THE TWINS: Began their "second half" with two losses to the Tigers yesterday...today they will continue their roadtrip with the series finale in Detroit...after today's game, they will travel to Chicago for four games from Monday-Wednesday, which includes a doubleheader tomorrow...the Twins have gone 22-25 at home this season and 17-27 on the road.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The Twins lost both games of their doubleheader in Detroit yesterday by scores of 0-1 in game one and 4-5 in game two...Charlie Barnes made his major league debut as the starter in game one, allowing one run on four hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the only run scored in the first game was a Robbie Grossman leadoff homer...Kenta Maeda made the start in game two, allowing three runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts...the losses made the Twins 1-7 in doubleheaders in 2021.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 12th of 19 games in 2021...Twins have gone 7-4 vs. Detroit this season, going 4-0 at Target Field and 3-4 at Comerica Park...the Twins have won 13 of their last 18 over the Tigers, 18 of their last 26 and 21 of their last 30.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .302 (134-for-443) with 22 doubles, 26 home runs, 78 RBI, 52 walks, a .533 slugging percentage and a .910 OPS in 118 career games against the Tigers...his 26 home runs are the most among actives (list, lower right margin)...since joining the Twins in 2019, he is hitting .358 (48-for-134) with five doubles, nine home runs, 25 RBI and a 1.011 OPS in 35 games vs. Detroit...he is hitting .331 (83-for-251) with 11 doubles, 20 home runs, 52 RBI, 19 walks and a .995 OPS in 63 career games at Comerica Park...in his last 32 games here, he is hitting .368 (50-for-136) with 16 home runs, 32 RBI and a 1.167 OPS...in fact, since 2015, he leads all opponents in home runs at Comerica with 16.

☞ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .331 (41-for-124) with eight doubles, one home run, 14 RBI, 16 walks, a .406 on-base percentage and an .825 OPS in 36 career games vs. the Tigers.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with three doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, three walks and a 1.024 OPS in 11 games this season against the Tigers.

DONALDSON'S DIVISION: Josh Donaldson is a career .307/.404/.612 (298-for-971) hitter in 268 games against the AL Central, with 63 doubles, four triples, 75 home runs, 215 RBI, 198 runs scored and a 1.016 OPS...he's batting .321 (18-for-56) with four doubles, six homers, 12 RBI, 12 runs scored, a .403 on-base percentage, a .714 slugging percentage and a 1.117 OPS in his last 17 games against the division...additionally, Donaldson's homer in game two yesterday was the 75th of his career against the division, breaking a tie with New York-NL's Francisco Lindor to take sole possession of eighth-most longballs against the AL Central among active players.

NELSON CRUZ, ACCOMPLISHED BASE STEALER: Nelson Cruz stole his third base of the season in the top of the eighth inning of game two yesterday...he's the first major leaguer age 40-plus with at least three thefts in a single season since Ichiro Suzuki stole 10 bases for the Miami Marlins in 2016...Cruz is also the first Twin age 40-or-older with at least three stolen bases in a season since Hall-of-Famer Paul Molitor stole nine bases in 1998.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: The Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Brent Rooker and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Jordan Balazovic minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Rooker played in seven games for the Saints, hitting .308 (8-for-26) with one double, five home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.290 OPS...he hit three home runs and drove in seven on Tuesday against Columbus...the 26-year-old was selected 35th overall by the Twins in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft.

☞ Balazovic started two games for the Wind Surge, going 1-0, 0.00 ERA (13.0 IP) with six hits allowed, one walk and 18 strikeouts...he fanned 11 batters in 7.0 innings on Thursday against Tulsa...the 22-year-old was selected by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, TORII: Twins Hall-of-Famer Torii Hunter is celebrating his 46th birthday today...Hunter appeared in 12 games on his birthday throughout his career, hitting .262 (11-for-42) with three doubles, two home runs and six RBI...Hunter owns the second-highest BWAR (50.7) among players born on this day, trailing only Hall-of-Fame manager Joe Torre (57.5).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2015, 44,152 people took in Kenny Chesney's "The Big Revival" tour and Jason Aldean's "The Burn It Down" tour at Target Field, the highest-attended concert in ballpark history.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his fifth win and fourth quality start of the season in his last outing on July 8 vs. Detroit...gave up three runs on eight hits over 7.0 innings; his longest outing since April 28 at Cleveland (also 7.0 IP)...allowed just one walk and struck out eight batters, while surpassing the 100-pitch mark for the sixth time this season...gave up a two-run home run to Eric Haase in the fourth...Minnesota's offense took the lead in the bottom of the seventh inning and the Twins' bullpen tossed 2.0 scoreless innings after Happ departed to secure the 5-3 victory.

TWO STARTS AGO: Evened his season record at 4-4 after shouldering the loss from the Twins 7-4 defeat on July 2 at Kansas City...allowed six runs on a season-high-tying nine hits (2 HR) over 4.1 innings of work, with just one walk and four strikeouts...gave up a home run to Salvador Perez in the second, as well as a two-run homer to Hanser Alberto in the third...departed in the fifth inning in favor of Tyler Duffey.

DEFEATING DETROIT: Happ is making his 15th career appearance and 14th start vs. Detroit this afternoon...has gone 4-2, 4.86 ERA (74.0 IP, 40 ER), with 26 walks and 69 strikeouts over his previous 14 outings against the Tigers.

☞ Has faced Detroit twice so far this season: once on April 6 at Comerica Park and again on July 8 at Target Field...has gone 1-0, 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP, 4 ER), with four walks and 12 strikeouts against Detroit so far.

☞ Happ holds a record of 1-1, 4.58 ERA (39.1 IP, 36 H, 20 ER), with 17 walks and 32 strikeouts when facing Detroit as the visiting pitcher.

☞ Holds a record of 4-3, 6.84 ERA (51.1 IP, 39 ER) in 10 starts against the American League Central division this season.

LOW TRAFFIC: Since the beginning of the 2018 season, Happ has averaged 11.51 base runners-per-9.0 innings, 8th fewest in the American League and 24th fewest in the majors (min. 435.0 IP)...Happ has allowed the 5th fewest total base runners (602) in the American League over that span (min. 435.0 IP). ☞ However, this season has allowed 13.66 base runners-per-9.0 innings (125 in just 82.1 IP).

RISP MANAGEMENT: Happ held opposing hitters to a .156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

☞ However, this season opposing hitters are 22-for-76 (.289) against Happ with RISP, far above his career .234 mark of (350-for-1498).

A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB: Happ's start on April 13 vs. Boston was the 300th of his career...he is one of 11 active pitchers to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (478), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (437), Ervin Santana (386), Max Scherzer (385), Clayton Kershaw (372), Adam Wainwright (344), Johnny Cueto (322), David Price (315) and Madison Bumgarner (308).

☞ He has made at least 10 starts against 15 of 30 MLB teams.

PITCH SELECTION: This season Happ has featured five different pitches...he relies heavily on his four-seam fastball, throwing it more than half of the time...here is his 2021 repertoire, according to Baseball Savant:

☞ Ranks in the upper 55th percentile in baseball in fastball spin.
☞ He has allowed just 25 walks this season, ranking in the upper 73rd percentile of BB% in baseball.

NIGHT AND DAY, HOME AND ROAD: Happ has made 16 starts so far this season, taking the mound 10 times at night and six times during the day...during his 10 starts under the lights, he is 2-4, 7.43 ERA (49.2 IP, 41 ER) with 17 walks, 35 strikeouts and a .385 opponent on-base percentage...however, his numbers improve when the sun is up; during his six starts in the daytime, he is 3-0, 3.58 ERA (32.2 IP, 13 ER) with eight walks, 32 strikeouts and a .273 opponent on-base percentage.

☞ Nine of his starts this season have come at Target Field and the other seven have come on the road...his numbers at home outshine his record on the road...**He is 4-1, 4.25 ERA (48.2 IP, 23 ER) with 16 walks and 36 strikeouts in nine home starts**, while he is 1-3, 8.29 ERA (33.2 IP, 31 ER) with nine walks and 31 strikeouts in seven starts on the road.

FANNED BY DOUBLE DIGITS: Happ fanned a season-high 10 batters in Cleveland on May 23, his 12th career game with double-digit strikeouts...became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history age 38-or-older with at least 10 strikeouts in a start since Connie Marrero (age 39.037) on June 1, 1950 (12.0 IP, 10 K)...also became the third to do so in nine innings-or-less, joining Johnny Niggeling, who did it twice: August 16, 1944 (8.0 IP, 11 K) and July 8, 1944 (9.0 IP, 10 K).

FRESH STARTS: Happ allowed just two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his first five starts to begin this season, the longest such streak to start a campaign in his career...however, is 3-4, 8.00 ERA (54.0 IP, 48 ER) in his last 11 starts (beginning May 12).

CAREER NOTES

- Ranks fourth among active left-handed pitchers in wins (128) and starts (314), while he is fifth in innings pitched (1823.2) and seventh in strikeouts (1606).
- Pitched a career best of 7.1 hitless innings on April 23, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh...left the game allowing only one hit over 7.1 innings...combined with Tyler Duffey and Taylor Rogers on the 19th one-hitter in Twins history.
- Made his 300th career start April 13, 2021 vs. Boston.
- In 2020, led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655)...did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
- Has made 12 Opening Day rosters with six teams: Philadelphia (2009-10), Houston (2011-12), Toronto (2013, '16-18), Seattle (2015), New York-AL (2019-20) and Minnesota (2021).
- Enters 2021 with 14 MLB seasons under his belt, with the Phillies (2007-10), Astros (2010-12), Blue Jays (2012-14, '16-18), Mariners (2015), Pirates (2015) and Yankees (2018-20).
- Made his 300th career major league appearance and 275th career start on June 23, 2019 vs. Houston.
- Compiled a career-best 19.1-inning scoreless streak from August 26-September 12-G1, 2019, the AL's eighth-longest scoreless streak in 2019 and longest by a Yankee.
- Finished sixth in 2016 AL Cy Young Award voting after going 20-4, 3.18 ERA for Toronto and tying for the second-most wins in baseball...marks his only career 20-win season and is one of just seven pitchers in the majors (and one of two southpaws) with a 20-win campaign in 2016.
- Finished second in 2009 BBWAA NL Rookie of the Year balloting to Florida's Chris Coghlan...appeared on all 32 ballots, receiving 10 first-place votes...won the 2009 Players' Choice Award for NL Outstanding Rookie...named 2009 NL Rookie of the Year by The Sporting News.
