**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 3-2 through five games on their seven-game homestand, going 1-2 vs. the White Sox and 2-0 vs. the Tigers...today they will continue their homestand with the third of four against the Tigers leading up to the break...after tomorrow's game, Major League Baseball will hold the All-Star Break in Colorado from July 12-15...the Twins have gone 20-25 at home this season and 17-25 on the road.

**FOUR-RUN SIXTH TAKES DOWN TIGERS:** The Twins beat the Tigers last night by a score of 4-2...Kenta Maeda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts...Jorge Alcalá (2-3) was credited with the win as Hansel Robles earned his ninth save with 1.2 scoreless innings...the offense recorded just four hits, two from Max Kepler, who recorded two RBI and the Twins' only extra-base hit with a sixth-inning triple...Target Field drew a season-best with 21,725 in attendance.

**TWINS AND TIGERS:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the eighth of 19 games in 2021...Twins have gone 5-2 this season, going 2-0 at Target Field and 3-2 at Comerica Park...the Twins have won 11 of their last 14 over the Tigers, 16 of their last 22 and 19 of their last 26. Today marks the third of eight straight against the Tigers as the Twins will travel to Detroit after the All-Star Break for a four-game series at Comerica Park from July 16-18 with a doubleheader on the 16th. Twins are 10-1 in their last 11 against the Tigers at Target Field and 16-4 in their last 20 here.

**KEPLER HEATING:** Max Kepler has reached base safely in nine-straight games, hitting .333 (10-for-30) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, seven RBI, four walks, a .412 on-base percentage and a 1.178 OPS in that span...on the season, 23 of Kepler's 42 hits have gone for extra bases (19 singles, 11 doubles, 3 triples, 9 home runs).

**LUKY LEADOFF:** Luis Arraez is hitting .329 (56-for-170) with eight doubles, four triples, 14 RBI, 31 runs scored, 16 walks and a .389 on-base percentage out of the leadoff spot...he leads the team with 42 starts out of that spot, including 12 of the Twins' last 17 games...among all American League players, he ranks first in batting average from the top spot in the lineup and second in on-base percentage, trailing the Angels' Justin Upton (.417).

**FEELING A DRAFT:** Major League Baseball's First-Year Player Draft will take place tomorrow night, starting at 6:00 pm (CT)...the Twins will select 26th overall with a second pick at number 36, which represents the Competitive Balance Round A selection...they will continue the draft on Monday with the second round (61st selection)...in 2020 the Twins drafted first baseman Aaron Sabato out of the University of North Carolina with the 27th overall pick.

**FUTURES GAME FOR THE WIN(DER):** Tomorrow at 2:00 pm (CT), the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game will be played at Coors Field...the Twins will be represented by right-handed pitcher Josh Winder (pronounced WINE-der)...the 24-year-old has split the 2021 season between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, combining to go 4-0, 2.17 ERA (62.1 IP, 15 ER) with 13 walks, 75 strikeouts and a 0.91 WHIP in 12 starts...Winder was selected by the Twins in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...additionally, former Twins reliever and current Twins Special Assistant/broadcaster LaTroy Hawkins will manage the AL Futures Team, before serving as the Twins' on-site representative at the draft.

**ALL-STAR FLASHBACKS:** Notables on past All-Star games played on this day:  
 ☞ In 2012 at Kauffman Stadium, Joe Mauer was the Twins lone representative, playing 2.0 innings at first base, singling off Arizona's Wade Miley in his only plate appearance.  
 ☞ In 2007 at AT&T Park, Twins representatives Justin Morneau and Torii Hunter both went 0-for-2 off the AL bench and Johan Santana pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief with two strikeouts in a 5-4 AL victory.  
 ☞ In 2001 at Safeco Field, Cristian Guzmán made a pinch hit appearance and struck out in his one at-bat...Joe Mays pitched 1.0 perfect inning of relief...Eric Milton did not appear.  
 ☞ In 1990 at Wrigley Field, Kirby Puckett represented the Twins in his fifth of 10 career All-Star appearances...he pinch hit for Ken Griffey Jr. in the eighth inning and singled off Cincinnati's Randy Myers in his only plate appearance.

**WELCOME BACK WEEK:** With the Twins opening Target Field to full, 100 percent capacity, without restrictions, the club is celebrating a "Welcome Back Week" for its fans during this homestand that runs through tomorrow...all seven games this week feature some combination of a promotional giveaway, theme night or other special event.

☞ **Today - 30 HR "Bomba Club" Bobblehead presented by Delta Air Lines:** Within the Twins' famed 2019 "Bomba Squad" that hit a single-season MLB record 307 home runs, there was a quintet that formed another single-season mark by becoming the first set of five teammates to all reach the 30-homer plateau...the first 10,000 fans in attendance will receive a special 30 HR "Bomba Club" Bobblehead, presented by Delta Air Lines, featuring the likenesses of Miguel Sanó, Eddie Rosario, Mitch Garver, Nelson Cruz and Max Kepler.

**LAST START:** Earned his first career win in his last start in the homestand opener on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL, leading the Twins to an 8-5 win...permitted just two hits – a second-inning double by Gavin Sheets and a fifth-inning single by Tim Anderson – across 5.0 shutout frames, with a career-high three walks and a career-high-tying seven strikeouts (also, June 11 vs. Houston)...threw a career-high 93 pitches, the first time in his career he crossed the 90-pitch threshold, while also matching his career high with 5.0 innings pitched.

**START PRIOR:** Took his first career decision, a loss, on June 30 at Chicago-AL...pitched just 3.1 innings, the shortest outing of his career, while permitting a career-high five runs on four hits (3 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts as the Twins eventually fell 13-3...worked a scoreless opening frame before yielding three runs in the second on a solo shot by Brian Goodwin and a two-run homer off the bat of Andrew Vaughn...allowed a single tally in the third (José Abreu solo shot) and departed with two on, one out in the fourth; one additional run scored off Matt Shoemaker...reached the 80-pitch mark for the second time in his career, also doing so in his first career start on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL.

**DIVISIONAL REDUX:** This afternoon marks Ober's first career start and appearance against the Tigers...four of his seven career starts to date have come against the American League Central division and he's 1-1, 5.51 ERA (16.1 IP, 10 ER) with six walks, 18 strikeouts and a .250 opponent batting average (16-for-64) in those four outings.

**LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD:** Through his first seven career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .150 batting average (3-for-20) with runners in scoring position as well as a .100 (1-for-10) mark with RISP and two outs...has not allowed a hit with runners in scoring position in each of his last two starts...this trend was also true in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, as he held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position for the Saints.

**LOW TRAFFIC:** Ober struck out 100 batters and walked just nine in 2019, good for an MiLB-best 11.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min. 75.0 IP)...that season, he also ranked second in the minors in WHIP (0.81) and base runners-per-9.0 IP (7.55), and was fifth in walks-per-9.0 IP (1.03).  
 ☞ In seven MLB starts this season, Ober has allowed 40 total base runners in 29.2 innings, good for a 12.13 base-runners-per-9.0 IP ratio...he's also averaging just 2.73 walks-per-9.0 IP while averaging 10.01 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP...he has walked just nine batters compared to 33 strikeouts, good for a 3.67 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** Ober is one of six players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of two pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2) and RHP Griffin Jax (June 8).

**WALKING TALL:** Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is one of just five players 6-8-or-taller to suit up for the Twins and Senators, as well as just the third pitcher of that height to debut for Minnesota or Washington...additionally, Ober's 33 career strikeouts are tied with Kam Mickolio for 11th most among all pitchers 6-9-or-taller in major league history...the other pitchers 6-8-or-taller to play for the Twins are:

**SAINTLY SUMMARY:** Ober made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average (13-for-60)...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints' fifth game on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run scored on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work...took the ball again on May 13 vs. Iowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision...earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at Iowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none and fanning five as the Saints exploded for 17 runs en route to a 17-5 rout of the I-Cubs...his other start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, fanning a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep.

**CAREER REDUX:** Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a .222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances (35 starts)...was added to the Twins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020 and is currently ranked as the 21st-best prospect in the Twins system by MLB.com...spent part of the offseason working out in Colorado with fellow Twins pitcher Taylor Rogers and Griffin Jax.  
 ☞ Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).  
 ☞ Over that same time span, Ober ranks third by allowing just 8.79 base runners-per-9.0 innings, fourth by walking just 1.18 batters-per-9.0-innings and fifth in WHIP (0.96).

**TOMORROW'S STARTER – JOSÉ BERRÍOS (2021 SEASON: 7-3, 3.36 ERA // CAREER: 55-41, 4.08 ERA)**

Berrios is due to start tomorrow's series and first half finale against the Tigers...was saddled with his third loss of the season in his last start on July 6 vs. Chicago-AL, despite allowing just two runs (1 ER), on one hit, with three walks and 10 strikeouts in 7.0 innings as the Twins fell 4-1...marked his 11th career game with double-digit strikeouts and second this season, after fanning 12 batters on April 3 at Milwaukee...is due to face the Tigers for the second time this season, after taking a no-decision despite a quality start on May 8 at Comerica Park...yielded two runs on six hits (1 HR), with a season-high five walks and one strikeout in a 7-3 Twins loss...is 4-2, 6.08 ERA (47.1 IP, 32 ER) with 24 walks and 40 strikeouts in 10 career appearances vs. the Tigers, including nine starts.
