the sixth-lowest mark among all major league pitchers (min. 20 opp. at-bats)...however, of the five pitchers ranked above him in batting average in those circumstances, only one has issued fewer full-count walks than Maeda's seven (NYM's Marcus Stroman has a .040 BAA and 5 walks issued in full counts).

FANTASTIC FIRSTS AND TERRIBLE TWOS: Opponents are just 6-for-34 (.176) against Maeda in the first inning...that increases to 21-for-48 (.438) in the second inning and down to 11-for-42 (.262) in the third inning before dropping back to 5-for-31 (.161) in the fourth...has run into trouble in the fifth and sixth innings, where opposing hitters are a combined 12-for-34 (.353) against him...20 of his 31 runs allowed this season have occurred in the second and third innings combined.

- ✎ Nine of the 20 extra-base hits Maeda has allowed this season have occurred in innings three to five (5 doubles, 3 home runs).

DAYLIGHT, NOT ALRIGHT: This afternoon marks Maeda's seventh start of the season in a day game...he's 1-1, 6.08 ERA (26.2 IP, 18 ER) in his six day starts this year, compared to 1-1, 3.60 ERA (20.0 IP, 8 ER) in four starts under the lights.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP J.A. HAPP (2021 SEASON: 3-3, 6.12 ERA // CAREER: 126-95, 4.05 ERA)

Veteran southpaw Happ is due to start tomorrow night's series and homestand opener against the Cincinnati Reds at Target Field...was saddled with his third loss of the season in his last start on Tuesday in Seattle, yielding six runs (5 ER) on nine hits (1 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts in 4.0 innings...marked his third start this season allowing nine hits and his five strikeouts matched his second-highest single-start total (second time – season high is 10 K)...Happ last faced the Reds on May 30, 2017 with Toronto; took a no-decision at Rogers Centre, permitting two runs on three hits (2 HR), with three walks and three strikeouts in 4.0 innings as the Blue Jays eventually won 6-4...is 3-3, 5.36 ERA (50.1 IP, 30 ER) in nine career starts against Cincinnati...is also 15-9, 4.00 ERA (193.1 IP, 86 ER) in 34 appearances (33 starts) in Interleague Play.

CAREER NOTES

- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
