**THE TWINS:** The Twins began their seven-game homestand by splitting the first two contests with the White Sox...today they will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against Chicago...tomorrow night the Twins will welcome the Tigers for four from Thursday-Sunday...after this weekend, Major League Baseball will hold the All-Star Break in Colorado from July 12-15...the Twins have gone 18-24 at home this season and 17-25 on the road.  
☞ Twins are 19-25 in day games this season, tied for third most day wins in the AL and tied for sixth most in baseball...they lead baseball with 44 day games played in 2021.

**BERRÍOS FANS 10 IN THE RAIN, TWINS LOSE:** The Twins lost to the White Sox last night by a score of 4-1 as the Sox evened the series at 1-1. José Berríos (7-3) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs (1 earned) on one hit in 7.0 innings pitched...Berríos struck out 10, marking the 11th time in his career with double-digit strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits compared to Chicago's three, marking the Twins' seventh loss this season (26-7) when out-hitting their opponent...Alex Kirilloff and Miguel Sanó each had multi-hit games, while Max Kepler had the lone extra-base hit with a second-inning double.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins announced today that they have returned right-handed pitcher Michael Pineda from rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Pineda, who has missed the Twins' last 19 games with right elbow inflammation, made one rehab start for Triple-A St. Paul last Thursday against Omaha, pitching 4.0 innings with four hits allowed, three walks and one strikeout...Pineda has made 11 starts this season, going 3-4, 3.70 ERA (56.0 IP, 23 ER), 15 walks, 51 strikeouts, a .230 opponent batting average and a 1.14 WHIP...to make room for Pineda on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Griffin Jax to Triple-A St. Paul...Jax appeared in five games and made one start for the Twins, going 1-1 with an 8.66 ERA (17.2 IP, 17 ER), eight walks and 14 strikeouts...he earned his first career win on June 25 vs. Cleveland with 4.1 innings of relief.

**TWINS AND SOX:** The Twins and White Sox are playing the 12th of 19 meetings this season...Twins are 2-9 against the Sox this season, going 2-3 at Target Field and 0-6 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Twins have been outscored by the White Sox this season 46-85.  
☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .396 (53-for-134) with 11 doubles, 14 home runs, 39 RBI, 19 walks, a .471 OBP, an .791 slugging percentage and a 1.262 OPS in 36 games vs. the Sox while in a Minnesota uniform (since 2019).  
☞ Miguel Sanó has 13 home runs and 26 RBI in 33 games vs. the Sox since the start of 2019...full list of home run leaders against the Sox since 2019 at bottom right.

**MIGGY TIME:** Miguel Sanó is hitting .357 (10-for-28) with three doubles, one home runs, two RBI, four walks, a .438 on-base percentage and a 1.009 OPS in his last nine games, including just seven strikeouts (32 total plate appearances)...in that span (since June 21), he ranks fourth in baseball in average exit velocity at 96.7 mph, trailing Yordan Alvarez (97.9), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (97.6) and Joey Gallo (96.8).

**MAX POWER:** Max Kepler enters today with a four-game hitting streak, matching a season-high, previously done from May 20-23...during the current streak he is hitting .333 (5-for-15) with one double, three home runs, four RBI, one walk and a 1.375 OPS.  
☞ Kepler's career-long for a hitting streak is 10, done twice, both in 2019.

**ARRAEZ TO THE TOP:** Luis Arraez is hitting .327 (53-for-162) with seven doubles, four triples, 14 RBI, 30 runs scored, 16 walks and a .390 on-base percentage at the leadoff spot...he leads the team with 40 starts out of that spot, including 10 of the Twins' last 14 games...among all American League players, he ranks first in batting average from the top spot in the lineup and second in on-base percentage, trailing the Angels' Justin Upton (.417).

**SUMMER CRUZ:** 2021 All-Star Nelson Cruz is hitting .362 (34-for-94) with six doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI, 14 walks, a .445 on-base percentage and a 1.126 OPS in 26 games since June 1...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in batting average, third in OBP and fifth in OPS (minimum 100 plate appearances).  
☞ Cruz's .288 batting average and .906 OPS in July are both his career-best of any month.

### RATED ROOKIES:

☞ Alex Kirilloff has hit safely in 21 of his last 25 games, hitting .298 (28-for-94) with five doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, five walks and an .808 OPS in that span (since June 4)...in that span he ranks second among all rookies in baseball in average and fifth in OPS.  
☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with one double, one home run, five RBI and a .937 OPS in his last six games.

**BIRTHDAY BOYS:** Twins radio studs Dan Gladden and Cory Provus are both celebrating their birthday today...the Twins are 21-36 all-time on their birthday, tied for fifth-fewest wins of any day in July...Twins communications intern Carter Martin is also celebrating his birthday today, as he turns 23...they all share a birthday with Gladden's former broadcast partner John Gordon (aka Wally Holland), comedian Jim Gaffigan and musician Ringo Starr.  
☞ Gladden appeared in five career games on his birthday, hitting .526 (10-for-19) with one double, four RBI, five runs scored and three three-hit games.

**WELCOME BACK WEEK:** With the Twins opening Target Field to full, 100 percent capacity, without restrictions, beginning Monday night, the club is celebrating a "Welcome Back Week" for its fans during this homestand that runs through Sunday...all seven games this week will feature some combination of a promotional giveaway, theme night or other special event.

☞ **Today - Student Day presented by Rasmussen University:** Returning today for the first time in 2021, Ballpark Access tickets are just \$5 for students, thanks to Rasmussen University...students can purchase tickets through the MLB Ballpark app; additionally, students can text "STUDENT" to 51655 to receive special Student Day offers...**Dollar-a-Dog Day:** Every Wednesday, hot dogs are just \$1 at the Hennepin Grille and Taste of Twins Territory concession stands.

- Recalled from his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul and activated from the 10-day Injured List today...will make his 12th start of the season, but first since June 13.
- Making the 160th start and appearance of career, and his 11th against the White Sox.
- Went 0-2, 7.94 ERA (11.1 IP, 10 ER) in his last three starts prior to landing on the IL with right elbow inflammation, after starting the season 3-2, 2.62 (44.2 IP, 13 ER) in his first eight outings.

**BIG MIKE RETURNS:** Pineda was returned from his rehabilitation assignment with Triple-A St. Paul and activated from the 10-day Injured List this morning...had been out since June 14 with right elbow inflammation, missing the Twins' last 19 games.

- "Big Mike" made one rehab start with the Saints, last Thursday (July 1) at CHS Field against Omaha...threw 75 pitches (45 for strikes) over 4.0-plus innings, allowing five runs (four earned) on four hits, with three walks and one strikeout...yielded four hits, two walks and all five runs in the span of his first 10 batters faced, then retired nine straight...was removed after issuing a leadoff walk in the fifth, and shouldered the 6-1 loss.

**LAST START PRIOR TO IL:** Big Mike threw just 64 pitches in a start June 13 vs. Houston at Target Field, exiting after 4.0 innings...yielded three runs on six hits (including a two-out, two-run homer to Kyle Tucker in the fourth), with a walk and a strikeout, and was the losing pitcher as the Astros rolled to a 14-3 victory...landed on the IL the next day.

**BIG MIKE'S 2021, PART ONE (A DOMINANT APRIL AND MAY):** Pineda enjoyed one of the best season-opening stretches of his career, going 3-2, 2.62 ERA (44.2 IP, 13 ER) over his first eight starts through May...allowed two-or-fewer runs in six of those efforts, while posting four quality starts.

- His **2.62 ERA through his first eight starts was the third-best mark to begin a season of his career**, behind the 2.09 ERA (43.0 IP, 10 ER) during his injury-interrupted 2014 campaign with the Yankees and the 2.45 mark (51.1 IP, 14 ER) of his 2011 rookie year with Seattle.
- Big Mike fashioned a 0.99 WHIP over that span, while compiling 47 strikeouts (9.47 K/9) against just 12 walks (3.92 K/BB ratio)...held opposing hitters to a .198 average (32-for-162), with a .251 on-base percentage, a .395 slugging mark and a .646 OPS.
- Was placed on the 10-day IL May 19 (retroactive to May 16) due to an abscess, but returned to toss 6.0 innings of three-hit, one-run ball in a 3-2 victory over Baltimore on May 26.

**BIG MIKE'S 2021, PART TWO (INJURIES & INEFFECTIVENESS LEAD TO ROUGH JUNE):** Although he made three turns through the rotation in June, Pineda struggled with injury and ineffectiveness, stumbling to an 0-2 mark with a 7.94 ERA (11.1 IP, 10 ER) as the Twins lost all three contests...has matched a career-worst stretch (second time) by failing to pitch at least 5.0 innings in three-straight starts within the same season (also done September 4-15 with the Yankees).

- In his three June starts, opponents went 17-for-51 (.333) off Pineda, with three doubles, one triple, one home run and three walks (.364 on-base percentage, .490 slugging and an .854 OPS)...Big Mike logged a 1.76 WHIP, while recording just four strikeouts (3.18 K/9 and a 1.33 K/BB ratio).
- Pineda's three June outings marked the first time in his career he struck out two-or-fewer batters in consecutive starts (1 on June 1 in Baltimore, 2 on June 8 vs. New York-AL and 1 on June 13 vs. Houston).
- Pineda's 3.0 innings pitched in his 7-4, June 1 loss at Baltimore was the shortest start of his Twins career...experienced right forearm soreness following the start and was given an extra day of rest before his June 8 outing vs. the Yankees (4.1 IP, 2 ER in a no-decision).

**MINNESOTA MIKE:** Big Mike has made 42 starts in a Minnesota uniform, going 16-9, 3.86 ERA (228.2 IP, 98 ER) with a 4.32 strikeout-to-walk ratio (216 K, 50 BB) and a 1.16 WHIP (215 hits)...the Twins are 25-17 (.595) when he tows the rubber.

- His 4.2 WAR (per Fangraphs) since 2019 is 16th among AL starters (min 220.0 IP).
- Beginning June 29, 2019, Pineda is 12-5, 3.22 ERA (148.0 IP, 52 ER), 36 walks, 149 strikeouts and a .234/.281/.382 opponent slash line over his last 27 starts (Minnesota is 17-10 in those games).

**SOUTH SIDE SUCCESS:** Since joining the Twins, Pineda is 4-1, 3.22 ERA (36.1 IP, 13 ER) in six starts vs. the White Sox (Minnesota is 5-1)...his lone loss came in a 4-2 setback opposite Lance Lynn on May 13 at Guaranteed Rate Field, a game in which Pineda allowed three runs on four hits (including solo homers to Tim Anderson and Jake Lamb) in 5.1 innings, with three walks and seven strikeouts.

- Is 1-0, 4.15 ERA (13.0 IP, 6 ER) vs. Chicago-AL here at Target Field...defeated the White Sox 14-4 on August 20, 2019 (7.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 0 BB, 4 K)...made his delayed 2020 season debut on September 1, but did not factor in the decision as the Twins eventually won, 3-2 (6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 4 K).
- Pineda is 5-4, 3.38 ERA (61.1 IP, 23 ER) in 10 career starts against the South Siders.

**HOME COOKING:** Pineda will make his ninth home start of the season in this afternoon's game...is 2-2, 3.16 ERA (42.2 IP, 15 ER) and a 1.03 WHIP over his first eight Target Field outings of 2021.

- Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in six of his eight home efforts this season, logging four quality starts...opponents are slashing just .214/.259/.403 off Big Mike at Target Field in 2021, going 34-for-159 with six doubles, eight home runs, 10 walks and 38 strikeouts.
- Is 6-5, 3.68 ERA (137.0 IP, 56 ER) in 25 career home starts with the Twins, including 5-3, 3.05 (106.1 IP, 36 ER) in his last 19 efforts.

**DAYTIME DRAMA:** When he takes the ball this afternoon, Pineda will make his ninth day start of the season (of 12 outings overall)...during his Twins tenure, Big Mike has actually pitched more under the sun (23 day starts) than under the lights (19 night starts).

- Pineda is 2-3, 3.09 ERA (43.2 IP, 15 ER) in his first eight day starts this year; 8-6, 3.67 (125.0 IP, 51 ER) as a Twin; and 21-19, 3.81 (363.1 IP, 154 ER) in 65 career starts under the sun.
- At night, Big Mike is 1-1, 5.84 ERA (12.1 IP, 8 ER) in 2021; 8-3, 4.08 (103.2 IP, 47 ER) with Minnesota and 35-31, 4.13 (545.1 IP, 250 ER) lifetime (94 starts).

**START 'EM WITH STRIKE ONE, THEN GET 'EM TO CHASE:** Pineda ranks sixth in the American League (min. 50.0 IP) by pouring in strike one at a 68.0 percent clip...he has also induced opposing batters to chase, in any count, 32.6 percent of the time to rank in the 90th percentile among all big league hurlers...for his career, Big Mike owns a 65.4 percent first-strike rate and a 33.4 percent chase rate.

**LAST BUT NOT LEAST:** Today marks Pineda's seventh start this season in a series finale (also April 4 at Milwaukee, April 15 vs. Boston, May 6 vs. Texas, May 13 at Chicago-AL, May 26 vs. Baltimore, June 13 vs. Houston)...he is 2-2, 2.43 ERA (33.1 IP, 9 ER) when wrapping up a set (Twins are 3-3).
