THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 3-2 through five games on their season-long, nine-game homestand, going 2-1 against the White Sox, followed by a split of the first two games with the Rays over the last two nights...today they will play the three-game series finale with Tampa Bay before welcoming in Cleveland for three from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have gone 27-32 at home this season and 24-34 on the road.

☞ The Twins have gone 6-10 in rubber games this season.

TWINS STING THE RAYS WITH A DOZEN: The Twins beat the Rays at Target Field last night by a score of 12-0 while celebrating the 30th Anniversary of the 1991 World Series Champions...the win marked their largest margin of victory in a shutout since beating San Diego by a score of 16-0 on September 12, 2017...Kenta Maeda (6-4) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, one walk and four strikeouts...Ralph Garza Jr. made his Twins debut, pitching 2.0 perfect innings of relief...the offense recorded 16 hits, tied for their second most this season (18 on April 21 at Oakland)...six different Twins had multiple hits...Brent Rooker, Luis Arraez, Ryan Jeffers and Max Kepler each homered as Kepler's was the 12th leadoff shot of his career, tying Dan Gladden for fourth on the club's all-time leadoff home run list.

TWINS-RAYS: The Twins and Rays are playing for the third of six scheduled meetings in 2021...they will visit Tropicana Field for three games from September 3-5...the Twins have won nine of their last 13 over the Rays dating back to July of 2018.

☞ Twins are looking to win their third-consecutive series over Tampa Bay, dating back to May of 2019...it will mark their longest series-win streak against Tampa since taking five straight from July of 2004-September of 2006.

☞ Twins are 81-83 all-time against the Rays...they went 44-29 over Tampa from 1998-2006 and have since gone 37-54 since 2007.

☞ Twins were 31-17 against the Rays in the Metrodome and are 14-24 at Target Field.

☞ Luis Arraez is 8-for-17 (.471) with two walks in four career games against Tampa Bay.

☞ **DID YOU KNOW:** When Rocco Baldelli was a Devil Ray, he played in 33 career games against the Twins, hitting .277 (36-for-130) with eight doubles, one triple, four home runs and 22 RBI with a .755 OPS...Rocco hit his first career home run at the Metrodome on April 30, 2003 off Brad Radke and finished the day with a career-high five RBI...he hit his only career grand slam also at the Dome on July 22, 2004 off Juan Rincon.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Twins are looking to win their 11th series of the season...they have gone 10-22-6 in series play this season, 5-12-1 at home and 5-10-5 on the road...they enter today having won each of their last two series, both against first place teams: last Thursday-Sunday at Houston (3-1) and this past Monday-Wednesday vs. Chicago-AL (2-1)...the last time they won three-consecutive series came in 2020: August 15-17 vs. Kansas City (3-1), August 18-20 vs. Milwaukee (2-1) and August 21-23 at Kansas City (2-1).

MIGGY, THE MAN ON BASE: Miguel Sanó has reached base in 16 of his last 17 games, dating back to July 26...in that span, he is hitting .302 (19-for-63) with five doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, 12 walks, a .413 on-base percentage and a .985 OPS...since that date, he ranks tied for fourth in the American League in walks, eighth in OBP and 10th in OPS.

ARRAEZ UP: Luis Arraez has hit safely in 23 of his last 25 games, hitting .419 (36-for-86) in that span, the best in baseball since July 4 (minimum 75 plate appearances)...he is 16-for-39 (.410) with four doubles and five walks in 12 games since being reinstated from the 10-day Injured List on July 31.

☞ He enters today with a season-long 10-game hitting streak...his career-long is 12 done from July 2-19, 2019...it is tied with Jorge Polanco (7/26-8/6), Byron Buxton (4/1-20) and Nelson Cruz (4/5-16) for the longest by a Twin this season...the last Twin with 11-plus was Arraez (exactly 11), which spanned from August 31, 2020-April 5, 2021.

DAY MAN, FIGHTER OF THE NIGHT MAN: The Twins are playing their 56th day game of the season today...their 55 day games lead baseball...they have gone 23-32 during the day, tied for sixth-most day wins in the American League and tied for 12th most in baseball.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .338 (50-for-148) with eight doubles, 20 walks and a .418 on-base percentage in 42 day games this season...his day OBP ranks fifth in the AL while his batting average ranks sixth.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Single-A Cedar Rapids infielder Yunior Severino and right-handed pitcher Ben Gross have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Severino, 21, played in six games for the Kernels, hitting .560 (14-for-25) with three doubles, one home run, two RBI, three walks, six runs scored and a 1.421 OPS...he recorded two four-hit games this week, one on Sunday vs. Quad Cities and the other on Friday at Peoria...the Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent in December of 2017.

☞ Gross, 24, made one start for the Kernels on Wednesday, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and a career-high 13 strikeouts, earning the win...the Cranbury, New Jersey native was drafted by the Twins in the 10th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Duke University...this marks his second honor this season (also August 1).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2011, Jim Thome hit two home runs in a 9-6 win at Detroit to become the eighth player to reach 600 home runs; Thome hit a two-run homer off Rick Porcello in the sixth for number 599, then a three-run shot against Daniel Schlereth in the seventh...in 2020, in front the big head cutouts debut at Target Field, Nelson Cruz homered in each game of a doubleheader against the Royals...for Cruz, it marked the first of three times in 2020 to homer in both games of a doubleheader (8/29 at DET & 9/8 at STL).

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, TK! Former manager Tom Kelly is celebrating his 71st birthday today...TK shares a birthday with actress Jennifer Lawrence (30), actor Ben Affleck (48), The Walking Dead star Emily Kinney (35), former Twins player Chad Allen (53) and former Vikings Quarterback Bobby Brister (59) - Dan Gladden's starting quarterback on his Fantasy Football team in 2000 (0 TD, 1 INT, 82 Yards)...Kelly is the Twins all-time managerial wins leader (1,140)...on his birthday, Kelly held a managerial record of 7-6.

LAST TIME OUT: Barnes' last outing came in the homestand opener, on August 9 vs. Chicago-AL, as he worked the final 4.2 innings of the Twins' 11-1 loss to the White Sox...made his first career relief appearance and allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR), with a career-high-tying two walks and a career-high three strikeouts in a career-high-tying 4.2 innings of work.

SECOND START SUMMARY: Barnes' most recent start occurred on August 4 at Cincinnati, taking the loss as the Twins fell to the Reds, 6-5...yielded a career-high five runs on seven hits, with two walks and two strikeouts in 4.0 innings...also tossed a career-high 80 pitches...maneuvered around a pair of singles in the first and second innings to complete two scoreless frames; ran into trouble in the third, allowing four runs on three-straight RBI hits by Kyle Farmer (single), Joey Votto (double) and Tyler Stephenson (single)...departed after completing four innings and permitting a fifth run on a Jonathan India RBI single.

DEBUT DEBRIEF: Barnes made his major league debut for the Twins in the first game of the July 17 doubleheader in Detroit; took the 1-0 loss as the Twins were shut out in seven innings...allowed a leadoff homer to Robbie Grossman before settling in to toss 4.2 shutout innings, with just four total hits allowed, one walk and one strikeout...marked the first Twins starting pitcher to allow a homer to the first batter he faced in his career since Hall-of-Famer Bert Blyleven did so against the Senators' Lee Maye on June 5, 1970.

🔒 Barnes became just the second pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) to make his major league debut as the starting pitcher in the first game of a doubleheader, joining Bert Cueto, who did so on June 18, 1961 at Chicago-AL (ND, 8.1 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 3 BB, 3 K).

🔒 Also became the second pitcher in Twins history to allow one-or-fewer runs in his debut and take the loss, joining Brad Havens on June 5, 1981 at Detroit (L, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 K).

THE ARSENAL: As a pitcher who relies primarily on finesse and pinpoint location rather than overpowering speed, Barnes' fastball averages between 88-90 MPH...as a result, MLB's Statcast has had trouble registering his fastball and has consistently labelled it as a changeup or sinker...with that caveat, here's a picture of the rookie's arsenal, per Baseball Savant.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT: When he debuted, Barnes became the seventh player to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of three pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), RHP Bailey Ober (May 18), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2) and RHP Griffin Jax (June 8).

SPLITS ROUNDUP: Barnes did not face a left-handed batter in his major league debut and has held lefties to just 2-for-7 so far in his career, compared to the .333 (15-for-45) mark that righties have against him...fared better against right-handed batters than left-handed batters across his 13 starts for St. Paul this season, holding righties to a .246 (43-for-175) batting average, compared to the .286 (20-for-70) average that lefties have against him...additionally, Barnes has been effective with runners on base — opponents are hitting just .226 (14-for-62) off him with traffic on the bases in Triple-A and he held the Tigers to just 1-for-8 with runners on (0-for-3, 1 BB with RISP) in his major league debut...he's struggled in scoring situations since his debut, as opponents are 5-for-10 against him with RISP in his last two outings combined.

SAINT PAUL SEASON SUMMARY: Barnes has gone 5-3, 4.24 ERA (63.2 IP, 33 ER) with 23 walks, 54 strikeouts, a 1.35 WHIP and a .257 (63-for-245) opponent batting average in 13 starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season.

🔒 Made his season debut on May 5 at Omaha, earning his second career Triple-A victory while holding the Storm Chasers to three runs on seven hits, with no walks and two strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work; the Saints won 10-4.

🔒 Four of his 13 starts have been quality, including a stretch of three-straight quality starts from May 26-June 8...posted a 0.95 ERA (19.0 IP, 2 ER) in that stretch.

🔒 Tossed a season-high 7.0 innings on two occasions, May 26 at Iowa (W, 7.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 7 K) and July 3 vs. Omaha (W, 7.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 3 K).

🔒 Did not allow a home run until his seventh start of the season on June 13 vs. Omaha; permitted four longballs for the first time in his career and took the loss as the Saints fell 15-4...however, Barnes has allowed just six home runs in 63.2 innings of work this season, good for a 0.85 homers-per-9.0 IP ratio...he's also yielded just 25 home runs in 361.1 career minor league innings; his 0.62 career homers-per-9.0 IP ratio is 18th best among all minor leaguers since 2017 (min. 360.0 IP).

🔒 Threw at least 90 pitches in six of his 13 starts and struck out at least six batters in four starts.

🔒 The Saints have gone 8-5 as a team in Barnes' 13 starts...since his professional debut on June 27, 2017 for the Rookie-Elizabethton Twins, Barnes' teams have gone 42-35 in games in which he pitches, including 42-30 in his starts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER — RHP GRIFFIN JAX (2021 SEASON: 3-1, 5.45 ERA // CAREER: 3-1, 5.45 ERA)

Rookie right-hander Jax is due to start tomorrow night as the Twins host Cleveland for the first of three games...will be making his 10th career appearance and sixth start, as he faces Cleveland for the first time in his career...earned the win in his last outing earlier this homestand, leading the Twins to a 4-3 win over Chicago-AL on August 10...notched his first career quality start, allowing three runs on six hits (2 HR), with one walk and a career-high 10 strikeouts in a career-high 6.0 innings of work...became the first Twins rookie with at least 10 strikeouts in a game since Trevor May on September 14, 2014 (also 10 K)...enters tomorrow night having posted a 2.66 ERA (20.1 IP, 6 ER) and .153 opponent batting average (11-for-72) in his last four starts, dating back to July 19.
