THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-2 through six games on their seven-game homestand, going 1-2 vs. the White Sox and 3-0 vs. the Tigers...today they will complete the homestand with the four-game series finale against Detroit...this week Major League Baseball will hold the All-Star Break in Colorado from July 12-15 as 2020 Robert O. Fisher Award winner, Dustin Morse, will work for the American League squad...the Twins have gone 21-25 at home this season and 17-25 on the road.

DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon by a score of 9-4...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on four hits in 3.1 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts...Alexander Colomé earned his fifth hold with 1.0 scoreless inning, stranding Jonathan Schoop, who led off the eighth inning with a double...the offense recorded 10 hits, three apiece from Luis Arraez and Nelson Cruz...Alex Kirilloff cut the Tigers four-run lead in half with two-run homer in the sixth inning, his eighth of the season...Jorge Polanco gave the Twins a 5-4 lead with a go-ahead three-run homer in the seventh inning, his 11th of the season.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the ninth of 19 games in 2021...Twins have gone 6-2 this season, going 3-0 at Target Field and 3-2 at Comerica Park...the Twins have won 12 of their last 15 over the Tigers, 17 of their last 23 and 20 of their last 27.
 ☞ Today marks the fourth of eight straight against the Tigers as the Twins will travel to Detroit after the All-Star Break for a four-game series at Comerica Park from July 16-18, with a doubleheader on the 16th.
 ☞ Twins are 11-1 in their last 12 against the Tigers at Target Field and 17-4 in their last 21 here.

SWEEP! SWEEP! SWEEP! The Twins are looking for their third sweep of an opponent this season, their other two coming May 24-26 vs. Baltimore and June 18-20 at Texas...the Twins last four-game sweep of an opponent came August 15-18, 2019 at Texas...their last four-game sweep at Target Field came September 28-30, 2018 vs. Chicago-AL...their last four-game sweep of Detroit came September 21-24, 2017 at Comerica Park...the Twins have never swept the Tigers in four games in Minnesota.

LUKY LEADOFF: Luis Arraez is hitting .337 (59-for-175) with eight doubles, four triples, 16 RBI, 33 runs scored, 16 walks and a .395 on-base percentage out of the leadoff spot...he leads the team with 43 starts out of that spot, including 13 of the Twins' last 18 games...among all American League players, he ranks first in batting average from the top spot in the lineup and second in on-base percentage, trailing the Angels' Justin Upton (.417).

ROCKY MOUNTAIN NELLIE: On Tuesday night in Colorado, Nelson Cruz will represent the Twins in the All-Star Game...this marks Cruz's seventh time being named an All-Star, previously in 2009 and '13 with Texas, 2014 with Baltimore, and 2015, '17 and '18 with Seattle...in his five ASG appearances (DNP in 2009), he has gone 0-for-7 with two walks and three strikeouts...at 41-years-old he is the oldest All-Star since Mariano Rivera (43) in 2013...this marks the first time in club history that a designated hitter has been named to represent the Twins.
 ☞ In 77 games this season, Cruz is hitting .304 (82-for-270) with 11 doubles, 18 home runs, 46 RBI, 30 walks, a .375 on-base percentage, a .552 slugging percentage and a .927 OPS...he ranks seventh in the AL in batting average, fourth in OPS, sixth in slugging and ninth in on-base percentage.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Single-A Cedar Rapids outfielder Michael Helman and Double-A Wichita left-handed pitcher Jovani Moran are the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
 ☞ Helman played in six games for the Kernels, hitting .409 (9-for-22) with one double, two home runs, four RBI, one walk, a .458 on-base percentage and a 1.186 OPS...the 25-year-old was selected by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas A&M University.
 ☞ Moran made two relief appearances for the Wind Surge, allowing one run on two hits in 5.0 innings pitched with two hits allowed, no walks and eight strikeouts...the 24-year-old was selected by the Twins in the seventh round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of the Carlos Beltrán Baseball Academy.

FEELING A DRAFT: Major League Baseball's First-Year Player Draft will take place tonight, starting at 6:00 pm (CT)...the Twins will select 26th overall with a second pick at number 36, which represents the Competitive Balance Round A selection...they will continue the draft on Monday with the second round (61st selection)...in 2020 the Twins drafted first baseman Aaron Sabato out of the University of North Carolina with the 27th overall pick.

FUTURES GAME FOR THE WINDER: Today at 2:00 pm (CT), the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game will be played at Coors Field...the Twins will be represented by right-handed pitcher Josh Winder (pronounced WINE-der)...the 24-year-old has split the 2021 season between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, combining to go 4-0, 2.17 ERA (62.1 IP, 15 ER) with 13 walks, 75 strikeouts and a 0.91 WHIP in 12 starts...Winder was selected by the Twins in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...additionally, former Twins reliever and current Twins Special Assistant/broadcaster LaTroy Hawkins will manage the AL Futures Team, before serving as the Twins' on-site representative at the draft.

WELCOME BACK WEEK: With the Twins opening Target Field to full, 100 percent capacity, without restrictions, the club is celebrating a "Welcome Back Week" for its fans during this homestand...all seven games this week feature some combination of a promotional giveaway, theme night or other special event.

☞ **Today - Twins Photo Magnet Schedule presented by Star Tribune:** The first 10,000 fans in attendance will receive a special, July-through-September version of a Twins Photo Magnet Schedule, presented by the Star Tribune...**Kids Day presented by Gillette Children's Specialty Healthcare:** Every Sunday, kids' meals are half price - just \$4 - thanks to Gillette Children's Specialty Healthcare...postgame, all kids 12-and-younger can run the bases on the field.

FORE!!: Joe Mauer is currently participating in the American Century Championship, a celebrity golf tournament held in Nevada at Edgewood Tahoe Golf Course...as of this morning, Mauer was tied for 42nd with Larry Fitzgerald, Derek Carr and Roger Clemens...the leader was John Smoltz, just ahead of former San Antonio Spurs guard Vinny Del Negro.

LAST START: Took his third loss of the season last Tuesday, July 6 vs. Chicago-AL, despite working 7.0 innings and allowing just two runs (1 ER) on one hit, with three walks and 10 strikeouts in a 4-1 White Sox victory...both runs occurred on a Zack Collins two-RBI single in the second inning, the only hit of the game permitted by Berríos; only one of the runs was earned, due to a pair of Twins errors earlier in the inning...retired 16 of the final 17 batters he faced, including his last 10...snapped his five-game winning streak, dating back to May 2...was the 11th time in his career recording double-digit strikeouts and second this season (also April 3 at Milwaukee, 12 K)...became only the fifth pitcher since 2000 to pitch 7.0-plus innings, allow one-or-fewer hits, collect 10-plus strikeouts and take the loss; first since Rich Hill did so for Los Angeles-NL on August 23, 2017 at Pittsburgh (L, 0-1).

START PRIOR: Did not factor into the decision on July 1 at Chicago-AL, working 5.0 innings and permitting four runs (3 ER) on a season-high 10 hits, with one walk and no strikeouts in an eventual 8-5 Twins loss...allowed a solo home run to Brian Goodwin leading off the second inning before two more runs crossed the plate in the third on an RBI single by Yasmani Grandal and a sacrifice fly by Gavin Sheets...took the mound in the fifth with a 4-3 lead but Grandal tied the game when he scored an unearned run after reaching on a throwing error earlier in the inning...marked Berríos' first career game with at least 5.0 innings pitched and no strikeouts...also marked his 27th-consecutive start allowing four earned runs-or-fewer, the longest such streak by a Twin since Johan Santana recorded a run of 35-straight starts of four earned runs-or-fewer from July 15, 2006-July 18, 2007.

700 CLUB: This season, Berríos has surpassed both 700 strikeouts and 700.0 innings pitched for his career...his 700th strikeout came in the fifth inning on May 15 vs. Oakland, fanning Seth Brown...became the 15th Twin to reach 700 strikeouts and the 28th Twin to reach 700.0 innings pitched.
 ☞ He needs 11 strikeouts to tie Scott Baker (770) for 12th on the Twins all-time strikeout list (list in lower right area of page).

MOTOWN RUNDOWN: Berríos is making his 11th career appearance (10th start) against Detroit today, having gone 4-2, 6.08 ERA (47.1 IP, 32 ER) in his 10 prior outings against the Tigers
 ☞ His 6.08 ERA vs. Detroit is his highest mark against any team which he's faced at least five times in his career.
 ☞ Has made one start against Detroit this year, coming on May 8 at Comerica Park...earned a quality start, working 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on six hits, with a season-high five walks and one strikeout...five walks was his most in a start since setting a career high with six free passes on August 9, 2018 at Cleveland.
 ☞ Last faced the Tigers at Target Field on August 23, 2019, taking the loss after allowing five runs on 10 hits, with two walks and five strikeouts over 5.1 innings of work in a 9-6 Tigers victory.

FIRST HALF CONSISTENCY: Berríos has been a consistent staple of the Twins' rotation, especially in the season's first half, since his first full major league season in 2017...some pre-All-Star Break notes below:
 ☞ Has made at least 11 starts and recorded at least seven wins in the first half of every season (excluding 2020 - no "first half") dating back to 2017...maintained a pre-All-Star Break ERA between 3.00 and 3.68 in each of those campaigns.
 ☞ His monthly ERAs this season have followed a similar pattern, not wavering below 3.00 or above 3.58 in any singular month so far (April - 3.04, May - 3.58, June - 3.55, July - 3.00).
 ☞ Owns a career 33-18, 3.62 ERA (432.1 IP, 174 ER) before the All-Star Break, compared to 17-19, 4.84 ERA (266.0 IP, 143 ER) after the Break.

SLICK LEATHER: He has four defensive runs saved this season, tied with Tampa Bay's Josh Fleming and Seattle's Chris Flexen for third best in baseball, trailing only Chicago-AL's Dallas Keuchel (5) and New York-NL's Taijuan Walker (5)...Berríos finished tied for fifth in baseball among pitchers in DRS in 2020 with one...since 2019, he ranks tied for 10th in DRS with five...his three pickoffs this season are tied for tops in the AL and tied for third most in the majors.

RIGHTY TIGHTY: Berríos is holding right-handed hitters to a .179 (35-for-196) average with five doubles, three home runs, eight walks and 55 strikeouts, compared to lefties hitting .279 (50-for-179) with 14 doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 19 walks and 51 strikeouts against him...his right-handed opponent batting average ranks first among AL righties (min. 175 opp. AB) and third in the AL, behind Chicago-AL's Carlos Rodón (.169) and Baltimore's John Means (.177).

TARGETING HISTORY: Berríos is currently tied with former Twin Kyle Gibson for most career wins at Target Field...a win today would give Berríos the most victories in the history of this ballpark.

2021 ARSENAL: Berríos features a four-pitch repertoire, highlighted by his curveball, which he throws more than 30% of the time...below is a look at his arsenal, per Baseball Savant.

☞ His 25.7% strikeout percentage ranks in the 63rd percentile in baseball and is currently the highest single-season mark of his career.
 ☞ Has walked just 27 batters in 413 opponent plate appearances this season, good for a 6.5 walk percentage, ranking in the 76th percentile of all MLB pitchers...6.5% is a vast improvement from 2020 for Berríos, who walked 9.6% of all batters last season.
 ☞ Opposing batters are swinging at 30.7% of Berríos' pitches outside of the zone, ranking in the 78th percentile for chase rate.

CAREER NOTES

- Named to 2018 and 2019 AL All-Star teams, pitching 1.0 inning in both games.
- Started Game 1 of the 2019 ALDS against New York-AL and Game 2 of the 2020 AL Wild Card Series vs. Houston.
- In 2019, teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 K on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893, when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall-of-Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.
- Given the 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of BBWAA...also won the Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.
- Became 21st pitcher in Twins' history to reach the 200-strikeout mark in a season (202 in 2018).
- Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts.
- Made MLB debut April 27, 2016 vs. Cleveland.
- Named Twins' second-best prospect entering 2016, as well as best curveball, best changeup, and best control in Twins' system by *Baseball America*.
