THE TWINS: Have gone 0-4 through four games on their six-game roadtrip, going 0-3 in Chi-
cago (rainout/PPD on Monday) and 0-1 in Kansas Citytoday the Twins will continue the trip
with the second of three at Kauffman Stadiumafter this series, the Twins will travel home
to complete the "first half" of the season with a seven-game homestand (3 vs. Chicago-AL
and 4 vs. Detroit) leading up to the All-Star Breakthe Twins have gone 17-23 at home this
season and 16-24 on the road.

TWINS DROP GAME ONE IN KANSAS CITY: The Twins lost to the Royals last night by a score of 4-7, squandering an early 3-0 lead...J.A. Happ (4-4) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs (5 earned) on nine hits in 4.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Trevor Larnach and Alex Kirilloff...they also both recorded the only two RBI for the club...Josh Donaldson went 1-for-4, extending his on-base streak to seven-straight games.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 12th of 19 meetings in 2021...Twins are 5-6 against the Royals this season, going 3-3 at Target Field and 2-3 at Kauffman Stadium.

♣ Miguel Sanó has 19 career home runs against the Royals, 12 at Kauffman Stadium, his most in any opposing ballpark...since 2017, he has 11 homers in this park, the most among opponents (25 games).

♣ Alex Kirilloff is hitting 310 (13-for-42) with four home runs, 11 RBI, three walks, five runs scored and a .943 OPS in 11 career games against the Royals...four of his six career homers and 11 of his 28 RBI have come against the Royals.

♣ Josh Donaldson is hitting .327 (35-for-107) with 11 doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.028 OPS in 29 career games at Kauffman Stadium.

♣ Since joining the Twins in 2019, Nelson Cruz is hitting .344 (42-for-122) with 10 doubles, 16 home runs, 39 RBI, a .442 on-base percentage, a .820 slugging percentage and a 1.262 OPS in 34 games vs. the Royals (Twins are 21-13 in those games)...he has 31 home runs in 103 career games against Kansas City (chart to the bottom right).

♣ Cruz is tied with Miguel Sanó for third-most homers among active opponents at Kauffman Stadium with 12, trailing Miguel Cabrera (19) and Albert Pujols (17).

♣ Luis Arraez is hitting .348 (24-for-69) with 10 walks and a .444 OBP in 19 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 18 of those 19.

ROAD CRUZIN': Nelson Cruz is hitting .355 (43-for-121) with five doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 24 RBI, 11 walks, a .415 on-base percentage and a 1.051 OPS in 34 road games this season...last night he went 0-for-4, snapping a 13-game road hitting streak...on the season, he leads baseball in road OPS and ranks second in road batting average, trailing only Michael Brantley (.396).

ALL ABOUT ALEX: Alex Kirilloff is hitting .313 (20-for-64) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, 10 RBI, four walks, a .353 on-base percentage and an .853 OPS in his last 17 games...among all rookies in baseball in that span, he ranks second in batting average, fourth in on-base percentage and fifth in OPS.

TWINS AND SOUTHPAWS: The Twins are hitting .256 (236-for-922) with a .445 slugging percentage and a .758 OPS vs. lefties this season, compared to .240 (427-for-1782) with a .424 slugging and a .742 OPS against righties.

▼ Twins rank second in baseball in slugging percentage vs. lefties, trailing Houston (.447).

▼ Nelson Cruz is hitting .386 (34-for-88) with six doubles, six home runs and a 1.091 OPS vs. lefties this season...his average against lefties ranks second in all of baseball, trailing only Buster Posey (.390)...in his last 10 games vs. lefties, he is hitting .517 (15-for-29) with three doubles, three home runs, two walks and a 1.494 OPS.

▼ Cruz is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with five home runs lifetime against Danny Duffy.

▼ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with two doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.114 OPS vs. lefties...four of his five home runs have come against lefties.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2020, the Twins officially began Summer Camp at Target Field...is served as the club's "second spring training"...the Twins originally played 19 spring training games from February 21-March 11, going 7-8-4, prior to leaving camp due to the COVID-19 pandemic and flew home to Minnesota on March 15...the Twins held Summer Camp from July 3-21 and played Intrasquad scrimmages near the back half with Team Polanco (white tops) vs. Team Kepler (blue tops)...they opened the 2020 regular season at Chicago-AL on July 24...in 2010, Jim Thome hit career home runs 573 and 574 at Target Field vs. Tampa Bay, both off Wade Davis...his 574th moved him past Harmon Killebrew and into sole possession of 10th on baseball's all-time home run list.

WIND UP: Right-handed pitcher Josh Winder (pronounced WINE-der) made his Triple-A debut for St. Paul last night against Omaha, carrying a no-hitter into the sixth inning...he finished as the winner, allowing one run on one hit in 5.2 innings pitched, with two walks and eight strikeouts...the game was played in front of 8,002 fans, marking a single-game high for the Saints this season...Winder was recently named to the American League roster for the 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, which will be played on July 11 at Coors Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Jax last pitched on June 25 vs. Cleveland, working a career-high 4.1 innings out of the bullpen in relief of Opener Danny Couloumbe...permitted three runs on three hits (1 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts...entered in the second inning with Minnesota behind 1-3 and earned his first career victory in a back-and-forth battle, as the Twins took the lead for good in the sixth and eventually defeated the Indians 8-7...marked his first major league appearance since June 15, as well as his first time pitching in a Twins win.

BIG LEAGUE BREAKDOWN: Jax is in his second stint with the Twins this season, after being with

BIG LEAGUE BREAKDUWN: Jax is in his second stint with the Twins this season, after being with the club from June 5-15...the 26-year-old right-hander has appeared four times out of the bullpen, including his June 8 major league debut, going 1-0, 7.82 ERA (12.2 IP, 11 ER), five walks and 11 strikeouts across those outings.

◆ Had his contract purchased June 5, while his big league debut came at Target Field on June 8 vs. the New York Yankees...pitched the ninth inning, fanning Tyler Wade for his first career strikeout.

◆ Also pitched June 9 vs. the Yankees and June 15 at Seattle...was optioned following his 4.0-inning, six-strikeout, 93-pitch effort vs. the Mariners...was recalled just nine days later and earned his first career win in relief on June 25 vs. Cleveland (4.1 IP, 3 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 2 K, full outing detailed in note above).

LOTS OF LOVE FOR THE LEFTIES: Jax has held left-handed batters to a .200 (5-for-25) batting average, with two doubles, one homer, three walks and five strikeouts so far in his major league career...this compares to the .360 (9-for-25) batting average that right-handed batters have posted against him thus far.

BEARING DOWN: During his initial big league foray, Jax has demonstrated an ability to get outs when most needed, holding opposing hitters to just two singles in 10 at-bats (.200) with runners in scoring position, with three walks and four strikeouts...opponents are also just 1-for-5 (.200) against him with RISP and two outs...additionally, of the 57 batters he's faced so far in his major league career, he's reached a 3-0 count on just one (the plate appearance ended in a walk).

THE ARSENAL: Jax has used four different offerings so far in his major league career, relying primarily on

ACROSS THE RIVER: Jax did not play an official professional game in 2020 and was not part of the Twins' 60-man player pool...participated in the Twins Fall Instructional League in Fort Myers in October 2020...opened 2021 in the rotation for Triple-A St. Paul, going 3-1, 3.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 10 ER) in five starts during May...did not pitch upon being optioned to the Saints on June 16 and returned to the Twins on June 24.

The Pritched at least 5.0 innings in all five of his Triple-A starts, while cresting the 90-pitch plateau in each of his last four efforts.

◆ Held opponents to one-or-zero runs in four of his five Saints starts...in fact, taking away his lone poor outing in a May 18 loss to Indianapolis (5.0 IP, 7 ER), he posted a 3-0 mark with a 1.23 ERA (22.0 IP, 3 ER) in his other four outings...bounced back from his lone loss five days later to hold that same Indians club to one run on seven hits, with a walk and eight strikeouts, in 6.0 innings.

◆ In his final Triple-A start May 28 at lowa, established a career high across any level with 10 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-hit, shutout ball (2 walks).

CAPTAIN JAX: Jax is the first graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy to ever play in the major leagues... became the sixth Academy product ever to be drafted (now 9) when he was selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

Received the email informing him of his promotion to Captain on June 5, his first day in a big league uniform... with that honor, matched the current rank of his wife, Savannah, who is an intelligence officer in the Air Force based out of Moody Air Force Base in Georgia...Savannah, has also completed a six month tour of duty in Afrabairstan within the last 18 months. nah has also completed a six-month tour of duty in Afghanistan within the last 18 months.

JAX AND THE AIR FORCE ACADEMY: Jax was able to play baseball full-time through 2019 while concurrently serving in the Air Force through the Air Force's World Class Athlete Program (WCAP); he was accepted into the program in April 2018, following baseball's readmittance as an Olympic sport, as a Second Lieutenant (the rank all cadets receive after graduating from the academy).

The WCAP program was established in 1995 in honor of Tuskegee Airman Malvin G. Whitfield, who in 1952 became the first active-duty American serviceman to win an Olympic gold medal, doing so while simultaneously serving as a Korean War tail gunner.

The program allows active duty solders to train for the Olympics as their full-time job responsibility, while still maintaining active duty status in the military...Jax continued to complete all mandatory Air Force trainings, continuing education, fitness assessments, etc.

While part of the WCAP, he was paid by the Air Force as he could not have an outside source of income while on active duty...thanks to a special deal arranged between MLB and the Air Force, the Twins paid for his equipment, travel, etc.

Completed his two-year active duty commitment in 2019 and was transferred to the Air Force Reserve in November 2019, while continuing with his five-year Reserve requirement with around 24 days per year of military activity.

His wife, Savannah, is also in the Air Force and completed a six-month deployment to Afghanistan within the last 18 months.

 Named best control in Twins minor league system by Baseball America in 2019.
