THE TWINS: The Twins began their seven-game homestand by going 1-2 against the White Sox, losing the final two games...tonight they will begin their final series before the All-Star break with the first of four against the Tigers...after this weekend, Major League Baseball will hold the All-Star Break in Colorado from July 12-15...the Twins have gone 18-25 at home this season and 17-25 on the road.

TWINS DROP RUBBER GAME TO SOX: The Twins lost to the White Sox on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 6-1...Michael Pineda (3-5) made his return from the Injured List (right elbow inflammation), allowing five runs on 12 hits in 5.1 innings pitched with no walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded six hits, two from both Luis Arraez and Jorge Polanco...Trevor Larnach drove in the Twins' only run with a solo home run in the fourth inning, his seventh homer of the season.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the sixth of 19 games in 2021...Twins have gone 3-2 this season with all five games coming at Comerica Park...their last series against Detroit came May 7-8 as they split 1-1 with the third game being postponed due to rain...the Twins have won nine of their last 12 over the Tigers, 14 of their last 20 and 17 of their last 24.

☞ Twins are 8-1 in their last nine against the Tigers at Target Field and are 14-4 in their last 18 here.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .302 (128-for-424) with 21 doubles, 26 home runs, 76 RBI, 48 walks, a .540 slugging percentage and a .915 OPS in 112 career games against the Tigers...his 26 home runs are the most among actives...since joining the Twins in 2019, he is hitting .365 (42-for-115) with four doubles, nine home runs, 23 RBI and a 1.044 OPS in 29 games vs. Detroit.

☞ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .336 (37-for-110) with eight doubles, one home run, 14 RBI, 14 walks, a .409 on-base percentage and an .846 OPS in 31 career games vs. the Tigers.

LUEY LEADOFF: Luis Arraez is hitting .331 (55-for-166) with eight doubles, four triples, 14 RBI, 30 runs scored, 16 walks and a .392 on-base percentage out of the leadoff spot...he leads the team with 41 starts out of that spot, including 11 of the Twins' last 15 games...among all American League players, he ranks first in batting average from the top spot in the lineup and second in on-base percentage, trailing the Angels' Justin Upton (.417).

SUMMER CRUZ: 2021 All-Star Nelson Cruz is hitting .357 (35-for-98) with six doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI, 14 walks, a .439 on-base percentage and a 1.102 OPS in 27 games since June 1...since that date, he ranks fifth in baseball in batting average and sixth in OBP and OPS (minimum 100 plate appearances).

☞ Cruz's .288 batting average and .904 OPS in July are both his career-best of any month.

THE BOOMSTICK: Nelson Cruz has eight home runs in his last 22 games, with his last coming on June 30 at Chicago-AL...he needs one to pass Carlos Beltrán and move into sole possession of 46th on baseball's all-time home run list:

TWINS AND SOUTHPAWS: The Twins are hitting .258 (253-for-979) with a .445 slugging percentage and a .761 OPS vs. lefties this season, compared to .239 (452-for-1894) with a .424 slugging and a .741 OPS against righties.

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs (42) against lefties...they also rank second in slugging percentage and eighth in OPS and batting average.

☞ Twins are facing a lefty for the 31st time this season, having gone 10-20 in games started by southpaws...they were 9-7 vs. lefty starters in 2020 and 22-17 in 2019.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .387 (36-for-93) with six doubles, six home runs and a 1.081 OPS vs. lefties this season...his average against lefties ranks second in all of baseball, trailing only Buster Posey (.393)...in his last 15 games vs. lefties, he is hitting .500 (17-for-34) with three doubles, three home runs, three walks and a 1.406 OPS.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2015, All-Star Glen Perkins converted his 28th-straight save opportunity, setting a club record, passing Joe Nathan's 27 straight (May 8-August 15, 2004)...it marked his 116th career save, tying Eddie Guardado for third on the Twins all-time list (Joe Nathan - 260, Rick Aguilera - 254)...Perkins finished his career with 120 saves and is now a Bally Sports North analyst.

LAST TIME OUT: Evened his season record at 4-4 after shouldering the loss from the Twins 4-7 defeat on July 2 at Kansas City...allowed six runs on a season-high-tying nine hits (2 HR) over 4.1 innings of work, with just one walk and four strikeouts...gave up a home run to Salvador Perez in the second, as well as a two-run homer to Hanser Alberto in the third...departed in the fifth inning in favor of Tyler Duffey.

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his fourth win and third quality start of the season on June 27 vs. Cleveland after allowing just two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings, with seven strikeouts and no walks...threw 100+ pitches in back-to-back starts for the first time since September 18-23, 2018...gave up a home run to catcher René Rivera in the sixth and departed in favor of Tyler Duffey...the Twins' bullpen threw 3.0 scoreless innings in relief, solidifying an 8-2 win.

DEFEATING DETROIT: Happ is making his 14th career appearance and 13th start vs. Detroit this evening...has gone 3-2, 4.87 ERA (67.0 IP, 37 ER), with 25 walks and 61 strikeouts over his previous 13 outings against the Tigers.

- ☞ Has faced Detroit once so far this season on April 6 at Comerica Park...he did not factor into the decision of the Twins 3-4 loss after allowing one run on three hits over 4.0 innings of work, with three walks and four strikeouts.
- ☞ Happ holds a record of 2-1, 5.53 ERA (27.2 IP, 38 H, 17 ER, 8 BB, 29 K) when facing Detroit as the home pitcher.
- ☞ Holds a record of 3-3 in nine starts against the AL Central this season.

LOW TRAFFIC: Since the beginning of the 2018 season, Happ has averaged 11.51 base runners-per-9.0 innings, 8th fewest in the American League and 25th fewest in the majors (min. 430.0 IP)...Happ has allowed the 10th-fewest total base runners (593) in the American League over that span (min. 430.0 IP).

- ☞ However, this season has allowed 13.86 base runners-per-9.0 innings (116 in just 75.1 IP).

RISP MANAGEMENT: Happ held opposing hitters to a .156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

- ☞ However, this season opposing hitters are 21-for-71 (.296) against Happ with RISP, far above his career .234 mark (349-for-1493).

A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB: Happ's start on April 13 vs. Boston was the 300th of his career...he is one of 11 active pitchers to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (477), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (436), Ervin Santana (386), Max Scherzer (384), Clayton Kershaw (372), Adam Wainwright (343), Johnny Cueto (322), David Price (314) and Madison Bumgarner (307).

- ☞ He has made at least 10 starts against 15 of 30 MLB teams.

PITCH SELECTION: This season Happ has featured five different pitches...he relies heavily on his four-seam fastball, throwing it more than half of the time...here is his 2021 repertoire, according to Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Ranks in the upper 56th percentile in baseball in fastball spin.
- ☞ He has allowed just 24 walks this season, ranking in the upper 67th percentile of BB% in baseball.

NIGHT AND DAY, HOME AND ROAD: Happ has made 14 starts so far this season, taking the mound nine times at night and six times during the day...during his nine starts under the lights, he is 1-4, 8.02 (4.2 IP, 38 ER) with 16 walks, 27 strikeouts and a .394 opponent on-base percentage...however, his numbers improve when the sun is up; during his six starts in the daytime, he is 3-0, 3.58 (32.2 IP, 13 ER) with eight walks, 32 strikeouts and a .273 opponent on-base percentage.

- ☞ Eight of his starts this season have come at Target Field and the other seven have come on the road...his numbers at home outshine his record on the road.
- ☞ He is 3-1, 4.32 (41.2 IP, 20 ER) with 15 walks, 28 strikeouts in eight home starts, while he is 1-3, 8.29 (33.2 IP, 31 ER) with nine walks, 31 strikeouts in seven starts on the road.

FANNED BY DOUBLE DIGITS: Happ fanned a season-high 10 batters in Cleveland on May 23, his 12th career game with double-digit strikeouts...became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history age 38-or-older with at least 10 strikeouts in a start since Connie Marrero (age 39.037) on June 1, 1950 (12.0 IP, 10 K)...also became the third to do so in nine innings-or-less, joining Johnny Niggeling, who did it twice: August 16, 1944 (8.0 IP, 11 K) and July 8, 1944 (9.0 IP, 10 K).

FRESH STARTS: Happ allowed just two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his first five starts to begin this season, the longest such streak to start a campaign in his career...however, is 2-4, 8.62 ERA (47.0 IP, 45 ER) in his last 10 starts (beginning May 12).

CAREER NOTES

- Ranks fourth among active left-handed pitchers in wins (127) and starts (313), while he is fifth in innings pitched (1816.2) and seventh in strikeouts (1598).
- Pitched a career best of 7.1 hitless innings on April 23, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh...left the game allowing only one hit over 7.1 innings...combined with Tyler Duffey and Taylor Rogers on the 19th one-hitter in Twins history.
- Made his 300th career start April 13, 2021 vs. Boston.
- In 2020, led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655)...did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
- Has made 12 Opening Day rosters with six teams: Philadelphia (2009-10), Houston (2011-12), Toronto (2013, '16-18), Seattle (2015), New York-AL (2019-20) and Minnesota (2021).
- Enters 2021 with 14 MLB seasons under his belt, with the Phillies (2007-10), Astros (2010-12), Blue Jays (2012-14, '16-18), Mariners (2015), Pirates (2015) and Yankees (2018-20).
- Made his 300th career major league appearance and 275th career start on June 23, 2019 vs. Houston.
- Compiled a career-best 19.1-inning scoreless streak from August 26-September 12-G1, 2019, the AL's eighth-longest scoreless streak in 2019 and longest by a Yankee.
- Finished sixth in 2016 AL Cy Young Award voting after going 20-4, 3.18 ERA for Toronto and tying for the second-most wins in baseball...marks his only career 20-win season and is one of just seven pitchers in the majors (and one of two southpaws) with a 20-win campaign in 2016.
- Finished second in 2009 BBWAA NL Rookie of the Year balloting to Florida's Chris Coghlan...appeared on all 32 ballots, receiving 10 first-place votes...won the 2009 Players' Choice Award for NL Outstanding Rookie...named 2009 NL Rookie of the Year by The Sporting News.
- Selected by Philadelphia in the third round of the 2004 First-Year Player Draft out of Northwestern University...debuted for the Phillies on June 30, 2007.
