LAST TIME OUT: Maeda last started on Saturday, July 17 in the second game of a doubleheader at Detroit, taking a no-decision in an eventual 5 -4 Twins loss...allowed three runs on three hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...all three runs came on a bases-loaded triple off the bat of Akil Baddoo in the second inning...departed after the fifth inning with the game tied $3-3$; the Tigers scored two runs in the eighth to win.
START PRIOR: Maeda started on July 9 vs. Detroit at Target Field, taking a no-decision in an eventual 4-2 Twins win....worked 5.0 shutout innings and allowed just two singles, with two walks and seven strikeouts...departed with the score tied $0-0$; the Twins scored four runs in the sixth to win...marked his fourth start this season in which he did not allow an extra-base hit alaso, July 4 at Kansas City, May 3 vs. Texas and April 1 at Milwaukee)...paired with his start on July 4 at Kansas City, marked the second time in his career that Maeda has allowed two-or-fewer hits and worked at least 5.0 ally, was the fourth time in his career with back-to-back scoreless starts, last doing so May $10-15$, ally, was the fourth
2019 with the Dodgers.

JULY HEAT: Maeda enters tonight 1-0, 1.69 ERA ( 16.0 IP, 3 ER) with four walks, 25 strikeouts and a . 130 opponent batting average (7-for-54) in three July starts...his ERA so far this month represents his second-lowest mark in any month in his career (min. 3 starts), behind only the 1.41 ERA (32.0 IP, 5 ER) he posted in April 2016 - his first career month in Major League Baseball.
$\Phi$ Maeda enters tonight leading the majors with a 130 ( 7 -for- 54 ) opponent batting average this
month (min. 50 AB ).... he's also eighth in the American League in ERA this month (min. 15.0 IP ).
HELLO, HALOS: Tonight marks Maeda's seventh career appearance and sixth start against the Angels, as well as his first outing vs. Los Angeles-AL as a Twin...he's 2-3, 4.56 ERA (25.2 IP, 13 ER) with nine walks, 32 strikeouts and a 200 ( 19 -for-95) opponent batting average in his prior outings...last faced the Halos in 2019 while playing for the Dodgers, going $0-2,0.31$ ERA ( $0.2 \mathrm{IP}, 0$ ER) with five walks
and 11 strikeouts in two starts, one at Angel stadium and one at Dodger stadium.
$\Phi$ Maeda went 1-1, 2.70 ERA (16.2 IP, 5 ER) in his first three career starts vs. Los Angeles-AL, but is $0-2,8.31 \mathrm{ERA}(8.2 \mathrm{IP}, 8 \mathrm{ER})$ in his last two.
Maeda could be facing his countryman Shohei Ohtani for the fourth time in an MLB game and
first since July 23,2019 Ohtani is 2 -for- 5 with one homer and two RBl off Maed first since July 23, 2019...Ohtani is 2-for-5 with one homer and two RBI off Maeda.
GO WEST: Tonight marks Maeda's sixth start of the season against the American League West division, going 2-0, 5.40 ERA (21.1 IP, 13 ER$)$ with seven walks and 22 strikeouts in his five prior starts... is a-4-1, 5.22 ERA 58.21 , 24 ER 14 career appearances ( 12 starts) vs. he ALWest, his highest ERA

COMFORTS OF HOME: Just four of Maeda's 15 starts so far this season have come at home, and he's 1-1, 2.41 $\operatorname{ERA}$ ( $18.2 \mathrm{IP}, 5 \mathrm{ER}$ ), seven walks and 22 strikeouts in those starts...this compares to $3-2$, 5.50 RRA (54.0 IP, 33 ER) in 11 starts away from Target Field this season.
$\Phi$ Is $4-1,2.09$ ERA ( $51.2 \mathrm{IP}, 12 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with 13 walks, 64 strikeouts and a 170 opponent batting average ( 31 -for-182) in nine career starts at Target Field.

MILESTONE MAN: Maeda surpassed two career milestones in his start against the Mariners in Seattle on June 14 ...at the end of his second inning of work he reached 700 career MLB innings, becoming the 10th Japanese-born pitcher to hit that plateau in the majors...the others are: Hideo Nomo (1,976.1 IP), Hiroki Kuroda ( $1,319.0$ IP), Yu Darvish (1,237.2 IP), Tomo Ohka (1,070.0 IP), Masahiro Tanaka (1,054.1 IP), Hisashi Iwakuma ( 883.2 IP), Daisuke Matsuzaka (790.1 IP), Masato Yoshii (757.1 IP) and Shigetoshi Hasegawa ( $(720.1$ IP)...additionally, Maeda's strikeout of Shed Long Jr. in the fourth
inning on June 14 was the 2,000 th of his career...he now has 2,033 strikeouts combined between Nippon Professional Baseball ( 1,233 ) and Major League Baseball ( 800 ).

- Maeda's final strikeout in his last start was the 800th of his major league career...he became just the fifth Japanese-born pitcher in major league history to reach 800 career strikeouts, joining Nomo ( 1,918 ), Darvish ( 1,520 ), Tanaka ( 991 ) and Kuroda ( 986 ).
Maeda's seven career games with 10-plus strikeouts are fourth most among Japanese-born pitchers in major league history, behind Darvish (46), Nomo (31) and Tanaka (14)

2021 ARSENAL: Maeda's slider has surpassed his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch over the last two seasons....he threw them equally in his rookie 2016 campaign and his four-seamer was his most frequent offering from 2017-19...however, his slider has been his top pitch since the start of 2020 , followed by his split finger....here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:

OPPOSING COUNTS: Opponents are hitting. 394 (13-for-33) off Maeda's first offering of an at-bat... however, opponents are batting. 187 ( 29 -for-155) off Maeda with two strikes, above the . 087 ( 13 -for150) mark he held them to in 2020 and his career mark of . 147 ( 232 -for-1582)...the league average mark this season with two strikes is .163 .

When the count goes full, Maeda is holding opposing hitters to just 3-for-32 (.094), the eighthlowest mark among all major league pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats)...since 2017 , he's held hitters oo a. 131 (27-for-206) batting average on full counts, the second-lowest mark in the majors in that span (min. 200 AB ), behind only Jhoulys Chacín (.128).
