THE TWINS: Began their six-game roadtrip (rainout/PPD in Chicago on Monday) with a three-game sweep at the hands of the White Sox...this evening the Twins will begin a three-game weekend series at Kauffman Stadium...after this series, the Twins will travel home to complete the "first half" of the season with a seven-game homestand (3 vs. Chicago-AL and 4 vs. Detroit) leading up to the All-Star Break...the Twins have gone 17-23 at home this season and 16-23 on the road.

TWINS SUFFER SWEEP ON SOUTH SIDE: The Twins lost to the White Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 8-5, suffering their third sweep of the season...the pitching staff allowed 15 hits, tied for their third most this season...the Sox finished the series with 36 hits, eight being home runs...José Berrios was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs (3 earned) on 10 hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded nine hits, three being doubles from Alex Kirilloff (10), Andrelton Simmons (9) and Trevor Larnach (9)...Kirilloff and Nelson Cruz had two hits apiece, while Cruz also drove in a run on his 41st birthday.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 11th of 19 meetings in 2021...Twins are 5-5 against the Royals this season, going 3-3 at Target Field and 2-2 at Kauffman Stadium...these two teams last met for four games at Kauffman from June 3-6 as the Twins split the four games, taking the third and fourth games.

☞ Miguel Sanó made his major league debut on this day in 2015 at Kauffman Stadium, going 1-for-4, recording his first career hit with an infield single in the ninth inning off Greg Holland.
☞ Sanó has 19 career home runs against the Royals, 12 at Kauffman Stadium, his most in any opposing ballpark...since 2017, he has 11 homers in this park, the most among opponents (25 games).

☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .289 (11-for-38) with four home runs, 10 RBI, three walks, five runs scored and a .939 OPS in 10 career games against the Royals...four of his six career homers and 10 of his 27 RBI have come against the Royals.

☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .330 (34-for-103) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.033 OPS in 28 career games at Kauffman Stadium...he has eight hits in his last 18 at-bats at Kauffman (2 singles, 4 doubles and 2 home runs).

☞ Since joining the Twins in 2019, Nelson Cruz is hitting .356 (42-for-118) with 10 doubles, 16 home runs, 39 RBI, a .455 on-base percentage, a .847 slugging percentage and a 1.302 OPS in 33 games vs. the Royals (Twins are 21-12 in those games)...he has 31 home runs in 102 career games against Kansas City (chart to the bottom right).

☞ Cruz is tied with Miguel Sanó for third-most homers among active opponents at Kauffman Stadium with 12, trailing Miguel Cabrera (19) and Albert Pujols (17).

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .354 (23-for-65) with nine walks and a .447 OBP in 18 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 17 of those 18.

SUMMER CRUZ: Nelson Cruz is hitting .386 (32-for-83) with six doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI, 12 walks, a .464 on-base percentage and a 1.211 OPS in 23 games since June 1...since that date, he leads baseball in on-base percentage (minimum 80 plate appearances)... additionally, he ranks second in batting average and OPS, while third in slugging percentage.

CENTRAL HEATING:

☞ Josh Donaldson is a career .308 (292-for-947) hitter with 60 doubles, four triples, 74 home runs and 212 RBI in 260 games vs. the AL Central; his 74 homers vs. the division are tied for eighth among actives with Francisco Lindor...he has homered three times in his last four divisional games and five times in his last nine.

☞ Since the start of 2019, Nelson Cruz has hit .339 (158-for-466) with 26 doubles, 46 home runs, 118 RBI, 57 walks, a .695 slugging percentage and a 1.109 OPS in 125 games against the American League Central...he has hit safely in five straight vs. the AL Central, hitting .421 (8-for-19) with two doubles, two home runs and seven RBI in that span.

ALL ABOUT ALEX: Alex Kirilloff is hitting .300 (18-for-60) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, nine RBI, four walks, a .344 on-base percentage and an .844 OPS in his last 16 games...among all rookies in baseball in that span, he ranks second in batting average, fifth in on-base percentage and sixth in OPS.

THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ Since June 3, Josh Donaldson and Nelson Cruz each have eight home runs, tied for fifth-most in the AL since that date.
- ☞ Caleb Thielbar has an 8.1-scoreless inning streak, tied for 10th-longest active streak in the AL.
- ☞ Nick Gordon is hitting .342 (13-for-38) against right-handed pitching...Luis Arraez is hitting .302 (42-for-139) against righties.
- ☞ Lifetime vs. Brady Singer: Luis Arraez is 3-for-8 (.375)...Max Kepler is 3-for-8 (.375) with two doubles, a home run and a walk... Nelson Cruz is 2-for-6 (.333) with a walk...Andrelton Simmons is 2-for-2 with two walks.
- ☞ On this day in 2012, the Twins beat the Tigers by a score of 6-4 at Comerica Park to give Ron Gardenhire his 900th career managerial victory.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his fourth win and third quality start of the season on June 27 vs. Cleveland after allowing just two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings, with seven strikeouts and no walks...threw 100+ pitches in back-to-back starts for the first time since September 18-23, 2018...gave up a home run to catcher René Rivera in the sixth and departed in favor of Tyler Duffey...the Twins' bullpen threw 3.0 scoreless innings in relief, solidifying an 8-2 win.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision of the Twins 7-5, 12-inning, walk-off victory on June 21 vs. Cincinnati...allowed three runs on five hits (2 HR) over 4.2 innings, with five walks and four strikeouts...gave up a two-run home run in the fourth inning to Eugenio Suárez, opening the scoring for the Reds...threw 108 pitches (60 strikes), marking the fourth time this season he has tossed over 100 pitches...marked Happ's second Interleague start of the season.

KEEPING UP WITH KANSAS CITY: Happ is making his 12th career appearance and start vs. Kansas City this evening and has gone 6-3, 4.50 ERA (64.0 IP, 32 ER), with 14 walks and 54 strikeouts over his previous 11 outings against the Royals.

- ☞ Has faced Kansas City twice so far this season, first on May 29 at Target Field (W, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 5 K) and then at Kauffman Stadium on June 3 (ND, 5.0 IP, 9 H, 5 R/ER, 3 HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- ☞ Happ has maintained a winning streak against the Royals from April 8, 2018-present, going 4-0, 4.82 ERA (28.0 IP, 15 ER), with five walks and 27 strikeouts, with a .226 opponent batting average (24-for-106) over five starts during that span.
- ☞ Holds a record of 3-2 against the AL Central this season.

LOW TRAFFIC: Since the beginning of the 2018 season, Happ has averaged 11.42 base runners-per-9.0 innings, 14th fewest in the American League and 25th fewest in the majors (min. 425.0 IP)...Happ has allowed the 10th-fewest total base runners (583) in the American League over that span (min. 425.0 IP).

RISP MANAGEMENT: Happ held opposing hitters to a .156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

- ☞ However, this season opposing hitters are 17-for-64 (.266) against Happ with RISP, above his career .232 mark (345-for-1486).

A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB: Happ's start on April 13 vs. Boston was the 300th of his career...he is one of 11 active pitchers to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (476), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (435), Ervin Santana (386), Max Scherzer (383), Clayton Kershaw (371), Adam Wainwright (342), Johnny Cueto (321), David Price (314) and Madison Bumgarner (307).

- ☞ He has made at least 10 starts against 15 of 30 MLB teams.

PITCH SELECTION: This season Happ has featured five different pitches...he relies heavily on his four-seam fastball, throwing it more than half of the time...here is his 2021 repertoire, according to Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Ranks in the upper 56th percentile in baseball in fastball spin.
- ☞ He has allowed just 23 walks this season, ranking in the upper 66th percentile of BB% in baseball.

NIGHT AND DAY, HOME AND ROAD: Happ has made 13 starts so far this season, taking the mound eight times at night and six times during the day...during his eight starts under the lights, he is 1-3, 7.75 (38.1 IP, 33 ER) with 15 walks, 23 strikeouts and a .387 opponent on-base percentage...however, his numbers improve when the sun is up; during his six starts in the daytime, he is 3-0, 3.58 (32.2 IP, 13 ER) with eight walks, 32 strikeouts and a .273 opponent on-base percentage.

- ☞ Seven of his starts this season have come at Target Field and the other six have come on the road...his numbers at home outshine his record on the road.
