THE TWINS: After completing their season-long nine-game roadtrip with a record of 5-4 (1-2 in St. Louis, 1-1 in Cincinnati and 3-1 in Houston), the Twins began their season-long nine-game homestand by splitting the first two games over the last two nights...today they will play the final game against the Sox in 2021...the Twins will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then play three against Nelson Cruz and the Rays this weekend, followed by three against the Indians from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have gone 25-31 at home this season and 24-34 on the road.
 ☞ Twins are 5-10 in rubber games this season and 9-22-6 in series play (4-12-1 at home).

GRIFFIN JAX AND TORTUGA JACKS: The Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 4-3, evening the series at one game apiece...Griffin Jax (3-1) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and a career-high 10 strikeouts...he became the 10th rookie in club history (since 1961) to record double-digit strikeouts and first since Trevor May on September 14, 2014 at Chicago-AL (10)...also marked the fifth time this season a Twins starter recorded 10-plus K's...the offense recorded six hits, highlighted by a Willians Astudillo sixth-inning two-run go-ahead home run.

LOG ON, LOG IN: Today's game can be seen on YouTube...it marks the second time the Twins played on YouTube this season; the other came on April 28 at Cleveland, winning by a score of 10-2, highlighted by a Byron Buxton 5-for-5 day with 10 total bases (1 home run, 2 doubles, 2 singles)...he earned YouTube Player of the Game and was awarded with a trophy postgame.

DAY MAN, FIGHTER OF THE NIGHT MAN: The Twins are playing their 55th day game of the season today...their 54 day games lead baseball...they have gone 22-32 during the day, tied for seventh-most day wins in the American League and tied for 13th most in baseball.
 ☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .340 (49-for-144) with seven doubles, 20 walks and a .422 on-base percentage in 41 day games this season...his day OBP ranks third in the AL while his batting average ranks fourth.

ADDITIONALLY: Polanco has 11 home runs since July 1, tied with Toronto's George Springer and Seattle's Kyle Seager for most in the AL since that date.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: In their last eight games (since August 3), the Twins bullpen has combined to go 2-0-4, 2.94 ERA (33.2 IP, 11 ER) with 12 walks, 35 strikeouts, a .200 opponent batting average and an opponent OPS of .612.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the final of 19 meetings this season...Twins are 5-13 against the Sox in 2021, going 3-5 at Target Field and 2-8 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Twins have been outscored by the Sox this season 70-123 (-53).
 ☞ Max Kepler (15), former Twin Nelson Cruz (15) and Miguel Sanó (14) hold the top three spots in home runs against the White Sox since the start of 2019.
 ☞ The Twins have hit 82 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019, ahead of second place Cleveland's 53.

ARRAEZ AND SHINE: Luis Arraez has hit safely in 21 of his last 23 games, hitting .423 (33-for-78) in that span, the best in baseball since July 4 (minimum 70 plate appearances)...he is 13-for-31 (.419) with three doubles and four walks in 10 games since being reinstated from the 10-day Injured List on July 31.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2001, Doug Mientkiewicz made all three putouts in the bottom of the second inning without touching first base...Tampa Bay had Toby Hall on third base and Randy Winn on first with no outs in the inning when Aubrey Huff hit a weak grounder to Mientkiewicz...the first baseman crossed the diamond to chase Hall back to third, then tagged out Winn who had run all the way around from first...Mientkiewicz then caught Hall wandering off the base to complete an unassisted double play...the next Rays hitter, Jared Sandberg, hit a foul pop-up that Mientkiewicz caught for the third out...in 2008, Ron Gardenhire earned his 600th managerial win in a 4-0 defeat of New York-AL at the Metrodome...Glen Perkins was the starter and winner that day, pitching 8.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed.

LAST START: Ober did not factor into the decision last Friday night in Houston, an eventual 5-4, 11-inning Twins win in the second of four games at Minute Maid Park...

Has a 3.77 ERA (14.1 IP, 6 ER) in his last three starts, after allowing seven earned runs in 8.1 innings pitched (7.56 ERA) in the prior two.

START PRIOR: Bailey also had a no-decision in the Twins' 8-1 victory in St. Louis on July 31 after allowing just one run on four hits over 4.0 innings of work...

FAMILIAR FOE: Today marks the fifth start of Ober's rookie campaign against Chicago-AL, far and away the most oft-faced opponent of his young career...

- Made his major league debut May 18 opposite Lance Lynn and Chicago-AL here at Target Field, allowing four runs on five hits in 4.0 innings (Twins rallied to win in walk-off fashion, 5-4).
Picked up his first big league victory over the White Sox on July 5 at Target Field...tossed 5.0 innings of two-hit, shutout ball, with a career-high seven strikeouts, before the Twins held on for an 8-5 victory...the start also marked his last decision overall...
Is 1-0, 2.70 ERA (10.0 IP, 3 ER) in his last two starts vs. the White Sox, after going 0-1, 11.05 (7.1 IP, 9 ER) in his first two.

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first 12 career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .188 batting average (3-for-16) with runners in scoring position and two outs...

2021 ARSENAL: Here's a look at the rookie's repertoire, per Baseball Savant. PITCH (AVG, MPH) PCT. (# vs. RHB/LHB) RESULTS

Ranks in the upper 75th percentile with a 30.4 chase rate.

LOW TRAFFIC: Ober struck out 100 batters and walked just nine in 2019, good for an MLB-best 11.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min. 75.0 IP)...that season, he also ranked second in the minors in WHIP (0.81) and base runners-per-9.0 IP (7.55), and was fifth in walks-per-9.0 IP (1.03).

In 12 MLB starts this season, Ober has allowed 69 total base-runners in 52.1 innings, good for an 11.87 base-runners-per-9.0 IP ratio...he's also averaging 2.58 walks-per-9.0 IP while averaging 9.63 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP...he has walked just 15 batters compared to 56 strikeouts, recording a 3.73 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Ober is one of seven players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of three pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2), RHP Griffin Jax (June 8) and LHP Charlie Barnes (July 17).

SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average (13-for-60)...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints' fifth game on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run scored on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work...took the ball again on May 13 vs. Iowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision...earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at Iowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none and fanning five as the Saints exploded for 17 runs en route to a 17-0 rout of the I-Cubs...his other start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, fanning a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep.

CAREER REDUX: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a .222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances (35 starts) from 2017-21...was added to the Twins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020...spent part of the off-season working out in Colorado with fellow Twins staffmate Taylor Rogers and last night's pitcher Griffin Jax.

- Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).
Over that same time span, Ober ranks fourth by allowing just 8.79 base runners-per-9.0 innings, fourth by walking just 1.18 batters-per-9.0-innings and sixth in WHIP (0.96).

SKOL TWINS: Ober attended Charlotte Christian School in Charlotte, North Carolina, where he was batterymates on the baseball team and friends with Vikings center Garrett Bradbury...Bradbury had just arrived in the Twin Cities for OTAs at the time of Ober's debut on May 18, and attended the game with his wife, Carson...Carson is also the older sister of Kansas City Royals No. 4 prospect Jackson Kowar.

#82 IN YOUR PROGRAMS, #1 IN YOUR HEART: Ober is the first player in Twins history to wear uniform number 82...former hitting coach James Rowson is the only other uniformed personnel to wear #82, doing so while presiding over 2019's "Bomba Squad."

FRIDAY'S STARTER - RHP MICHAEL PINEDA [2021 SEASON: 4-7, 3.83 ERA // CAREER: 57-53, 4.00 ERA]

Pineda is set to take the mound Friday in the series opener against Tampa Bay...has fashioned a 3.00 ERA (21.0 IP, 7 ER) in four starts (including two quality starts) since the All-Star Break, despite going 1-2...was saddled with the 4-0 loss last Saturday in Houston, despite allowing two runs in 6.0 innings while recording his sixth quality start...will make his first start against the Rays since April 10, 2017 at Yankee Stadium...is 3-5, 4.31 ERA (79.1 IP, 38 ER) in 14 career starts vs. Tampa Bay...is 2-3, 3.67 ERA (54.0 IP, 22 ER) in 10 starts this season at Target Field, with five quality starts.

- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of CenturyLink Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, Single-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
Named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week for Fort Myers on April 14 and Southern League Pitcher of the Week for Pensacola on September 2.
Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for theernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston for the 2017 season.
Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John Surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
