**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-2 through four games on their all-Ohio homestand, splitting a two-game series with Cincinnati, followed by splitting the first two games with Cleveland...today they will play the series finale with the Indians after a rainout yesterday afternoon...after today's game, they will travel to Chicago to begin a seven-game roadtrip with four against the White Sox from Monday-Thursday, and then three against the Royals next weekend...the Twins have gone 16-23 at home this season and 16-20 on the road.

☞ The Twins have won six of their last eight games and 10 of their last 18.  
 ☞ Yesterday's game against Cleveland was postponed due to inclement weather and will be made up as part of a split doubleheader on September 14...the first game will be the makeup of yesterday's game and will start at 1:10 p.m., followed by the regularly-scheduled game at 6:40 p.m...per Major League Baseball rules, both games of the September 14 doubleheader will be seven-inning contests.

**THE LUIS ARRAEZ GAME:** The Twins beat the Indians on Friday night by a score of 8-7, evening the series at one game apiece...Danny Coulombe was the Opener, allowing three runs (1 earned) on two hits in 1.2 innings pitched...Griffin Jax (1-0) earned his first career win, allowing three runs on three hits in 4.1 innings pitched...Alex Colomé (4) and Taylor Rogers (6) earned holds while Hansel Robles earned his seventh save...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Luis Arraez, who tripled twice (3, 4) and doubled (5).

☞ Arraez became the fourth player in Twins history with two triples and a double in a game, joining Carlos Gómez (September 25, 2008 vs. Chicago-AL), Chuck Knoblauch (June 29, 1996 at Kansas City) and Rod Carew (May 8, 1977 at Toronto)...also became the first Twins hitter to accumulate at least eight total bases in a game without hitting a home run since Joe Mauer (single, 2 doubles, triple) on August 3, 2016 at Cleveland.

**JUNE BOOM:** Twins have won six of their last eight games after starting June with a record of 4-10...below are number comparisons from the first 14 and the last eight:

**TWINS AND CLEVELAND:** The Twins are playing the Indians for the ninth of 19 meetings in 2021...these two teams will meet next for three games at Target Field from August 16-18...the Twins have gone 4-4 against Cleveland this season, outscoring the Indians 47-35.

☞ Since the start of 2020, 15 of the 18 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and nine have been decided by two runs-or-less.  
 ☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .294 (59-for-201) with seven doubles, two triples, 13 home runs, 46 RBI, 33 walks and a .935 OPS in 53 career games vs. Cleveland.  
 ☞ Max Kepler has 17 career home runs against the Tribe, his most against any opponent (next: White Sox - 13, Tigers - 12)...additionally, his 71 career hits are also his most.  
 ☞ Miguel Sanó has seven home runs in his last 14 games against Cleveland.  
 ☞ Cleveland starter Sam Hentges was born in Shoreview, MN and attended Mounds View High School, approximately 12 miles northeast of Target Field...in 2014, he was named Gatorade Minnesota Baseball Player of the Year...he was a finalist for the Mr. Baseball Minnesota Award in 2014 but lost out to Rochester Mayo's Brad Mathiowetz.

**DIVISIONAL CRUZ:** Since joining the Twins prior to the 2019 season, Nelson Cruz has hit .335 (151-for-451) with 24 doubles, 44 home runs, 112 RBI, 55 walks, a .685 slugging percentage and a 1.095 OPS in 121 games against the American League Central...here are his home runs by division opponent in that span:

**SOME LOVE FOR THE LEFTIES:** The Twins are hitting .255 (221-for-867) with a .446 slugging percentage and a .755 OPS vs. lefties this season, compared to .242 (405-for-1675) with a .424 slugging and a .743 OPS against righties.

☞ Twins rank fourth in baseball in slugging percentage vs. lefties, trailing Houston (.459), Colorado (.448) and Chicago-AL (.447)...additionally, their OPS vs. lefties ranks sixth in baseball.  
 ☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .390 (32-for-82) with six doubles, six home runs and a 1.121 OPS vs. lefties this season...his average against lefties leads all of baseball...in his last 10 games vs. lefties, he is hitting .565 (13-for-23) with three doubles, three home runs, two walks and a 1.702 OPS.  
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with two doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.164 OPS vs. lefties...four of his five home runs have come against lefties, including his last, which was off Lucas Sims on Tuesday vs. Cincinnati.

**TWINS ML WEEKLYS:** Double-A Wichita infielder Jose Miranda and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Josh Winder (WINE-der) have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Miranda hit .536 (15-for-28) with two doubles, three home runs, four RBI, two walks and a 1.495 OPS in six games for the Wind Surge, including a five-hit game on Thursday at Midland.  
 ☞ Winder made one start for the Wind Surge coming on Wednesday at Midland, allowing one run on four hits in 7.0 innings pitched with no walks and seven strikeouts.

**YOU KNOW GLEN?:** Bally Sports North analyst Glen Perkins appeared in 44 games (2 starts) in his career against the Indians, going 4-2, 3.40 ERA (55.2 IP, 21 ER) with 13 walks, 50 strikeouts and 16 saves (17 opportunities)...the 16 saves were tied with the White Sox for his most against any opponent...Perk's first career win over Cleveland came on July 6, 2008 at the Metrodome, pitching 7.0 innings opposite that season's AL Cy Young Award winner Cliff Lee.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision of the Twins 7-5, 12-inning, walk-off victory on June 21 vs. Cincinnati...allowed three runs on five hits (2 HR) over 4.2 innings, with four walks and five strikeouts...gave up a two-run home run in the fourth inning to Eugenio Suárez, opening the scoring for the Reds...threw 108 pitches (60 strikes), marking the fourth time this season he has tossed over 100 pitches...marked Happ's second Interleague game of the season.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Was dealt his third loss of the season on June 15 in Seattle, as the Twins were shut out 10-0...allowed six runs on a season-high-tying nine hits (1 HR) over 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...allowed a solo home run in the first inning to shortstop J.P. Crawford...left the game with a 0-6 score...marked Happ's first start this season without any run support, and the first time he received zero runs of support in a start since September 1, 2019 at Oakland (with New York-AL, 6.0 IP; Yankees won 5-4).

**CLEVELAND ENCOUNTERS:** Happ is making his 10th career appearance and ninth start vs. Cleveland this afternoon and has gone 4-2, 4.18 ERA (47.1 IP, 22 ER) over his previous nine outings against the Indians.

- ☞ Has faced the Tribe twice so far this season, playing both games at Progressive Field and going 1-0, 4.15 ERA (13.0 IP, 6 ER).
- ☞ Has never lost to the Indians at home in his career, holding a record of 3-0, 1.80 ERA (25.0 IP, 5 ER) with five walks, 22 strikeouts and a .242 opponent batting average (23-for-95) in four career outings (all starts) as the home pitcher.
- ☞ Holds an even record of 2-2 against the AL-Central this season.

**LOW TRAFFIC:** Since the beginning of the 2018 season, Happ has averaged 11.46 base runners-per-9.0 innings, 13th fewest in the American League and 26th fewest in the majors (min. 420.0 IP)...Happ has allowed the 10th-fewest total base runners (577) in the American League over that span (min. 420.0 IP).

**RISP MANAGEMENT:** Happ held opposing hitters to a .156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

- ☞ However, this season opposing hitters are 16-for-61 (.262) against Happ with RISP, above his career .232 mark (344-for-1483).

**A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB:** Happ's start on April 13 vs. Boston was the 300th of his career...he is one of 11 active pitchers to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (475), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (434), Ervin Santana (386), Max Scherzer (382), Clayton Kershaw (370), Adam Wainwright (341), Johnny Cueto (320), David Price (314) and Madison Bumgarner (307).

- ☞ He has made at least 10 starts against 15 of 30 MLB teams.

**PITCH SELECTION:** This season Happ has featured five different pitches...he relies heavily on his four-seam fastball, throwing it more than half of the time...here is his 2021 repertoire, according to Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Ranks in the upper 56th percentile in baseball in fastball spin.
- ☞ He has allowed just 22 walks this season, ranking in the upper 55th percentile of BB% in baseball.

**NIGHT AND DAY, HOME AND ROAD:** Happ has made 13 starts so far this season, taking the mound eight times at night and five times during the day...during his eight starts under the lights, he is 1-3, 7.75 (38.1 IP, 33 ER) with 15 walks, 23 strikeouts and a .387 opponent on-base percentage...however, his numbers improve when the sun is up; during his five starts in the daytime, he is 2-0, 3.71 (26.2 IP, 11 ER) with eight walks, 25 strikeouts and a .278 opponent on-base percentage.

- ☞ Seven of his starts this season have come at Target Field and the other six have come on the road...his numbers at home outshine his record on the road.
- ☞ He is 1-2, 7.98 (29.1 IP, 26 ER) with eight walks, 27 strikeouts in six starts on the road, while he is 2-1, 4.54 (35.2 IP, 18 ER) with 15 walks, 21 strikeouts in seven home starts.

**FANNED BY DOUBLE DIGITS:** Happ fanned a season-high 10 batters in Cleveland on May 23, his 12th career game with double-digit strikeouts...became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history age 38-or-older with at least 10 strikeouts in a start since Connie Marrero (age 39.037) on June 1, 1950 (12.0 IP, 10 K)...also became the third to do so in nine innings-or-less, joining Johnny Niggeling, who did it twice: August 16, 1944 (8.0 IP, 11 K) and July 8, 1944 (9.0 IP, 10 K).

**FRESH STARTS:** Happ allowed just two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his first five starts to begin this season, the longest such streak to start a campaign in his career...his streak ended on May 12.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP KENTA MAEDA (2021 SEASON: 3-2, 4.85 ERA // CAREER: 56-38, 3.83 ERA)

Maeda is due to take the mound for the series opener against the White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field tomorrow evening; he was originally scheduled to start Saturday's game vs. Cleveland, which was postponed due to inclement weather...earned the win in his last start on June 20 at Texas, working 5.1 innings of five-hit, two-run ball to set the tone for the Twins in a 4-2 victory over the Rangers...walked one and fanned four batters in the start, his second since being reinstated from the 10-day Injured List on June 14...will be facing the White Sox for the second time this season, after allowing three runs on four hits in 5.0 innings, with two walks and three strikeouts in his other start on May 11 in Chicago, a 9-3 Twins loss...is 2-0, 3.60 ERA (20.0 IP, 8 ER) with four walks, 20 strikeouts and a .243 (18-for-74) opponent batting average in four career starts against Chicago-AL.

CAREER NOTES

- Ranks fourth among active left-handed pitchers in wins (126) and starts (311), while he is fifth in innings pitched (1806.2) and seventh in strikeouts (1587).
- Pitched a career best of 7.1 hitless innings on April 23, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh...left the game allowing only one hit over 7.1 innings...combined with Tyler Duffey and Taylor Rogers on the 19th one-hitter in Twins history.
- Made his 300th career start April 13, 2021 vs. Boston.
- In 2020, led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655)...did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
