THE TWINS: Have gone 1-2 through three games on their six-game, seven-day all-Ohio homestand, splitting a two-game series with Cincinnati, followed by a loss to Cleveland last night...tonight they will play the second of four with the Indians...they will conclude the series on Sunday, then travel to Chicago to begin a seven-game roadtrip with four against the White Sox from June 28-July 1, and then three against the Royals from July 2-4...the Twins have gone 15-23 at home this season and 16-20 on the road.

☞ The Twins have won five of their last seven games.

ROSIE GETS THE TWINS IN GAME ONE: The Twins lost to the Indians last night by a score of 4-1 as former Twin Eddie Rosario drove in the game winning run with an eighth-inning single...José Berríos was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 6.1 innings pitched, while striking out nine...Jorge Alcalá (1-2) was issued the loss, allowing three runs in the top of the eighth...the offense recorded six hits, two apiece from Josh Donaldson and Jorge Polanco...Polanco hit his team-leading 17th double and team-leading 19th multi-hit game...the Twins also went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position and left six men on base.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Luke Farrell on the 10-day Injured List with a right oblique strain...Farrell has appeared in 13 games for the Twins this season, going 1-0 with a 1.76 ERA (15.1 IP, 3 ER), six walks and 17 strikeouts...to replace Farrell on the 26-man roster, the Twins have selected the contract of left-handed pitcher Danny Coulombe from Triple-A St. Paul...Coulombe has appeared in 14 games for the Saints this season, going 1-1 with a 1.77 ERA (20.1 IP, 4 ER), three walks and 27 strikeouts, including scoreless appearances in each of his last seven outings...the 31-year-old pitched in two games for the Twins in 2020, tossing 2.2 scoreless innings in late August.

TWINS AND CLEVELAND: The Twins are playing the Indians for the eighth of 19 meetings in 2021...they have gone 3-4 against Cleveland this season...in the seven games this season, the Twins have outscored Cleveland 39-27.

☞ Since the start of 2020, 14 of the 17 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and eight have been decided by two runs-or-less.

☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .291 (58-for-199) with seven doubles, two triples, 13 home runs, 44 RBI, 32 walks and a .933 OPS in 52 career games vs. Cleveland.

☞ Max Kepler has 17 career home runs against the Tribe, his most against any opponents (next: White Sox - 13, Tigers - 12)...additionally, his 71 career hits are also his most.

☞ Miguel Sanó has seven home runs in his last 14 games against Cleveland.

BASEPATH BOUNTIES: The Twins have been caught stealing just thrice in 30 stolen base attempts so far this season, good for a 90 percent success rate that leads the majors...last time a Twins runner was thrown out on the basepaths occurred on May 23 at Cleveland (Alex Kirilloff)...for context, the single-season club record for team stolen base percent is 78.9, done by the 2007 Twins team, which went 112-for-142 in steal attempts...Max Kepler currently leads the club with seven thefts this season, a new single-season career-best total for him...the Twins also have four players with at least five steals each so far, their most in a single campaign since having five such players in 2018.

'PENMANSHIP: Despite last night's loss, the Twins' bullpen has a 3.08 ERA (26.1 IP, 9 ER) in six games in the last week, since June 18...the 'pen's ERA in that span is fourth best in the American League and sixth best in the majors.

RATED ROOKIES: Individual Twins rookie numbers this month:

☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .284 (19-for-67) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, nine RBI, six walks and a .342 on-base percentage in 19 June games...his 19 hits this month are tied with Trevor Larnach for eighth most among all rookies.

☞ Nick Gordon is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with one double, one home run, two RBI, four runs scored and is three-for-three in stolen base attempts...his average is sixth among all rookies this month (minimum 30 plate appearances).

☞ Ryan Jeffers has eight extra-base hits this month (14 total hits) — two doubles, one triple and five home runs...he also has 13 RBI and a .600 slugging percentage in 15 June games...he ranks third among all rookies this month in slugging percentage and eighth in OPS (.905).

THIS AND THAT:

☞ Nick Gordon is hitting .344 (11-for-32) against right-handed pitching...Luis Arraez is hitting .304 (38-for-125) against right-handed pitching.

☞ Nelson Cruz has 433 career home runs and needs one to tie Juan Gonzalez and Andruw Jones for 47th on baseball's all-time list.

☞ Josh Donaldson has an OPS of .976 with 17 hits, three doubles, five home runs, seven RBI, eight walks and a .382 on-base percentage in his last 18 games.

☞ The Twins have hit 107 homers on the season, the third most in baseball, trailing San Francisco (111) and Toronto (109)...Twins have 54 home runs at Target Field and 53 on the road...they have 69 homers vs. right-handed pitchers and 38 vs. left-handers.

☞ The Twins, together with partners Saint Paul Parks and Recreation, CUB Pharmacy, Boys & Girls Clubs of the Twin Cities and Twins RBI, today announced they will hold a pair of free community youth and family vaccination clinics, open to individuals 12-or-older, on Saturday, June 26...the first will be from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the Jerry Gamble Boys & Girls Club, located at 2410 N. Irving Avenue in Minneapolis...the second is scheduled for 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. at the Arlington Hills Community Center, located at 1200 Payne Avenue in St. Paul.
