ANGELS TAKE DOWN TWINS：The Twins lost to the Angels last night by a score of 3－2 in the Halos＇first visit to Target Field since May of 2019．．．Kenta Maeda（4－4）was the starter and loser，allowing three runs on seven hits in a season－high 7.0 innings pitched．．．the offense recorded six hits and went 1－for－6 with runners in scoring position．．．Gilberto Celestino and Willians Astudillo each drove in a run，both coming in the fourth inning．．．the attendance was 23，337，which marked a 2021 single－game high．

BYE，BYE，BOOMSTICK：The Twins traded designated hitter Nelson Cruz to Tampa Bay yes－ terday．．．it marked the first time Cruz had been traded since going from Milwaukee to Texas in 2006．．．below is a look back at Nellie＇s accomplishments during his time in Minnesota：

TWO STARTS AGO：Earned his fifth win and recorded his fourth quality start of the season in his last outing on July 8 vs．Detroit．．．gave up three runs on eight hits over 7.0 innings；his longest outing since April 28 at Cleveland（also 7.0 IP）．．．allowed just one walk and struck out eight batters，while Haase in the fourth．．．．Minnesota＇s offense took the lead in the bottom of the seventh inning and the Twins＇bullpen tossed 2.0 scoreless innings after Happ departed to secure the $5-3$ victory．
