THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 4-2 (1-2 in Seattle and $3-0$ in Texas), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day Ohio homestand with a victory over the Reds last night...today they will play the two-game series finale with Cincy, enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then play four against Cleveland from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 15-21 at home this season and 16-20 on the road.
$\Phi$ A win today would give the Twins their sixth-consecutive victory, extending their sea-
son-long winning streak and marking their longest since July 31-August 5, 2020 (also 6)
MARATHON VICTORY: The Twins beat the Reds last night by a score of $7-5$ in 12 innings...J.A. Happ was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on five hits in 4.2 innings pitched...Matt Shoemaker (3-8) earned the win in relief -- his first out of the bullpen since August 9,2014 vs. Boston (with Los Angeles-AL) -- with 2.0 scoreless innings, no hits allowed and three strikeouts...the offense recorded 13 hits, including home runs from Miguel Sanó (14) and Nelson Cruz (16)...for Sanó, it was his third career walk-off plate appearance and second via home run, the other coming on August 5, 2019 at Atlanta...was the Twins' first walkoff homer in extra innings since Brian Dozier's 1'0th inning grand slam on July 15, 2018 (off Matt Andriese) gave Minnesota an 11-7 victory over Tampa Bay...the game was played in five hours and 14 minutes, the longest game in baseball this season and ninth-longest extra-inning game in club history....marked the Twins' fourth-consecutive extra-innings victory, after starting the season 0-8 in extras.
ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed outfielder Byron Buxton on the 10-day Injured List with a left hand fracture...Buxton, who returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List on Saturday (right hip strain), suffered the injury last night after being hit by a pitch in the fourth inning....Buxton has hit .369 (38-for-103) with 11 doubles, 10 home runs, $19 \mathrm{RBI}, 21$ runs scored, a .767 slugging percentage and a 1.176 OPS in 27 games this season...he had gone 4 -for-11 with a double and a home run since his recent return...to replace Buxton on the 26 -man roster, the Twins have recalled outtielder Gilberto Celestino from Triple-A St. Paul...Celestino, who was ontioned to St. Paul on Friday, has hit . 125 (4-for-32) with one double, one home run and one RBI in 10 games for the Twins this season.

CRUZ CRUSH: Nelson Cruz has six home runs in his last 11 games...last night's home run was the 433rd of his career, moving within one of tying Andruw Jones and Juan Gonzalez for 47th on baseball's all-time list...he passed Cal Ripken Jr. on Saturday...below are his ranks on MLB's all-time list (left)

for fourth most in a player's first four in Twins history, trailing only Dave Boswell ( 25 K ), Fernando Romero ( 22 K ) and Jim Merritt ( 22 K )
$\Phi$ Ober's two walks allowed through his first four career appearances are the fewest in Twins history among pitchers whose first four career outings were all starts.

START PRIOR: Settled for a no-decision despite setting several career highs in his start on June 11 vs. Houston...fanned a career-high seven batters over a career-long 5.0 innings, while allowing two runs on a career-high seven hits (1 HR), with one walk...allowed one run on a sacrifice fly in the third
and another on a solo homer in the fifth...his 15 career strikeouts through his first three career games and another on a solo homer in the fitth...his 15 career strikeouts through his first three career games
marked the most by a wins pitcher since José Berríos had 19 strikeouts in his first three in 2016 .
SECOND START SUMMARY: In his second career start, did not factor into the decision in the Twins 2-1 victory June 6 at Kansas City, opposite Brady Singer...made second career start and helped the

WALKING TALL: Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is one of just five players 6-8-or-taller to suit up for the Twins and Senators, as well as just the third pitcher of that height to debut for Minnesota or Washington...additionally, Ober's 21 career strikeouts are 12th most among all pitchers 6-9-or-taller in major league history...the other pitchers 6-8-or-taller to play for the Twins are:


CAREER REDUX: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25 -year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a . 222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances ( 35 starts)...was added to the Twins 40 -man roster on November 20, 2020 and is currently ranked as the 22nd-best prospect in the Twins system by MLB. com.
$\Phi$ Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).
$\Phi$ Over that same time span, Ober ranks fourth by allowing just 8.79 base runners-per- 9.0 innings,
