**THE TWINS:** Have gone 1-4 through five games on their seven-game roadtrip, going 1-2 against Baltimore and 0-2 against Kansas City...after winning the roadtrip opener Monday in Baltimore, they have lost four straight...today they will continue the trip with the third of four at Kauffman Stadium against the Royals...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day then begin a six-game homestand with three against the Yankees from June 8-10 and three against the Astros from June 11-13...the Twins have gone 12-17 at home this season and 10-18 on the road.

**TWINS DIG HOLE EARLY IN KC:** The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 14-5...the Twins pitching staff allowed 13 of the 14 runs in the first two innings... Matt Shoemaker (2-7) was the starter and loser, allowing nine runs (8 earned) on six hits in 0.1 innings pitched...Williams Astudillo made his third pitching appearance of the season and bottomed out at 41.3 mph on a pitch...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Nick Gordon, who singled twice and hit his first career major league home run, a solo shot off Wade Davis...Jorge Polanco (6) and Miguel Sanó (10) each added homers...Twins homered for the 15th-straight game (note below).

**HOMER HEAVY:** The Twins have homered in a season-long 15-straight games...during the current streak, they have hit 24 home runs...they are tied with Arizona (April 17-May 4) for second-longest streak in baseball this season, trailing Atlanta (16, May 7-23)...the current streak is the fourth-longest in Twins/Senators franchise history:

**NOTE:** Sanó has 18 career home runs against the Royals, 11 at Kauffman Stadium, his most in any opposing ballpark...Miggy hit his first Kauffman Stadium home run in the 12th inning on September 5, 2015, off Franklin Morales, in a pinch-hit role that gave the Twins a 3-2 victory.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Griffin Jax from Triple-A St. Paul...Jax, 26, has made five starts for the Saints, going 3-1, 3.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 10 ER), 10 walks, 29 strikeouts, no home runs allowed and a 1.33 WHIP...the 6-foot-2, 195-pound pitcher was drafted by the Twins in the third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of the United States Air Force Academy...over five seasons in the Twins minor league system, he has gone 13-15, 3.20 ERA (281.2 IP, 100 ER), 60 walks and 217 strikeouts in 52 games (47 starts)...he spent the 2020 season at the alternate training site in St. Paul and was named as having the best control in the Twins' system by *Baseball America* in 2019...when he debuts, Jax will become the first graduate of the Air Force Academy to be drafted and play in the majors...he will be in uniform for today's game in Kansas City and will wear number 83...to make room for Jax on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Juan Minaya for release or assignment...Minaya, who was added to the roster on May 29, appeared in four games, posting a 4.26 ERA (6.1 IP, 3 ER) with three walks and four strikeouts.

**TWINS AND ROYALS:** The Twins and Royals are playing the ninth of 19 meetings in 2021...Twins are 3-5 against the Royals this season, going 3-3 at Target Field and 0-2 at Kauffman Stadium.  
 ☞ Miguel Sanó is hitting .297 (51-for-172) with nine doubles, two triples, 15 home runs, 52 RBI, 23 walks and a 1.014 OPS against the Royals in 48 games since 2017.  
 ☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with four home runs, 10 RBI, two walks, four runs scored and a 1.033 OPS in eight career games against the Royals...all four of his career homers and 10 of his 18 RBI have come against the Royals.  
 ☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .343 (34-for-99) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.072 OPS in 27 career games at Kauffman Stadium, reaching base safely in 14 straight in this ballpark...he has eight hits in his last 14 at-bats at Kauffman (2 singles, 4 doubles and 2 home runs).  
 ☞ Since joining the Twins in 2019, Nelson Cruz is hitting .351 (39-for-111) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, 39 RBI, a .452 on-base percentage, a .865 slugging percentage and a 1.317 OPS in 31 games vs. the Royals (Twins are 20-11 in those games)...he has 31 home runs in 100 career games against Kansas City (chart to the right).  
 ☞ Cruz has the third-most homers among active opponents at Kauffman Stadium with 12, trailing Miguel Cabrera (19) and Albert Pujols (17).

**JUST JOSHIN':** Josh Donaldson has reached base safely in 12 of his last 14 games, dating back to game two of the Angels doubleheader on May 20...in that span, he has reached base 24 times in 66 plate appearances (13 hits and 11 walks) for an on-base percentage of .379.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2014, the Twins selected infielder Nick Gordon with the fifth overall pick in the MLB First-Year Player Draft...Twins top prospect Royce Lewis turns 22-years-old today...Lewis is out this season, recovering from a right ACL injury he suffered this spring.

**DID YOU KNOW?:** Bally Sports North analyst Justin Morneau hit 26 career home runs against the Royals, his most vs. any opponent...in 153 career games vs. Kansas City, Morneau hit .256 (149-for-581) with 35 doubles, 26 home runs, 92 RBI with 60 walks...his first career homer was on June 17, 2003 at Kauffman Stadium, a solo shot off Albie Lopez.

**SWING FOR THE KIDS:** Today the Twins are inviting fans to take batting practice at Target Field, joined by Rod Carew, Bert Blyleven, Tony Oliva and Tom Kelly during one of two sessions...proceeds will benefit the Minnesota Twins Community Fund in its efforts to support kids and families throughout Twins Territory...the event will be open to fans ages 13-and-over and will feature rotating groups, moving between live hitting, playing in the infield, shagging in the outfield, throwing in the Twins' bullpen and waiting "on deck" in the Twins' dugout — all while receiving instruction from Carew, Blyleven, Oliva and TK.

**LAST START:** Did not factor into the decision in the Twins 3-2, 10-inning victory on May 31 at Baltimore...started game one of a three-game series...set a season high with 8.0 innings pitched, his longest outing since June 17, 2019 vs. Boston (also 8.0)...his only run allowed came on a Ryan Mountcastle solo homer in the fifth inning...the Twins scored two runs in the 10th inning, highlighted by a Jorge Polanco homer...he threw 101 pitches, his fourth 100+ pitch outing this season.

- ☞ His start marked the longest outing for a Twins starter this season and longest since Kenta Maeda went 8.0 innings on August 18, 2020 vs. Milwaukee.

**START PRIOR:** Was the winner in the Twins 7-4 victory on May 25 vs. Baltimore, opposite Dean Kremer...earned his third win in as many decisions as one more would match his longest streak from last season...allowed two runs in the second inning, both unearned after a fielding error by Andrelton Simmons at second base...third run allowed came on a Pedro Severino double in the fourth inning...struck out seven batters for the second-straight start...threw a season-high 106 pitches (73 strikes)...passed Eric Milton (715) on the Twins' all-time strikeout list.

**700 CLUB:** This season he has surpassed both 700 strikeouts and 700.0 innings pitched for his career...his 700th strikeout came in the fifth inning on May 15 vs. Oakland, fanning Seth Brown... became the 15th Twin to reach 700 strikeouts and the 28th Twin to reach 700.0 innings pitched.

- ☞ He needs two strikeouts to tie Kevin Tapani (724) for 13th on the Twins all-time strikeout list (list in lower right area of page).

**AGAINST THE ROYALS:** Is making his 17th career start against the Royals...his last start came on May 2 at Target Field, earning the win in a Twins 13-4 victory, allowing four runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with nine strikeouts...he is 4-4, 4.74 ERA (93.0 IP, 49 ER) with 10 home runs, 32 walks and 83 strikeouts in 16 career starts against KC...16 starts, 93.0 innings pitched and 83 strikeouts are all his second most vs. any opponent (CWS - 17 starts, 108.2 IP, 111 K's)...his 79.1 innings vs. KC since 2017 are third most, trailing Matthew Boyd (104.2) and Lucas Giolito (92.1).

- ☞ His last start at Kauffman Stadium came on August 9, 2020, allowing four runs on eight hits in 5.1 innings pitched and was dealt the loss in a Twins 4-2 defeat.
- ☞ His last win at Kauffman came on September 27, 2019, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched.
- ☞ His nine career starts at Kauffman match his most in any opposing ballpark (also 9 at Guaranteed Rate Field).

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Berríos is making his seventh road start this season...has gone 2-1, 2.27 ERA (35.2 IP, 9 ER) with three home runs, eight walks, 34 strikeouts and a .185 opponent batting average in six starts away from Target Field this season...his last road win came on May 20 at Los Angeles-AL (Game 2), allowing three runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched in a Twins 6-3 victory...is 22-22, 4.55 ERA (368.0 IP, 186 ER) in 67 career road starts.

- ☞ Dating back to September 14, 2020, he has gone 3-1, 1.93 ERA (46.2 IP, 10 ER) with 10 walks and 40 strikeouts in eight road starts.
- ☞ His two road wins this season came on April 3 at Milwaukee and May 20 at Los Angeles-AL.

**RIGHTY TIGHTY:** He has held right-handed hitters to a .171 (21-for-123) average with five doubles, three home runs, seven walks and 38 strikeouts, compared to lefties hitting .286 (32-for-112) with 11 doubles, one triple, four home runs, 10 walks and 31 strikeouts...his right-handed opponent batting average ranks sixth in the AL (min. 100 opp. AB).

**TOP OF THE CLASS:** Berríos has 50 wins since the start of 2017, second most in the American League in that span trailing only Justin Verlander (53)...MLB-wide in that span, 50 wins are tied for eighth in the majors with Lance Lynn and Aaron Nola, trailing Gerrit Cole (60), Zack Greinke (59), Clayton Kershaw (56), Max Scherzer (55), Verlander (53), and Trevor Bauer (51) and Charlie Morton (51)...his 673 strikeouts are fourth in the AL in that span, trailing Verlander (816), Cole (800) and Chris Sale (763).

**2020 SEASON:**

- ☞ Held right-handed hitters to .287 (37-for-129) at the plate, and left-handers to .180 (20-for-111)...among pitchers that faced at least 100 left-handed hitters, his .180 opponent batting average ranked third in the American League and seventh in baseball.
- ☞ Held opponents to a .174 (8-for-46) batting average with runners in scoring position...ranked third in the American League and tied fourth in the majors in that regard (min. 45 opponent AB with RISP).
- ☞ Led club in games started (12), pickoffs (2), and finished second in innings pitched (63.0), quality starts (4) and pitching WAR (1.1)...also tied for the most home wins (3) on the team.
- ☞ Started Game 2 in AL Wild Card September 30 vs. Houston at Target Field, allowing one run on two hits in 5.0 innings pitched with two walks and four strikeouts as the Twins lost 3-1.

CAREER NOTES

- Named to 2018 and 2019 AL All-Star teams, pitching 1.0 inning in both games.
- Started Game 1 of the 2019 ALDS against New York-AL and Game 2 of the 2020 AL Wild Card Series vs. Houston.
- In 2019, teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 K on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893, when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall-of-Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.
- Given the 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of BBWAA...also won the Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.
- Became 21st pitcher in Twins' history to reach the 200-strikeout mark in a season (202 in 2018).
- Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts.
- Made MLB debut April 27, 2016 vs. Cleveland.
- Named Twins' second-best prospect entering 2016, as well as best curveball, best changeup, and best control in Twins' system by *Baseball America*.
- Named 20th best prospect in baseball by MLB.com entering 2016.
