THE TWINS: Have gone 2-4 through six games on their current seven-game homestand, losing a four-game series to the Angels over the weekend, followed by a split of the first two games with Detroit the last two nights...today they will finish the homestand with the three-game series finale against the Tigers...after the game, the Twins will travel to St. Louis to begin their longest roadtrip of the season, playing nine games in 11 days...after the off-day tomorrow, they will play three games in St. Louis over the weekend, enjoy another off-day on Monday, then play two games in Cincinnati August 3-4 and four games in Houston August 5-8...the Twins have gone 24-29 at home this season and 19-30 on the road.

The Twins have gone 5-8 in rubber games this season.

TWINS LOSE IN GRAND FASHION: The Twins lost to the Tigers last night by a score of 6-5 in 11 innings...Kenta Maeda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 6.1 innings pitched...Hansel Robles allowed a grand slam to Eric Haase in the ninth inning, which forced extras and an eventual defeat...the offense recorded eight hits, including a career-high three from Brent Rooker...Mitch Garver hit his first career grand slam in the first inning...the Twins started the night with a Jorge Polanco single, a Rooker single, a Josh Donaldson walk, followed by the Garver slam, marking the second time in club history to "lead off" the game with a grand slam, having the first three batters reach base and the fourth batter hit a grand slam...the previous came on April 16, 1961 vs. Baltimore when Bob Allison did it.

The Garver and Haase grand slams marked the first time in baseball history that both catchers accomplished that feat in the same game (Elias).

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 15th of 19 games in 2021...their next meeting will be a stand-alone makeup game at Comerica Park on August 30, a continuation of their series from July 16-18...the Twins are 8-6 vs. Detroit this season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 3-5 at Comerica Park...the Twins have won 14 of their last 21 over the Tigers, 19 of their last 29.

♣ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .311 (42-for-135) with eight doubles, one home run, 14 RBI, 18 walks, a .391 on-base percentage and a .784 OPS in 39 career games vs. the Tigers.

♣ Jorge Polanco is hitting .307 (95-for-309) with 18 doubles, four triples, 10 home runs, 48 RBI, a .354 on-base percentage and an .843 OPS in 80 career games vs. Detroit...this season, he is hitting .327 (18-for-55) with four doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, five walks and a .951 OPS in 14 games against the Tigers.

TWINS, TIGERS, TARGET FIELD: The Twins have gone 13-2 at home against the Tigers, dating back to August 24, 2019...below are the head-to-head numbers in those 15.

RED HOT JORGE: In 23 games this month, Jorge Polanco is hitting .303 (27-for-89) with four doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI, five walks, a .344 on-base percentage and an .861 OPS... among all AL players in July, he ranks fourth in RBI and hits, and sixth in total bases (46)... additionally, he is sixth in batting average among players with a minimum of 75 at-bats.

ROOKER RAKING: Since being recalled on Friday, Brent Rooker is hitting .316 (6-for-19) with two doubles, two home runs, two RBI and a 1.118 OPS in five games...in his last 14 games between Minnesota and Triple-A St. Paul combined, he is hitting .291 (16-for-55) with three doubles, seven home runs, 16 RBI, 14 runs scored and a 1.087 OPS.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2018, Twins Bench Coach Derek Shelton filled in for Paul Molitor as Twins manager as Mollie traveled to Cooperstown for the 2018 Hall of Fame induction (former Twins Jack Morris and Jim Thome)...the Twins lost both games under Shelton by scores of 10-4 and 3-0 at Fenway Park.

The Happy day-early birthday to Twins bullpen coach Pete Maki, who will be turning 39 on the off-day tomorrow.

YOU KNOW PERK?: Bally Sports North pregame analyst Glen Perkins went 4-3, 3.05 ERA (76.2 IP, 26 ER) with 13 saves (15 opportunities), 25 walks and 62 strikeouts in 48 career games (5 starts) vs. the Tigers...his games, innings and strikeouts were his most vs. any opponent.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 5-4 victory against the Angels on July 23...allowed four runs on seven hits (2 HR) over 6.0 innings, with one walk and four strikeouts...marked Happ's fifth-straight start allowing just one walk-or-less...ran into early trouble by allowing three runs in the opening frame, on a José Iglesias single and a two-run home run by Kurt Suzuki...he later gave up a longball to Jack Mayfield in the second...departed after the sixth inning in favor of Alex Colomé with the Twins trailing by one; Minnesota scored two runs in the bottom of the eighth, winning 5-4.

TWO STARTS AGO: Was dealt the loss in the Twins' 7-0 defeat on July 18 at Comerica Park...allowed seven runs on a career-high-tying 11 hits over 7.0 innings of work; paired with his start on July 8 vs. Detroit, marked the second time this season he pitched 7.0+ innings in back-to-back starts (also, April 23-28)...Happ gave up just one walk and struck out four Tigers...allowed two two-run home runs, one to Jonathan Schoop in the fifth inning and another to Jeimer Candelario in the seventh inning.

TAMING THE TIGERS: Happ is making his 15th career start and 16th career appearance vs. Detroit this afternoon...has gone 4-3, 5.22 ERA (81.0 IP, 47 ER), with 27 walks and 73 strikeouts over his previous 15 outings against the Tigers.

- The Happ has faced Detroit three times this season going 1-1, 5.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 11 ER), with five
- Play has faced before times times times season going 1-1, 5.50 ERA (16.0 IP, 11 ER), with nive walks and 16 strikeouts.
 Happ holds a record of 3-1, 5.19 ERA (34.2 IP, 20 ER), with nine walks and 37 strikeouts when facing the Tigers as the home pitcher.
 Holds a record of 4-4, 7.10 ERA (58.1 IP, 46 ER) in 11 starts against the American League Central division this season.

LOW TRAFFIC: Since the beginning of the 2018 season, Happ has averaged 11.57 base runners-per-9.0 innings, 8th fewest in the American League and 24th fewest in the majors (min. 445.0 IP)...Happ has allowed the 10th fewest total base runners (622) in the American League over that span (min. 445.0 IP).

4 However, this season has allowed 13.69 base runners-per-9.0 innings (a team-leading 145 in

RISP MANAGEMENT: Happ held opposing hitters to a .156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

4 However, this season opposing hitters are 27-for-94 (.287) against Happ with RISP, far above his career mark of .234 (355-for-1516).

A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB: Happ's start on April 13 vs. Boston was the 300th of his career...he is one of 11 active pitchers to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (480), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (439), Ervin Santana (386), Max Scherzer (386), Clayton Kershaw (372), Adam Wainwright (346), Johnny Cueto (324), David Price (317) and Madison Bumgarner (309).

Thapp has made at least 10 starts against 16 of 30 MLB teams

Ranks in the upper 54th percentile in baseball in fastball spin.

He has allowed just 27 walks this season, ranking in the upper 75th percentile in BB% in baseball...Happ is tied for eighth-fewest walks among left-handed pitchers this season (min. 95.0 IP).

NIGHT AND DAY, HOME AND ROAD: Happ has made 18 starts so far this season, taking the mound 11 times at night and seven times during the day...during his 11 starts under the lights, he is 2-4, 7.28 ERA (55.2 IP, 45 ER) with 18 walks, 39 strikeouts and a .377 opponent on-base percentage... however, his numbers improve when the sun is up; during his seven starts in the daytime, he is 3-1, 4.54 ERA (39.2 IP, 20 ER) with nine walks, 36 strikeouts and a .291 opponent on-base percentage... \$\Phi\$ 10 his starts this season have come at Target Field and the other eight have come on the road...his numbers at home outshine his record on the road...he is 4-1, 4.45 ERA (54.2 IP, 27 ER) with 17 walks and 40 strikeouts in 10 home starts, while he is 1-4, 8.41 ERA (40.2 IP, 38 ER) with 10 walks and 35 strikeouts in eight starts on the road.

FANNED BY DOUBLE DIGITS: Happ fanned a season-high 10 batters in Cleveland on May 23, his 12th career game with double-digit strikeouts...became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history age 38-or-older with at least 10 strikeouts in a start since Connie Marrero (age 39.037) on June 1, 1950 (12.0 IP, 10 K)...also became the third to do so in nine innings-or-less, joining Johnny Niggeling, who did it twice: August 16, 1944 (8.0 IP, 11 K) and July 8, 1944 (9.0 IP, 10 K).

FRESH STARTS: Happ allowed just two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his first five starts to begin this season, the longest such streak to start a campaign in his career...however, is 3-5, 8.11 ERA (61.0 IP, 55 ER) in his last 13 starts (beginning May 12).

- Ranks fourth among active left-handed pitchers in wins (128) and starts (316), while he is fifth in innings pitched (1836.2) and seventh in strikeouts (1614).
- Pitched a career-best 7.1 hitless innings on April 23, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh...left the game allowing only one hit over 7.1 innings...combined with Tyler Duffey and Taylor Rogers on the 19th one-hitter in Twins history.

 Made his 300th career start April 13, 2021 vs. Boston.
- In 2020, led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655)...did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
- Has made 12 Opening Day rosters with six teams: Philadelphia (2009-10), Houston (2011-12), Toronto (2013, '16-18), Seattle (2015), New York-AL (2019-20) and Minnesota (2021).
- Enters 2021 with 14 MLB seasons under his belt, with the Phillies (2007-10), Astros (2010-12), Blue Jays (2012-14, '16-18), Mariners (2015), Pirates (2015) and Yankees (2018-20).
- Made his 300th career major league appearance and 275th career start on June 23, 2019
- Compiled a career-best 19.1-inning scoreless streak from August 26-September 12-G1,
- 2019, the AL's eighth-longest scoreless streak in 2019 and longest by a Yankee. Finished sixth in 2016 AL Cy Young Award voting after going 20-4, 3.18 ERA for Toronto and tying for the second-most wins in baseball...marks his only career 20-win season and is one of just seven pitchers in the majors (and one of two southpaws) with a 20-win campaign in 2016.
