THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their seven-game roadtrip, going 1-2 against Baltimore and 0-1 against Kansas City...tonight they will continue the trip with the second of four at Kauffman Stadium against the Royals through Sunday... the Twins have gone
$12-17$ at home this season and $10-17$ on the road.
TWINS DROP GAME ONE AT KAUFFMAN: The Twins lost to the Royals last night by a score of 6-5 in game one of the four-game series.....A. Happ started and allowed five runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings pitched but did not factor into the decision...Hansel Robles ( $0-1$ ) was issued the loss, aliowing an unearned run in the seventh inning atter two errors on one play in left-centerfield from Gilberto Celestino...the offense recorded 10 hits, including three apiece Jorge Polanco and Josh Donaldson...Donaldson doubled and hit two home runs, marking his 21st career multi-homer game.
$\Phi$ Donaldson became the fifth different Twins player to record three extra-base hits in a
game this season, joining Rob Reftsnyder (May 25), Miguel Sano (May 18), Byron Buxton (April 28) and Nelson Cruz (April 5)...those five such games match Cincinnati for the most in baseball this season.
TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the eighth of 19 meetings in 2021.. Twins are 3-4 against the Royals this season, going 3-3 at Target Field and 0-1 at Kauffman Stadium...the Twins have won seven of their last 12 against the Royals, dating back to August 16, 2020 .

Miguel Sanó is hitting .298 ( 50 -for-168) with nine doubles, two triples, 14 home runs $50^{\circ}$ RBI, 23 walks and a 1.008 OPS against the Royals in 47 games since 2017.
क Alex Kirilloff is hitting. 320 (8-for-25) with four home runs, nine RBI, two walks, four runs scored and a 1.157 OPS in seven career games against the Royals...all four of his
$\Phi$ career homers and nine of his 17 RBI have come against the Royals.
$\Phi$ Josh Donaldson is hitting. 333 (32-for-96) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI
and a 1.060 OPS in 26 career games at Kauffman Stadium, reaching base safely in 13 and a 1.060 ops in 26 career games at Kauftman Stadium, reaching base safely in 13
straight in this ballpark....he has six hits in his last 11 at-bats at Kauffman (4 doubles and 2 home runs).
$\Phi$ Individuals vs. Brad Keller in their careers: Alex Kirilloff is 3 -for-4...Ben Rortvedt is 1 -for-2 with his only major league home run (May 30 at Target Field).... Josh Donaldson is 3 -for-8 with two doubles and a walk.

MORE ON THE MATCHUP: Twins and Royals head-to-head this season:

HOMER HEAVY: The Twins have homered in 14 -straight games, matching their season-long, previously done from May 4-19...during the current streak, they have hit 21 home runs...they are the only team in baseball this season with two 14-game homer streaks...they trail Atlanta (16, May 7-23) and Arizona (15, April 17-May 4) for longest runs in baseball this season...the current streak is tied for fourth-longest in Twins/Senators franchise history...the club record is 16, done three times, twice in 2017 and once in 1979.
$\Phi$ On the season, the Twins have hit 77 home runs, fourth most in baseball, trailing Atlanta
(84), Toronto (81) and San Francisco (79),

MIGGY IS DUE: Miguel Sanó is looking to snap an 0-for-last-21 and record his first hit since a go-ahead sixth inning homer on May 26 vs. Baltimore, off Jorge López...despite his recent slump, Sanó has seven home runs in his last 20 games, dating back to May 15 , tied for third most in baseball since that date...he has 140 for his career and is in within one of tying Michael Cuddyer for 12th on the Twins all-time list (sine 1961):

HEY ROOKIE!: The Twins have five rookies in their lineup tonight in Alex Kirilloff, Trevor Larnach, Nick Gordon, Gilberto Celestino and Ben Rortvedt....excluding Kirilloff, who debuted in the 2020 AL Wild Card Series, the other four made their major league debut this season... on Wednesday night, Celestino became the fifth player to debut for the Iwins in 2021 (also Bailey Ober)...it marked the fifth-most debuts in the AL, trailing Baltimore (7), Houston (7), Cleveland (6) and Seattle (6).

JUST JOSHIN': Josh Donaldson has reached base safely in 11 of his last 13 games, dating back to game two of the Angels doubleheader on May 20 ...in that span, he has reached base 21 times in 62 plate appearances ( 111 hits and 10 walks) for an on-base percentage of 355 .
ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2012, the Twins selected Byron Buxton with the second overall selection in the MLB First-Year Player Draft after Houston selected Carlos Correa first overall...Buxton came out of Appling County High School in Baxley, Georgia...Buck, the AL Player of the Month for April of 2021, is currently on the 10-day Injured List with a right hip strain, missing the last 26 games.
MINOR MATTER: Single-A Fort Myers beat St. Lucie last night by a score of 7-0, marking the fifth shutout for the Mighty Mussels in their last nine games...Fort Myers has won four straight and seven of their last 10...they play St. Lucie tonight at 6:00 pm (CT).

LAST TIME OUT: Took his team-leading sixth loss of the season last Sunday in the series and homestand finale vs. Kansas City....allowed five runs on six hits, with one walk and five strikeouts in 4.1 innings of work....was his shortest outing since going just 3.1 innings on May 1 vs. Kansas City...allowed one run in the first inning on an Andrew Benintendi RBI single scoring Whit Merrifield, but then retired 11-straight batters until allowing an Edward Olivares single to lead off the fifth...departed with the bases loaded and one out in the fifth, having already allowed two runs in the frame...gave way to Caleb Thielbar, who allowed two inherited runs to score...threw only 66 pitches in the outing, his fewest in a start this season and fewest since throwing 54 on September 21, 2020 vs. New York-AL (3.0 IP)...Twins went on to lose the game throwing 54 on September 21,2020
$(6-3)$ and series $(1-2)$ to the Royals.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took a no-decision May 24 in the series and homestand opener vs. Baltimore despite allowing only one run on five hits over 6.0 innings, his third quality start of the season... threw a season-high 96 pitches, his most in a start since throwing 100 pitches on April 15 , 2019...only run he allowed came on an Anthony Santander first-inning RBI double, just the third time in nine starts that Shoemaker had allowed a run in the first inning this season (now 4 times in 10 starts)...was his first time recording back-to-back quality starts this season and first since March 29-April 3, 2019...Shoemaker exited after 6.0 innings leading 2-1, but Twins bullpen surrendered the lead on a DJ Stewart two-run homer in the top of the eighth...Twins regained the lead in the bottom half of that inning, scoring six runs in the frame en route to an $8-3$ victory over the 0 's.

OPPOSITION IMBALANCE: Shoemaker is looking for his first victory against a team other than Detroit, as most of the Michigan native's success in the season's first two months came exclusively against the Tigers...below is a breakdown of his numbers against Detroit compared to those against all other competition
