THE TWINS: Completed their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 4-2, going 1-2 in Seattle and 3-0 in Texas...tonight they will begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with two against Cincinnati this evening and tomorrow afternoon, followed by an off-day on Wednesday, then four against Cleveland from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 14-21 at home this season and 16-20 on the road.

TWINS SWEEP TO END THE TRIP: The Twins beat the Rangers yesterday afternoon by a score of 4-2 at Globe Life Field...they swept Texas in three games, marking their second sweep of the season...Kenta Maeda (3-2) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.1 innings pitched...the bullpen combined to hold a two-run lead and pitch 3.2 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded 14 hits, three apiece from Luis Arraez, Trevor Larnach and Andrelton Simmons...Byron Buxton recorded his 11th double and hit his 10th home run...the Twins also went 1-for-13 with runners in scoring position and left 10 men on base.

NATIONAL TREASURE: The Twins have gone 3-3 in Interleague Play this season, going 2-1 at Milwaukee from April 1-4 and 1-2 vs. Pittsburgh from April 23-25...after this series, their IL schedule is as follows: three at St. Louis July 30-August 1, two at Cincinnati August 3-4, three vs. Milwaukee August 27-29, two vs. Chicago-NL August 31-September 1 and two at Chicago-NL September 14-15.

Twins are 235-213 all-time in IL Play, the fifth-most wins in baseball, trailing Boston (273-182), New York-AL (262-187), Los Angeles-AL (249-203) and Oakland (245-209). Josh Donaldson is hitting .311 (153-for-492) with 27 doubles, 31 home runs, 98 RBI, 98 runs scored and a .959 OPS in 133 career IL games...his IL average ranks seventh among actives (minimum 300 plate appearances)...in his last 18 IL games, he is hitting .356 (21-for-59) with a 1.124 OPS, six doubles, five home runs and 17 RBI.

Nelson Cruz is hitting .278 (197-for-708) with 30 doubles, 53 home runs, 147 RBI and a .909 OPS in 200 career Interleague games...among actives, he ranks third in homers (Pujols - 67, Cabrera - 57) and RBI (Pujols - 230, Cabrera - 205).

TWINS AND REDS: The Twins and Reds are playing for the first of four scheduled meetings in 2021...the Twins will play a two-game series at Great American Ball Park from August 3-4...the last meeting between these two teams came in the final series of 2020 at Target Field as the Twins won the middle game of the three-game set...the Twins are 13-14 all-time against the Reds, going 2-4 at Target Field, 3-3 at Great American Ball Park, 7-2 at the Metrodome and 1-5 at Cinergy Field.

Andrelton Simmons is hitting .333 (31-for-93) with 10 doubles, five home runs, 10 RBI and a .969 OPS in 23 career games vs. the Reds.

BALLOT BOX UPDATE: Major League Baseball released its second balloting update for the 2021 All-Star Game...Byron Buxton ranks third among American League outfielders with 710,270 votes, trailing Mike Trout (1,371,004) and Aaron Judge (1,030,139)...Nelson Cruz ranks sixth among AL designated hitters with 163,618 votes, Mitch Garver ranks 10th among catchers with 69,608 votes and Josh Donaldson ranks 10th among third basemen with 114,751 votes...on Sunday, June 27, the top three vote-getters at each position (and the top nine outfielders) in each League will be revealed at 12:00 pm (ET) on the 2021 Google MLB All-Star Ballot Finalists Show exclusively on MLB Network, and they will advance to the second phase of voting to determine who makes the All-Star teams and starts for each League.

AS BUXTON GOES, SO DO TWINS: Byron Buxton is 3-for-9 with a double, a home run and two RBI since returning from the Injured List (right hip strain) on Saturday...on the season, he is hitting .366 (37-for-101) with 11 doubles, 10 home runs, 19 RBI, a .772 slugging percentage and a 1.174 OPS...he leads baseball in average, slugging percentage and OPS (minimum 100 plate appearances)...the Twins are 86-52 since the start of 2019 when he is in the starting lineup and 100-64 since 2018.

NELLY THE MACHINE: Nelson Cruz has a 15-game on-base streak, dating back to June 1...he's hitting .392 (20-for-51) with three doubles, five home runs, 12 RBI, nine walks, a .475 on-base percentage and a 1.221 OPS during the streak...his .475 on-base percentage is second in baseball for June, trailing only Baltimore's Cedric Mullins (.479).

MIKE BELL TRIBUTE TONIGHT: Tonight the Twins will honor the life and legacy of former bench coach Mike Bell, who passed away on March 26 at the age of 46 from cancer...tonight's game will also serve as the Twins' annual Cancer Awareness Night, as part of the club's theme nights lineup...members of the Bell family that will be in attendance this evening include Mike's brother and Reds manager David Bell, Mike's wife Kelly and their children Madeline, Mikayla, Luke; Luke's girlfriend, Emily; Mike's sister Kristi, her husband Bobby and their children Hayes, Baker and Bode; and Mike's mother Gloria...Mike Bell's 29 years in professional baseball, including his two with the Twins, left an indelible impact upon all those whom he met, an influence of positivity and kindness that will forever resonate both on and off the field...away from the ballpark, Mike's passionate work on behalf of GiGi's Playhouse helped further efforts to realize their vision of a world in which individuals with Down syndrome are accepted and embraced in their families, schools and communities.

Fans who purchase a ticket through the special Cancer Awareness Night theme night package will receive an exclusive Twins Cancer Awareness cap, available in 10 different colors corresponding to the most prevalent cancers seen in Twins Territory...additionally, as part of the Twins' longstanding efforts to strike out cancer, a portion of each ticket purchased through this special ticket package will be donated back to the American Cancer Society to support further research and awareness.

Here is the timeline for tonight's pregame ceremony: 7:01: Introduction of the Bell family. 7:03: Mike Bell tribute video. 7:06: Presentation of a gift from the 2021 Twins team to the Bell family, along with a \$10,000 donation to GiGi's Playhouse Twin Cities from the Twins and the Minnesota Twins Community Fund in Mike Bell's honor. 7:08: Ceremonial first pitch; the ball will be delivered by Twins manager Rocco Baldelli to Luke Bell (Mike's son), who will throw the pitch to be caught by David Bell (Mike's brother and Cincinnati Reds manager).

DINKELMAN 100: Single-A Cedar Rapids skipper Brian Dinkelman earned his 100th career managerial win in a 9-2 victory over South Bend yesterday...the former Twin has managed the Kernels for the last three seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Was dealt his third loss of the season on June 15 in Seattle after allowing six runs on a season-high-tying nine hits (1 HR) over 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...allowed a solo home run in the first inning to shortstop J.P. Crawford...left the game with a 0-6 score...marked Happ's first start this season without any run support, and the first time he received zero runs of support in a start since September 1, 2019 at Oakland (with New York-AL, 6.0 IP; Yankees won 5-4).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in the Twins' 7-5 walk-off victory vs. New York-AL on June 10 at Target Field...was Happ's first time facing the Yankees since playing for the club from 2018-20...allowed four runs on eight hits (2 HR) in 5.0 innings of work, with one walk and two strikeouts...eclipsed the 100-pitch mark for the third time this season.

SEEING RED: Happ is making his 10th career start and appearance vs. Cincinnati tonight and has gone 3-3, 5.36 ERA (50.1 IP, 30 ER) over his last nine outings against the Reds.

- ⌘ Last faced the Reds on May 30, 2017 at Rogers Centre with Toronto...did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on three hits (2 HR), with three walks and three strikeouts in an eventual 6-4 Toronto win.
- ⌘ Owns a 1-1, 3.00 ERA (24.0 IP, 8 ER) in four career outings at home vs. Cincinnati.
- ⌘ Has not lost in his last three starts against the Reds, dating back to September 9, 2015...is 2-0, 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER) with six walks, 20 strikeouts and a .161 opponent batting average (9-for-56) in that span.

INTERLEAGUE HISTORY: Tonight marks Happ's 35th career appearance and 34th start in Interleague Play, as well as his second Interleague start this season...tossed 7.1 no-hit innings before allowing a one-out double to Jacob Stallings in the top of the eighth on April 23 vs. Pittsburgh at Target Field...marked his first career start of at least 7.1 innings and just one hit allowed...Happ is 15-9, 4.00 ERA (193.1 IP, 86 ER) in his career in Interleague Play; his 15 Interleague wins are tied for 12th most among active players.

LOW TRAFFIC: Since the beginning of the 2018 season, Happ has averaged 11.37 base runners-per-9.0 innings, 12th fewest in the American League and 22nd fewest in the majors (min. 415.0 IP)...Happ has allowed the 13th-fewest total base runners (567) in the American League over that span (min. 415.0 IP).

RISP MANAGEMENT: Happ held opposing hitters to a .156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

- ⌘ However, this season opposing hitters are 15-for-54 (.278) against Happ with RISP, well above his career .232 mark (343-for-1476).

A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB: Happ's start on April 13 vs. Boston was the 300th of his career...he is one of 11 active pitchers to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (474), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (433), Ervin Santana (386), Max Scherzer (381), Clayton Kershaw (369), Adam Wainwright (340), Johnny Cueto (319), David Price (314) and Madison Bumgarner (307).

- ⌘ After tonight, he will have made at least 10 starts against 15 of 30 MLB teams.

PITCH SELECTION: This season Happ has featured five different pitches...he relies heavily on his four-seam fastball, throwing it more than half of the time...here is his 2021 repertoire, according to Baseball Savant:

DARE TO COMPARE: Happ has made 12 starts so far this season, taking the mound seven times at night and five times during the day...during his seven starts under the lights, he is 1-3, 8.02 (33.2 IP, 30 ER) with 10 walks, 19 strikeouts and a .380 opponent on-base percentage...however, his numbers significantly improve when the sun is up; during his five starts in the daytime, he is 2-0, 3.71 (26.2 IP, 11 ER) with eight walks, 25 strikeouts and a .278 opponent on-base percentage).

- ⌘ Six of his starts this season have come at Target Field and the other six have come on the road...his numbers at home outshine his record on the road.
- ⌘ He is 1-2, 7.98 (29.1 IP, 26 ER) with eight walks, 27 strikeouts on the road, while he is 2-1, 4.35 (31.0 IP, 15 ER) with 10 walks, 17 strikeouts at home.

FANNED BY DOUBLE DIGITS: Happ fanned a season-high 10 batters in Cleveland on May 23, his 12th career game with double-digit strikeouts...became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history age 38-or-older with at least 10 strikeouts in a start since Connie Marrero (age 39.037) on June 1, 1950 (12.0 IP, 10 K)...also became the third to do so in nine innings-or-less, joining Johnny Niggeling, who did it twice: August 16, 1944 (8.0 IP, 11 K) and July 8, 1944 (9.0 IP, 10 K).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2021 SEASON: 0-0, 3.71 ERA // CAREER: 0-0, 3.71 ERA)

Ober will take the mound for the series finale against Cincinnati at Target Field tomorrow afternoon...the rookie was selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston...has made four major league starts so far this season, going 0-0, 3.71 ERA (17.0 IP, 7 ER), with two walks and 21 strikeouts in that span...will be looking for his first career win as he faces Cincinnati for the first time...retired each of the first nine batters he faced in his last start at Seattle on June 16 and allowed just one hit over 4.0 innings, with no walks and six strikeouts; was his first career outing in which he did not allow a run...he departed with a 7-0 lead and took a no-decision as the Twins won 7-2...is in his second stint with the Twins this season...has made four starts this season with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER) with five walks and 21 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- Ranks fourth among active left-handed pitchers in wins (126) and starts (310), while he is fifth in innings pitched (1801.2) and seventh in strikeouts (1583).
- Pitched a career best of 7.1 hitless innings on April 23, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh...left the game allowing only one hit over 7.1 innings...combined with Tyler Duffey and Taylor Rogers on the 19th one-hitter in Twins history.
- Made his 300th career start April 13, 2021 vs. Boston.
- In 2020, led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655)...did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
- Has made 12 Opening Day rosters with six teams: Philadelphia (2009-10), Houston (2011-12), Toronto (2013, '16-18), Seattle (2015), New York-AL (2019-20) and Minnesota (2021).
- Enters 2021 with 14 MLB seasons under his belt, with the Phillies (2007-10), Astros (2010-12), Blue Jays (2012-14, '16-18), Mariners (2015), Pirates (2015) and Yankees (2018-20).
- Made his 300th career major league appearance and 275th career start on June 23, 2019 vs. Houston.
- Compiled a career-best 19.1-inning scoreless streak from August 26-September 12-G1, 2019, the AL's eighth-longest scoreless streak in 2019 and longest by a Yankee.
- Finished sixth in 2016 AL Cy Young Award voting after going 20-4, 3.18 ERA for Toronto and tying for the second-most wins in baseball...marks his only career 20-win season and is one of just seven pitchers in the majors (and one of two southpaws) with a 20-win campaign in 2016.
- Finished second in 2009 BBWAA NL Rookie of the Year balloting to Florida's Chris Coghlan...appeared on all 32 ballots, receiving 10 first-place votes...won the 2009 Players' Choice Award for NL Outstanding Rookie...named 2009 NL Rookie of the Year by The Sporting News.
- Selected by Philadelphia in the third round of the 2004 First-Year Player Draft out of Northwestern University...debuted for the Phillies on June 30, 2007.
