THE TWINS: Have gone $0-5$ through five games on their six-game roadtrip, going 0-3 in Chicago (rainout/PPD on Monday) and 0-2 in Kansas City...today the Twins will complete the trip with the three-game series finale at Kauffman Stadium....after today's game, the Twins will travel home and begin a seven-game homestand with three against the White Sox from Monday-Wednesday, followed by four games against the Tigers from Thursday-Sunday...after the homestand, Major League Baseball will hold the All-Star Break in Colorado from July 1215...the Twins have gone 17-23 at home this season and 16-25 on the road.

玉 The Twins are looking to avoid falling 16 games under .500 for the first time this season and snap their five-game losing streak...their last six-game losing streak came August 25-31, 2020.
TWINS DROP GAME TWO IN KC: The Twins lost the Royals yesterday afternoon by a score of 3-6...Griffin Jax (1-1) made his first career start, allowing six runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, holding the Royals scoreless for three innings until allowing six runs in the fourth and fifth innings combined...the offense recorded nine hits, two from both Jorge Polanco and Trevor Larnach, who came off the bench...Larnach had the Twins' only home run with a solo shot in the eighth inning, the sixth of his season/career...Josh Donaldson exited the game in the third inning after experiencing hamstring tightness while running out a double.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 13th of 19 meetings in 2021...Twins are 5-7 against the Royals this season, going 3-3 at Target Field and 2-4 at Kauffman Stadium...these two teams will meet again for three games at Target Field from September 10-12.
© Miguel Sanó has 19 career home runs against the Royals, 12 at Kauffman Stadium, his most in any opposing ballpark...since 2017, he has 11 homers in this park, the most among opponents (26 games).

LAST TIME OUT: Maeda shouldered his third loss of the season in his last start on June 29 at ChicagoAL, yielding seven runs on eight hits, with five walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work... matched his career highs with five walks (2nd time, last done on June 19, 2018 at Chicago-NL) and seven earned runs allowed (3rd time, last done on April 21 at Oakland)...walked the bases loaded in the opening frame, the fifth time in his career that he's walked three batters in an inning and second this season (also, bottom 1st, June 14 at Seattle)...pitched out of the jam with only one run allowed and worked scoreless second and fourth frames, but yielded two more runs in the third and three in the fifth before departing with one on, two out ( 1 additional run scored off Danny Coulombe)...Maeda also pitched on at least eight days of rest in a start that did not occur at the beginning of a season or after an Injured List stint for the first time since also pitching on eight days of rest on July 24, 2018 at Philadelphia (with Los Angeles-NL - first start after All-Star Break).
START PRIOR: Maeda earned his third win of the season and first since May 3 on June 20 at Texas... worked 5.1 innings of five-hit, two-run ball, walking one while striking out four batters as the Twins beat the Rangers 4-2...pitched 5.0 shutout innings before allowing a pair of one-out solo shots to Adolis Garcia and Joey Gallo in the sixth and departing in favor of Tyler Duffey...the Twins' bullpen tossed 3.2 scoreless innings in relief to close out the win.
ROYAL WELCOME: Today marks Maeda's second career start and appearance against Kansas City, as well as his first in a Twins uniform and first at Kauffman Stadium...did not face the Royals last season... his lone career outing against Kansas City came in Interleague Play on July 7,2017 for Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium...earned the win after tossing 5.0 innings and yielding just one run on four hits, with two walks and five strikeouts in a 4-1 team win

CENTRAL-FUGAL FORCE: Maeda is 1-2, 6.49 ERA ( $26.1 \mathrm{IP}, 19 \mathrm{ER}$ ), nine walks, 22 strikeouts and a 284 (29-for-102) opponent batting average in five starts against the AL Central so far this season.... Went (93.1 IP, 40 ER) in 17 career starts vs. the division, marking his second-best career ERA against any single division (NL East - 3.11 ERA).

MISSING HOME: Nine of Maeda's 12 starts so far this season have come on the road, and he's 2-2, 6.28 ERA ( 43.0 IP, 30 ER) with 15 walks and 39 strikeouts in those outings...this compares to his 1-1 record, 3.29 ERA (13.2 IP, 5 ER), five walks and 15 strikeouts in three home starts this year.

MILESTONE MAN: Maeda surpassed two career milestones in his start against the Mariners in Seattle on June 14...at the end of his second inning of work he reached 700 career MLB innings, becoming the 10th Japanese-born pitcher to hit that plateau in the majors...the others are: Hideo Nomo (1,976.1 IP), Hiroki Kuroda (1,319.0 IP), Yu Darvish (1,229.0 IP), Tomo Ohka (1,070.0 IP), Masahiro Tanaka (1,054.1 IP), Hisashi Iwakuma (883.2 IP), Daisuke Matsuzaka (790.1 IP), Masato Yoshii (757.1 IP) and Shigetoshi Hasegawa (720.1 IP)...additionally, Maeda's strikeout of Shed Long Jr. in the fourth inning on June 14 was the 2,000th of his career....he now has 2,008 strikeouts combined between Nippon Professional Baseball $(1,233)$ and Major League Baseball $(775)$.

2021 ARSENAL: Maeda's slider has surpassed his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch over the last several seasons....he threw them equally in his rookie 2016 campaign and his four-seamer was his most frequent offering from 2017-19...however, his slider has been his top pitch since the start of 2020, followed by his split finger...here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results: PITCH (AVG. $\Phi$ When the count goes full, Maeda is holding opposing hitters to just 3-for-24 (.125), the 13thlowest mark among American League pitchers (min. 20 opp. at-bats)

SETTLING IN: Maeda finished April with a 6.56 ERA, his second-highest single-month ERA in his career behind his 6.58 mark in April 2017...he tends to heat up with the weather, owning a 3.68 career ERA in May and 3.25 mark in June... his 3.25 ERA in June is his lowest in a single calendar month in his career; is 7-7 with 45 walks, 125 strikeouts and a . 214 opponent batting average ( 86 -for-419) in 22 career games ( 20 starts) in summer's first month...however, his career ERA jumps to 4.36 in July, his second-highest full month mark in his career, behind only his 4.48 ERA in April...here are his numbers by month in his career (full months only, excluding March and October)
