<b>THE TWINS:</b> Have gone 2-3 through five games on their current seven-game homestand,
losing a four-game series to the Angels over the weekend, followed by a win over Detroit
last nighttonight they will continue the homestand/series with the second of three against
the Tigersafter tomorrow afternoon's game, the Twins will travel to St. Louis to begin their
longest roadtrip of the season, playing nine games in 11 daysthey will play three games in
St. Louis July 30-August 1, two games in Cincinnati August 3-4 and four games in Houston
August 5-8the Twins have gone 24-28 at home this season and 19-30 on the road.
The Twine are 10-13 this month, they need to win all four of their remaining July games

The livins are 10-13 this month...they need to win all four of their remaining July games to secure a winning month.

TWINS TAKE TIGERS IN TEN: The Twins beat the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 6-5 in 10 innings, making them 7-9 in extra-innings this season...Michael Pineda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits, two being home runs from Brent Rooker (3) and Josh Donaldson (16)...Max Kepler drove in the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th inning, scoring pinch-runner Kenta Maeda from second base...it was the sixth walk-off win for the Twins this season.

◆ For Kepler, it marked his ninth career walk-off plate appearance, tying him with Rod Carew, Tom Brunansky and Justin Morneau for fourth-most in club history (since 1961), trailing only Harmon Killebrew (11), Kirby Puckett (11) and Kent Hrbek (10).

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins announced today that they have placed left-handed pitcher Taylor Rogers on the 10-day Injured List with a left middle finger sprain...Rogers, who exited the game in the ninth inning last night against Detroit, has gone 2-4, 3.35 ERA (40.1 IP, 15 ER), nine saves, eight walks, 59 strikeouts and a 1.14 WHIP in 40 games...this marks Rogers' first trip to the Injured List in his major league career...to replace Rogers on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Beau Burrows from Triple-A St. Paul...Burrows has appeared in four games for the Saints, going 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (8.2 IP, 2 ER), three walks and four strikeouts..he made one appearance for the Twins this season, coming on July 17 at Detroit, pitching 1.1 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, no walks and one strikeout.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 14th of 19 games in 2021...the Twins have gone 8-5 vs. Detroit this season, going 5-0 at Target Field and 3-5 at Comerica Park...the Twins have won 14 of their last 20 over the Tigers, 19 of their last 28 and 22 of their last 32. 
₱ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .321 (42-for-131) with eight doubles, one home run, 14 RBI, 17 walks, a .397 on-base percentage and an .802 OPS in 38 career games vs. the Tigers. 
₱ Jorge Polanco is hitting .306 (94-for-304) with 17 doubles, four triples, 10 home runs, 48 RBI, a .353 on-base percentage and an .840 OPS in 79 career games vs. Detroit...this season, he is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with three doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, five walks and a .946 OPS in 13 games against the Tigers.

**TARGET PRACTICE:** The Twins have won eight straight at home against the Tigers, marking their longest winning streak at home over Detroit since winning eight straight at the Metrodome from May 6, 2002-August 1, 2003...the Twins have never won nine-plus in Minnesota over Detroit...in fact, since August 24, 2019, the Twins have gone 13-1 at home against the Tigers...below are the head-to-head numbers in those 14.

**HOT SAUCE, COMING UP:** Since returning from the 10-day Injured List (groin contusion) on July 19, Mitch Garver has gone 4-for-10 (.400) with two doubles, two home runs, three RBI, three walks and a 1.771 OPS...in his last 15 games, dating back to May 17, he is hitting .361 (13-for-36) with seven doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, 14 walks, a .549 on-base percentage and a 1.438 OPS.

**SUMMER RAINSTORM:** Josh Donaldson went 2-for-4 with a two-run homer last night, his 16th of the season...he's batting .344 (11-for-32) with three doubles, three homers, eight RBI, nine runs scored, nine walks, a .488 on-base percentage and a 1.207 OPS in 10 games vs. the Tigers this season...the second RBI on the homer last night marked Donaldson's 700th career RBI and he became the 30th active player to reach the 700 mark for his career...he now ranks third among AL third basemen with an .843 OPS this season, behind only Boston's Rafael Devers (.935) and Cleveland's José Ramírez (.854).

**TWINS INK PETTY:** The Twins announced yesterday the signing of their first-round pick, right-handed pitcher Chase Petty from Mainland Regional High School (NJ), whom they selected with the 26th overall pick in the 2021 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft... the 6-foot-1, 190-pound right-hander was a four-year starter for the Mustangs...his prep career culminated this season, when he was named the 2021 New Jersey Gatorade Player of the Year after going 6-1 with a 1.15 ERA (48.2 IP, 8 ER) and 99 strikeouts compared to just 17 walks his senior season...he threw a no-hitter on April 28 vs. Millville, the same high school that Los Angeles-AL's Mike Trout was drafted out of in the first round in 2009...Petty fanned a career-high 18 batters with just one walk in 7.0 innings in the start...the 18-year-old was ranked the 27th-best prospect entering the draft by MLB.com and 29th best by *Baseball America.*..he was also listed as the second-best right-handed pitcher and ninth-best high school player in the country by Perfect Game...he's from Somers Point, New Jersey, the same hometown as Twins pitcher Cody Stashak, a 13th-round selection in the 2015 First-Year Player Draft...Petty will report to the CenturyLink Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In **1978**, Mike Cubbage went 4-for-4 and became the fifth Twin to ever hit for the cycle (11 now) in a 6-3 win over Toronto...in **1991**, Dan Gladden hit a walk-off three-run homer in the ninth inning to give the Twins a 7-4 win over Milwaukee... it was in the middle of a five-game stretch in which Gladden drove in 12 runs (4, 3, 3, 1 & 1).

LAST APPEARANCE IN A GAME: Maeda pinch ran for fellow hurler Caleb Thielbar in the bottom of the 10th inning of last night's 6-5, extra-inning victory over the Detroit Tigers, and scored the winning run on Max Kepler's walk-off single...marked Maeda's fourth career appearance as a pinch runner and first since June 2, 2019 vs. Philadelphia for Los Angeles-NL...Maeda became the first Twins pitcher to pinch run since Liam Hendriks on June 22, 2012 at Cincinnati, as well as the first to pinch run and score since rai manonies pin the 12th inning on August 9, 1994 vs. Boston ch run and score since Pat Mahomes pinch ran and scored the winning run in the bottom of

LAST START: Maeda's last start came in the homestand opener on July 22 vs. Los Angeles-AL, as he shouldered the loss in a 3-2 Twins defeat...worked a season-high 7.0 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits, with no walks and six strikeouts, good for his third quality start of the season... marked his first start of at least 7.0 innings since September 11, 2020 vs. Cleveland (also 7.0 IP)...did not walk a batter for the first time since April 27 at Cleveland (5.2 IP)...also marked his seventh career start in which he worked at least 7.0 innings and threw 95-or-fewer pitches...all three Angels runs came on a Jack Mayfield three-run homer in the top of the fifth inning — the second-consecutive start in which all the runs he allowed came via one two-out, three-run swing of the bat.

**START PRIOR:** Maeda made the start on Saturday, July 17 in the second game of a doubleheader at Detroit, taking a no-decision in an eventual 5-4 Twins loss...allowed three runs on three hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...all three runs came on a bases-loaded triple off the bat of Akil Baddoo in the second inning...departed after the fifth inning with the game tied 3-3; the Tigers scored two runs in the eighth to win.

**TIGER KING:** Is 2-2, 4.05 ERA (40.0 IP, 18 ER), five walks, 53 strikeouts and a .199 opponent batting average (29-for-146) in seven career starts against the Tigers...this includes 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), four walks, 21 strikeouts and a .214 (12-for-56) opponent batting average in three starts against the Tigers this season...he's also 1-0, 3.18 ERA (17.0 IP, 6 ER), three walks, 24 strikeouts

against the rights this season...ne's also 1-0, 3.10 Erk (17.0 Fr, 6 Erk), three warks, 24 strikebuts and a .136 opponent hatting average in three career outings vs. Detroit at Target Field.

◆ Last faced Detroit on July 17 at Comerica Park, taking a no-decision in a 5-4 Twins loss after allowing three runs on three hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

◆ Has won two of his last three decisions against the Tigers, dating back to September 23, 2020... has a 2.65 ERA (17.0 IP, 5 ER), three walks, 22 strikeouts and a .213 (13-for-61) opponent

₱ Four of his seven starts against Detroit have been quality, and he allowed just seven earned runs in 16.0 innings (3.94 ERA) combined in the three non-quality starts...has also fanned seven-ormore batters in six of the seven starts, and struck out six batters in his other start.

CENTRAL-FUGAL FORCE: Maeda is 2-2, 4.68 ERA (42.1 IP, 22 ER), 13 walks, 47 strikeouts and a .231 (36-for-156) opponent batting average in eight starts against the AL Central so far this season... went 5-1, 2.74 ERA (46.0 IP, 14 ER) in eight starts against the AL Central last season...is 10-4, 3.54 ERA (109.1 IP, 43 ER) in 20 career starts vs. the division, marking his second-best career ERA against any single division (NL East - 3.11 ERA).

JULY HEAT: Maeda enters tonight 1-1, 2.35 ERA (23.0 IP, 6 ER) with four walks, 31 strikeouts and a .173 opponent batting average (14-for-81) in four July starts...his ERA so far this month represents his third-lowest mark in any month in his career (min. 3 starts), behind the 1.41 ERA (32.0 IP, 5 ER) he posted in April 2016 and the 1.71 ERA (21.0 IP, 4 ER) he had in June 2017.

Maeda enters tonight fifth in the majors with a .173 (14-for-81) opponent batting average this month (min. 80 opponent at-bats)...he's also eighth in the American League in ERA this month (min. 20.0 IP).

COMFORTS OF HOME: Just five of Maeda's 16 starts so far this season have come at home, and he's 1-2, 2.81 ERA (25.2 IP, 8 ER), seven walks and 28 strikeouts in those starts...this compares to 3-2, 5.50 ERA (54.0 IP, 33 ER) in 11 starts away from Target Field this season.

◆ Is 4-2, 2.30 ERA (58.2 IP, 15 ER) with 13 walks, 70 strikeouts and a .182 opponent batting average (38-for-209) in 10 career starts at Target Field.

MILESTONE MAN: Maeda surpassed two career milestones in his start against the Mariners in Seattle on June 14....at the end of his second inning of work he reached 700 career MLB innings, becoming the 10th Japanese-born pitcher to hit that plateau in the majors...the others are: Hideo Nomo (1,976.1 IP), Hiroki Kuroda (1,319.0 IP), Yu Darvish (1,242.2 IP), Tomo Ohka (1,070.0 IP), Masahiro Tanaka (1,054.1 IP), Hisashi Iwakuma (883.2 IP), Daisuke Matsuzaka (790.1 IP), Masato Yoshii (75.1 IP) and Shigetoshi Hasegawa (720.1 IP)...additionally, Maeda's strikeout of Shed Long Jr. in the fourth inning on June 14 was the 2,000th of his career...he now has 2,039 strikeouts combined between Nippon Professional Baseball (1,233) and Major League Baseball (806).

### Maeda's final strikeout on July 17 was the 800th of his major league career...he became just the fifth Japanese-born pitcher in major league history to reach 800 career strikeouts, joining Nomo (1,918), Darvish (1,526), Tanaka (991) and Kuroda (986).

#### Maeda's seven career games with 10-plus strikeouts are fourth most among Japanese-born pitchers in major league history, behind Darvish (46), Nomo (31) and Tanaka (14).

**2021 ARSENAL:** Maeda's slider has surpassed his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch over the last two seasons...he threw them equally in his rookie 2016 campaign and his four-seamer was his most frequent offering from 2017-19...however, his slider has been his top pitch since the start of 2020, followed by his split finger...here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:
