THE TWINS: Have gone $1-5$ through six games on their current roadtrip, going $0-3$ in Detroit and $1-2$ in Chicago...tonight they will complete the trip with the four-game series finale against the White Sox...after tonight's game they will travel home to begin a seven-game homestand with four against the Angels from tomorrow-Sunday and three against the Tigers from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have gone $22-25$ at home this season and $18-30$ on the road...Twins are looking to split the series tonight with the Sox.

BACK AND FORTH GAME ENDS WITH SOX VICTORY: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night by a score of $9-5 .$. . Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs ( 3 earned) on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the bullpen allowed five runs in 3.0 innings, including a five-run eighth after the Twins had taken a 5 -4 lead in the top half..the Twins offense recorded eight hits, two from both Josh Donaldson and Max Kepler...Kepler hit his 11th home run, Donaldson hit his 15 th homer and Jorge Polanco hit his 13th homer and drove in two runs.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have placed outfielder/first baseman Alex Kirilloff on the 10 -day Injured List with a ligament tear in his right wrist (retroactive to July 20)...Kirilloff is scheduled to have surgery later this week to repair the ligament (Dr. Thomas Graham)...Kirilloft has played in 59 games for the Twins this season, hitting 251 (54--fo-215) with 11 doubles, one triple, eight home runs, $34 \mathrm{RBI}, 14$ walks and a .722 OPS.. Kirilloff spent time on the Injured List earlier this season (May 5-21) after injuring the same ligament in his right wrist...to replace Kirilloff on the 26 -man roster, the Twins have recalled catcher/infielder Willians Astudillo from Triple-A St. Paul..Astudillo hit. 281 (25-for-89) with three doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and a 701 OPS in 22 games for the Saints after being optioned to Triple-A on June 19 ...in 41 games with the Twins earlier this season, he hit . 254 (31-for-122) with four doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI and a .661 OPS.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the 16th of 19 meetings this season... their next and final series will be in three games at Target Field from August $9-11 \ldots$...Wins are 3-12 against the Sox in 2021, going 2-4 at Target Field and 1-8 at Guaranteed Rate Field. $\Phi$ Nelson Cruz is hitting .372 ( 55 -for-148) with 11 doubles, 15 home runs, 41 RBI, 20 walks a .444 OBP, a .750 slugging percentage and a 1.1940 PS in 40 games vs. the Sox while in a Minnesota uniform (since 2019)
$\Phi$ Nelson Cruz (15), Max Kepler (14) and Miguel Sanó (13) hold the top three spots in home runs against the White Sox since the start of 2019.
क The Twins have hit 78 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019, ahead of second place Detroit's 49... 54 have been hit at Guaranteed Rate Field, ahead of Kansas City's 29.
क Josh Donaldson is hitting .295 ( 65 -for-220) with 10 doubles, 20 home runs, 49 RBI, 43 walks and a 1.019 OPS in 64 career games vs. the White Sox.
玉 Lifetime against Dylan Cease: Nelson Cruz is hitting . 545 ( 6 -for-11) one double, one home run, five RBI, three walks and a .909 OPS...Jorge Polanco is 4-for-12 (.333) with one double, one home run, two RBI and two walks...Max Kepler is 4-for-12 (.333) with two home runs, five RBI and two walks...Luis Arraez is 4-for-12 (.333) with one RBI and one walk.
 ADDITIONALLY: Polanco's 87 games lead the club...he has played 68 games at second base, the eighth most in the AL.
SAUCE 162: Over his last 162 games, Mitch Garver is hitting 252 (130-for-515) with 27 doubles, one triple 43 home runs, 97 RBI, 99 runs scored, 69 walks, a .559 slugging percentage and a .905 OPS
$\Phi$ Garver has hit 42 home runs from the catcher position since 2019, the fourth most in baseball, trailing New York-AL's Gary Sánchez (52), Chicago-AL's Yasmani Grandal (44) and Philadelphia's J.T. Realmuto (43).
ROAD CRUZIN': Nelson Cruz is hitting . 329 (47-for-143) with six doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, $27 \mathrm{RBI}, 15$ walks, a .399 on-base percentage and a .993 OPS in 41 road games this season...he has hit safely in 16 of his last 21 road games....on the season, he ranks second in baseball in road OPS, trailing Houston's Michael Brantley (1.023) and third in batting average, trailing Brantley (.392) and Tampa Bay's Joey Wendle (.333).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2017, the Twins unveiled former Twins Manager Tom Kelly's statue outside of Target Field, one of seven at Target Field, joining Rod Carew, Harmon Killebrew, Kirby Puckett, Carl and Eloise Pohlad, Tony Oliva and Kent Hrbek.

$\Phi$ Luis Arraez is hitting 324 ( 59 -for-182) against right-handed pitching this season, fourthbest in the AL (min. 175 AB's), trailing Michael Brantley (.376), Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (352) and Los Angeles-AL's Jared Walsh (.327).
$\Phi$ Former Twins outfielder Brian "Buck" Buchanan is celebrating his 48th birthday today...he played two seasons for the Twins from 2000-02, hitting . 258 (107-for-414) with 20 doubles, 16 home runs and 55 RBI...he is the current hitting coach for the Triple-A Omaha Storm Chasers.
玉 Tomorrow night against the Angels is Celebrate Diversity Day at Target Field, presented by Prairie Island Indian Community and Treasure Island Resort \& Casino...the day will include several festivities aimed at cultivating diverse voices, perspectives and experiences to build a better us.

## 2021: 3-5, 4.11 ERA CAREER: 56-51, 4.03 ERA

$\Phi$ Will make his 13th start of the season, first of the second half and just his second since June 13 . $\Phi$ Is making his second-consecutive start against the White Sox and third of 2021 ( $0-2,6.75$ ERA). $\Phi$ Marks the 161 st start and appearance of career.
$\Phi$ Is $0-3,8.10 \mathrm{ERA}(16.2 \mathrm{IP}, 15 \mathrm{ER})$ in his last four starts, after starting the season 3-2, 2.62 (44.2 $\mathrm{IP}, 13 \mathrm{ER}$ ) in his first eight outings.


DOUBLE BREAK: Pineda will make his first start in 13 days, having last toed the rubber for the July 7 series finale against Chicago-AL at Target Field...the Twins then wrapped up the first half with a four-game series against the Tigers before enjoying the Major League Baseball All-Star Break; Pineda did not pitch in last weekend's series in Detroit.
LAST TIME OUT: "Big Mike" was returned from his rehabilitation assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, reinstated from the 10 -day Injured List and started July 7 vs. these same White Sox at Target Field.... surrendered a career-high 12 hits in 5.1 innings, while yielding five runs and getting tagged with the $6-1$ loss...struck out four, while not walking a batter.
$\Phi$ Was touched for a career-high-tying seven extra-base hits for the second time (also on April 26, 2016 vs. TB for NYY), with five doubles, one triple and a homer...allowed at least one hit in each of his innings, and multiple hits in the second (3), tourth (2), fifth (2) and sixth (3, before departing).
क However, the score was just 2-1 Chicago through the fourth, and 3-1 through the fifth...two doubles and a triple with one out in the sixth gave the White Sox a $5-1$ lead and ended Pineda's day.

INJURED LIST STAY: Pineda was sidelined from June 14-July 6 with right elbow inflammation, missing 19 games....made one rehab start with Triple-A St. Paul on July 1 at CHS Field, allowing five runs (four earned) with three walks and one strikeout in 4.0 -plus innings against Omaha.

FIRST HALF RECAP, PART ONE (A DOMINANT APRIL AND MAY): Big Mike enjoyed one of the best season-opening stretches of his career, going 3-2, 2.62 ERA (44.2 IP, 13 ER) over his first eight starts through May...allowed two-or-fewer runs in six of those efforts, while posting four quality starts. His 2.62 ERA through his first eight starts was the third-best mark to begin a season of his career, behind the 2.09 ERA (43.0 IP, 10 ER) during his injury-interrupted 2014 campaign with the Yankees and the 2.45 mark ( 51.1 IP, 14 ER) of his 2011 rookie year with Seattle.
$\Phi$ Pineda fashioned a 0.99 WHIP over that span, while compiling 47 strikeouts ( $9.47 \mathrm{~K} / 9$ ) against just 12 walks ( $3.92 \mathrm{~K} / \mathrm{BB}$ ratio)...held opposing hitters to a . 198 average (32-for-162), with a .251 on-base percentage, a .395 slugging mark and a . 646 OPS
$\Phi$ Was placed on the 10-day Injured List May 19 (retroactive to May 16) due to an abscess, but returned to toss 6.0 innings of three-hit, one-run ball in a 3-2 victory over Baltimore on May 26.

FIRST HALF RECAP, PART TWO (INJURIES \& INEFFECTIVENESS): Pineda has strugged with injury and related ineffectiveness since the start of June, stumbling to an $0-3$ mark with an 8.10 ERA (16.2 IP, 15 ER)....he has yielded a $.387 / .405 / .627$ slash line in those outings, with opponents going $29-$-for-75 with eight doubles, two triples, two home runs, three walks and just eight strikeouts.
$\Phi$ The Twins have lost four-straight Pineda starts for the first time since they dropped fiveconsecutive Big Mike outings from April 18-May 11, 2019...between that losing skid and the current one, Minnesota went 22-9 (.710) when Pineda took the mound.
\$ Pineda failed to pitch at least 5.0 innings in each of his three June starts, matching a careerworst within the same season (also done September 4-14, 2016 with the Yankees)...those three outings also marked the first time in his career that he struck out two-or-fewer batters in consecutive starts.
क His 3.0 -inning stint in a June 1 loss at Baltimore was the shortest start of his Twins career experienced right forearm soreness following the start and was given an extra day of rest before his June 8 outing vs. New York-AL
MINNESOTA MIKE: Big Mike has made 43 starts in a Minnesota uniform, going 16-10, 3.96 ERA (234.0 IP, 103 ER ) with a 4.40 strikeout-to-walk ratio ( $220 \mathrm{~K}, 50 \mathrm{BB}$ ) and a 1.18 WHIP ( 227 hits)... the Twins are 25-18 (.581) when he toes the rubber
$\Phi$ His 4.3 WAR (per Fangraphs) since 2019 is 18th among AL starters (min 230.0 IP),
SOX FLIPPED INSIDE OUT: The Twins won all of five of Pineda's starts against the White Sox during his first two seasons with the club (2019-20), with Big Mike personally going 4-0, 2.90 ERA (31.0 IP, 10 ER )...that script has been flipped in 2021, with Pineda posting a 6.75 ERA ( $10.2 \mathrm{IP}, 8 \mathrm{ER}$ ) and losing each of his two starts against Chicago-AL (both opposite Lance Lynn).
$\Phi$ In addition to the loss July 7 at Target Field (see "LAST TIME OUT" note above), Pineda also was tagged with the 4-2 setback May 13 at Guaranteed Rate Field...he allowed three runs on four hits (including 2 homers) in 5.1 innings, with three walks and seven strikeouts.
$\Phi$ Pineda is 5-5, 3.78 ERA ( 66.2 IP, 28 ER) in 11 career starts against the South Siders, including 3-3, 3.47 (36.1 IP, 14 ER) at Guaranteed Rate Field.
ROAD RARITY: Pineda is set to make just his fourth road start of the season, while he has gone 1-2, 5.40 ERA (13.1 IP, 8 ER) in his first three efforts...made his 2021 debut on April 4 in Milwaukee, allowing an unearned run in 5.0 innings for the $8-2$ win...since then, he has taken back-to-back road losses on May 13 at Chicago-AL and June 1 at Baltimore, with an 8.64 ERA (8.1 IP, 8 ER) in that span. $\Phi$ Going back further, Big Mike has made just 17 road starts with the Twins, going 10-4, 4.12 ERA ( 91.2 IP, 42 ER ) in those efforts... his May 13 loss here at Guranteed Rate Field snapped a sevendecision road winning streak that spanned eight starts from June 29, 2019 through April 4, 2021.
START 'EM WITH STRIKE ONE, THEN GET 'EM TO CHASE: Pineda ranks third in the American League ( min . 50.0 IP ) by pouring in strike one at a 68.9 percent clip....he has also induced opposing batters to chase, in any count, 33.2 percent of the time to rank in the 92 nd percentile among all big league hurlers...for his career, Big Mike owns a 65.6 percent first-strike rate and a 33.4 percent chase rate.

LAST BUT NOT LEAST: Today marks Pineda's eighth start this season in a series finale (also April 4 at Milwaukee, April 15 vs. Boston, May 6 vs. Texas, May 13 at Chicago-AL, May 26 vs. Baltimore, June 13 vs. Houston and July 7 vs. Chicago-AL)...he is 2-3, 3.26 ERA ( 38.2 IP, 14 ER) when wrapping
