THE TWINS: After completing their last homestand with a record of 3-2 (1-1 vs. Cincinnati and 2-1 vs. Cleveland), the Twins began their roadtrip with a loss in Chicago last night... tonight they will play the second of three with the White Sox...after tomorrow's series finale, the Twins will travel to Kansas City for three with the Royals over the weekend...the Twins have gone 17-23 at home this season and 16-21 on the road.

TWINS DROP GAME ONE ON SOUTH SIDE: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 7-6...Kenta Maeda (3-3) was the starter and loser, allowing seven runs on eight hits in 4.2 innings pitched...Danny Coulombe pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Nelson Cruz...Josh Donaldson hit his 12th home run of the season and his second in as many games...for Donaldson, it was his seventh home run in his last 18 games and the second time this season he's homered in back-to-back games.

JUNE BOOM: Twins have won seven of their last 10 games after starting June with a record of 4-10...below are number comparisons from the first 14 and the last 10:

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the eighth of 19 meetings this season... Twins are 1-6 against the Sox this season.

☞ Twins have lost five straight at Guaranteed Rate Field and are looking to avoid losing six straight here for the first time since May 23-September 3, 2012.

☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .301 (62-for-206) with 10 doubles, 18 home runs, 45 RBI, 39 walks and a 1.021 OPS in 59 career games vs. the White Sox.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .390 (48-for-123) with 10 doubles, 13 home runs, 37 RBI, 17 walks, a .464 OBP, an .789 slugging percentage and a 1.253 OPS in 33 games vs. the Sox while in a Minnesota uniform (since 2019)...at Guaranteed Rate Field in that span, he is hitting .402 (33-for-82) with 11 home runs, 31 RBI and a 1.340 OPS in 21 games.

☞ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .297 (33-for-111) in 29 career games vs. the Sox...in his last 11, he is hitting .318 (14-for-44) with six RBI and seven runs scored.

☞ Miguel Sanó has 13 home runs and 26 RBI in 29 games vs. the Sox since the start of 2019.

THE BRINGER OF RAIN: Josh Donaldson is hitting .292 (33-for-113), with six doubles, eight home runs and 25 RBI in 31 career games at Guaranteed Rate Field...he is a career .309 (291-for-942) hitter with 60 doubles, four triples, 73 home runs and 210 RBI in 258 games vs. the AL Central; his 73 homers vs. the division are ninth among actives.

☞ He is hitting .412 (7-for-17) with two home runs, six RBI and a 1.215 OPS in his last seven games overall.

SUMMER CRUZ: In 21 games this month, Nelson Cruz is hitting .368 (28-for-76) with five doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI, 10 walks, a .443 on-base percentage, a .711 slugging percentage and a 1.154 OPS...he has reached base in 20 of those 21 games (0-for-4 on June 24 vs. CLE).

WIND IT UP: Rosters for the 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, which will be played on July 11 at Coors Field, were announced by Major League Baseball earlier today...the Twins will be represented by right-handed pitcher Josh Winder (pronounced WINE-der)...the 24-year-old has made 10 starts for Double-A Wichita this season, going 3-0, 1.98 ERA (54.2 IP, 12 ER) with 10 walks and 65 strikeouts...Winder was selected by the Twins in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...additionally, former Twins reliever and current Twins Special Assistant/broadcaster LaTroy Hawkins will manage the AL Futures Team.

MINOR MATTER: Infielder Jose Miranda celebrated his 23rd birthday yesterday by going 5-for-6 with three home runs for Triple-A St. Paul, in his first career Triple-A game...Miranda, who was just promoted from Double-A Wichita, was hitting .345 (67-for-194) with the Wind Surge, with eight doubles, 13 home runs 38 RBI and a .996 OPS in 47 games...he is currently ranked as the Twins' No. 16 prospect per MLB.com.

LAST START: Ober's last start came on June 22 vs. Cincinnati, a 10-7 Twins loss...did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts in 4.1 innings of work...walked multiple batters for the first time in his career...permitted just one run on a Tucker Barnhart third-inning solo homer across the first four innings, before running into trouble in the fifth...allowed each of the first four batters to reach to start the fifth (1B, 1B, BB, 2B), capped off by a two-run double by Jesse Winker...induced a lineup and departed the game with two on, one out, an additional run scored off Tyler Duffey...the four earned runs matched Ober's career high, done previously in his first career start on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL.

☞ Ober's 5.75 strikeout-to-walk ratio (23 K, 4 BB) is the best mark in Twins history within a pitcher's first five career outings, among those whose first five career outings were all starts.

START PRIOR: Ober was close to perfect in his start on June 16 at Seattle, retiring his first nine batters faced in a 7-2 Twins victory...yielded a leadoff single to J.P. Crawford in the fourth, but struck out Jake Fraley and Mitch Haniger, and Crawford was caught stealing to end the frame...allowed just one base runner in 4.0 innings...Ober's 21 strikeouts through his first four career appearances matched Boof Bonser for fourth most in a player's first four in Twins history, trailing only Dave Boswell (25 K), Fernando Romero (22 K) and Jim Merritt (22 K)...**additionally, his two walks allowed through his first four career appearances were the fewest in Twins history among pitchers whose first four career outings were all starts.**

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: Ober will face an opponent for the second time for the first time in his career tonight, as he makes his second career start against the White Sox...made his major league debut on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field, allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in a 4.0-inning no-decision...the Twins won, 5-4, on Jorge Polanco's walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth...Ober recorded his first career strikeout in the opening frame, fanning Adam Eaton for the second out of the inning...he worked scoreless second and fourth frames but ran into trouble in the first and third innings, yielding a solo homer to Jake Lamb in the first and three runs in the third on a Yoán Moncada double and a Yasmán Grandal two-run homer...four of the five hits he allowed were extra-base hits (2 doubles, 2 home runs).

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first five career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .176 batting average (3-for-17) with runners in scoring position as well as a .143 (1-for-7) mark with RISP and two outs...this trend was also true in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, as he held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position for the Saints.

LOW TRAFFIC: Ober struck out 100 batters and walked just nine in 2019, good for an MLB-best 11.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min. 75.0 IP)...that season, he also ranked second in the minors in WHIP (0.81) and base runners-per-9.0 IP (7.55), and was fifth in walks-per-9.0 IP (1.03).

☞ In five MLB starts this season, Ober has allowed 29 total base runners 21.1 innings, good for a 12.23 base-runners-per-9.0 IP ratio...he's also averaging just 1.69 walks-per-9.0 IP and has walked just four batters compared to 23 strikeouts, good for a 5.75 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Ober is one of six players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of two pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2) and RHP Griffin Jax (June 8).

WALKING TALL: Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is one of just five players 6-8-or-taller to suit up for the Twins and Senators, as well as just the third pitcher of that height to debut for Minnesota or Washington...additionally, Ober's 23 career strikeouts are 12th most among all pitchers 6-9-or-taller in major league history...the other pitchers 6-8-or-taller to play for the Twins are:

SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average (13-for-60)...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints' fifth game on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run scored on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work...took the ball again on May 13 vs. Iowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision...earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at Iowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none and fanning five as the Saints exploded for 17 runs en route to a 17-5 rout of the I-Cubs...his other start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, fanning a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep.

CAREER REDUX: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a .222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances (35 starts)...was added to the Twins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020 and is currently ranked as the 21st-best prospect in the Twins system by MLB.com.

☞ Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).

☞ Over that same time span, Ober ranks third by allowing just 8.79 base runners-per-9.0 innings, fourth by walking just 1.18 batters-per-9.0-innings and fifth in WHIP (0.96).

NO RUNS: Ober posted a miniscule 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) in 2019, his most recent full professional season...his mark led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) and he also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961...also marked the second-lowest single-season ERA by any minor league pitcher since 1992 (min. 75.0 IP), trailing only Erasmo Ramirez's 0.51 ERA (88.0 IP, 5 ER) in 2009 for the VSL Mariners.
