THE TWINS: After completing their last homestand with a record of 3-2 (1-1 vs. Cincinnati and 2-1 vs. Cleveland), the Twins began their roadtrip with consecutive losses in Chicago...today they will play the three-game series finale with the White Sox...after the game, the Twins will travel to Kansas City for three with the Royals over the weekend...the Twins have gone 17-23 at home this season and 16-22 on the road.

TWINS LOSE SLUGFEST ON SOUTH SIDE: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night by a score of 13-3...Bailey Ober (0-1) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on four hits in 3.1 innings pitched...the pitching staff allowed a season-high six home runs...the offense recorded five hits, two from Nelson Cruz who doubled (11) and homered (18)...Josh Donaldson also homered, marking his 13th of the season.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Derek Law from Triple-A St. Paul...Law will be making his second stint with the Twins this season, after previously appearing in five games from May 8-17 and allowing six earned runs in 6.1 innings, with nine strikeouts in those outings...the 30-year-old has also posted a 4.61 ERA (13.2 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 12 strikeouts in 11 relief appearances for Triple-A St. Paul this season...to make room for Law on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Matt Shoemaker for release or assignment...Shoemaker appeared in 16 games (11 starts) for the Twins, going 3-8 with an 8.06 ERA (60.1 IP, 54 ER), 27 walks and 40 strikeouts.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the ninth of 19 meetings this season...Twins are 1-7 against the Sox this season...these two teams will meet next for a three-game series at Target Field next week from July 5-7.

☞ Twins have lost six straight at Guaranteed Rate Field and are looking to avoid losing seven straight here for the first time since April 26-September 9, 2003.

☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .301 (63-for-209) with 10 doubles, 19 home runs, 46 RBI, 39 walks and a 1.031 OPS in 60 career games vs. the White Sox.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .397 (50-for-126) with 11 doubles, 14 home runs, 38 RBI, 18 walks, a .472 OBP, an .817 slugging percentage and a 1.290 OPS in 34 games vs. the Sox while in a Minnesota uniform (since 2019)...at Guaranteed Rate Field in that span, he is hitting .412 (35-for-85) with 12 home runs, 32 RBI and a 1.391 OPS in 22 games.

☞ Miguel Sanó has 13 home runs and 26 RBI in 30 games vs. the Sox since the start of 2019.

THE BRINGER OF RAIN: Josh Donaldson is hitting .293 (34-for-116), with six doubles, nine home runs and 26 RBI in 32 career games at Guaranteed Rate Field...he is a career .309 (292-for-945) hitter with 60 doubles, four triples, 74 home runs and 211 RBI in 259 games vs. the AL Central; his 74 homers vs. the division are tied for eighth among actives.

☞ He is hitting .400 (8-for-20) with three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.285 OPS in his last eight games overall.

THE BOOMSTICK: Nelson Cruz's home run last night was the 435th of his career, passing Juan Gonzalez and Andruw Jones and tying Carlos Beltrán for 46th on baseball's all-time home run list.

Nelson Cruz is celebrating his 41st birthday today...Cruz has played nine career games on his birthday, hitting .344 (11-for-32) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs and nine RBI...since turning 40-years-old, he has hit 34 home runs...he has 34 homers since turning 40; only 14 players in baseball history have hit more at age 40+

WELCOME BACK WEEK: With the Twins opening Target Field to full, 100 percent capacity, without restrictions, beginning July 5, the club today announced plans to celebrate a "Welcome Back Week" for its fans during the July 5-11 homestand...all seven games vs. AL Central division rivals the Chicago White Sox (July 5-7) and Detroit Tigers (July 8-11) will feature some combination of a promotional giveaway, theme night or other special event.

☞ "Monday, July 5 - when we can fully open the Target Field gates and welcome back all Twins fans - will be a wonderful moment 636 days in the making," said Twins President & CEO Dave St. Peter. "It has been a long and sometimes unfathomable road from October 2019 to today. We cannot wait to fully remove all barriers and come together with our incredible fans and community to celebrate each other, Twins baseball and our shared Target Field experience."

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision a week ago vs. Cleveland despite pitching 6.1 innings of one-run, four-hit ball, with two walks and nine strikeouts...the only run he allowed came on a two-strike, two-out single off the bat of Austin Hedges in the second inning...retired 13 of the final 15 men he faced, departing in favor of Caleb Thielbar with one out in the seventh and the game tied 1-1...Twins bullpen surrendered three runs in the eighth and the Indians won, 4-1...Berríos' nine strikeouts marked his highest total since also fanning nine on May 2 vs. Kansas City...recorded his team-leading sixth quality start and third consecutive, his longest stretch since a streak of seven-straight quality outings from May 24-June 28, 2019.

START PRIOR: Did not factor into the decision May 18 at Texas, despite notching his team-leading fifth quality start...worked 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits, with one walk and six strikeouts...surrendered two runs in the first inning on consecutive RBI singles by Nick Solak and Willie Calhoun...allowed his third run on a Jose Trevino sacrifice fly in the fourth inning, scoring Eli White...retired the final seven men he faced and exited with a 4-3 lead; the Rangers tied the game in the seventh but the Twins won 7-5 in 10 innings...marked Berríos' 25th-consecutive start allowing four earned runs-or-fewer, dating back to July 30, 2020, the longest such streak for a Twins pitcher since Johan Santana recorded 35-straight starts of four earned runs-or-fewer from July 15, 2006-July 18, 2007.

GOING STREAKING: Despite not factoring into the decision in his last two starts, Berríos remains on a five-game winning streak, matching the longest of his career, previously done April 14-May 7, 2019.

- ☞ Is 5-0, 3.57 ERA (63.0 IP, 25 ER) with 15 walks and 63 strikeouts in 10 starts since May 2...has completed at least 5.0 innings in all 10 of those games, including five quality starts (Twins are 8-2).
- ☞ Twins hitters have supported Berríos with 39 runs during that stretch (5.57 run support average), tied for the eighth-highest total among all American League starters in that span.
- ☞ His last losing decision came in the second game of the doubleheader at Oakland on April 20, when he surrendered one run on four hits with one walk and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings in a 1-0 A's victory.

700 CLUB: This season, Berríos has surpassed both 700 strikeouts and 700.0 innings pitched for his career...his 700th strikeout came in the fifth inning on May 15 vs. Oakland, fanning Seth Brown...became the 15th Twin to reach 700 strikeouts and the 28th Twin to reach 700.0 innings pitched.

- ☞ He needs 21 strikeouts to tie Scott Baker (770) for 12th on the Twins all-time strikeout list (list in lower right area of page).

GUARANTEED WINNER: Berríos is making his 18th career start against the White Sox today, breaking a tie with Kansas City for his most starts vs. any opponent...owns a career 12-2, 2.65 ERA (108.2 IP, 32 ER) with 111 strikeouts and a .223 opponent batting average.

- ☞ 12 wins and 111 strikeouts are his most against any opponent, with his 12 wins marking his only double-digit win total against one team...his 4.44 strikeout-to-walk ratio (111 K, 25 BB) vs. Chicago-AL is his third-best mark vs. any opponent he's faced at least four times in his career (Seattle - 5.86, Baltimore - 5.44).
- ☞ Is 4-2, 4.09 ERA (50.2 IP, 23 ER) with 15 walks and 42 strikeouts in nine career starts at Guaranteed Rate Field, last pitching here on September 14, 2020 (ND, 5.0 IP, 6 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 2 K).

SLICK LEATHER: He has four defensive runs saved this season, good for third best in baseball among all pitchers, trailing only Chicago-AL's Dallas Keuchel (6) and New York-NL's Taijuan Walker (5)...Berríos finished tied for fifth in baseball among pitchers in DRS in 2020 with one...since 2019, he ranks tied for ninth in DRS with five...his three pickoffs this season are tied for tops in the AL and tied for third most in the majors.

RIGHTY TIGHTY: Berríos is holding right-handed hitters to a .175 (31-for-177) average with five doubles, three home runs, eight walks and 51 strikeouts, compared to lefties hitting .279 (43-for-154) with 12 doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 15 walks and 45 strikeouts against him...his right-handed opponent batting average ranks second in the AL (min. 175 opp. AB), behind only this afternoon's opposing starter, Chicago-AL's Carlos Rodón (.156).

TOP OF THE CLASS: Berríos has 52 wins since the start of 2017, second most in the American League in that span, trailing only Justin Verlander (53)...MLB-wide in that time frame, 52 wins ranks eighth in the majors, trailing Gerrit Cole (62), Zack Greinke (61), Clayton Kershaw (58), Max Scherzer (57), Charlie Morton (54), Trevor Bauer (53) and Verlander (53)...his 700 strikeouts are fourth in the AL, trailing Cole (825), Verlander (816) and Chris Sale (763).

- ☞ His 26.5% strikeout percentage ranks in the 68th percentile in baseball and is currently the highest single-season mark of his career.
- ☞ Has walked just 23 batters in 362 opponent plate appearances this season, good for a 6.4 walk percentage, ranking in the 77th percentile of all MLB pitchers...6.4% is a vast improvement from 2020 for Berríos, who walked 9.6% of batters last season.
- ☞ Has a strikeout percentage of 38.2% on his curveball, which ranks 10th among American League starters (min. 50 PA).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP J.A. HAPP (2021 SEASON: 4-3, 5.83 ERA // CAREER: 127-95, 4.05 ERA)

Veteran southpaw Happ is due to toe the rubber tomorrow night in the series opener at Kansas City...recorded his fourth win of the season in his last start on June 27, working 6.0 innings of two-run ball, allowing six hits, no walks and striking out seven as the Twins defeated the Indians, 8-2...is 1-0, 6.30 ERA (10.0 IP, 7 ER) with two walks and seven strikeouts in his two starts vs. the Royals this season...is undefeated in four career starts (2-0, 5.16 ERA) at Kauffman Stadium with his most recent appearance there coming earlier this month on June 3 (ND, 5.0 IP, 9 H, 5 ER, 0 BB, 2 K).

CAREER NOTES

- Named to 2018 and 2019 AL All-Star teams, pitching 1.0 inning in both games.
- Started Game 1 of the 2019 ALDS against New York-AL and Game 2 of the 2020 AL Wild Card Series vs. Houston.
- In 2019, teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 K on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893, when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall-of-Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.
- Given the 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of BBWAA...also won the Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.
- Became 21st pitcher in Twins' history to reach the 200-strikeout mark in a season (202 in 2018).
