FUTURES GAME FOR THE WIN(DER): Tomorrow at 2:00 pm (CT), the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game will be played at Coors Field...the Twins will be represented by right-handed pitcher Josh Winder (pronounced WINE-der)...the 24 -year-old has split the the 2021 season between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, combining to go 4-0, 2.17 ERA (62.1 IP, 15 ER) with 13 walks, 75 strikeouts and a 0.91 WHIP in 12 starts...Winder was selected by the Twins in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...additionally, former Twins reliever and
current Twins Special Assistant/broadcaster LaTroy Hawkins will manage the AL Futures Taam current Twins Special Assistant/broadcaster LaTroy Hawkins will manage the AL Futures Team, before serving as the Twins' on-site representative at the draft.

START PRIOR: Took his first career decision, a loss, on June 30 at Chicago-AL....pitched just 3.1 innings, the shortest outing of his career, while permitting a career-high five runs on four hits (3 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts as the Twins eventually fell 13-3...Worked a scoreless opening frame before yielding three runs in the second on a solo shot by Brian Goodwin and a two-run homer off the bat of Andrew Vaughn...allowed a single tally in the third (José Abreu solo shot) and departed with two on, one out in the fourth; one additional run scored off Matt Shoemaker...reached the 80 -pitch mark for the second time in his career, also doing so in his first career start on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL.
DIVISIONAL REDUX: This afternoon marks Ober's first career start and appearance against the Tigers... four of his seven career starts to date have come against the American League Central division and he's $1-1,5.51 \mathrm{ERA}(16.1 \mathrm{IP}, 10 \mathrm{ER})$ with six walks, 18 strikeouts and a 250 opponent batting average ( 16 -for-64) in those four outings.
LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first seven career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a 150 batting average ( 3 -for-20) with runners in scoring position as well as a .100 ( 1 -for-10) mark with RISP and two outs...has not allowed a hit with runners in scoring position in each of his last two starts...this trend was also true in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, as he held opposing hitters to just a. 182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position for the Saints.

WALKING TALL: Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is one of just five players 6-8-or-taller to suit up for the Twins and Senators, as well as just the third pitcher of that height to debut for Minnesota or Washington....additionally, Ober's 33 career strikeouts are tied with Kam Mickolio for 11th most among all pitchers 6-9-or-taller in major league history...the other pitchers 6-8-or-taller to play for the Twins are:

SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average ( 13 -for- 60 )...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints tifth game on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run scored on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work... took the ball again on May 13 vs. lowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision...earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at lowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none and fanning five as the Saints exploded for 17 runs en route to a 17-5 rout of the I-Cubs....his other start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, fanning a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep.
