THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 2-5 (0-3 against the Tigers and 2-2 against the White Sox), the Twins began their seven-game homestand by going 1-2 against the Angels over the last three nights...today they will continue the homestand with the four-game series finale with Los Angeles...they will welcome in the Tigers for three tomorrow night through Wednesday...the Twins have gone 23-27 at home this season and 19-30 on the road.

SATURDAY NIGHT, NOT ALRIGHT: The Twins lost to Patrick Sandoval and the Angels last night by a score of 2-1 at Target Field...José Berrios (7-5) was the starter and loser, allowing two unearned runs on three hits in 7.0 innings pitched...Caleb Thielbar pitched 1.1 scoreless innings of relief and Jorge Alcala pitched 0.2 scoreless inning of relief...the offense was hitless until a Brent Rooker ninth-inning one-out double...Josh Donaldson drove in Rooker with a double, giving the Twins their only run of the game.

☞ Rooker came into the game with three hits in 33 at-bats all season.
☞ The Twins were almost no-hit for the fifth time in club history and first time since Jered Weaver did so at Angel Stadium on May 2, 2012...it would have marked the first time for the Twins to be no-hit in Minnesota.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have reinstated catcher Mitch Garver from the Paternity List...Garver and his wife Sarah had their first child, a son named Gamble Lynn on Thursday afternoon...Garver is batting .230 (28-for-122) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 19 RBI, 19 runs scored and an .884 OPS in 43 games this season...to make room for Garver on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned catcher Ben Rortvedt to Triple-A St. Paul...Rortvedt replaced Garver during his Paternity Leave but did not appear for the Twins during this recent stint.

TWINS AND HALOS: Tonight marks the last of seven scheduled meetings with the Angels this season...the Twins have gone 2-4 against the Angels in 2021, going 1-2 in Anaheim April 16 & May 20 (doubleheader) and 1-2 at Target Field this weekend...Twins have won seven of their last 11 against the Angels.

☞ Since 2018, 15 of 19 games between these two teams have decided by three runs-or-less.
☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .329 (25-for-76) with 10 doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, 15 walks and a .976 OPS in his last 21 games against the Angels.

☞ Max Kepler is hitting .299 (29-for-97) with five doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, 16 walks, a .414 on-base percentage and a .884 OPS in 30 career games against the Angels...he has reached safely in 10 straight and 24 of his last 27 vs. the Halos.

☞ Miguel Sanó is hitting .297 (30-for-101) with nine doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 14 walks and a .977 OPS in 27 career games vs. the Angels...he is hitting .342 (25-for-73) with seven doubles, six home runs, 16 RBI and a 1.077 OPS in that span.

☞ Tony Diaz was drafted by California in the 46th round of the 1995 First-Year Player Draft.

DID YOU KNOW?: Twins hitting coach Edgar Varela and Angels hitting coach Jeremy Reed were teammates at Long Beach State for two seasons...Varela played two seasons there from 2001-02 while Reed played there from 2000-02...Reed was drafted by the White Sox in the second round of the 2002 First-Year Player Draft while Varela was drafted by the White Sox in the 38th round in '02...while playing at Long Beach State, Varela played third base and was the club's starter in 2001 and Reed started in left and rightfield.

RED HOT JORGE: In 20 games this month, Jorge Polanco is hitting .304 (24-for-79) with three doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI, four walks, a .341 on-base percentage and a .873 OPS...among all AL players in July, he ranks tied for second in RBI, fourth in hits, and seventh in total bases.

☞ As a left-handed batter this month, he is hitting .372 (16-for-43) with a 1.056 OPS and .222 (8-for-36) with a .639 OPS as a right-handed batter.

BRINGER OF RAIN: Josh Donaldson has posted a .379 on-base percentage in his last 22 games, recording 22 hits and drawing 13 walks in that span...additionally, he has 15 RBI and a .929 OPS in those 22 games.

☞ Donaldson enters today with 698 RBI, two away from reaching 700 for his career...he also has 243 career doubles, seven away from 250...29 active players have 700-plus career RBI.

LONGBALL DROUGHT: The Twins have not homered in three-straight games, matching their season-long for a home run drought, done twice this season, the first from April 13-14 and again April 16-20...the last time they went at least four-straight games without a home run came September 27-29, 2018 (also 4)...they have homered in 76 of their 99 games...their 138 home runs entering the day are fourth-most in baseball, trailing Toronto (149), San Francisco (147) and Los Angeles-NL (139)...they have 68 home runs at home, sixth-most in baseball.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Single-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Louie Varland and Double-A Wichita outfielder Trey Cabbage have been named Twins minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week.

☞ Varland, 23, made one start for the Kernels on Wednesday vs. Beloit, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, two walks and nine strikeouts...the St. Paul, MN native was selected by the Twins in the 15th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Concordia University in St. Paul.

☞ Cabbage, 24, played six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .300 (6-for-20) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, four walks and seven strikeouts...the Knoxville, TN was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Grainger High School in Rutledge, TN.

LAST START: Ober's last start came on July 20 against the White Sox in Chicago; took a no-decision in a 9-5 Twins loss...allowed four runs (3 ER) on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in a career-high-tying 5.0 innings...ran into early trouble by allowing two runs in the opening frame, on a José Abreu double and a Brian Goodwin single...needed just four pitches to complete the second inning but permitted another pair of runs in the third inning on a two-run homer by Yoán Moncada...departed after finishing the fifth down by two runs; the Twins took a one-run lead in the top of the eighth, but the White Sox scored five runs in the bottom of the frame to pull ahead for good.

START PRIOR: Ober made the start on July 10 vs. Detroit at Target Field, in the Twins' penultimate game before the All-Star Break...he did not factor into the decision as the Twins scored nine runs in the sixth through eighth innings en route to a 9-4 victory...allowed four runs on four hits (2 HR) in a career-low-tying 3.1 innings, with two walks and four strikeouts...struck out the side in the first inning (4 BF, 1B), doing so in back-to-back starts for the first time in his career...yielded back-to-back home runs to Niko Goodrum and Zack Short in the second inning before working a scoreless third...ran into trouble in the fourth, permitting an RBI single to Harold Castro and departing with two on, one out; an additional run scored off Derek Law.

WESTERN DOMINANCE: This afternoon marks Ober's first career start and appearance against Los Angeles-AL...owns two career starts against the American League West division, going 0-0, 2.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 2 ER) with one walk, 13 strikeouts and a .250 opponent batting average (8-for-32) against Houston and Seattle.

- Faced the Astros at Target Field on June 11, his third career start, and held the Houston offense to one run on five hits, with one walk and a career-high seven strikeouts in 4.0 innings as the Twins fell 6-4.
- Started against Seattle at T-Mobile Park in his next outing on June 16, allowing just one base runner (a leadoff single in the fourth) in 4.0 innings, with no walks and six strikeouts in a 7-2 Twins win...the base runner was quickly eliminated on a strike 'em out, throw 'em out double play.

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first nine career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .214 batting average (6-for-28) with runners in scoring position as well as a .154 (2-for-13) mark with RISP and two outs...allowed two hits with runners in scoring position in his last start on July 20, doing so for the first time in his career...in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, Ober held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position for the Saints.

LOW TRAFFIC: Ober struck out 100 batters and walked just nine in 2019, good for an MiLB-best 11.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min. 75.0 IP)...that season, he also ranked second in the minors in WHIP (0.81) and base runners-per-9.0 IP (7.55), and was fifth in walks-per-9.0 IP (1.03).

- In nine MLB starts this season, Ober has allowed 52 total base runners in 38.0 innings, good for a 12.32 base-runners-per-9.0 IP ratio...he's also averaging 2.84 walks-per-9.0 IP while averaging 9.71 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP...he has walked just 12 batters compared to 41 strikeouts, recording a 3.42 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Ober is one of seven players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of three pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortved (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2), RHP Griffin Jax (June 8) and LHP Charlie Barnes (July 17).

SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average (13-for-60)...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints' fifth game on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run scored on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work...took the ball again on May 13 vs. Iowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision...earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at Iowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none and fanning five as the Saints exploded for 17 runs en route to a 17-5 rout of the I-Cubs...his other start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, fanning a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep.

CAREER REDUX: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a .222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances (35 starts) from 2017-21...was added to the Twins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020...spent part of the offseason working out in Colorado with fellow Twins staffmate Taylor Rogers and yesterday's game one starting pitcher Griffin Jax.

- Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).
- Over that same time span, Ober ranks third by allowing just 8.79 base runners-per-9.0 innings, fourth by walking just 1.18 batters-per-9.0-innings and fourth in WHIP (0.96).

SKOL TWINS: Ober attended Charlotte Christian School in Charlotte, North Carolina, where he was batterymates on the baseball team and friends with Vikings center Garrett Bradbury...Bradbury had just arrived in the Twin Cities for OTAs at the time of Ober's debut on May 18, and attended the game with his wife, Carson...Carson is also the older sister of Kansas City Royals No. 4 prospect Jackson Kowar.

#82 IN YOUR PROGRAMS, #1 IN YOUR HEART: Ober is the first player in Twins history to wear uniform number 82...former hitting coach James Rowson is the only other uniformed personnel to wear #82, doing so while presiding over 2019's "Bomba Squad."

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP MICHAEL PINEDA (2021 SEASON: 4-5, 3.93 ERA // CAREER: 57-51, 4.02 ERA)

Pineda will toe the rubber in tomorrow night's series opener vs. the Detroit Tigers...earned the win in his last outing on July 21 at Chicago-AL, holding the White Sox to just one run on four hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings, as the Twins won 7-2...is due to face the Tigers for the first time this season and first since September 7, 2020 at Target Field; led the Twins to a 6-2 win after tossing 7.0 strong innings and yielding two runs on three hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts...is 4-2, 3.91 ERA (53.0 IP, 23 ER) with nine walks and 59 strikeouts in nine career starts against Detroit.

- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of CenturyLink Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, Single-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week for Fort Myers on April 14 and Southern League Pitcher of the Week for Pensacola on September 2.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
