LAST START: Ober's last start came on June 22 vs. Cincinnati, a $10-7$ Twins loss...did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts in 4.1 innings of work...walked multiple batters for the first time in his career....permitted just one run on a Tucker Barnhart third-inning solo homer across the first four innings, before running into trouble in the a two-run double by Jesse Winker induced a lineout and departed the game with two on one out. an additional run scored off Tyler Duffey...the four earned runs matched Ober's career high, done previously in his first career start on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL
\$ Ober's 5.75 strikeout-to-walk ratio ( $23 \mathrm{~K}, 4 \mathrm{BB}$ ) is the best mark in Twins history within a
pitcher's first five career outings, among those whose first five career outings were all starts.
START PRIOR: Ober was close to perfect in his start on June 16 at Seattle, retiring his first nine batters faced in a 7-2 Twins victory....yielded a leadoff single to J.P. Crawford in the fourth, but struck out Jake Fraley and Mitch Haniger, and Crawford was caught stealing to end the frame....allowed just one Boof Bonser for fourth most in a player's first four in Twins history, trailing only Dave Boswell ( 25 K), Fernando Romero ( 22 K ) and Jim Merritt ( 22 K )...additionally, his two walks allowed through his first four career appearances were the fewest in Twins history among pitchers whose first four career outings were all starts.

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: Ober will face an opponent for the second time for the first time in his career tonight, as he makes his second career start against the White Sox...made his major league debut on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field, allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in a 4.0-inning no-decision...the Twins won, 5-4, on Jorge Polanco's walk-off single in Faton for the second out of the inning he worked scoreless second and fourth frames but ran into trouble in the first and third innings, vielding a solo homer to Jake Lamb in the first and three runs in the third on a Yoán Moncada double and a Yasmani Grandal two-run homer...four of the five hits he allowed were extra-base hits (2 doubles, 2 home runs).

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first five career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a 176 batting average (3-for-17) with runners in scoring position as well as a . 143 (1-for-7) mark with RISP and two outs...this trend was also true in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, as he held opposing hitters to just a . 182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring
position for the Saints.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Ober is one of six players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of two pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2) and RHP Griffin Jax (June 8).
WALKING TALL: Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is one of just five players 6-8-or-taller to suit up for the Twins and Senators, as well as just the third pitcher of that height to debut for Minnesota or in major league history...the other pitchers 6-8-or-taller to play for the Twins are:


SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average ( 13 -for- 60 )...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints fifth game on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run scored on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work... took the ball again on May 13 vs. lowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision...earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at lowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, fanning a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep.

NO RUNS: Ober posted a miniscule 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) in 2019, his most recent full professional season...his mark led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) and he also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961 ...also marked the second-lowest single-season ERA by any minor league pitcher since 1992
