THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their six-game, seven-day all-Ohio home-
stand, splitting a two-game series with Cincinnati, followed by splitting the first two games
with Clevelandtoday they will play the third of four with the Indiansthey will conclude the
series tomorrow afternoon, then travel to Chicago to begin a seven-game roadtrip with four
against the White Sox from June 28-July 1, and then three against the Royals from July 2-4
the Twins have gone 16-23 at home this season and 16-20 on the road.

The Twins have won six of their last eight games and 10 of their last 18.

THE LUIS ARRAEZ GAME: The Twins beat the Indians last night by a score of 8-7, evening the series at one game apiece...Danny Coulombe was the Opener, allowing three runs (1 earned) on two hits in 1.2 innings pitched...Griffin Jax (1-0) earned his first career win, allowing three runs on three hits in 4.1 innings pitched...Alex Colomé (4) and Taylor Rogers (6) earned holds while Hansel Robles earned his seventh save...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Luis Arraez, who tripled twice (3, 4) and doubled (5).

The Arraez became the fourth player in Twins history with two triples and a double in a game, in Taylor Carlos Comez (September 25, 2008 vs. Chicago. Al.). Chuck Knoblauch (June 29)

joining Carlos Gómez (September 25, 2008 vs. Chicago-AL), Chuck Knoblauch (June 29, 1996 at Kansas City) and Rod Carew (May 8, 1977 at Toronto)...also became the first Twins hitter to accumulate at least eight total bases in a game without hitting a home run since Joe Mauer (single, 2 doubles, triple) on August 3, 2016 at Cleveland.

JUNE BOOM: Twins have won six of their last eight games after starting June with a record of 4-10...below are number comparisons from the first 14 and the last eight:

TWINS AND CLEVELAND: The Twins are playing the Indians for the ninth of 19 meetings in 2021...they have gone 4-4 against Cleveland this season...in the eight games this season, the Twins have outscored Cleveland 47-35.

Since the start of 2020, 15 of the 18 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and nine have been decided by two runs-or-less.

Josh Donaldson is hitting .294 (59-for-201) with seven doubles, two triples, 13 home runs, 46 RBI, 33 walks and a .935 OPS in 53 career games vs. Cleveland.

Max Kepler has 17 career home runs against the Tribe, his most against any opponent (next: White Sox - 13, Tigers - 12)...additionally, his 71 career hits are also his most.

Miguel Sanó has seven home runs in his last 14 games against Cleveland.

Kenta Maeda has gone 3-1, 2.51 ERA (28.2 IP, 8 ER) with five walks, 29 strikeouts and a .192 opponent batting average in five starts against the Tribe since joining the Twins prior to the 2020 season...he went 3-0, 0.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 1 ER) with one home run allowed (Cesar Hernandez) in three starts last season but is 0-1, 5.91 ERA (10.2 IP, 7 allowed (Cesar Hernandez) in three starts last season but is 0-1, 5.91 ERA (10.2 IP, 7 FR) in two starts this season.

Cleveland starter Sam Hentges was born in Shoreview, MN and attended Mounds View High School, approximately 12 miles northeast of Target Field...in 2014, he was named Gatorade Minnesota Baseball Player of the Year...he was a finalist for the Mr. Baseball Minnesota Award in 2014 but lost out to Rochester Mayo's Brad Mathiowetz.

DIVISIONAL CRUZ: Since joining the Twins prior to the 2019 season, Nelson Cruz has hit .335 (151-for-451) with 24 doubles, 44 home runs, 112 RBI, 55 walks, a .685 slugging percentage and a 1.095 OPS in 121 games against the American League Central...here are his home runs by division opponent in that span:

SOME LOVE FOR THE LEFTIES: The Twins are hitting .255 (221-for-867) with a .446 slugging

percentage and a .755 OPS vs. lefties this season, compared to .242 (405-for-1675) with a .424 slugging and a .743 OPS against righties.

Twins rank fourth in baseball in slugging percentage vs. lefties, trailing Houston (.459), Colorado (.449) and Chicago-AL (.447)...additionally, their OPS vs. lefties ranks sixth in

₱ Nelson Cruz is hitting .390 (32-for-82) with six doubles, six home runs and a 1.121 OPS vs. lefties this season...in his last 10 games vs. lefties, he is hitting .565 (13-for-23) with three doubles, three home runs, two walks and a 1.702 OPS.
 ₱ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with two doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.164 OPS vs. lefties...four of his five home runs have come against lefties, including his last, which was off Lucas Sims on Tuesday vs. Cincinnati.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1977, on Jersey Day in Minnesota, every fan received a jersey with #29 on it, Rod Carew's number...Carew responded by going 4-for-5, scoring four runs, and raising his average to .403...one of the hits was a grand slam...teammate Glenn Adams drove in eight as the Twins beat the White Sox, 19-12.

YOU KNOW GLEN?: Bally Sports North analyst Glen Perkins appeared in 44 games (2 starts) in his career against the Indians, going 4-2, 3.40 ERA (55.2 IP, 21 ER) with 13 walks, 50 strikeouts and 16 saves (17 opportunities)...the 16 saves were tied with the White Sox for his most against any opponent...Perk's first career win over Cleveland came on July 6, 2008 at the Metrodome, pitching 7.0 innings opposite that season's AL Cy Young Award winner Cliff Lee.

LAST TIME OUT: Maeda earned his third win of the season and first since May 3 in his last start on June 20 at Texas...worked 5.1 innings of five-hit, two-run ball, walking one while striking out four batters as the Twins beat the Rangers 4-2...pitched 5.0 shutout innings before allowing a pair of one-out solo shots to Adolis García and Joey Gallo in the sixth and departing in favor of Tyler Duffey... the Twins' bullpen tossed 3.2 scoreless innings in relief to close out the win.

START PRIOR: Returned from rehab and was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List to start on June 14 against the Mariners in Seattle...facing the Mariners for the first time in his professional career, he held Seattle to one run on three hits in 4.0 innings, with a season-high three walks and seven strikeouts — his second-highest single-start total this season...maneuvered out of a jam in the opening frame after walking the bases loaded with one out; induced a popout by Dylan Moore before striking out Jake Bauers to end the inning.

COUNTER CLEVELAND: Today marks Maeda's third start of the season against the Indians, first at Target Field...shouldered the loss on April 27 at Progressive Field, working 5.2 innings and allowing five runs (4 ER) on seven hits (3 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts...paired with his start on April 21, yielded three longballs in consecutive starts for the first time in his career and became the fifth starting pitcher in Twins/Senators history to allow at least three home runs and zero walks in back-to-back starts, first since Michael Pineda did so from May 11-16, 2019...also faced Cleveland on May 22, his final outing prior to going on the 10-day Injured List; permitted three runs on three hits (1 HR) in 5.0 inplines before being removed from the game with a right adductor injury.

To ls 3-1, 2.51 ERA (28.2 IP, 8 ER), five walks, 29 strikeouts and a .192 opponent batting average (20-for-104) in four career starts against Cleveland...his ERA is his third-lowest mark against any opponent that he's faced at least thrice in his career, behind only his ERAs against Atlanta (2.00) and Miami (2.28).

CENTRAL-FUGAL FORCE: Maeda is 1-1, 4.98 ERA (121.2 IP, 12 ER), four walks, 18 strikeouts and a .259 (21-for-81) opponent batting average in four starts against the AL Central so far this season... went 5-1, 2.74 ERA (46.0 IP, 14 ER) in eight starts against the AL Central last season...is 9-3, 3.35 ERA (88.2 IP, 33 ER) in 16 career starts vs. the division, marking his second-best career ERA against any single division (NL East - 3.11 ERA).

HOMEWARD BOUND: Is making his fourth home start of the season today, going 1-1, 3.29 ERA (13.2 IP, 5 ER) across his three prior starts on April 14 vs. Boston, May 3 vs. Texas and May 16 vs. Oakland... went 3-0, 1.91 ERA (33.0 IP, 7 ER), six walks, 42 strikeouts and a .109 BAA (12-for-110) in five home starts in 2020; led the majors in home BAA (min. 100 AB)...did not allow more than three earned runs or more than four hits in any of his five Target Field starts last season.

The Mada is 4-1, 2.31 ERA (46.2 IP, 12 ER) in eight career starts at Target Field...his 2.31 ERA here is the second lowest mark by any nitcher in the history of this ballnark (min. 40 0 IP at Target).

MILESTONE MAN: Maeda surpassed two career milestones in his start against the Mariners in Seattle on June 14...at the end of his second inning of work he reached 700 career MLB innings, becoming the 10th Japanese-born pitcher to hit that plateau in the majors...the others are: Hideo Nomo (1,976.1 In the Inabariese-both pitcher to fit that plateau in the Inabots...the others are: Indee Notino (1,576.1 FP), Hiroki Kuroda (1,319.0 IP), Yu Darvish (1,217.0 IP), Tomo Ohka (1,070.0 IP), Masahiro Tanaka (1,054.1 IP), Hisashi Iwakuma (883.2 IP), Daisuke Matsuzaka (790.1 IP), Masato Yoshii (757.1 IP) and Shigetoshi Hasegawa (720.1 IP)...additionally, Maeda's strikeout of Shed Long Jr. in the fourth inning was the 2,000th of his career...he now has 2,004 strikeouts combined between Nippon Professional Baseball (1,233) and Major League Baseball (771).

2021 ARSENAL: Maeda's slider has surpassed his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch over the last several seasons...he threw them equally in his rookie 2016 campaign and his four-seamer was his most frequent offering from 2017-19...however, his slider has been his top pitch since the start of 2020, followed by his split finger...here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:

FANTASTIC FIRSTS AND TERRIBLE TWOS: Opponents are just 7-for-38 (.184) against Maeda in the first inning...that increases to 21-for-51 (.412) in the second inning and down to 12-for-46 (.261) in the third inning before dropping back to 6-for-35 (.171) in the fourth inning...has run into trouble in the fifth and sixth innings, where opposing hitters are a combined 14-for-40 (.350) against him...20 of his 33 runs allowed this season have occurred in the second and third innings combined.
