THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their current seven-game homestand losing a four-game series to the Angels over the weekend, followed by a win over Detroi last night...tonight they will continue the homestand/series with the second of three agains the Tigers...after tomorrow afternoon's game, the Twins will travel to St. Louis to begin their longest roadtrip of the season, playing nine games in 11 days...they will play three games in St. Louis July 30-August 1, two games in Cincinnati August 3-4 and four games in Houston August 5-8...the Twins have gone 24-28 at home this season and 19-30 on the road.

The Twins are 10-13 this month...they need to win all four of their remaining July games to secure a winning month.
TWINS TAKE TIGERS IN TEN: The Twins beat the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 6-5 in 10 innings, making them 7-9 in extra-innings this season...Michael Pineda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits, two being home runs from Brent Rooker (3) and Josh Donaldson (16)...Max Kepler drove in the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th inning, scoring pinch-runner Kenta Maeda from second base...it was the sixth walk-off win for the Twins this season.
$\Phi$ For Kepler, it marked his ninth career walk-off plate appearance, tying him with Rod Carew, Tom Brunansky and Justin Morneau for fourth-most in club history (since 1961), trailing only Harmon Killebrew (11), Kirby Puckett (11) and Kent Hrbek (10).

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have placed left-handed pitcher Taylor Rogers on the 10-day Injured List with a left middle finger sprain...Rogers, who exited the game in the ninth inning last night against Detroit, has gone 2-4, 3.35 ERA (40.1 IP, 15 ER), nine saves, eight walks, 59 strikeouts and a 1.14 WHIP in 40 games...this marks Rogers' first trip to the Injured List in his major league career...to replace Rogers on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Beau Burrows from Triple-A St. Paul...Burrows has appeared in four games for the Saints, going 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA ( 8.2 IP, 2 ER), three walks at Detroit, pitching 1.1 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, no walks and one strikeout.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 14th of 19 games in 2021...the Twins have gone 8-5 vs. Detroit this season, going 5-0 at Target Field and 3-5 at Comerica Park...the Twins have won 14 of their last 20 over the Tigers, 19 of their last 28 and 22 of their last 32. $\mp$ Andrelton Simmons is hitting . 321 (42-for-131) with eight doubles, one home run, 14 RBI 17 walks, a . 397 on-base percentage and an . 802 OPS in 38 career games vs. the Tigers क Jorge Polanco is hitting . 306 ( 94 -for-304) with 17 doubles, four triples, 10 home runs 48 RBI, a . 353 on-base percentage and an . 840 OPS in 79 career games vs. Detroit...this season, he is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with three doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, five walks and a . 946 OPS in 13 games against the Tigers.

TARGET PRACTICE: The Twins have won eight straight at home against the Tigers, marking their longest winning streak at home over Detroit since winning eight straight at the Metrodome from May 6, 2002-August 12003 the Twins have never won nine-plus in Minnesota over Detroit...in fact, since August 24, 2019, the Twins have gone 13-1 at home against the Tigers...below are the head-to-head numbers in those 14 .

the 12 th inning on August 9,1994 vs. Boston.

LAST START: Maeda's last start came in the homestand opener on July 22 vs. Los Angeles-AL, as he shouldered the loss in a 3-2 Twins defeat.. worked a season-high 7.0 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits, with no walks and six strikeouts, good for his third quality start of the season... marked his first start of at least 7.0 innings since September $11,2020 \mathrm{vs}$. Cleveland (also 7.01 IP )... did not walk a batter for the first time since Apriil 27 at Cleveland ( 5.2 IP)...also marked his seventh career start in which he worked at least 7.0 innings and threw 95 -or-fewer pitches....all three Angels runs came on a Jack Mayfield three-run homer in the top of the fifth inning- the second-consecutive start in which all the runs he allowed came via one two-out, three-run swing of the bat.
START PRIOR: Maeda made the start on Saturday, July 17 in the second game of a doubleheader at Detroit, taking a no-decision in an eventual $5-4$ Twins loss....llowed three runs on three hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...all three runs came on a bases-loaded triple $3-3$; the Tigers scored two runs in the eighth to win.

TIGER KING: Is 2-2, 4.05 ERA (40.0 IP, 18 ER ), five walks, 53 strikeouts and a 199 opponent batting average (29-for-146) in seven career starts against the Tigers...this includes 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), four walks, 21 strikeouts and a .214 (12-for-56) opponent batting average in three starts against the Tigers this season...he's also 1-0, 3.18 ERA (17.0 IP, 6 ER), three walks, 24 strikeouts and a. 136 opponent batting average in three career outings vs. Detroit at Target Field.

(1,054.1 IP), Hisashi Iwakuma ( 883.2 IP), Daisuke Matsuzaka ( 790.1 |P). Masato Yoshii ( 757.1 IP) and Shigetoshi Hasegawa ( 720.1 IP)...additionally, Maeda's strikeout of Shed Long Jr. in the fourth inning on June 14 was the 2,000th of his career....he now has 2,039 strikeouts combined between Nippon Professional Baseball' (1,233) and Major League Baseball' (806).
$\Phi$ Maeda's final strikeout on July 17 was the 800th of his major league career...he became just the fifth Japanese-born pitcher in major league history to reach 800 career strikeouts, joining Nomo ( 1,918 ), Darvish ( 1,526 ), Tanaka ( 991 ) and Kuroda ( 986 ).
$\Phi$ Maeda's seven career games with 10-plus strikeouts are fourth most among Japanese-born pitchers in major league history, behind Darvish (46), Nomo (31) and Tanaka (14).

- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18,2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12)
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 Baseball America Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.
- Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings in his major league debut, also hitting a solo home run in his second career at-bat.
