THE TWINS: Completed their roadtrip with a record of 1-5, going 0-3 in Chicago and 1-2 in Kansas City...tonight they will begin a seven-game homestand with three against the White Sox tonight through Wednesday, followed by four games against the Tigers from Thursday-Sunday...after the homestand, Major League Baseball will hold the All-Star Break in Colorado from July 12-15...the Twins have gone 17-23 at home this season and 17-25 on the road.

TWINS SET OFF THE FIREWORKS IN THE FINALE: The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon by a score of 6-2...Kenta Maeda (4-3) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, one walk and a season-high 10 strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, three from leadoff hitter Luis Arraez, who also walked and scored three runs...the Twins hit three home runs with Jorge Polanco (10), Alex Kirilloff (7) and Max Kepler (7) all connecting...the club finished their "first half" road schedule with a record of 17-25.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the 10th of 19 meetings this season...Twins are 1-8 against the Sox this season, going 1-2 at Target Field and 0-6 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Twins were swept last week at Chicago in three games from Tuesday-Thursday (rainout/PPD on Monday), getting outscored 14-28 in the series.

- Twins have been outscored by the White Sox this season 37-76.
- Josh Donaldson is hitting .299 (63-for-211) with 10 doubles, 19 home runs, 47 RBI, 41 walks and a 1.025 OPS in 61 career games vs. the White Sox.
- Nelson Cruz is hitting .400 (52-for-130) with 11 doubles, 14 home runs, 39 RBI, 19 walks, a .477 OBP, an .808 slugging percentage and a 1.284 OPS in 35 games vs. the Sox while in a Minnesota uniform (since 2019)...he has two hits in each of his last four games vs. the Sox, going 8-for-15 with two doubles and two home runs in that span.
- Miguel Sanó has 13 home runs and 26 RBI in 31 games vs. the Sox since the start of 2019.
- Lifetime against Dylan Cease: Cruz is 6-for-11 (.545) with one double, one home run, five RBI and three walks...Jorge Polanco is 4-for-9 (.444) with one double, one home run and two walks...Luis Arraez is 3-for-9 (.333) with one walk.

NELLIE IS THE MAN: All-Star Game rosters were announced yesterday as Nelson Cruz will be the lone Twins representative...it marks Cruz's seventh time being named an All-Star, previously in 2009 and '13 with Texas, 2014 with Baltimore, and 2015, '17 and '18 with Seattle...in his five ASG appearances (DNP in 2009), he has gone 0-for-7 with two walks and three strikeouts...at 41-years-old he is the oldest All-Star since Mariano Rivera (43) in 2013...this marks the first time in club history that a designated hitter has been named to represent the Twins.

- Additionally, he is one of seven players named to either roster with at least seven selections, joining Los Angeles-AL's Mike Trout (8), Chicago-NL's Craig Kimbrel (8), Houston's Jose Altuve (7), New York-AL's Aroldis Chapman (7), Kansas City's Salvador Perez (7) and San Francisco's Buster Posey (7).
- In 72 games this season, Cruz is hitting .306 (77-for-252) with 11 doubles, 18 home runs, 45 RBI, 29 walks, a .381 on-base percentage, a .571 slugging percentage and a .952 OPS...he ranks sixth in the AL in batting average, third in slugging and OPS, ninth in on-base percentage and tied for 11th in homers.

SUMMER CRUZ: Nelson Cruz is hitting .367 (33-for-90) with six doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI, 14 walks, a .453 on-base percentage and a 1.153 OPS in 25 games since June 1...since that date, he leads baseball in on-base percentage, is second in batting average and third in OPS (minimum 100 plate appearances).

JORGE HEATING: In 25 games since June 3, Jorge Polanco is hitting .298 (31-for-104) with six doubles, five home runs, 12 RBI, 20 runs scored, eight walks, a .354 on-base percentage and an .854 OPS...during that span, as a left-handed batter, he is hitting .300 (18-for-60) with four home runs, seven RBI, seven walks and a .906 OPS.

ARRAEZ TO THE TOP: Luis Arraez is hitting .325 (50-for-154) with seven doubles, four triples, 14 RBI, 29 runs scored, 15 walks and a .387 on-base percentage at the leadoff spot...he leads the team with 38 starts out of that spot, including eight of the Twins last 12 games...among all American League players, he ranks third in batting average from that spot in the order, trailing only Seattle's J.P. Crawford (.333) and Los Angeles-AL's Justin Upton (.326).

FELIZ CUMPLEAÑOS! Jorge Polanco is celebrating his 28th birthday today...he has played three career games on his birthday, first in 2017 vs. Los Angeles-AL, going 0-for-3 with a walk, again in 2018, going 1-for-3 with a double and a walk, and in 2019 vs. Texas, going 2-for-5 with one home run and two RBI...he shares a birthday with former Twin Jesse Crain (40) and Angels All-Star Shohei Ohtani (27).

MAGGI MAGIC: Triple-A St. Paul infielder Drew Maggi has been named MiLB.com Triple-A East Player of the Week...the 32-year-old hit .429 (9-for-21) with two doubles, four home runs, five RBI and seven runs scored in five games...he became the first player in the 29-year history of the St. Paul Saints franchise (Independent and Triple-A) to homer in four consecutive games as he did so on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday against Omaha at CHS Field.

WELCOME BACK WEEK: With the Twins opening Target Field to full, 100 percent capacity, without restrictions, beginning tonight, the club is celebrating a "Welcome Back Week" for its fans during this homestand that runs through Sunday...all seven games vs. AL Central division rivals the Chicago White Sox (tonight-Wednesday) and Detroit Tigers (Thursday-Sunday) will feature some combination of a promotional giveaway, theme night or other special event.

- Tonight:** AYCE food, available for free to anyone with a ticket, is located in the Gate 34 area, along with Sections 27, 114, 120, 126, 133, 237, R, 311 and 323...the menu includes hot dogs, peanuts, nacho chips with cheese and more...a pregame party at gate 34: When the gates open at 4:40 pm, DJ Matty Matt will provide musical entertainment...and finally, tonight is Minnesota Lynx Night where fans who purchase this theme night package will receive a ticket to the game, along with an exclusive co-branded Lynx/Twins beanie.
- Tomorrow night vs. the White Sox:** Pride Night presented by Target: The Twins are proud to join the LGBTQ+ community, friends, family and organizations in celebrating the club's annual Pride Night, presented by Target...fans who purchase this theme night package will receive a ticket to the game, along with a first-of-its-kind, customizable Twins/Pride Night jersey with their personal pronouns of choice.

LAST START: Took his first career decision, a loss, on June 30 at Chicago-AL, opposite Dylan Cease...pitched just 3.1 innings, the shortest outing of his career, while permitting a career-high five runs on four hits (3 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts...worked a scoreless opening frame before yielding three runs in the second on a solo shot by Brian Goodwin and a two-run homer off the bat of Andrew Vaughn...allowed a single tally in the third (José Abreu solo shot) and departed with two on, one out in the fourth; one additional run scored off Matt Shoemaker...reached the 80-pitch mark for the second time in his career, also doing so in his first career start on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL.

START PRIOR: Ober started against Cincinnati on June 22, a 10-7 Twins loss...did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts in 4.1 innings of work...walked multiple batters for the first time in his career...permitted just one run on a Tucker Barnhart third-inning solo homer across the first four innings, before running into trouble in the fifth...allowed each of the first four batters to reach to start the fifth (1B, 1B, BB, 2B), capped off by a two-run double by Jesse Winker...induced a lineup and departed the game with two on, one out; an additional run scored off Tyler Duffey...the four earned runs matched Ober's then-career high, done previously in his first career start on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL.

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: Tonight marks Ober's third career start and appearance against the White Sox, his most vs. any opponent in his career...is 0-1, 11.05 ERA (7.1 IP, 9 ER) with three walks, seven strikeouts and a .281 opponent batting average (9-for-32) in his two prior starts...made his major league debut on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field, allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in a 4.0-inning no-decision...the Twins won, 5-4, on Jorge Polanco's walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth...Ober recorded his first career strikeout in the opening frame, fanning Adam Eaton for the second out of the inning...also faced the White Sox in his last start on June 30 (see last start note above).

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first six career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .176 batting average (3-for-17) with runners in scoring position as well as a .143 (1-for-7) mark with RISP and two outs...this trend was also true in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, as he held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position for the Saints.

LOW TRAFFIC: Ober struck out 100 batters and walked just nine in 2019, good for an MiLB-best 11.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min. 75.0 IP)...that season, he also ranked second in the minors in WHIP (0.81) and base runners-per-9.0 IP (7.55), and was fifth in walks-per-9.0 IP (1.03).

In six MLB starts this season, Ober has allowed 35 total base runners 24.2 innings, good for a 12.77 base-runners-per-9.0 IP ratio...he's also averaging just 2.19 walks-per-9.0 IP and has walked just six batters compared to 26 strikeouts, good for a 4.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Ober is one of six players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of two pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2) and RHP Griffin Jax (June 8).

WALKING TALL: Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is one of just five players 6-8-or-taller to suit up for the Twins and Senators, as well as just the third pitcher of that height to debut for Minnesota or Washington...additionally, Ober's 26 career strikeouts are 12th most among all pitchers 6-9-or-taller in major league history...the other pitchers 6-8-or-taller to play for the Twins are:

SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average (13-for-60)...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints' fifth game on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run scored on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work...took the ball again on May 13 vs. Iowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision...earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at Iowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none and fanning five as the Saints exploded for 17 runs en route to a 17-5 rout of the I-Cubs...his other start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, fanning a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep.

CAREER REDUX: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a .222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances (35 starts)...was added to the Twins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020 and is currently ranked as the 21st-best prospect in the Twins system by MLB.com...spent part of the offseason working out in Colorado with fellow Twins pitchers Griffin Jax and Taylor Rogers.

- Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).
- Over that same time span, Ober ranks third by allowing just 8.79 base runners-per-9.0 innings, fourth by walking just 1.18 batters-per-9.0-innings and fifth in WHIP (0.96).

NO RUNS: Ober posted a miniscule 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) in 2019, his most recent full professional season...his mark led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) and he also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961...also marked the second-lowest single-season ERA by any minor league pitcher since 1992 (min. 75.0 IP), trailing only Erasmo Ramirez's 0.51 ERA (88.0 IP, 5 ER) in 2009 for the VSL Mariners.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOSÉ BERRÍOS (2021 SEASON: 7-2, 3.52 ERA // CAREER: 55-40, 4.10 ERA)

Berrios is due to start tomorrow night's contest against the White Sox, matching up with Carlos Rodón for the second-straight start...did not factor into the decision in his last outing on July 1 in Chicago, allowing four runs (3 earned) on 10 hits (1 HR), with no strikeouts and one walk in 5.0 innings of work...marked his first career start of at least 5.0 innings in which he did not strike out a batter...tomorrow will mark his second start of the season against the White Sox, after his last outing...he's 12-2, 2.77 ERA (113.2 IP, 35 ER) with 26 walks and 111 strikeouts in 18 career starts vs. the White Sox, his most starts, wins, strikeouts and innings pitched against any single opponent in his career.
