LAST TIME OUT: Jax's last start came on Thursday, August 5 in the Twins' series opener in Houston, a 5-3 Minnesota win...limited the potent Astros offense to one run on three hits, with one walk and
no strikeouts in a career-high 5.1 innings of work retired 13 batters in a row from the first through no strikeouts in a career-high 1 Innings of work...retired Ma batters in a row trom the tirst through the sixth inning in a start for the first time in his major league career, and the lone run he yielded on the night came on a Jason Castro solo homer to lead off that frame...departed with one out in the sixth after allowing a double to Chas McCormick; Caleb Thielbar stranded the runner.

After allowing six earned runs in his tirst career start on July 3 at Kansas City, has permitted just
three runs on six hits $(3$ singles 1 do three runs on six hits (3 singles, 1 double, 2 homers), with four walks and eight strikeouts in 14.1 innings combined across his last three starts.... owns a 1.88 ERA and .122 opponent batting average ( 6 -for-49) in that span.

START PRIOR: Jax started on July 30 in St. Louis, as he took a no-decision in the Twins' 5 -1 loss to the Cardinals....worked a career-high-tying 5.0 innings, allowing one run on two hits, with two walks and two strikeouts...allowed a base runner in each of the first three innings but didn't yield a run
until the fourth, when Tyler 0 'Neil scored on Harrison Bader's sacrifice fly...lsso went 0 -for-2 with a strikeout at the ' late...departed after completing 5.0 innings with the score tied $1-1$; St. Louis scored thrice in the sixth inning and once more in the seventh to win 5-1.
CENTRAL COMMAND: Jax is due to make his second career start and appearance against the White Sox tonight...started the first game of the July 19 doubleheader in Chicago, working 4.0 strong inbatter and fanned a career-high-tying six, ancluding striking out the side in the first inning anter Anderson reached on an error...departed with a blister issue after completing 4.0 innings, as the Twins ultimately prevailed, winning $3-2$ in extra innings.
$\Phi$ Tonight also marks his fourth career appearance and third start against the American League Central division, and he's 1 -1, 6.75 ERA (13.1 IP 10 ER) with six waiks and 11 strikeouts in his prior outings...six of the earned runs he's yielded to the division came in his start on July 3 at Kansas.. City, and he's permitted just three runs (June 25 vs. CLE, relief) and one
run (July 19 at CWS, start) in his other two outings.

EARLY DOMINANCE: Jax is holding opposing hitters to just 4-for-45 (.089) combined in innings one through three so far in his career....he hasn't fared as well when tasked with pitching in the middle imnings of games, as opponents are batting . 302 (16-for-53) against him in innings four through six, including a 7 -for-20 $(.350)$ mark in the fourth inning alone.
LOTS OF LOVE FOR THE LEFTIES: Jax has held left-handed batters to a 125 ( 6 -for--48) batting average, with two doubles, two homers, six walks and nine strikeouts so far in his major league career...this compares to the . 306 (22-for-72) batting average that right-handed batters have posted against him.

BIG LEAGUE BREAKDOWN: Jax is in his fourth stint with the Twins this season, after being with the club from June $5-15$, June $24-$-July 7 and on July 19 as the 27th man for the doubleheader...the 26-year-old has appeared four times out of the bullpen, including his June 8 major league debut, and Hade four starts, on July 3 at Kansas City July 19 at Chicago-AL. July 30 at St. Louis and August 5 at
