THE TWINS: Have gone 1-4 through five games on their current roadtrip, going 0-3 in Detroit and 1-1 yesterday in Chicago...tonight they will continue their trip with the third of four against the White Sox...after tomorrow night's game they will travel home to begin a seven-game homestand with four against the Angels (July 22-25) and three against the Tigers (July 26-28)...the Twins have gone 22-25 at home this season and 18-29 on the road.

TWINS SPLIT THE DAY IN CHICAGO: The Twins beat the White Sox in game one of yesterday's doubleheader on the South Side by a score of 3-2 in extras, followed by a loss in the night game by a score of 3-5...Griffin Jax was the starter in game one, allowing one run on one hit in 4.0 innings pitched while tying his season/career high with six strikeouts...José Berrios was the game two starter and was issued the loss despite his fourth career complete game, as he allowed five runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched...Nelson Cruz hit his team-leading 19th home run in game one which also marked the 436th of his career, passing Carlos Beltrán and moving into sole possession of 46th place on baseball's all-time home run list...Mitch Garver made his return to the club from injury and hit two solo homers in game two, marking his seventh career multi-homer game.

A SIDE OF SAUCE: Mitch Garver hit his 49th and 50th career homers yesterday and now has 10 on the season, marking his second season with double-digit homers (31 in 2019)...since his Silver Slugger season in 2019, Garver has homered in 7.5 percent of his plate appearances, the highest among all players with at least 500 PA's in that span.

☞ Garver has hit 42 home runs from the catcher position since 2019, the fourth most in baseball, trailing New York-AL's Gary Sánchez (51), Chicago-AL's Yasmani Grandal (44) and Philadelphia's J.T. Realmuto (43).

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the 15th of 19 meetings this season...Twins are 3-11 against the Sox in 2021, going 2-4 at Target Field and 1-7 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Twins have been outscored by the White Sox this season 53-98 (-45 run differential).

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .382 (55-for-144) with 11 doubles, 15 home runs, 41 RBI, 19 walks, a .451 OBP, a .771 slugging percentage and a 1.222 OPS in 39 games vs. the Sox while in a Minnesota uniform (since 2019).

☞ Miguel Sanó has 13 home runs and 26 RBI in 35 games vs. the Sox since the start of 2019...full list of home run leaders against the Sox since 2019 at bottom right.

☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .293 (63-for-215) with 10 doubles, 19 home runs, 48 RBI, 43 walks and a 1.010 OPS in 63 career games vs. the White Sox.

☞ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .301 (22-for-73) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, four walks and a .338 on-base percentage in 21 career games at Guaranteed Rate Field.

ARRAEZ TO THE TOP: Luis Arraez is hitting .340 (66-for-194) with nine doubles, four triples, 16 RBI, 36 runs scored, 17 walks and a .395 on-base percentage out of the leadoff spot...he leads the team with 48 starts out of that spot...among all American League players, he ranks first in batting average and on-base percentage from the top spot in the lineup (minimum 150 at-bats).

MORE ON LUEY: After going 3-for-7 in yesterday's doubleheader, Luis Arraez has now hit safely in 11-straight starts since July 4...in that span he is hitting .432 (19-for-44) with six multi-hit games, three doubles, three walks, a .468 on-base percentage, a .968 OPS and just five strikeouts...among all players in baseball during July, he ranks third in hits with 20, trailing Los Angeles-AL's David Fletcher (27) and Chicago-AL's Tim Anderson (24).

ROUNDRIP CRUZ: Yesterday Nelson Cruz hit his 436th career home run, passing Carlos Beltrán and moving into sole possession of 46th on baseball's all-time home run list...Cruz hit 216 of his home runs before his 35th birthday and 220 since...the only players to hit more after turning 35 were Barry Bonds (340) and Hank Aaron (245).

LEFT SIDE IS OUR BEST SIDE: The Twins are hitting .257 (274-for-1068) with a .446 slugging percentage and a .760 OPS vs. lefties this season, compared to .237 (490-for-2070) with a .416 slugging and a .732 OPS against righties.

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs (47) against lefties...they also rank third in slugging percentage and seventh in OPS.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .369 (38-for-103) with seven doubles, six home runs and a 1.028 OPS vs. lefties this season...his average against lefties ranks second in all of baseball (minimum 100 AB's), trailing only Los Angeles-AL's David Fletcher (.381).

☞ Lifetime against Dallas Keuchel: Mitch Garver is hitting .500 (6-for-12)...Nelson Cruz is hitting .327 (18-for-55) with six home runs, 10 RBI and eight walks...Cruz is the only player to homer at least six times off Keuchel (next: Albert Pujols - 4).

DIVISIONAL CRUZ: Since joining the Twins prior to the 2019 season, Nelson Cruz has hit .330 (168-for-509) with 27 doubles, 47 home runs, 122 RBI, 64 walks, a .664 slugging percentage and a 1.071 OPS in 138 games against the American League Central...here are his home runs by division opponent in that span:

LAST START: Ober's last start occurred on July 10 vs. Detroit at Target Field; he did not factor into the decision as the Twins scored nine runs in the sixth through eighth innings en route to a 9-4 victory... Ober allowed four runs on four hits (2 HR) in a career-low-tying 3.1 innings, with two walks and four strikeouts...struck out the side in the first inning (4 BF, 1B), doing so in back-to-back starts for the first time in his career...yielded back-to-back home runs to Niko Goodrum and Zack Short in the second inning before working a scoreless third...ran into trouble in the fourth, permitting an RBI single to Harold Castro and departing with two on, one out; an additional run scored off Derek Law.

START PRIOR: Earned his first career win in the Twins' pre-Break homestand opener on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL, leading the Twins to an 8-5 win...permitted just two hits – a second-inning double by Gavin Sheets and a fifth-inning single by Tim Anderson – across 5.0 shutout frames, with a career-high three walks and a career-high-tying seven strikeouts (also, June 11 vs. Houston)...threw a career-high 93 pitches, the first time in his career he crossed the 90-pitch threshold, while also matching his career high with 5.0 innings pitched.

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: Tonight marks Ober's fourth career start and appearance against the White Sox, his most vs. any opponent in his career and the only opponent he's faced more than once... is 1-1, 6.57 ERA (12.1 IP, 9 ER) with six walks, 14 strikeouts and a .224 opponent batting average (11-for-49) in his three prior starts.

- Ober made his major league debut on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field, allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in a 4.0-inning no-decision...the Twins won, 5-4, on Jorge Polanco's walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth...Ober recorded his first career strikeout in the opening frame, fanning Adam Eaton for the second out of the inning.
- Was saddled with the loss on June 30 at Guaranteed Rate Field, allowing a career-high five runs on four hits (3 HR) in 3.1 innings, with two walks and three strikeouts in a 13-3 loss.
- Faced the White Sox on July 5 at Target Field; for details see "START PRIOR" note above.
- He's also 1-1, 6.41 ERA (19.2 IP, 14 ER), eight walks, 22 strikeouts and a .256 (20-for-78) opponent batting average in five career starts against the American League Central division.

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first eight career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .174 batting average (4-for-23) with runners in scoring position as well as a .091 (1-for-11) mark with RISP and two outs...has allowed just one hit with RISP in his last three starts, holding opposing hitters to 1-for-6 in scoring situations in that span...this trend was also true in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, as he held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position for the Saints.

Ober ranks in the upper 85th percentile with a 31.6 chase rate.

LOW TRAFFIC: Ober struck out 100 batters and walked just nine in 2019, good for an MLB-best 11.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min. 75.0 IP)...that season, he also ranked second in the minors in WHIP (0.81) and base runners-per-9.0 IP (7.55), and was fifth in walks-per-9.0 IP (1.03).
 In eight MLB starts this season, Ober has allowed 46 total base runners in 33.0 innings, good for a 12.55 base-runners-per-9.0 IP ratio...he's also averaging 3.00 walks-per-9.0 IP while averaging 10.09 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP...he has walked just 11 batters compared to 37 strikeouts, recording a 3.36 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Ober is one of seven players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of three pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2), RHP Griffin Jax (June 8) and LHP Charlie Barnes (July 17).

SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober has made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average (13-for-60)...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints' fifth game on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run scored on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work...took the ball again on May 13 vs. Iowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision...earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at Iowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none and fanning five as the Saints exploded for 17 runs en route to a 17-5 rout of the I-Cubs...his other start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, fanning a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep.

CAREER REDUX: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a .222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances (35 starts) from 2017-21...was added to the Twins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020...spent part of the offseason working out in Colorado with fellow Twins staffmate Taylor Rogers and yesterday's game one starting pitcher Griffin Jax.

- Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).
- Over that same time span, Ober ranks third by allowing just 8.79 base runners-per-9.0 innings, fourth by walking just 1.18 batters-per-9.0-innings and fifth in WHIP (0.96).

SKOL TWINS: Ober attended Charlotte Christian School in Charlotte, North Carolina, where he was batterymates on the baseball team and friends with Vikings center Garrett Bradbury...Bradbury had just arrived in the Twin Cities for OTAs at the time of Ober's debut on May 18, and attended the game with his wife, Carson...Carson is also the older sister of Kansas City Royals No. 4 prospect Jackson Kowar.

#82 IN YOUR PROGRAMS, #1 IN YOUR HEART: Ober is the first player in Twins history to wear uniform number 82...former hitting coach James Rowson is the only other uniformed personnel to wear #82, doing so while presiding over 2019's "Bomba Squad."

TOMORROW'S STARTER – RHP MICHAEL PINEDA [2021 SEASON: 3-5, 4.11 ERA // CAREER: 56-51, 4.03 ERA]

Pineda is due to toe the rubber in tomorrow night's series finale against the White Sox, making his first start after the All-Star Break...last pitched on July 7, facing Chicago-AL at Target Field...allowed five runs on a career-high 12 hits (1 HR) and shouldered the loss as the Twins fell, 6-1...Pineda will be facing the White Sox for the third time this season and has gone 0-2, 6.75 ERA (10.2 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and 11 strikeouts in his two prior starts...he's 3-3, 3.47 ERA (36.1 IP, 14 ER) in six career starts at Guaranteed Rate Field.
