THE TWINS: Began their "second half" with a three-game sweep at the hands of the Tigers at Comerica Park over the weekend...today they will continue their roadtrip with two games in Chicago against the White Sox...they will play games three and four against the Sox on Tuesday and Wednesday...they will travel home after Wednesday's game to begin a seven-game homestand with four against the Angels (July 22-25) and three against the Tigers (July 26-28)...the Twins have gone 22-25 at home this season and 17-28 on the road.

TWINS SWEEPED OUT OF DETROIT: The Twins lost to the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Comerica Park by a score of 7-0, suffering their fifth sweep of the season...J.A. Happ (5-5) was the starter and loser, allowing seven runs on 11 hits in 7.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded six hits, two from both Luis Arraez and Trevor Larnach...Arraez had the club's only extra-base hit with a third-inning double...the Twins were shutout for the fifth time this season and second time on the trip.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have reinstated left-handed pitcher Danny Coulombe from the Paternity List...Coulombe and his wife, Lauren, recently welcomed their second son, Thomas...the southpaw had his contract selected from Triple-A St. Paul on June 25 and has appeared in six games (1 start) for the Twins this season, going 1-0 with a 1.13 ERA (8.0 IP, 1 ER), one walk and 11 strikeouts...to make room for Coulombe on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Beau Burrows to Triple-A St. Paul...Burrows, who was recalled on Saturday, made one scoreless appearance in the first game of that day's doubleheader in Detroit, working 1.1 innings and allowing two hits while striking out one batter. Additionally, Griffin Jax has been added today as the club's 27th man.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the 13th and 14th of 19 meetings this season...Twins are 2-10 against the Sox in 2021, going 2-4 at Target Field and 0-6 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Twins have been outscored by the White Sox this season 47-91 (-44). Nelson Cruz is hitting .391 (54-for-138) with 11 doubles, 14 home runs, 39 RBI, 19 walks, a .465 OBP, a .775 slugging percentage and a 1.240 OPS in 37 games vs. the Sox while in a Minnesota uniform (since 2019).

Miguel Sanó has 13 home runs and 26 RBI in 34 games vs. the Sox since the start of 2019...full list of home run leaders against the Sox since 2019 at bottom right.

Josh Donaldson is hitting .299 (63-for-211) with 10 doubles, 19 home runs, 47 RBI, 41 walks and a 1.025 OPS in 61 career games vs. the White Sox...he has homered in three of his last six games against the Sox and in four of his last 10.

Andrelton Simmons is hitting .310 (22-for-71) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, four walks and a .347 on-base percentage in 19 career games at Guaranteed Rate Field. The Twins have lost seven straight at Guaranteed Rate Field, their last win here coming on September 16, 2020.

DONALDSON'S DIVISION: Josh Donaldson is a career .307/.405/.612 (299-for-973) hitter in 269 games against the AL Central, with 63 doubles, four triples, 75 home runs, 215 RBI, 198 runs scored and a 1.017 OPS...he's batting .328 (19-for-58) with four doubles, six homers, 12 RBI, 12 runs scored, a .423 on-base percentage, a .707 slugging percentage and a 1.129 OPS in his last 18 games against the division...additionally, Donaldson's 75 home runs are eighth most among actives.

ARRAEZ TO THE TOP: Luis Arraez is hitting .337 (63-for-187) with nine doubles, four triples, 16 RBI, 34 runs scored, 17 walks and a .394 on-base percentage out of the leadoff spot...he leads the team with 46 starts out of that spot...among all American League players, he ranks first in batting average from the top spot in the lineup and second in on-base percentage, trailing the Angels' Justin Upton (.417).

DIVISIONAL CRUZ: Since joining the Twins prior to the 2019 season, Nelson Cruz has hit .332 (167-for-503) with 27 doubles, 46 home runs, 120 RBI, 64 walks, a .664 slugging percentage and a 1.074 OPS in 136 games against the American League Central...here are his home runs by division opponent in that span:

BALAZOVIC WINS THE WEEK: Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Jordan Balazovic today was named Double-A Central Pitcher of the Week...Balazovic started two games for the Wind Surge, going 1-0, 0.00 ERA (13.0 IP) with six hits allowed, one walk and 18 strikeouts...he fanned 11 batters in 7.0 innings on Thursday against Tulsa...the 22-year-old was selected by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1982, the Twins overcame two homers by Robin Yount to beat the Brewers, 6-4...Tom Brunansky hit his second inside-the-park homer of the year (the other came on May 28), but this one a grand slam off Jerry Augustine...the inside-the-park grand slam marked the first and only one in Twins history...in that game, Paul Molitor led off for the Brewers, going 0-for-5.

- ☞ On June 8, became the first Air Force Academy graduate ever to play in the majors...originally selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT, UP AND DOWN: Jax last pitched in the majors on July 3 at Kansas City, making his first career start and taking the loss as the Twins fell to the Royals, 6-3...worked a career-high 5.0 innings and allowed a career-high six runs on eight hits (1 HR), with three walks and three strikeouts...maneuvered around a leadoff walk/stolen base by Whit Merrifield to complete a scoreless first and retired nine of the next 10 batters he faced from the first through third innings before running into trouble in the fourth...yielded four runs on four hits that frame, capped off by a two-run homer by Edward Olivares...allowed two more runs in the fifth inning before departing.

- ☞ Jax's most recent start for Triple-A St. Paul came on July 13 vs. Columbus, holding the Clippers to one run on a solo homer...the Saints' offense exploded for double-digit runs en route to a 19-1 win...Jax threw just 63 pitches in 5.0 innings and yielded three hits (1 HR).

BIG LEAGUE BREAKDOWN: Jax is in his third stint with the Twins this season, after being with the club from June 5-15 and June 24-July 7...the 26-year-old right-hander has appeared four times out of the bullpen, including his June 8 major league debut, and made one start, on July 3 at Kansas City...he's gone 1-1, 8.66 ERA (17.2 IP, 17 ER), eight walks and 14 strikeouts across those outings.

- ☞ Had his contract selected June 5, while his big league debut came at Target Field on June 8 vs. the New York Yankees...pitched the ninth inning, fanning Tyler Wade for his first career strikeout.
- ☞ Also pitched June 9 vs. the Yankees and June 15 at Seattle...was optioned following his 4.0-inning, six-strikeout, 93-pitch effort vs. the Mariners...was recalled just nine days later and earned his first career win in relief on June 25 vs. Cleveland (4.1 IP, 3 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 2 K)...also started July 3 at Kansas City (full outing detailed in the note above) before being optioned.

LOTS OF LOVE FOR THE LEFTIES: Jax has held left-handed batters to a .179 (5-for-28) batting average, with two doubles, one homer, five walks and five strikeouts so far in his major league career...this compares to the .395 (17-for-43) batting average that right-handed batters have posted against him.

EARLY DOMINANCE: Jax is holding opposing hitters to just 1-for-14 (.071) combined in innings one through three so far in his career...he's struggled when tasked with pitching in the middle innings of games, as opponents are batting .371 (13-for-35) against him in innings four through six, including a 6-for-11 (.545) mark in the fourth inning alone.

THE ARSENAL: Jax has used four different offerings so far in his major league career, relying primarily on his four-seam fastball...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire so far, per Baseball Savant.

ACROSS THE RIVER: Jax did not play an official professional game in 2020 and was not part of the Twins' 60-man player pool...participated in the Twins Fall Instructional League in Fort Myers in October 2020...opened 2021 in the rotation for Triple-A St. Paul, going 3-1, 3.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 10 ER) in five starts during May...did not pitch upon being optioned to the Saints on June 16 and returned to the Twins on June 24...made one start for the Saints during his most recent Triple-A stint, on July 13 vs. Columbus (W, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, HR).

- ☞ Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in all six of his Triple-A starts, while cresting the 90-pitch plateau in four of his six efforts...is 4-1, 3.09 ERA (32.0 IP, 11 ER) overall with the Saints.
- ☞ Has held opponents to one-or-zero runs in five of his six Saints starts...in fact, taking away his lone poor outing in a May 18 loss to Indianapolis (5.0 IP, 7 ER), he has posted a 4-0 mark with a 1.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 4 ER) in his other five outings...bounced back from his lone loss five days later to hold that same Indians club to one run on seven hits, with a walk and eight strikeouts, in 6.0 innings.
- ☞ In his final Triple-A start before his first major league stint on May 28 at Iowa, established a career high across any level with 10 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-hit, shutout ball (2 walks).
- ☞ Earned his fifth win of the season in his lone start of his most recent Saints stint, pitching an efficient 5.0 innings and allowing one run on a solo homer as St. Paul pummeled Columbus 19-1 on July 13.

CAPTAIN JAX: Jax is the first graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy to ever play in the major leagues...became the sixth Academy product ever to be drafted (now 9) when he was selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

- ☞ Received the email informing him of his promotion to Captain on June 5, his first day in a big league uniform...with that honor, matched the current rank of his wife, Savannah, who is an intelligence officer in the Air Force based out of Moody Air Force Base in Georgia...Savannah has also completed a six-month tour of duty in Afghanistan within the last 18 months.

JAX AND THE AIR FORCE ACADEMY: Jax was able to play baseball full-time through 2019 while concurrently serving in the Air Force through the Air Force's World Class Athlete Program (WCAP); he was accepted into the program in April 2018, following baseball's readmittance as an Olympic sport, as a Second Lieutenant (the rank all cadets receive after graduating from the academy).

- ☞ The WCAP program was established in 1995 in honor of Tuskegee Airman Malvin G. Whitfield, who in 1952 became the first active-duty American serviceman to win an Olympic gold medal, doing so while simultaneously serving as a Korean War tail gunner.
- ☞ The program allows active duty soldiers to train for the Olympics as their full-time job responsibility, while still maintaining active duty status in the military...Jax continued to complete all mandatory Air Force trainings, continuing education, fitness assessments, etc.
- ☞ While part of the WCAP, he was paid by the Air Force as he could not have an outside source of income while on active duty...thanks to a special deal arranged between MLB and the Air Force, the Twins paid for his equipment, travel, etc.
- ☞ Completed his two-year active duty commitment in 2019 and was transferred to the Air Force Reserve in November 2019, while continuing with his five-year Reserve requirement with around 24 days per year of military activity.
- ☞ His wife, Savannah, is also in the Air Force and completed a six-month deployment to Afghanistan within the last 18 months.

CAREER NOTES

- Made his major league debut on June 8, 2021, becoming the first Air Force Academy graduate to ever play in the majors...is a Captain in the United States Air Force Reserve, after completing his two-year active duty commitment in 2019.
- Enters his sixth year as a member of the Twins organization in 2021; did not play in 2020 when the minor league season was cancelled due to COVID-19.
- In 2019 for Double-A Pensacola, was a two-time Southern League Pitcher of the Week on May 5 (1-0, 0.75 ERA, 12.0 IP, 1 ER, 3 BB, 7 K) and June 30 (1-0, 0.69 ERA, 13.0 IP, 1 ER, 2 BB, 8 K)...also named SL Midseason All-Star, after going 2-2, 1.92 ERA (51.2 IP, 11 ER) with 11 walks and 34 strikeouts in 10 starts pre-break.
- Named best control in Twins minor league system by *Baseball America* in 2019.
- Selected by Twins in third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of the Air Force Academy...was rated 95th-best prospect entering the draft by *Baseball America*.

LAST START: Took a no-decision in his last outing on Sunday, July 11 vs. Detroit, working 7.0 innings and allowing a season-high-tying four runs on three hits, with four walks and eight strikeouts in a game the Twins ultimately won in extra innings, 12-9...all four runs occurred in the fifth inning on back-to-back two-RBI singles from Akil Baddoo and Jonathan Schoop...the Twins took the lead in the seventh, but the Tigers scored five runs off the Twins bullpen, sending the game to extras before the Twins walked off on a Jorge Polanco three-run homer in the 10th...Berríos tossed 108 pitches, his most in a game this season and most since throwing 113 on July 20, 2019 vs. Oakland...worked at least 7.0 innings in back-to-back starts for the first time since September 10-16, 2019...recorded at least eight strikeouts in back-to-back starts for the first time since April 3-8 of this season...despite tying his season high with four runs allowed, Berríos extended his streak of starts allowing four earned runs-or-fewer to 29, the longest stretch by a Twins pitcher since Johan Santana recorded 35-consecutive starts allowing four earned runs-or-fewer from July 15, 2006-July 18, 2007.

START PRIOR: Took his third loss of the season July 6 vs. Chicago-AL, despite working 7.0 innings and allowing just two runs (1 ER) on one hit, with three walks and 10 strikeouts in a 4-1 White Sox victory...both runs occurred on a Zack Collins two-RBI single in the second inning, the only hit of the game permitted by Berríos; only one of the runs was earned, due to a pair of Twins errors earlier in the inning...retired 16 of the final 17 batters he faced, including his last 10...snapped his five-game winning streak, dating back to May 2...was the 11th time in his career recording double-digit strikeouts and second this season (also April 3 at Milwaukee, 12 K)...became only the fifth pitcher since 2000 to pitch 7.0-plus innings, allow one-or-fewer hits, collect 10-plus strikeouts and take the loss; first since Rich Hill did so for Los Angeles-NL on August 23, 2017 at Pittsburgh (L, 0-1).

☞ He needs just three strikeouts to tie Scott Baker (770) for 12th on the Twins all-time strikeout list (list in lower right area of page)...next up would be Francisco Liriano, who recorded 788 strikeouts as a Twin from 2005-12.

SOUTHSIDE SHOWDOWN: Berríos is making his 20th career start against Chicago-AL today...owns a career 12-3, 2.69 ERA (120.2 IP, 36 ER), with 121 strikeouts, 29 walks and a .225 (101-for-448) opponent batting average vs. the White Sox.

☞ 20 starts, 12 wins and 121 strikeouts are his most against any opponent, with his 12 wins marking his only double-digit win total against any team...his 4.17 strikeout-to-walk ratio (121 K, 29 BB) vs. Chicago-AL is his third-best mark vs. any opponent he's faced at least four times in his career (Seattle - 5.86, Baltimore - 5.44).
