THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 2-5 (0-3 against the Tigers and 2-2 against the White Sox), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a loss and a win against the Angels the last two nights...tonight they will continue the homestand with the third of four with Los Angeles...they will conclude the series tomorrow afternoon then welcome in the Tigers for three from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have gone 23-26 at home this season and 19-30 on the road.

TWINS GET ANGELS IN EIGHTH: The Twins beat the Angels last night by a score of 5-4, evening the series at 1-1...the Twins entered the bottom of the eighth with a 3-4 deficit, but took the lead scoring on a Ryan Jeffers RBI-single and a Kurt Suzuki throwing error on one play...J.A. Happ was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits in 7.0 innings...Juan Minaya earned his first win as a Twin and Taylor Rogers recorded his 50th career save with a scoreless ninth inning...the offense recorded 13 hits, three from both Jorge Polanco and Jeffers (career-high)...Josh Donaldson went 2-for-4 and averaged 98.7 mph average exit velocity on his balls put in play last night...Nick Gordon also had a pair of hits, including an RBI-single, and scored the winning run.

TWINS AND HALOS: Tonight marks the sixth of seven scheduled meetings with the Angels this season...the Twins have gone 2-3 against the Angels in 2021, going 1-2 in Anaheim April 16 & May 20 (doubleheader) and 1-1 at Target Field...Twins have won seven of their last 10 against the Angels.

➡ Twins need to win the next two games to take the season-series vs. the Angels for the second-straight season (also 2019) and fourth time in their last five seasons (chart lower right).

➡ Since 2018, 14 of 18 games between these two teams have decided by three runs-or-less.

➡ Josh Donaldson is hitting ,329 (24-for-73) with nine doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, 14 walks and a .968 OPS in his last 20 games against the Angels.

➡ Max Kepler is hitting ,309 (29-for-94) with five doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, 16 walks, a .420 on-base percentage and a .941 OPS in 29 career games against the Angels...he has hit safely in seven straight and has reached safely in 23 of his last 26 vs. the Halos.

➡ Miguel Sanó is hitting ,309 (30-for-97) with nine doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 14 walks and a 1.015 OPS in 26 career games vs. the Angels...he has hit safely in seven straight against the Halos and in 17 of his last 18, hitting .362 (25-for-69) with six home runs and a 1.138 OPS in that span.

➡ Andrelton Simmons played five seasons for the Angels from 2016-20, hitting .281 (592-

♠ Andrelton Simmons played five seasons for the Angels from 2016-20, hitting .281 (592-for-2107) with 112 doubles, nine triples, 36 home runs, 238 RBI, 259 runs scored, 142 walks and a .722 OPS in 561 games...he played 559 games at shortstop for the Halos, which ranks fourth on their all-time list, while winning consecutive AL Gold Glove Awards (2017-18) at the position...he ranks 23rd in club history in WAR (10.8).

RED HOT JORGE: In 19 games this month, Jorge Polanco is hitting .320 (24-for-75) with three doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI, four walks, a .358 on-base percentage and a .918 OPS...among all AL players in July, he ranks tied for third in RBI, tied for sixth in hits, and tied for 12th in total bases.

LEFT SIDE IS OUR BEST SIDE: The Twins are hitting .254 (284-for-1118) with a .442 slugging percentage and a .755 OPS vs. lefties this season, compared to .240 (518-for-2156) with a .421 slugging and a .739 OPS against righties.

▼ Twins are tied with Seattle for most homers against lefties in baseball with 48...additionally, they rank fourth in slugging and eighth in OPS.

▼ Miguel Sanó is hitting .379 (11-for-29) with three walks, a .438 on-base percentage and a .024 OPS in his lost 12 genero against lefties.

LONGBALL DROUGHT?: The Twins have not homered in two-straight games...the last time they went three-straight games without a home run came April 16-20, which was their season-long...they have homered in 76 of their 98 games...their 138 home runs entering the day are tied with Los Angeles-NL for third most in baseball, trailing San Francisco (146) and Toronto (144)...they have 68 home runs at home, sixth-most in baseball.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2020, the Twins opened the season with a three-game series at Guaranteed Rate Field against the White Sox after nearly a four-month delay due to COVID-19...they beat Chicago that day by a score of 10-5...leading up to 2020 Opening Day, the Twins had Summer Camp at Target Field from July 3-21 and played Intrasquad scrimmages near the back half of camp with Team Polanco vs. Team Kepler.

YOU KNOW HAWK?: Bally Sports North Analyst LaTroy Hawkins pitched one season for the Angels in 2012...it was the ninth of 11 teams he pitched for in his career...during that season, he went 2-3, 3.64 ERA (42.0 IP, 17 ER) with one save, six holds, 13 walks and 23 strikeouts...Mike Trout is the only current active or non-active player on the Halos that was teammates with Hawk

LAST START: Shouldered his fourth loss of the season last Monday, July 19 in the second game of the doubleheader at Chicago-AL, despite recording his fourth career complete game in 5-3 Twins loss...worked 6.0 innings, allowing five runs on four hits (3 HR), with one walk and eight strikeouts...yielded just two hits (both were homers) through the first six innings before running into trouble in the seventh, in which he did not record an out...allowed the first two men to reach on a single and hit-by-pitch, before allowing a walk-off, three-run homer to Gavin Sheets...matched his career high with three home runs allowed, doing so for the first time since April 20, 2019 at Baltimore.

◆ The start marked his second career complete game with fewer than 9.0 innings pitched, also pitching a 6.0-inning complete game on September 27, 2019 at Kansas City (game was called after the top of the seventh due to inclement weather).

◆ Now has at least eight strikeouts in three-straight starts in the same season for the third time in his career, and first occurrence since his final trio of outings for the 2018 campaign (Sept. 14-28)...added a career-best fourth-consecutive, eight-plus strikeout outing in his first start of the 2019 season (March 28).

START PRIOR: Took a no-decision two starts ago on July 11 vs. Detroit, working 7.0 innings and allowing four runs on three hits, with four walks and eight strikeouts in a game the Twins ultimately won in extra innings, 12-9...all four runs occurred in the fifth inning on back-to-back two-RBI singles from Akil Baddoo and Jonathan Schoop...the Twins took the lead in the seventh, but the Tigers scored five runs off the Twins bullpen, sending the game to extras before the Twins walked off on a Jorge Polanco three-run homer in the 10th...Berrios tossed 108 pitches, his most in a game this season and most since throwing 113 on July 20, 2019 vs. Oakland... worked at least 7.0 innings in back-to-back starts for the first time since September 10-16, 2019.

ON TARGET: Tonight marks Berríos's 10th start of the season at Target Field; he's 4-2, 3.70 ERA (56.0 IP, 23 ER) with 19 walks, 70 strikeouts and a 211 opponent batting average (43-for-204) in his nine prior starts...he's worked at least 6.0 innings and struck out at least eight batters in each of his last four home starts dating back to June 12, going 1-1, 2.63 ERA (27.1 IP, 8 ER) with 10 walks, 35 strikeouts and a .140 opponent batting average (13-for-93) in that span.

© Berríos's 32 career victories at Target Field are tied with former Twin Kyle Gibson for most in this ballpark's history...his 62 career starts and 407 career strikeouts here are also second most in Target Field history, trailing only Gibson (95 GS, 425 K).

700 CLUB: This season, Berríos has surpassed both 700 strikeouts and 700.0 innings pitched for his career...his 700th strikeout came in the fifth inning on May 15 vs. Oakland, fanning Seth Brown...became the 15th Twin to reach 700 strikeouts and the 28th Twin to reach 700.0 innings pitched...he needs 13 strikeouts to tie Francisco Liriano (788) for 11th on the Twins all-time strikeout list (list in lower right area of page).

HALO HISTORY: Berríos is making his fifth career start against the Angels tonight... owns a career 2-2, 6.14 ERA (22.0 IP, 15 ER), with seven walks and 16 strikeouts in his four previous starts.

₱ Made one start vs. the Halos this season, coming in the second game of the doubleheader on May 20 at Angel Stadium...earned the win in a 6-3 Twins victory, allowing three runs on three hits (1 HR), with one walk and seven strikeouts over 5.0 innings.

₱ Tonight marks his second career start vs. the Angels at Target Field...lost his lone prior outing on May 13, 2019, yielding five runs on a career-high 12 hits, with three walks and three strikeouts; the Twins lost, 5-4.

SLICK LEATHER: He has four defensive runs saved this season which ranks fourth among all pitchers, trailing only Chicago-AL's Dallas Keuchel (5), New York-NL's Taijuan Walker (5) and Tampa Bay's Josh Fleming (5)...since 2019, he ranks tied for 10th in DRS among pitchers with five...his three pickoffs this season are tied for tops in the AL and tied for fourth most in the majors.

RIGHTY TIGHTY: Berríos is holding right-handed hitters to a .171 (37-for-217) average with five doubles, four home runs, 11 walks and 64 strikeouts, compared to lefties hitting .271 (55-for-203) with 14 doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 21 walks and 58 strikeouts against him...his right-handed opponent batting average ranks first among AL righties (min. 180 opp. AB), and second in the AL, behind Chicago-AL southpaw Carlos Rodón (.164)...MLB-wide, his right-handed opponent batting average ranks fifth behind San Francisco's Kevin Gausman (.133), Los Angeles-NL's Trevor Bauer (.146), Rodón and Los Angeles-NL's Walker Buehler (.170).

4 His overall opponent batting average of .219 (92-for-420) ranks fifth in the AL (min. 360 opp. AB) trailing New York-AL's Gerrit Cole (.208), Toronto's Robbie Ray (.215), Seattle's Yusei Kikuchi (.218) and Oakland's Chris Bassitt (.218).

 In 2019, teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 K on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893, when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall-of-Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.

 Given the 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of BBWAA...also won the Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.

 Became 21st pitcher in Twins' history to reach the 200-strikeout mark in a season

- Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts. Made MLB debut April 27, 2016 vs. Cleveland.
- Named Twins' second-best prospect entering 2016, as well as best curveball, best changeup, and best control in Twins' system by Baseball America.
 Named 20th-best prospect in baseball by MLB.com entering 2016.
 Started for the World Team in the Sirius XM Futures Games in consecutive seasons, 2014 at Target Field and 2015 at Great American Ball Park in Cincinnati.
