**THE TWINS:** Began their seven-game roadtrip by going 1-2 against Baltimore this week... tonight they will continue the trip with the first of four at Kauffman Stadium against the Royals through Sunday...the Twins have gone 12-17 at home this season and 10-16 on the road.  
☞ Twins have won eight of their last 13 overall.

**TWINS LOSE ON ROOKIE NIGHT IN BALTIMORE:** The Twins lost to the Orioles last night by a score of 6-3, dropping the series two games-to-one...the Twins used five rookies in the lineup in Alex Kirilloff, Trevor Larnach, Nick Gordon, Ryan Jeffers and Gilberto Celestino, who made his major league debut, going 0-for-2 with a strikeout...Randy Dobnak (1-5) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on eight hits in 5.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded six hits, two from Jeffers, who homered for the first time this season and tripled for the first time in his professional career...he became the first Twins catcher with a triple and homer in the same game since Marcus Jensen on April 19, 2000.  
☞ Celestino became the fifth player to debut for the Twins this season (Larnach, Rortvedt, Gordon, Ober), fifth most in the AL, trailing Baltimore (7), Houston (7), Cleveland (6) and Seattle (6).

**TWINS AND ROYALS:** The Twins and Royals are playing the seventh of 19 meetings in 2021... Twins have gone 3-3 against the Royals this season, taking two of three April 30-May 2 and losing two of three last weekend...tonight marks the Twins' first trip to Kauffman Stadium since August 21-23, 2020, when they won two of three...the Twins have won seven of their last 11 against the Royals.

☞ Miguel Sanó made his major league debut at Kauffman Stadium on July 2, 2015, going 1-for-4, recording his first career hit, an infield single to shortstop off Greg Holland... he is hitting .290 (18-for-62) with five doubles, one triple, five home runs, 14 RBI, 11 walks and a 1.151 OPS in his last 19 games against the Royals.

☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .333 (8-for-24) with four home runs, nine RBI, two walks, four runs scored and a 1.204 OPS in six career games against the Royals...all four of his career homers and nine of his 17 RBI have come against the Royals.

☞ Since joining the Twins in 2019, Nelson Cruz is hitting .351 (39-for-111) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, 39 RBI, a .452 on-base percentage, a .865 slugging percentage and a 1.317 OPS in 31 games vs. the Royals (Twins are 20-11 in those games)...he has 31 home runs in 100 career games against Kansas City (chart lower right margin).

☞ Cruz has the third-most homers among active opponents at Kauffman Stadium with 12, trailing Miguel Cabrera (19) and Albert Pujols (17).

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins announced today that they have placed left-handed pitcher Caleb Thielbar on the 10-day Injured List with a left groin strain...Thielbar was removed from last night's game in Baltimore with the injury...Thielbar has posted a 4.29 ERA (21.0 IP, 10 ER) with five holds, seven walks, 31 strikeouts and a 1.48 WHIP in 20 relief appearances for the Twins this season...five of his last six appearances since May 19 have been scoreless, posting a 1.59 ERA (5.2 IP, 1 ER) in that span...to replace Thielbar on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Shaun Anderson from Triple-A St. Paul...Anderson will be making his third stint with the Twins this season and has posted a 9.00 ERA (5.0 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and six strikeouts in three major league appearances in 2021...he was previously with the club on April 15 and from May 12 until his placement on the 10-day Injured List with a left quad strain on May 18...Anderson made two scoreless 1.0-inning rehab appearances for the Saints on May 28 and 30, and was returned from his rehab assignment, reinstated from the Injured List and optioned to St. Paul on May 31.

**SOUTHPAW STUFF:** The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the 19th time this season, going 6-12 in their previous 18 when a lefty starts...they faced 16 (9-7) lefties all of 2020 and 39 (22-17) in 2019...they are hitting .244 (145-for-594) with a .433 slugging percentage and a .738 OPS vs. lefties this season, compared to .236 (295-for-1248) with a .416 slugging and a .736 OPS against righties.

☞ Kyle Garlick has hit .306 (15-for-49) with six doubles, three home runs, five RBI and a .939 OPS against left-handed pitching this season.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .321 (18-for-56) with three doubles, three home runs, six RBI, three walks and a .902 OPS vs. lefties this season.

☞ Cruz is 3-for-6 with a double, a home run and two walks lifetime against Kris Bubic... Jorge Polanco is 4-for-8 with a double in his career against Bubic.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** Since May 24, Trevor Larnach is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with two doubles, two home runs, five RBI, five walks, a .519 on-base percentage and a 1.269 OPS in eight games...his .385 on-base percentage overall this season ranks second among all rookies (min. 75 PA), behind St. Louis' Edmundo Sosa (.410) and his .845 OPS is third, behind Texas' Adolis García (.893) and Detroit's Akil Baddoo (.845).

**HOMER HEAVY:** The Twins have homered in 13-straight...it's their second-longest streak of the season, behind their run of 14, done from May 4-19...on the season, the Twins have hit 75 home runs, fourth most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (83), Toronto (81) and San Francisco (78)...37 home runs have come at Target Field and 38 have come on the road.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1967, Harmon Killebrew hit the longest home run ever by a Twin at an estimated 520 feet...Killebrew hit a three-run shot off California right-hander Lew Burdette, which landed in the sixth row of the upper deck at Metropolitan Stadium...the ball cracked the seat, and was later painted orange to commemorate the event...the seat is now located in the Mall of America — the former site of "Met" Stadium — bolted to a wall in the amusement park, marking the height and position where the ball would have landed in the upper deck.

**HBD, RJ!:** Happy birthday to catcher Ryan Jeffers, who turns 24 today...in the baseball world, Jeffers shares a birthday with the late Royals ace Yordano Ventura and former Cleveland slugger Travis Hafner, as well as tennis star Rafael Nadal, newsman Anderson Cooper, entertainer and civil rights activist Josephine Baker, among others...Jeffers has never appeared in the majors on his birthday; he played once on his birthday in the minors, going 1-for-3 with an RBI, a walk and a run scored on June 3, 2019.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his third win of the season on May 29 vs. Kansas City after allowing just two runs on three hits (1 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings...the two runs he allowed came in the third inning on a two-run home run by Salvador Perez...was Happ's first outing since April 23 in which he did not allow more than three hits...the Twins won by a score of 6-5.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Did not factor into the decision in the Twins' first extra-inning win this season at Progressive Field on May 23...allowed four runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings in his second start of the season vs. Cleveland...three of his four runs allowed came in the first two innings, including two in the first, highlighted by a José Ramírez RBI double and an Eddie Rosario RBI single...Happ allowed just one walk and set season highs with 10 strikeouts and 103 pitches...was his third-straight start in which he allowed more than six hits and more than three runs.

- ☞ Happ fanned 10 batters in Cleveland, becoming the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history age 38-or-older with at least 10 strikeouts in a start since Connie Marrero (age 39.037) on June 1, 1950 (12.0 IP, 10 K)...also became the third to do so in nine innings-or-less, joining Johnny Niggeling, who did it twice: August 16, 1944 (8.0 IP, 11 K) and July 8, 1944 (9.0 IP, 10 K).

**ROYALS RIVALRY:** Today marks Happ's 11th career appearance and start against the Kansas City Royals and second consecutive...is 6-3, 4.12 ERA (59.0 IP, 27 ER) with 14 walks and 52 strikeouts against the Royals in his career...is 2-0, 4.08 ERA (17.2 IP, 8 ER) when facing the Royals at Kauffman Stadium...has won each of his last four starts against Kansas City, posting a 3.91 ERA (23.0 IP, 10 ER) and .181 (15-for-83) opponent batting average in that span.

**AL CENTRAL COMPETITION:** Happ has spent 10 seasons of his career in the American League and seven seasons in the National League...this year marks his first time playing for a team in the AL Central...is 20-17, 5.18 ERA (274.2 IP, 158 ER) in 52 career outings (49 starts) against the AL Central.

- ☞ Happ is 2-2, 7.45 ERA (29.0 IP, 24 ER), 12 walks and 26 strikeouts in six starts against the AL Central so far this season...by comparison, he's 1-0, 1.56 ERA (17.1 IP, 3 ER) with four walks and nine strikeouts in his other three starts against non-AL Central competition.

**KEEP THE SWINGS LOW:** Happ has allowed 27 runs, 43 hits and 55 base runners over the course of 46.1 innings this season...43 hits allowed is tied for 14th fewest among American League pitchers (min. 45.0 IP)...Happ's 27 runs allowed are tied for 10th fewest and his 16 walks are tied for 12th fewest by a left-handed pitcher in the American League (min. 45.0 IP).

- ☞ Happ is averaging 8.35 hits-per-9.0 IP and 11.65 base runners-per-9.0 IP.
- ☞ He owns a .243 (43-for-177) opponent batting average this season.
- ☞ Happ has allowed the fewest home runs (5) among Twins starting pitchers (min. 4 GS).

**LOW TRAFFIC:** Since the beginning of the 2018 season, Happ has averaged 11.12 base runners-per-9.0 innings, ranking sixth in the American League and 17th in the majors (min. 400.0 IP)...Happ has allowed the ninth-fewest total base runners (5327) in baseball over that span (min. 400.0 IP).

**RISP MANAGEMENT:** Happ held opposing hitters to a .156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

- ☞ However, this season opposing hitters are 10-for-34 (.294) against Happ with RISP, well above his career .232 mark (338-for-1456).

**QUALITY OVER QUANTITY:** Happ has collected 148 quality starts throughout his career, including two this season...88 of his quality starts have come against the American League and 19 of them vs. the AL Central...five of the quality starts he has recorded have come against Kansas City.

**A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB:** Happ's start on April 13 vs. Boston was the 300th of his career...he is one of 11 active pitchers to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (471), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (430), Ervin Santana (386), Max Scherzer (379), Clayton Kershaw (366), Adam Wainwright (336), Johnny Cueto (316), David Price (314) and Madison Bumgarner (307).

- ☞ He has made at least 10 starts against 13 of 30 MLB teams.

**PITCH SELECTION:** This season Happ has featured five different pitches...he relies heavily on his four-seam fastball, throwing it more than half of the time...he started adding curveballs into his mix three starts ago...here is his 2021 repertoire, according to Baseball Savant:

**FRESH STARTS:** Happ allowed just two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his first five starts to begin this season, the longest such streak to start a campaign in his career...his streak ended on May 12 at Chicago-AL (3.1 IP, 9 H, 9 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 3 K).

**HAPPY DAYS:** Happ has made nine starts so far this season...during his four starts under the lights he is 1-2, 7.32 (19.2 IP, 16 ER) with eight walks, 10 strikeouts and a .345 opponent on-base percentage...however, his numbers significantly improve when the sun is up; during his five starts in the daytime he is 2-0, 3.71 (26.2 IP, 11 ER) with eight walks, 25 strikeouts and a .278 opponent on-base percentage.

## CAREER NOTES

- Ranks fourth among active left-handed pitchers in wins (126), is tied with Madison Bumgarner for fourth in starts (307), while he is fifth in innings pitched (1787.2) and seventh in strikeouts (1574).
- Pitched a career best of 7.1 hitless innings on April 23, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh...left the game allowing only one hit over 7.1 innings...combined with Tyler Duffey and Taylor Rogers on the 19th one-hitter in Twins history.
- Made his 300th career start April 13, 2021 vs. Boston.
- In 2020, led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655)...did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
- Has made 12 Opening Day rosters with six teams: Philadelphia (2009-10), Houston (2011-12), Toronto (2013, '16-18), Seattle (2015), New York-AL (2019-20) and Minnesota (2021).
- Enters 2021 with 14 MLB seasons under his belt, with the Phillies (2007-10), Astros (2010-12), Blue Jays (2012-14, '16-18), Mariners (2015), Pirates (2015) and Yankees (2018-20).
- Made his 300th career major league appearance and 275th career start on June 23, 2019 vs. Houston.
- Compiled a career-best 19.1-inning scoreless streak from August 26-September 12-G1, 2019, the AL's eighth-longest scoreless streak in 2019 and longest by a Yankee.
- Finished sixth in 2016 AL Cy Young Award voting after going 20-4, 3.18 ERA for Toronto and tying for the second-most wins in baseball...marks his only career 20-win season and is one of just seven pitchers in the majors (and one of two southpaws) with a 20-win campaign in 2016.
