THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-2 through four games on their seven-game homestand.
going 1-2 vs. the White Sox this week, followed by a win over the Tigers last nighttonight
they will continue their final homestand leading up to the breakafter this weekend, Major
League Baseball will hold the All-Star Break in Colorado from July 12-15the Twins have
gone 19-25 at home this season and 17-25 on the road.

TWINS TAKE TIGERS IN QUICK FASHION: The Twins beat the Tigers last night by a score of 5-3, scoring all five runs in innings 5-7...J.A. Happ (5-4) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on eight hits in 7.0 innings pitched - one out short of his season-high for innings (7.1, 4/23 vs. PIT)...the offense recorded six hits, two being home runs from Ryan Jeffers and Miguel Sanó...Jeffers' homer broke up Tarik Skubal's perfect game in the fifth inning...the game was played in 2 hours and 23 minutes, their second-fastest game of 2021 (2:17, 4/23 vs. PIT).

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the seventh of 19 games in 2021... Twins have gone 4-2 this season, going 1-0 at Target Field and 3-2 at Comerica Park...the Twins have won 10 of their last 13 over the Tigers, 15 of their last 21 and 18 of their last 25.

◆ Tonight marks the second of eight straight against the Tigers as the Twins will travel to Detroit after the All-Star Break for a four-game series at Comerica Park from July 16-18 with a doubleheader on the 16th

with a doubleheader on the 16th.

Twins are 9-1 in their last 10 against the Tigers at Target Field and are 15-4 in their last 19 here.

Relson Cruz is hitting .299 (128-for-428) with 21 doubles, 26 home runs, 76 RBI, 48 walks, a .535 slugging percentage and a .906 OPS in 113 career games against the Tigers...his 26 home runs are the most among actives...since joining the Twins in 2019, he is hitting .353 (42-for-119) with four doubles, nine home runs, 23 RBI and a 1.010 OPS in 30 games vs. Detroit.

Andrelton Simmons is hitting .330 (37-for-112) with eight doubles, one home run, 14 RBI, 14 walks, a .403 on-base percentage and an .832 OPS in 32 career games vs. the Tigers.

LUEY LEADOFF: Luis Arraez is hitting .331 (55-for-166) with eight doubles, four triples, 14 RBI, 30 runs scored, 16 walks and a .392 on-base percentage out of the leadoff spot...he leads the team with 41 starts out of that spot, including 11 of the Twins' last 16 games...among all American League players, he ranks first in batting average from the top spot in the lineup and second in on-base percentage, trailing the Angels' Justin Upton (.417).

KEPLER HEATING: Max Kepler has reached base safely in eight-straight games, hitting .296 (8-for-27) with two doubles, three home runs, five RBI, four walks, a .387 on-base percentage and a 1.091 OPS in that span.

FOR STARTERS: The last full time through the rotation (beginning with Kenta Maeda's start on July 4 at Kansas City), Twins starters have gone 3-2, 2.67 ERA (30.1 IP, 9 ER) with just two home runs allowed, eight walks, 39 strikeouts and a .227 opponent batting average.

MIGGY TIME: Miguel Sanó is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with three doubles, two home runs, three RBI, four walks, a .405 on-base percentage and a 1.011 OPS in his last 11 games, including just eight strikeouts (37 total plate appearances)...in that span (since June 21), he ranks fourth in baseball in average exit velocity at 96.7 mph, trailing Yordan Alvarez (98.1), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (97.7) and Joey Gallo (97.4).

YOUTH MOVEMENT: A pair of rookie numbers since June 4.

₱ Alex Kirilloff has hit safely in 21 of his last 26 games, hitting .289 (28-for-97) with five doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, six walks and an .790 OPS in that span...since June 4, he ranks third among all rookies in baseball in average and fifth in OPS.

₱ Trevor Larnach has hit safely in 20 of his last 28 games, hitting .287 (29-for-101) with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI and an .800 OPS in that span...since June 4, he ranks fifth in both batting average and OPS among MLB rookies.

LAST TIME OUT: Maeda earned his fourth win of the season in his last start on July 4 at Kansas City, setting the tone for the Twins in a 6-2 win...permitted just three base runners (2 hits, 1 walk) over 6.0 shutout innings, with 10 strikeouts — his seventh career game with 10-plus strikeouts, first since August 18, 2020 vs. Milwaukee (12 K) and first-ever against an American League team... the outing also marked just his second quality start of the season (also, April 7 at Detroit), as well as the third start this year in which he did not allow an extra-base hit (also, May 3 vs. Texas and April 1 at Milwaukee)

 Ф Maeda's start was his fourth career outing of at least 6.0 innings with two-or-fewer hits allowed and at least 10 strikeouts, joining his performances on August 18, 2020 vs. Milwaukee (8.0 IP, 1 H, 12 K); May 23, 2018 vs. Colorado (6.2 IP, 2 H, 12 K); and July 10, 2016 vs. San Diego (7.0 IP, 2 H, 13 K).

START PRIOR: Shouldered his third loss of the season on June 29 at Chicago-AL, yielding seven runs on eight hits, with five walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work in an eventual 7-6 Twins loss... matched his career highs with five walks (2nd time, last done on June 19, 2018 at Chicago-NL) and seven earned runs allowed (3rd time, last done on April 21 at Oakland)...walked the bases loaded in the opening frame, the fifth time in his career that he's walked three batters in an inning and second this season (also, bottom 1st, June 14 at Seattle)...pitched out of the jam with only one run allowed and worked scoreless second and fourth frames, but yielded two more runs in the third and three in the fifth before departing with one on, two out (1 additional run scored off Danny Coulombe).

TIGER KING: Is 2-2, 4.50 ERA (30.0 IP, 15 ER), two walks, 38 strikeouts and a .214 opponent batting average (24-for-112) in five career starts against the Tigers...last faced Detroit on April 7 at Comerica Park, earning the win in a quality start after allowing two runs on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings, as the Twins won 3-2...was slated to start on Sunday, May 9 in Detroit (Mother's Day) but the game was postponed due to inclement weather.

The Has won each of his last two starts against the Tigers, dating back to September 23, 2020... has a 3.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 5 ER), one walk, 15 strikeouts and a .244 (11-for-45) opponent batting average in that span.

◆ Four of his five career starts against Detroit have been quality, and he allowed just four earned runs in 6.0 innings in the lone non-quality start...has also fanned seven-or-more batters in four of the five starts, and struck out six batters in his other start.

◆ Is 1-0, 4.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 6 ER) with one walk, 17 strikeouts and a .140 opponent batting average (6-for-43) in two career starts against the Tigers at Target Field.

CENTRAL-FUGAL FORCE: Maeda is 2-2, 5.29 ERA (32.1 IP, 19 ER), 10 walks, 32 strikeouts and a .254 (31-for-122) opponent batting average in six starts against the AL Central so far this season...went 5-1, 2.74 ERA (46.0 IP, 14 ER) in eight starts against the AL Central last season...is 10-4, 3.62 ERA (99.1 IP, 40 ER) in 18 career starts vs. the division, marking his second-best career ERA against any single division (NL East - 3.11 ERA).

COMFORTS OF HOME: Just three of Maeda's 13 starts so far this season have come at home, and he's 1-1, 3.29 ERA (13.2 IP, 5 ER), five walks and 15 strikeouts in those starts...this compares to 3-2, 5.51 ERA (49.0 IP, 30 ER) in 10 starts away from Target Field this season.

◆ Is 4-1, 2.31 ERA (46.2 IP, 12 ER) with 11 walks, 57 strikeouts and a .175 opponent batting average (29-for-166) in eight career starts at Target Field.

MILESTONE MAN: Maeda surpassed two career milestones in his start against the Mariners in Seattle on June 14...at the end of his second inning of work he reached 700 career MLB innings, becoming the 10th Japanese-born pitcher to hit that plateau in the majors...the others are: Hideo Nomo (1,976.1 IP), Hiroki Kuroda (1,319.0 IP), Yu Darvish (1,232.0 IP), Tomo Ohka (1,070.0 IP), Masahiro Tanaka (1,054.1 IP), Hisashi Iwakuma (883.2 IP), Daisuke Matsuzaka (790.1 IP), Masato Yoshii (757.1 IP) and Shigetoshi Hasegawa (720.1 IP)...additionally, Maeda's strikeout of Shed Long Jr. in the fourth inning on June 14 was the 2,000th of his career...he now has 2,018 strikeouts combined between Nippon Professional Baseball (1,233) and Major League Baseball (785).

© Maeda's seven career games with 10-plus strikeouts are fourth most among Japanese-born pitchers in major league history, behind Darvish (46), Nomo (31) and Tanaka (14).

2021 ARSENAL: Maeda's slider has surpassed his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch over the last several seasons...he threw them equally in his rookie 2016 campaign and his four-seamer was his most frequent offering from 2017-19...however, his slider has been his top pitch since the start of 2020, followed by his split finger—here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:

OPPOSING COUNTS: Opponents are hitting .419 (13-for-31) off Maeda's first offering of an at-bat... his opponent batting average on the first pitch is tied for 13th highest among American League pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats).

◆ Opponents are batting .206 (27-for-131) off Maeda with two strikes, far above the .087 (13-for-150) mark he held them to in 2020 and his career mark of .148 (230-for-1558)...the league average mark this season with two strikes is .163.

◆ When the count goes full, Maeda is holding opposing hitters to just 3-for-26 (.115), tied for the eighth-lowest mark among American League pitchers (min. 25 opp. at-bats).

NOT TOO HARD: Per Baseball Savant, Maeda's 24.7 hard hit percent in 2020 was the second lowest among qualified MLB pitchers, behind only Atlanta's Max Fried (23.8)...held opponents to an 85.3 average exit velocity, fourth lowest among qualifiers last season.

This season, however, Maeda has allowed a 38.9 hard hit percent through 13 starts, far above his 2020 mark and above his career mark of 29.0 percent...additionally, his soft contact percent (per Fangraphs) is down to 21.7 percent, below the career-best mark of 28.5 percent that he
