THE TWINS: After completing their last roadtrip with a record of 1-5 (0-3 in Chicago and 1-2 in Kansas City), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a victory over the White Sox last night...tonight they will continue the homestand with the second of three against Chicago...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will welcome the Tigers for four from Thursday-Sunday...after this weekend, Major League Baseball will hold the All-Star Break in Colorado from July 12-15...the Twins have gone 18-23 at home this season and 17-25 on the road.

TWINS MAX OUT OBER THE SOX: The Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 8-5, snapping their four-game losing streak to the Sox...Bailey Ober (1-1) was the starter and winner, earning his first major league victory (7th start) by pitching 5.0 scoreless innings with two hits, three walks and seven strikeouts...Hansel Robles earned his eighth save, converting his sixth consecutive opportunity...the offense recorded 10 hits, six going for extra-bases, including two home runs from Max Kepler (8, 9), the 10th multi-homer game of his career and third against the White Sox...the Twins drew a 2021 single-game attendance high of 20,321.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the 11th of 19 meetings this season...Twins are 2-8 against the Sox this season, going 2-2 at Target Field and 0-6 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Twins have been outscored by the White Sox this season 45-81.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .400 (52-for-130) with 11 doubles, 14 home runs, 39 RBI, 19 walks, a .477 OBP, an .808 slugging percentage and a 1.284 OPS in 35 games vs. the Sox while in a Minnesota uniform (since 2019)...he has two hits in each of his last four games vs. the Sox, going 8-for-15 with two doubles and two home runs in that span.

☞ Miguel Sanó has 13 home runs and 26 RBI in 32 games vs. the Sox since the start of 2019.

MAX POWER: Max Kepler hit his eighth and ninth home runs last night, matching his 2020 total...it marked his third home run in his last two games and fourth in his last eight...the home runs last night also tied him with Roy Smalley for 16th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

TWINS AND SOUTHPAWS: The Twins are hitting .258 (246-for-953) with a .449 slugging percentage and a .766 OPS vs. lefties this season, compared to .240 (445-for-1853) with a .428 slugging and a .747 OPS against righties.

☞ Twins lead baseball in slugging percentage and home runs (42) against lefties...they also rank fourth in OPS and eighth in batting average.

☞ Twins are facing a lefty for the 30th time this season, having gone 10-19 in games started by southpaws...they were 9-7 vs. lefty starters in 2020 and 22-17 in 2019.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .389 (35-for-90) with six doubles, six home runs and a 1.094 OPS vs. lefties this season...his average against lefties ranks second in all of baseball, trailing only Buster Posey (.393)...in his last 14 games vs. lefties, he is hitting .516 (16-for-31) with three doubles, three home runs, three walks and a 1.475 OPS.

ARRAEZ TO THE TOP: Luis Arraez is hitting .329 (52-for-158) with seven doubles, four triples, 14 RBI, 29 runs scored, 16 walks and a .393 on-base percentage at the leadoff spot...he leads the team with 39 starts out of that spot, including nine of the Twins last 13 games...among all American League players, he ranks second in batting average from that spot in the order, trailing only Seattle's J.P. Crawford (.333).

SUMMER CRUZ: Nelson Cruz is hitting .367 (33-for-90) with six doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI, 14 walks, a .453 on-base percentage and a 1.153 OPS in 25 games since June 1...since that date, he leads baseball in on-base percentage, is second in batting average and third in OPS (minimum 100 plate appearances).

RATED ROOKIES:

☞ Ryan Jeffers ranks fifth among MLB rookies in games caught with 31 (30 starts)...he is hitting .306 (11-for-36) with four home runs, 10 RBI, seven walks and a 1.113 OPS vs. lefties.

☞ Alex Kirilloff has hit safely in 20 of his last 24 games, hitting .289 (26-for-90) with 12 RBI and an .800 OPS in that span (since June 4)...in that span he ranks fifth among all rookies in baseball in average and OPS.

BASEPATH BRILLIANCE: Trevor Larnach's steal last night was the Twins' 29th theft of the season, and the club has been caught stealing just five times in 34 attempts so far...five caught stealings are tied with New York-AL for fewest among all major league teams, while the Twins' 85.3 stolen base percentage is second in the majors, behind only Philadelphia (87.0)...should the Twins keep up this pace of successful steals, they'd shatter the single-season club record for stolen base percent, currently held by the 2007 Twins (78.9, 112-for-142).

ICYMI: Right-handed pitcher Matt Shoemaker cleared waivers yesterday and accepted his assignment to Triple-A St. Paul...Shoemaker was designated for release or assignment on Thursday.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2014, Glen Perkins and Kurt Suzuki were named to the AL All-Star team as they combined to pitch/catch the ninth inning and secure the 5-3 AL victory at Target Field on July 14...in 2007, Ron Gardenhire earned his 500th career managerial victory with a 20-14 win in game one of a DH at Chicago-AL; Joe Mauer had four hits and five RBI in the game and Jason Kubel drove in seven.

WELCOME BACK WEEK: With the Twins opening Target Field to full, 100 percent capacity, without restrictions, beginning last night, the club is celebrating a "Welcome Back Week" for its fans during this homestand that runs through Sunday...all seven games this week will feature some combination of a promotional giveaway, theme night or other special event.

☞ **Tonight: Pride Night** presented by Target: The Twins are proud to join the LGBTQ+ community, friends, family and organizations in celebrating the club's annual Pride Night, presented by Target...fans who purchase this theme night package will receive a ticket to the game, along with a first-of-its-kind, customizable Twins/Pride Night jersey with their personal pronouns of choice.

☞ **Tomorrow vs. the White Sox - Student Day** presented by Rasmussen University: Returning on July 7 for the first time in 2021, Ballpark Access tickets are just \$5 for students, thanks to Rasmussen University...students can purchase tickets through the MLB Ballpark app; additionally, students can text "STUDENT" to 51655 to receive special Student Day offers, or sign up here...**Dollar-a-Dog Day:** Every Wednesday, hot dogs are just \$1 at the Hennepin Grille and Taste of Twins Territory concession stands.

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision last Thursday, July 1 at Chicago-AL, working 5.0 innings and permitting four runs (3 ER) on a season-high 10 hits, with one walk and no strikeouts...squared off against Carlos Rodón in a game the White Sox eventually won, 8-5... allowed a solo home run to Brian Goodwin leading off the second inning before allowing two more runs to cross in the third on an RBI single by Yasmani Grandal and a sacrifice fly by Gavin Sheets...took the mound in the fifth with a 4-3 lead but Grandal tied the game when he scored an unearned run after reaching on a throwing error earlier in the inning...marked Berríos' first career game with at least 5.0 innings pitched and no strikeouts...also marked his 27th-consecutive start allowing four earned runs-or-fewer, the longest such streak by a Twin since Johan Santana recorded a run of 35-straight starts of four earned runs-or-fewer from July 15, 2006-July 18, 2007.

START PRIOR: Did not factor into the decision on June 24 vs. Cleveland despite pitching 6.1 innings of one-run, four-hit ball, with two walks and nine strikeouts...the only run he allowed came on a two-strike, two-out single off the bat of Austin Hedges in the second inning...retired 13 of the final 15 men he faced, departing in favor of Caleb Thielbar with one out in the seventh and the game tied 1-1...Twins bullpen surrendered three runs in the eighth and the Indians won, 4-1...Berríos' nine strikeouts marked his highest total since also fanning nine on May 2 vs. Kansas City...recorded his team-leading sixth quality start and third consecutive, his longest stretch since a streak of seven-straight quality outings from May 24-June 28, 2019.

GOING STREAKING: Despite not factoring into the decision in his last three starts, Berríos remains on a five-game winning streak, matching the longest of his career, previously done April 14-May 7, 2019...is tied for the third-longest active streak in the American League, behind Oakland's Chris Bassitt (9) and Texas' Kyle Gibson (6).

☞ Is 5-0, 3.71 ERA (68.0 IP, 28 ER) with 16 walks and 63 strikeouts in 11 starts since May 2...has completed at least 5.0 innings in all 11 of those games, including five quality starts (Twins are 8-3).

☞ His last losing decision came in the second game of the doubleheader at Oakland on April 20, when he surrendered one run on four hits, with one walk and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings in a 1-0 A's victory.

700 CLUB: This season, Berríos has surpassed both 700 strikeouts and 700.0 innings pitched for his career...his 700th strikeout came in the fifth inning on May 15 vs. Oakland, fanning Seth Brown...became the 15th Twin to reach 700 strikeouts and the 28th Twin to reach 700.0 innings pitched.

☞ He needs 21 strikeouts to tie Scott Baker (770) for 12th on the Twins all-time strikeout list (list in lower right area of page).

CHICAGO, CHICAGO: Berríos is making his 19th career start against the White Sox tonight and second consecutive...owns a career 12-2, 2.77 ERA (113.2 IP, 35 ER) with 111 strikeouts and a .235 opponent batting average vs. the South Siders.

☞ 19 starts, 12 wins and 111 strikeouts are his most against any opponent, with his 12 wins marking his only double-digit win total against any team...his 4.27 strikeout-to-walk ratio (111 K, 26 BB) vs. Chicago-AL is his third-best mark vs. any opponent he's faced at least four times in his career (Seattle - 5.86, Baltimore - 5.44).

RIGHT ON TARGET: Berríos has earned the victory in each of his eight career Target Field starts against the White Sox, going 8-0, 1.40 ERA (58.0 IP, 9 ER) with 10 walks and 69 strikeouts.

☞ Has never allowed more than two earned runs in a home start vs. the White Sox and has worked at least 6.0 innings in all eight outings, collecting a quality start in each.

☞ His last start in this ballpark vs. Chicago-AL came on September 2, 2020...turned in 6.0 innings of one-run, three-hit ball, walking two and striking out eight en route to an 8-1 Twins victory.

☞ Is currently tied with former Twin Kyle Gibson for most wins at Target Field; a win tonight would give him the most in the ballpark's history.

SLICK LEATHER: He has four defensive runs saved this season, good for third best in baseball among all pitchers, trailing only Chicago-AL's Dallas Keuchel (6) and New York-NL's Taijuan Walker (5)...Berríos finished tied for fifth in baseball among pitchers in DRS in 2020 with one...since 2019, he ranks tied for ninth in DRS with five...his three pickoffs this season are tied for tops in the AL and tied for third most in the majors.

RIGHTY TIGHTY: Berríos is holding right-handed hitters to a .186 (35-for-188) average with five doubles, three home runs, eight walks and 51 strikeouts, compared to lefties hitting .297 (49-for-165) with 14 doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 16 walks and 45 strikeouts against him...his right-handed opponent batting average ranks third in the AL (min. 175 opp. AB), behind Chicago-AL's Carlos Rodón (.156) and Baltimore's John Means (.177).

TOP OF THE CLASS: Berríos has 52 wins since the start of 2017, second most in the American League in that span, trailing only Justin Verlander (53)...MLB-wide in that time frame, 52 wins ranks eighth in the majors, trailing Gerrit Cole (62), Zack Greinke (61), Clayton Kershaw (58), Max Scherzer (57), Charlie Morton (54), Trevor Bauer (53) and Verlander (53)...his 700 strikeouts are fourth in the AL, trailing Cole (831), Verlander (816) and Chris Sale (763).

CAREER NOTES

- Named to 2018 and 2019 AL All-Star teams, pitching 1.0 inning in both games.
- Started Game 1 of the 2019 ALDS against New York-AL and Game 2 of the 2020 AL Wild Card Series vs. Houston.
- In 2019, teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 K on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893, when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall-of-Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.
- Given the 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of BBWAA...also won the Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.
- Became 21st pitcher in Twins' history to reach the 200-strikeout mark in a season (202 in 2018).
- Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts.
- Made MLB debut April 27, 2016 vs. Cleveland.
- Named Twins' second-best prospect entering 2016, as well as best curveball, best changeup, and best control in Twins' system by *Baseball America*.
- Named 20th-best prospect in baseball by MLB.com entering 2016.
- Started for the World Team in the Sirius XM Futures Games in consecutive seasons, 2014 at Target Field and 2015 at Great American Ball Park in Cincinnati.
