$\Phi$ Making his 15th start of the season...marks his 313th career start and 339th appearance. $\Phi$ Is making his 12th career appearance and start vs. Kansas City.


LAST TIME OUT: Earned his fourth win and third quality start of the season on June 27 vs. Cleveland after allowing just two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings, with seven strikeouts and no walks...threw 100+ pitches in back-to-back starts for the first time since September 18-23, 2018...gave up a home run to catcher René Rivera in the sixth and departed in favor of Tyler Duffey...the Twins' bullpen threw 3.0 scoreless innings in relief, solidifying an 8-2 win.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision of the Twins 7-5, 12-inning, walk-off victory on June 21 vs. Cincinnati...allowed three runs on five hits ( 2 HR) over 4.2 innings, with five walks and four strikeouts...gave up a two-run home run in the fourth inning to Eugenio Suárez, opening the scoring for the Reds...threw 108 pitches ( 60 strikes), marking the fourth time this season he has tossed over 100 pitches...marked Happ's second Interleague start of the season.

KEEPING UP WITH KANSAS CITY: Happ is making his 12th career appearance and start vs. Kansas City this evening and has gone 6-3, 4.50 ERA (64.0 IP, 32 ER), with 14 walks and 54 strikeouts over his previous 11 outings against the Royals.
क Has faced Kansas City twice so far this season, first on May 29 at Target Field (W, 5.0 IP, 3 H , 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 5 K ) and then at Kauffman Stadium on June 3 (ND, 5.0 IP, $9 \mathrm{H}, 5 \mathrm{R} / \mathrm{ER}, 3$ HR, $0 \mathrm{BB}, 2 \mathrm{~K}$ ).
玉 Happ has maintained a winning streak against the Royals from April 8, 2018-present, going 4-0, 4.82 ERA (28.0 IP, 15 ER), with five walks and 27 strikeouts, with a 226 opponent batting average (24-for-106) over five starts during that span.
$\Phi$ Holds a record of 3-2 against the AL Central this season.
LOW TRAFFIC: Since the beginning of the 2018 season, Happ has averaged 11.42 base runners-per-9.0 innings, 14th fewest in the American League and 25 th fewest in the majors (min. 425.0 IP)...Happ has allowed the 10th-fewest total base runners (583) in the American League over that span (min. 425.0 IP ).

RISP MANAGEMENT: Happ held opposing hitters to a . 156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

क However, this season opposing hitters are 17-for-64 (.266) against Happ with RISP, above his career . 232 mark (345-for-1486).

A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB: Happ's start on April 13 vs. Boston was the 300th of his career....he is one of 11 active pitchers to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (476), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (435), Ervin Santana (386), Max Scherzer (383), Clayton Kershaw (371), Adam Wainwright (342), Johnny Cueto (321), David Price (314) and Madison Bumgarner (307).
$\Phi$ He has made at least 10 starts against 15 of 30 MLB teams.
PITCH SELECTION: This season Happ has featured five different pitches....he relies heavily on his four-seam fastball, throwing it more than half of the time... here is his 2021 repertoire, according to Baseball Savant: PITCH (AVG. MPH) PCT. (\#, vs. RHB/LHB)

NIGHT AND DAY, HOME AND ROAD: Happ has made 13 starts so far this season, taking the mound eight times at night and six times during the day...during his eight starts under the lights, he is 1-3, 7.75 ( $38.1 \mathrm{IP}, 33 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with 15 walks, 23 strikeouts and a 387 opponent on-base percentage... however, his numbers improve when the sun is up; during his six starts in the daytime, he is $3-0$, 3.58 ( 32.2 IP, 13 ER) with eight walks, 32 strikeouts and a 273 opponent on-base percentage.
$\Phi$ Seven of his starts this season have come at Target Field and the other six have come on the
road...his numbers at home outshine his record on the road.
क He is 1-2, 7.98 ( $29.1 \mathrm{IP}, 26 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with eight walks, 27 strikeouts in six starts on the road, while he is $3-1,4.32$ ( $41.2 \mathrm{IP}, 20 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with 15 walks, 28 strikeouts in eight home starts.

FANNED BY DOUBLE DIGITS: Happ fanned a season-high 10 batters in Cleveland on May 23, his 12th career game with double-digit strikeouts....became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history age 38-or-older with at least 10 strikeouts in a start since Connie Marrero (age 39.037) on June 1, 1950 (12.0 IP, 10 K)...also became the third to do so in nine innings-or-less, joining Johnny Niggeling, who did it twice: August 16, 1944 ( 8.0 IP, 11 K) and July 8, 1944 (9.0 IP, 10 K).

FRESH STARTS: Happ allowed just two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his first five starts to begin this season, the longest such streak to start a campaign in his career...his streak ended on May 12.

## CAREER NOTES

- Ranks fourth among active left-handed pitchers in wins (127) and starts (312), while he is fifth in innings pitched (1812.1) and seventh in strikeouts (1594).
- Pitched a career best of 7.1 hitless innings on April 23, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh...left the game allowing only one hit over 7.1 innings...combined with Tyler Duffey and Taylor Rogers on the 19th one-hitter in Twins history.
- Made his 300th career start April 13, 2021 vs. Boston.
- In 2020, led all American League left-handed pitchers with a 208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655)...did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
- Has made 12 Opening Day rosters with six teams: Philadelphia (2009-10), Houston (2011-
12), Toronto (2013, '16-18), Seattle (2015), New York-AL (2019-20) and Minnesota (2021).
- Enters 2021 with 14 MLB seasons under his belt, with the Phillies (2007-10), Astros (2010
12), Blue Jays (2012-14, '16-18), Mariners (2015), Pirates (2015) and Yankees (2018-20).
- Made his 300th career major league appearance and 275th career start on June 23, 2019 vs. Houston.
- Compiled a career-best 19.1-inning scoreless streak from August 26-September 12-G1, 2019, the AL's eighth-longest scoreless streak in 2019 and longest by a Yankee.
- Finished sixth in 2016 AL Cy Young Award voting after going 20-4, 3.18 ERA for Toronto and tying for the second-most wins in baseball...marks his only career 20-win season and is one of just seven pitchers in the majors (and one of two southpaws) with a 20 -win campaign in 2016.
- Finished second in 2009 BBWAA NL Rookie of the Year balloting to Florida's Chris Coghlan....appeared on all 32 ballots, receiving 10 first-place votes....won the 2009 Players' Choice Award for NL Outstanding Rookie...named 2009 NL Rookie of the Year by The Sporting News.
- Selected by Philadelphia in the third round of the 2004 First-Year Player Draft out of Northwestern University....debuted for the Phillies on June 30, 2007.
