THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 2-5 (1-3 against the Angels and 1-2 against the Tigers), the Twins began their roadtrip by splitting their first two games in St. Louis...today they will continue the trip with the three-game series finale against the Cardinals...they will enjoy a day off tomorrow then play two games in Cincinnati on Tuesday and Wednesday, followed by four games in Houston from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 24-30 at home this season and 20-31 on the road.

TWINS EVEN OUT THE SERIES IN ST. LOUIS: The Twins beat the Cardinals last night at Busch Stadium by a score of 8-1...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, two from both Jorge Polanco and Miguel Sanó...Ryan Jeffers hit his ninth home run, marking his third in his last two games.

☞ The Twins had 10 players with a hit in last night's game, matching their season high also done on April 8 vs. Seattle and June 10 vs. New York-AL...prior to last night, the last time the Twins had at least 10 different players with a hit in a road game was May 18, 2019 at Seattle (also 10) and last time this feat occurred in an Interleague game for the Twins was September 12, 2017 vs. San Diego (11 different players with a hit).

☞ Bailey Ober became the first Twins pitcher with a hit in his first career plate appearance since José Berríos singled off Bartolo Colon on September 16, 2016 in his first career trip to the plate...Ober also became the tallest player in Twins/Senators history to record a hit.

NATIONAL TREASURE: The Twins have gone 5-5 in Interleague Play this season, going 2-1 at Milwaukee from April 1-4, 1-2 vs. Pittsburgh from April 23-25, 1-1 vs. Cincinnati from June 21-22 and 1-1 vs. St. Louis this weekend...after this series, their IL schedule is as follows: two at Cincinnati August 3-4, three vs. Milwaukee August 27-29, two vs. Chicago-NL August 31-September 1 and two at Chicago-NL September 21-22.

☞ Twins are 237-215 all-time in IL Play, the fifth-most wins in baseball, trailing Boston (274-184), New York-AL (267-189), Los Angeles-AL (251-206) and Oakland (247-212).

☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .310 (153-for-493) with 27 doubles, 31 home runs, 98 RBI, 98 runs scored and a .959 OPS in 135 career IL games...his IL average ranks seventh among actives (minimum 300 plate appearances)...in his last 20 IL games, he is hitting .350 (21-for-60) with a 1.114 OPS, six doubles, five home runs and 17 RBI.

MAX POWER: Max Kepler has four home runs in his last 11 games...he is four away from tying Eddie Rosario for 15th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

TWINS AND BIRDS: Twins and Cardinals are playing each other for the final time this season...prior to this season, the Twins played the Cardinals for four games in 2020, going 2-0 at Target Field July 28-29 and 1-1 at Busch Stadium in a doubleheader on September 8...Twins are 17-15 all-time against St. Louis in the regular season (since 1997) and 9-3 in their last 12...they were 2-7 all-time in the regular season at the old Busch Stadium (1997-2001) and are 6-5 all-time at the new Busch Stadium (2009-21).
☞ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .384 (28-for-73) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI and an .893 OPS in 20 career games vs. the Cardinals.

ALL ABOUT MIGGY: Miguel Sanó has reached base multiple times in each of his last five games, tied for the fourth-longest such streak of his career and his longest since doing so in six-straight games from August 18-23, 2020...he owns a .560 on-base percentage in his last five games...he's also batting .303 (10-for-33) with four doubles, two home runs, six RBI, eight runs scored, eight walks, a .439 on-base percentage and a 1.045 OPS in his last nine games...his on-base percentage in that span (since July 22) is second in the American League and seventh in the majors (min. 40 plate appearances).

☞ Sanó's fifth-inning single off T.J. McFarland last night had an exit velocity of 117.1 MPH, the hardest-hit ball by a Twin in the Statcast Era (2015-present).

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: The Twins have named Single-A Cedar Rapids infielder/outfielder Michael Helman and Single-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Ben Gross the minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Helman played in seven games for theernels, hitting .423 (11-for-26) with one double, one triple, two home runs, three RBI, four walks and a 1.269 OPS...the 25-year-old was drafted by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas A&M.
☞ Gross started two games for the kernels, allowing two runs on seven hits in 10.2 innings pitched, posting a 1.69 ERA and holding opponents to a .184 batting average...the 24-year-old was drafted by the Twins in the 10th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Duke University.

THIS AND THAT:

☞ Williams Astudillo is batting .438 (7-for-16) with one double, one homer, two RBI and one run scored in six Interleague games this season.
☞ Ryan Jeffers has nine RBI across his last two games...he's the first Twins catcher with at least three RBI in consecutive games with an at-bat since Joe Mauer did so from April 15-16, 2013.

SECOND HALF SUCCESS: Pineda is 1-0, 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP, 3 ER), one walk, nine strikeouts and a .220/.238/.390 opponent slash line (9-for-41 with 4 doubles and 1 home run) in two starts since the All-Star Break...marks a return to form for "Big Mike," after he stumbled to an 0-3 mark with an 8.10 ERA (16.2 IP, 15 ER), three walks, eight strikeouts and a .387/.405/.627 opponent slash line (29-for-75 with 8 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs) in four starts from June 1-July 7.

LAST TIME OUT: "Big Mike" last took the mound July 26 vs. Detroit at Target Field and turned in his first quality start in exactly two months, limiting the Tigers to two runs (both on a Miguel Cabrera two-run homer in the sixth) on five hits over 6.0 innings in a game the Twins eventually won, 6-5 in 10 innings...did not walk a batter, while striking out six (his most since fanning 8 on May 26 vs. Baltimore).

- Blanked Detroit on three hits over the first 5.0 frames and retired 11 in a row before Jonathan Schoop singled with two outs in the sixth, immediately preceding Cabrera's homer.
- Departed with a 5-2 lead, but did not factor in the decision...the Tigers rallied with a pair of homers off Minnesota's bullpen to force extra innings, before Max Kepler delivered the walk-off winner for the Twins in the bottom of the 10th.

START PRIOR: Pitching for the first time in 13 days, Pineda snapped a career-high-tying three-game losing streak, and a stretch of four-straight Twins losses in his starts, with a 7-2 victory July 21 at Chicago-AL...allowed one run on four hits, with one walk and three strikeouts, over 5.0 strong innings...departed with a 3-1 lead, before the Twins broke it open on Jorge Polanco's two-out, three-run homer in the sixth.

MINNESOTA MIKE: Pineda has made 45 starts in a Minnesota uniform, going 17-10, 3.89 ERA (245.0 IP, 106 ER) with a 4.49 strikeout-to-walk ratio (229 K, 51 BB) and a 1.17 WHIP (236 hits)...the Twins are 27-18 (.600) when he toes the rubber.

- Big Mike's personal winning percentage (.630), team winning percentage, ERA, strikeout-to-walk ratio and WHIP with the Twins are all better than his overall career numbers: A personal .528 winning percentage (57-51) and a .525 team ledger (85-77) in 162 starts, with a 4.01 ERA (925.0 IP, 412 ER), 4.40 strikeout-to-walk ratio (916 K, 208 BB) and a 1.18 WHIP (888 hits).
- His 4.6 WAR (per Fangraphs) since 2019 is 14th among AL starters (min 240.0 IP).

SENIOR CIRCUIT SUCCESS: Pineda, who has spent his entire career in the American League, has gone 10-5, 2.98 ERA (123.2 IP, 41 ER) in 22 career Interleague starts.

- National League hitters have managed just a .219 batting average (100-for-457) off Pineda, with a .616 OPS.
- Has posted a 5-1 mark, 2.24 ERA (56.1 IP, 14 ER) in 10 career Interleague road starts.
- He is 3-2, 3.05 ERA (41.1 IP, 14 ER) in eight Interleague starts with the Twins, including 1-1, 3.86 (9.1 IP, 4 ER) in two 2021 efforts...won his 2021 debut April 4 at Milwaukee after allowing one unearned run in 5.0 innings...was tagged by Pittsburgh with a 6-2 loss April 24 at Target Field (4.1 IP, 6 H, 5 R/4 ER, 1 BB, 5 K).

BIG MIKE AT THE BAT: Pineda is 2-for-17 (.118) with no walks, eight strikeouts and one sacrifice in nine career games as a hitter...he went 0-for-2 with a strikeout and a GIDP on April 4 in Milwaukee.

- His two career hits came nearly six years apart—a single on June 23, 2011 at Washington (with Seattle) and a single on May 5, 2017 at Chicago-NL (with New York-AL).

RARE BIRD: Big Mike will make just his second career start vs. St. Louis today, and first at Busch Stadium...in his lone prior outing, he limited the Cardinals to two runs on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts, over 7.0 innings to earn a 9-3 win on April 16, 2017 at Yankee Stadium.

ROAD LESS TRAVELED: Pineda will pitch on the road for just the fifth time in 2021...has gone 2-2, 4.42 ERA (18.1 IP, 9 ER) in his first four road starts this season, as compared to 2-3, 3.67 (54.0 IP, 22 ER) in 10 starts at Target Field.

START 'EM WITH STRIKE ONE, THEN GET 'EM TO CHASE: Pineda ranks 12th in the American League (min. 70.0 IP) by pouring in strike one at a 66.6 percent clip...he has also induced opposing batters to chase, in any count, 34.0 percent of the time to rank in the 94th percentile among all big league hurlers...for his career, Big Mike owns a 65.4 percent first-strike rate and a 33.5 percent chase rate.

2021 ARSENAL: Below is a breakdown of Pineda's 2021 three-pitch repertoire, according to Baseball Savant, which follows a similar pattern to what he featured in 2020.

- Since his first start of the 2020 season, opponents are hitting .167 (22-for-131) with 53 strikeouts against Pineda's slider.
- In two-and-a-half seasons with the Twins, he has used his four-seam fastball more than half the time (53.7% in 2021, 50.1% in 2020, 54.1% in 2019)...after a career-high 59.5% use rate as a Mariners rookie, he never topped 47.7% as a Yankee.

TUESDAY'S STARTER - RHP KENTA MAEDA [2021 SEASON: 4-4, 4.40 ERA // CAREER: 57-40, 3.82 ERA]

Maeda is scheduled to start Tuesday night in the opener of a two-game series in Cincinnati...is 1-1, 2.15 ERA (29.1 IP, 7 ER), six walks and 36 strikeouts over his last five starts, while holding opposing batters to a .176/.229/.294 slash line (18-for-102 with 4 2B, 1 3B and 2 HR)...last pitched on July 27 vs. Detroit at Target Field, turning in his second-straight quality start (6.1 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 5 K)...departed with a 5-1 lead, only to see the Tigers rally off the Twins' pen for a 6-5, 11-inning win...his lone Interleague start this season came in a no-decision on Opening Day in Milwaukee...is 1-0, 2.52 ERA (25.0 IP, 7 ER) in four IL starts with the Twins and 7-7, 4.13 (106.2 IP, 49 ER) in 23 career IL games (19 starts)...made four appearances (3 starts) vs. Cincinnati while with the Dodgers, going 2-1, 3.54 ERA (20.1 IP, 8 ER) and one save (on June 9, 2017 at Dodger Stadium)...won as a starter in his lone career outing at Great American Ball Park on June 18, 2017.
