City．．．he＇s gone 1－1， 8.66 ERA（17．2 IP， 17 ER），eight walks and 14 strikeouts across those outings． $\Phi$ Had his contract selected June 5，while his big league debut came at Target Field on June 8 vs ． the New York Yankees．．．pitched the ninth inning，fanning Tyler Wade for his first career strikeout．
