THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 5-2 through seven games on their season-long, nine-game homestand, going 2-1 against the White Sox last week, 2-1 against the Rays over the weekend and 1-0 against the Indians...tonight they will play the second of three with Cleveland...after tomorrow's series finale, the Twins will travel to New York to begin an eight-day, seven-game roadtrip with four against the Yankees from Thursday-Sunday and three against the Red Sox from August 24-26...the Twins have gone 29-32 at home this season and 24-34 on the road.

TWINS TAKE TRIBE IN 10: The Twins beat the Indians last night at Target Field by a score of 5-4 in 10 innings...Griffin Jax was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs (2 earned) on seven hits in a career-high tying 6.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings of relief with one hit allowed, one walk and five strikeouts, including a perfect 10th (2 K) from winner Caleb Theilbar (5-0)...the offense recorded 14 hits, three from Josh Donaldson and two each from Luis Arraez and Jorge Polanco (including the walk-off double)...Max Kepler hit his 16th home run and Ryan Jeffers hit his 11th...Kepler's homer was his fourth leadoff blast of the season and 13th of his career, surpassing Dan Gladden for sole possession of fourth place on the Twins all-time list (1 behind Chuck Knoblauch's 14).

POLO WALK-OFF POWER: Jorge Polanco has delivered consecutive walk-off wins for the Twins, with a ninth-inning sacrifice fly on Sunday vs. Tampa Bay and a RBI double in the 10th last night vs. Cleveland...he is the first Twins player with walk-off plate appearances in back-to-back games since Jacque Jones on July 19 (homer) and July 20 (single), 2005 vs. Baltimore...Polanco now has four walk-off plate appearances in 2021 (also May 18 vs. Chicago-AL and July 11 vs. Detroit), becoming the first Minnesota player to do so in one season since Twins Hall-of-Famer Kent Hrbek had five walk-offs during the 1987 World Series Championship campaign.

TWINS AND CLEVELAND: The Twins are playing the Indians for the 11th of 19 meetings in 2021...the Twins have gone 6-4 against Cleveland this season, going 3-1 at Target Field and 3-3 at Progressive Field...the Twins have outscored the Indians this season 60-41.

☞ Since the start of 2020, 16 of the 20 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 10 have been decided by two runs-or-less.

☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .303 (64-for-211) with seven doubles, two triples, 14 home runs, 48 RBI, 33 walks and a .951 OPS in 55 career games vs. Cleveland.

☞ Max Kepler has 18 career home runs against the Tribe, his most against any opponent... additionally, his 72 career hits are his most.

☞ Miguel Sanó has seven home runs in his last 17 games against Cleveland.

☞ DID YOU KNOW: Indians infielder Owen Miller's brother, Noah, was selected by the Twins with the 36th overall pick (Competitive Balance Round A) in July's First-Year Player Draft.

HOT AUGUST NIGHTS: The Twins are 8-3 (.727) in their last 11 games, tied with the New York Yankees for the best record in the American League since August 5...Minnesota has won three-consecutive series against all three AL division leaders (taking 3 of 4 from the Astros from August 5-8, 2 of 3 from the White Sox from August 9-11 and 2 of 3 from the Rays from August 13-15) and is tied for the best record in baseball over the last 11 days, behind only Atlanta and San Francisco (both 9-2, .818) and Los Angeles-NL and St. Louis (both 8-2, .800)...the Twins are a perfect 5-0 in one-run games in that stretch, after going 15-18 in their first 31 one-run contests this season...below is a look inside the numbers during this stretch:

'PEN PALS: In their last 13 games (since August 3), the Twins bullpen has combined to go 5-0-5, 2.80 ERA (54.2 IP, 17 ER) with 21 walks, 55 strikeouts, a .185 opponent batting average and an opponent OPS of .590.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Twins are looking to win their 12th series of the season...they have gone 11-22-6 in series play this season, 6-12-1 at home and 5-10-5 on the road...they enter today having won each of their last three series...the last time they won four straight series came August 10-23, 2020, going 2-1 at Milwaukee (August 10-12), 3-1 vs. Kansas City (August 15-17), 2-1 vs. Milwaukee (August 18-20) and 2-1 at Kansas City (August 21-23).

ARRAEZ UP: Luis Arraez has reached safely in 12-straight games with a plate appearance, third-longest run of his career...his top two on-base streaks are 16 (September 1-17, 2019) and 13 (July 2-19, 2019)...on the season, he has posted a .380 on-base percentage, which ranks fifth in the AL among players with at least 300 plate appearances, trailing only Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.409), Houston's Michael Brantley (.383), Baltimore's Cedric Mullins (.382) and Houston's Yuli Gurriel (.381).

BACKSTOP BOMBAS: Ryan Jeffers hit his 11th homer of the season last night, breaking a tie with Butch Wynegar (1976) to set a new single-season record for most homers by a Twins rookie catcher...Jeffers, Mitch Garver (13 HR), Ben Rortved (2 HR) and Williams Astudillo (1 HR) have combined for 27 homers from the catcher position thus far, the second-most team homers as a catcher in the majors this season, trailing only Tampa Bay (30)...the 27 homers are also tied with the 1963 Twins for the second-most single-season home runs by catchers in Twins history (since 1961), behind just the 44 home runs that Garver, Jason Castro and Astudillo combined for in 2019.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, Jim Thome hit the first walk-off home run at Target Field, a two-run shot off Matt Thornton, beating the White Sox 7-6 in 10 innings...the win made the Twins 69-50 and put them 4.0 games up on second-place Chicago.

LAST START: Ober did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 1-0 victory on August 11 when facing the White Sox...did not allow a run while tossing a career-high-tying 5.1 innings, with six hits, one walk and six strikeouts...marked the third start in his career in which he did not allow any runs while fanning at least six batters (also 7/5 vs. Chicago-AL and 6/16 at Seattle)...did not allow any extra-base hits in this outing.

☞ **Has a 2.75 ERA (19.2 IP, 6 ER) with four walks and 21 strikeouts in his last four starts, after allowing seven earned runs in 8.1 innings pitched (7.56 ERA) in his prior two.**

START PRIOR: Ober did not factor into the decision August 6 in Houston, an eventual 5-4, 11-inning Twins win in the second of four games at Minute Maid Park...matched his career high by allowing seven hits (the same number the Astros collected off him on June 11 at Target Field), but limited the damage to just three runs over 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...all three Houston runs scored via a pair of home runs, the fourth time he has allowed multiple homers in a start.

A NEW OPPONENT BRINGS A NEW OPPORTUNITY: Tonight marks Ober's first time facing Cleveland...is 1-1, 5.10 ERA (30.0 IP, 17 ER) with 10 walks and 32 strikeouts against the American League Central...stands at 1-0, 4.08 ERA (17.2 IP, 8ER) with seven walks and 21 strikeouts when facing the AL Central at home.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Ober is one of seven players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of three pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2), RHP Griffin Jax (June 8) and LHP Charlie Barnes (July 17).

☞ **Ober's 13 starts this season lead Twins rookie pitchers...Minnesota is 8-5 when Ober takes the mound.**

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first 13 career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .167 batting average (3-for-18) with runners in scoring position and two outs, as well as a .222 (8-for-36) overall mark with RISP...has allowed multiple hits with runners in scoring position just once in his career, on July 20 at Chicago-AL (2-for-5)...in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, Ober held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring position.

LOW TRAFFIC: Ober struck out 100 batters and walked just nine in 2019, good for an MiLB-best 11.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min. 75.0 IP)...that season, he also ranked second in the minors in WHIP (0.81) and base runners-per-9.0 IP (7.55), and was fifth in walks-per-9.0 IP (1.03).

☞ **In 13 MLB starts this season, Ober has allowed 76 total base runners in 57.2 innings, good for an 11.86 base-runners-per-9.0 IP ratio...he's also averaging 2.50 walks-per-9.0 IP while averaging 9.68 strikeouts-per-9.0 IP...he has walked just 16 batters compared to 62 strikeouts, recording a 3.88 strikeout-to-walk ratio...owns the second-fewest walks allowed by a rookie pitcher in the American League (min. 50.0).**

SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average (13-for-60)...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints' fifth game on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run scored on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work...took the ball again on May 13 vs. Iowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision...earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at Iowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none and fanning five as the Saints exploded for 17 runs en route to a 17-5 rout of the I-Cubs...his other start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, fanning a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep.

CAREER REDUX: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a .222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances (35 starts) from 2017-21...was added to the Twins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020...spent part of the offseason working out in Colorado with fellow Twins staffmate Taylor Rogers and last night's pitcher Griffin Jax.

☞ **Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).**

☞ **Over that same time span, Ober ranks fifth by allowing just 8.79 base runners-per-9.0 innings, fourth by walking just 1.18 batters-per-9.0-innings and seventh in WHIP (0.96).**

SKOL TWINS: Ober attended Charlotte Christian School in Charlotte, North Carolina, where he was batterymates on the baseball team and friends with Vikings center Garrett Bradbury...Bradbury had just arrived in the Twin Cities for OTAs at the time of Ober's debut on May 18, and attended the game with his wife, Carson...Carson is also the older sister of Kansas City Royals No. 4 prospect Jackson Kowar.

NO RUNS: Ober posted a miniscule 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) in 2019, his most recent full professional season...his mark led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) and he also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961...also marked the second-lowest single-season ERA by any minor league pitcher since 1992 (min. 75.0 IP), trailing only Erasmo Ramirez's 0.51 ERA (88.0 IP, 5 ER) in 2009 for the VSL Mariners.
