**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 4-2 (1-2 in Seattle and 3-0 in Texas), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day all-Ohio homestand with a two-game split with the Reds earlier this week...they will continue the homestand tonight with the first of four with Cleveland tonight through the weekend...the Twins have gone 15-22 at home this season and 16-20 on the road.

**LATE RUNS FALL SHORT:** The Twins lost to the Reds on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 10-7, splitting the two-game series...the Twins scored five runs in the bottom of the eighth to tie the game but lost in the top of the ninth on a Tyler Naquin three-run homer...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits in 4.1 innings pitched...Hansel Robles (3-4) was issued the loss, allowing three runs on two hits in 1.0 inning of relief...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Trevor Larnach, who hit his fifth home run of the season...Max Kepler and Ryan Jeffers also added home runs, Kepler hitting his sixth and Jeffers hitting his fifth.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Randy Dobnak on the 10-day Injured List with a strained right middle finger (retro to June 21)...Dobnak has pitched in 13 games this season (5 starts), going 1-6, 7.83 ERA (43.2 IP, 38 ER), 12 walks, 25 strikeouts and one save...to replace Dobnak on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Griffin Jax from Triple-A St. Paul...Jax, who made his major league debut on June 8, posted an 8.64 ERA (8.1 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and nine strikeouts in his first stint with the Twins...in five starts for the Saints, the right-hander went 3-1 with a 3.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 10 ER), 10 walks and 29 strikeouts.

**TWINS AND CLEVELAND:** The Twins are playing the Indians for the seventh of 19 meetings in 2021...they have gone 3-3 against Cleveland this season...they are hosting the Tribe for the first time this season after visiting Cleveland for three from April 26-28 and three from May 21-23...in the six games this season, the Twins have outscored Cleveland 38-24.

☞ Since the start of 2020, 13 of the 16 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and eight have been decided by two runs-or-less.

**CRUZ CRUSH:** Nelson Cruz has six home runs in his last 12 games...he has 433 career home runs, one shy of Andruw Jones and Juan Gonzalez for 47th on baseball's all-time list...he passed Cal Ripken Jr. on Saturday...below are his ranks on MLB's all-time list (left) and all-time among active Dominican-born players:

**NELLY THE MACHINE:** Nelson Cruz has a 17-game on-base streak, dating back to June 1...he's hitting .400 (24-for-60) with four doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI, 10 walks, a .486 on-base percentage and a 1.253 OPS during the streak...his .486 on-base percentage this month is third in baseball (minimum 60 plate appearances), trailing Houston's Michael Brantley (.565) and Cincinnati's Tyler Stephenson (.492).

**SUMMER IS ROOKIE SZN:** Individual Twins rookie numbers this month:

- ☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .302 (19-for-63) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, nine RBI, six walks and a .362 on-base percentage in 18 June games.
- ☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .275 (19-for-69) with three doubles, two home runs, five RBI and four walks in 19 games this month.
- ☞ Nick Gordon is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with one double, one home run, two RBI, four runs scored and is three-for-three in stolen base attempts...his average is tied for fifth among all rookies this month (minimum 30 plate appearances).
- ☞ Ryan Jeffers has eight extra-base hits this month (14 total hits) — two doubles, one triple and five home runs...he also has 13 RBI and a .600 slugging percentage in 15 June games...his slugging percentage this month is tied for third best among all MLB rookies (minimum 40 PA).

**ICYMI:** The Twins announced on Tuesday that they have claimed right-handed pitcher Beau Burrows off waivers from the Detroit Tigers...Burrows, 24, made his major league debut on July 27, 2020 and appeared in six major league games for the Tigers from 2020-21, posting an 8.64 ERA (8.1 IP, 8 ER) with three walks, six strikeouts and a 1.56 WHIP...a native of Fort Worth, Texas, Burrows was selected by Detroit in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Weatherford (TX) High School.

### THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ The Twins have a team OPS of .784 so far in June, sixth best in the majors and fourth best in the American League.
- ☞ In six games since June 16, the Twins' bullpen has a 2.51 ERA (28.2 IP, 8 ER), third lowest in the majors in that span behind only Houston (1.35 ERA) and Miami (1.65 ERA)...the 'pen is holding opposing hitters to a .214 batting average in that timeframe.
- ☞ The Twins have hit 22 sacrifice flies this season, fourth most in the majors.
- ☞ Today is former Twins pitcher Phil Hughes' 35th birthday...the righty went 32-29 with a 4.43 ERA (489.2 IP, 241 ER) in parts of five seasons for the Twins...today is also the birthday of the late original Twin Don Mincher, who played for the Twins/Senators from 1960-66...Mincher's 23.1 career WAR (per Baseball Reference) is second highest among all players born on June 24.

**LAST START:** Did not factor into the decision last Friday at Texas, despite notching his team-leading fifth quality start...worked 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits with one walk and six strikeouts...surrendered two runs in the first inning on consecutive RBI singles by Nick Solak and Willie Calhoun...allowed his third run on a Jose Trevino sacrifice fly in the fourth inning, scoring Eli White...retired the final seven men he faced and exited with a 4-3 lead; the Rangers tied the game in the seventh but the Twins won the game 7-5 in 10 innings...marked Berrios' 25th-consecutive start allowing four earned runs-or-fewer, dating back to July 30, 2020, the longest such streak for a Twins pitcher since Johan Santana recorded 35-straight starts of four earned runs-or-fewer from July 15, 2006-July 18, 2007.

**START PRIOR:** Earned his team-leading seventh win of the season May 12 vs. Houston...pitched 7.0 innings of two-run ball, allowing five hits (2 HR) and one walk while striking out eight...worked 6.1 scoreless innings before allowing back-to-back solo home runs to Kyle Tucker and Robel Garcia...gave way to Hansel Robles and Taylor Rogers, who each pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief to seal the Twins' 5-2 victory...marked Berrios' 32nd career win at Target Field, matching former Twin Kyle Gibson for the most in the history of the ballpark.

**GOING STREAKING:** His current five-game winning streak matches the longest of his career, previously done April 14-May 7, 2019.

- ☞ Is 5-0, 3.81 ERA (56.2 IP, 24 ER) with 13 walks and 54 strikeouts in nine starts since May 2...has completed at least 5.0 innings in all nine of those games (Twins are 8-1).
- ☞ Twins hitters have supported Berrios with 38 runs during that stretch (6.04 run support average), tied for the fourth-highest total among all American League starters in that span.
- ☞ His last losing decision came in the second game of the doubleheader at Oakland on April 20, when he surrendered one run on four hits with one walk and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings in a 1-0 A's victory.

**700 CLUB:** This season, Berrios has surpassed both 700 strikeouts and 700.0 innings pitched for his career...his 700th strikeout came in the fifth inning on May 15 vs. Oakland, fanning Seth Brown...became the 15th Twin to reach 700 strikeouts and the 28th Twin to reach 700.0 innings pitched.

- ☞ He needs 30 strikeouts to tie Scott Baker (770) for 12th on the Twins all-time strikeout list (list in lower right area of page).

**TRIBE TALK:** Is 5-3, 3.91 ERA (78.1 IP, 34 ER) with 27 walks and 73 strikeouts in 14 career starts vs. Cleveland.

- ☞ Has made one start against Cleveland this season, working 5.2 innings and allowing two runs on five hits with one walk and three strikeouts on April 26 at Progressive Field...did not factor into the decision as he exited the game with a 2-2 tie; the Indians went on to win 5-3 in 10 innings.
- ☞ Owns a 2-3, 4.88 ERA (31.1 IP, 17 ER) with 11 walks and 33 strikeouts in six career starts vs. the Indians at Target Field...has made one additional start vs. Cleveland as the home team at Hiram Bithorn Stadium in San Juan, Puerto Rico on April 18, 2018 (ND, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 K).
- ☞ His 14 career starts vs. Cleveland are his third most vs. any opponent, having made 17 starts against both Chicago-AL and Kansas City.

**SLICK LEATHER:** He has four defensive runs saved this season, good for second best in baseball among all pitchers, trailing only Chicago-AL's Dallas Keuchel (6)...Berrios finished tied for fifth in baseball among pitchers in DRS in 2020 with one...since 2019, he ranks tied for seventh in DRS with five.

**RIGHTY TIGHTY:** Berrios is holding right-handed hitters to a .172 (29-for-169) average with five doubles, three home runs, eight walks and 48 strikeouts, compared to lefties hitting .293 (41-for-140) with 12 doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 13 walks and 39 strikeouts against him...his right-handed opponent batting average ranks second in the AL (min. 150 opp. AB), behind only Chicago-AL's Carlos Rodón (.160).

**TOP OF THE CLASS:** Berrios has 52 wins since the start of 2017, second most in the American League in that span, trailing only Justin Verlander (53)...MLB-wide in that time frame, 52 wins is tied for seventh in the majors, trailing Gerrit Cole (62), Zack Greinke (61), Clayton Kershaw (57), Max Scherzer (56), Charlie Morton (54) and Verlander (53), and is tied with Trevor Bauer (52)...his 691 strikeouts are fourth in the AL, trailing Cole (819), Verlander (816) and Chris Sale (763).

- ☞ His 25.7% strikeout percentage ranks in the 60th percentile in baseball and is currently the highest single-season mark of his career.
- ☞ Ranks in the lower 26th percentile in barrel percentage (9.8%).
- ☞ Has walked just 21 batters in 338 opponent plate appearances this season, good for a 6.2 walk percentage, ranking in the 80th percentile of all MLB pitchers...6.4% is a vast improvement from 2020 for Berrios, who walked 9.6% of batters last season.
- ☞ Has a strikeout percentage of 37.1% on his curveball, which ranks ninth in the American League (min. 50 PA).

CAREER NOTES

- Named to 2018 and 2019 AL All-Star teams, pitching 1.0 inning in both games.
- Started Game 1 of the 2019 ALDS against New York-AL and Game 2 of the 2020 AL Wild Card Series vs. Houston.
- In 2019, teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 K on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893, when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall-of-Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.
- Given the 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of BBWAA...also won the Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.
