LAST START: Earned his first career win in his last start in the homestand opener on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL, leading the Twins to an 8-5 win...permitted just two hits – a second-inning double by Gavin Sheets and a fifth-inning single by Tim Anderson – across 5.0 shutout frames, with a career-high three walks and a career-high-tying seven strikeouts (also, June 11 vs. Houston)...threw a career-high 93 pitches, the first time in his career he crossed the 90-pitch threshold, while also matching his career high with 5.0 innings pitched.

START PRIOR: Took his first career decision, a loss, on June 30 at Chicago-AL...pitched just 3.1 innings, the shortest outing of his career, while permitting a career-high five runs on four hits (3 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts as the Twins eventually fell 13-3...worked a scoreless opening frame before yielding three runs in the second on a solo shot by Brian Goodwin and a two-run homer off the bat of Andrew Vaughn...allowed a single tally in the third (José Abreu solo shot) and departed with two on, one out in the fourth; one additional run scored off Matt Shoemaker...reached the 80-pitch work for the scored the score clear of the first career state and the score of the s mark for the second time in his career, also doing so in his first career start on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL.

DIVISIONAL REDUX: This afternoon marks Ober's first career start and appearance against the Tigers... four of his seven career starts to date have come against the American League Central division and he's 1-1, 5.51 ERA (16.1 IP, 10 ER) with six walks, 18 strikeouts and a .250 opponent batting average (16-for-64) in those four outings.

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first seven career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .150 batting average (3-for-20) with runners in scoring position as well as a .100 (1-for-10) mark with RISP and two outs...has not allowed a hit with runners in scoring position in each of his last two starts...this trend was also true in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, as he held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position for the Saints.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Ober is one of six players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of two pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2) and RHP Griffin Jax (June 8).

WALKING TALL: Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is one of just five players 6-8-or-taller to suit up for the Twins and Senators, as well as just the third pitcher of that height to debut for Minnesota or Washington...additionally, Ober's 33 career strikeouts are tied with Kam Mickolio for 11th most among all pitchers 6-9-or-taller in major league history...the other pitchers 6-8-or-taller to play for the Twine or the Twins are

SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average (13-for-60)...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints' fifth game on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 intrings and allowing one run on three hits, intervention of the starts of the start of the starts of the sta on May 8 at Umaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three htts, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run scored on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work... took the ball again on May 13 vs. lowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision...earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at lowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none and fanning five as the Saints exploded for 17 runs en route to a 17-5 rout of the I-Cubs...his other start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, fanning a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep.

CAREER REDUX: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a .222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances (35 starts)...was added to the Iwins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020 and is currently ranked as the 21st-best prospect in the Twins system by MLB.com...spent part of the offseason working out in Colorado with fellow Twins pitcher Taylor Rogers and Griffin Jax.
 Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).
 Over that same time span, Ober ranks third by allowing just 8.79 base runners-per-9.0 innings, fourth by walking just 1.18 batters-per-9.0-innings and fifth in WHIP (0.96).
