A DIFFERENT KIND OF TIGER: Barnes was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Clemson University...he posted a 3.85 ERA (220.0 IP. 94 ER) with 54 walks and 220 strikeouts in 44 appearances (34 starts) over three seasons at Clemson.

The Barnes family has a long history with Clemson and Charlie attended his first Clemson football game when he was six weeks old...when he graduated early from the university in May 2017, the Sumter, South Carolina native became the 13th member of his family to earn a degree from Clemson...he took extra summer classes in order to earn his degree prior to being drafted...additionally, his brother, James, was a redshirt freshman quarterback on the 2016 Clemson football team.

LAST TIME OUT: Maeda last started on July 9 vs. Detroit at Target Field, taking a no-decision in eventual 4-2 Twins win...worked 5.0 shutout innings and allowed just two singles, with two walks and seven strikeouts...departed with the score tied 0-0; the Twins scored four runs in the sixth to win...marked his fourth start this season in which he did not allow an extra-base hit (also, July 4 at Kansas City, May 3 vs. Texas and April 1 at Milwaukee)...also marked the second time in his career that Maeda has allowed two-or-fewer hits and worked at least 5.0 innings in back-to-back starts, also doing so from May 17-23, 2018 with Los Angeles-NL...additionally, was the fourth time in his career with back-to-back scoreless starts, last doing so May 10-15, 2019 with the Dodgers. **& Maeda has yet to allow a run in his major league career while wearing high socks (11.0 IP over two starts)**.

 Maeda's seven career games with 10-plus strikeouts are fourth most among Japanese-born pitchers in major league history, behind Darvish (46), Nomo (31) and Tanaka (14).


