TWINS HAVE OFF NIGHT WITH BATS: The Twins lost to the Indians last night at Target Field by a score of 3-1...Bailey Ober (1-2) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs (2 earned) on five hits in a career-nigh 6.0 innings pitched...Ralph Garza Jr. (1.0 IP) and Nick Vincent (2.0 IP) combined for 3.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded just four hits, two from Jorge Polanco, who drove in the Twins' only run with an eighth-inning fielder's choice ground-out...the offense went 0-for-9 with runners in scoring position and left seven men on base.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Lewis Thorpe from Triple-A St. Paul...Thorpe appeared in six games (2 starts) for the Saints this season, going 1-2 with a 4.76 ERA (17.0 IP, 9 ER), seven walks and 12 strikeouts...Thorpe, who will be making his fifth stint with the Twins this season, has gone 0-2 with a 3.86 ERA (14.0 IP, 6 ER), four walks and five strikeouts for Minnesota...to make room for Thorpe on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Nick Vincent for release or assignment...the 35-year-old appeared in two games for the Twins, posting a 2.08 ERA (4.1 IP, 1 ER) with four hits allowed one walk and four strikeouts hits allowed, one walk and four strikeouts.

TWINS AND CLEVELAND: The Twins are playing the Indians for the 12th of 19 meetings in 2021... the Twins have gone 6-5 against Cleveland this season, going 3-2 at Target Field and 3-3 at Progressive Field...their next meeting will be a four-game series in Cleveland from September 6-9. 
₱ Since the start of 2020, 17 of the 21 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 11 have been decided by two runs-or-less.
₱ Josh Donaldson is hitting ,302 (65-for-215) with seven doubles, two triples, 14 home runs, 48 RBI, 33 walks and a .943 OPS in 56 career games vs. Cleveland.
₱ Max Kepler has 18 career home runs against the Tribe, his most against any opponent... additionally, his 72 career hits are his most...his 18 homers vs. Cleveland are tied with Mickey Vernon for 10th-most in Twins/Senators history.
₱ Brent Rooker is 2-for-4 with a double, a home run and an RBI in his career against Zach Plesac...he was hit on the forearm by a Plesac pitch on September 12, 2020; the plunking broke his arm and ended his season...Rooker responded by homering off of Plesac in their next meeting on April 26 at Progressive Field. next meeting on April 26 at Progressive Field.

POLO ON THE MARK: Jorge Polanco's numbers from the beginning of the season through June

MORE ON POLANCO: Jorge Polanco now has 10 stolen bases and 21 home runs this season... he is the third player in Twins history (sixth instance) to record 10-plus steals and 20-plus homers in a single campaign while playing at least 75% of his games at second base or shortstop...he joins Brian Dozier (four times from 2014-17) and Zoilo Versalles (1964) as the only Twins to do so.

**'PEN PALS:** In their last 14 games (since August 3), the Twins bullpen has combined to go 5-0-5, 2.65 ERA (57.2 IP, 17 ER) with 21 walks, 58 strikeouts, a .184 opponent batting average and an opponent OPS of .578.

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The Twins are looking to win their 12th series of the season...they have gone 11-22-6 in series play this season, 6-12-1 at home and 5-10-5 on the road...they enter today having won each of their last three series...the last time they won four-straight series came August 10-23, 2020, going 2-1 at Milwaukee (August 10-12), 3-1 vs. Kansas City (August 15-17), 2-1 vs. Milwaukee (August 18-20) and 2-1 at Kansas City (August 21-23).

I LOYE LUEY: Luis Arraez has reached safely in 13-straight games with a plate appearance, tied for the second-longest run of his career (also: July 2-19, 2019)...his top on-base streak is 16 (September 1-17, 2019)...on the season, he has posted a .382 on-base percentage, which ranks second in the AL among players with at least 300 plate appearances, trailing only Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.413).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2020, Kenta Maeda pitched eight no-hit innings against the Brewers and set a team record by striking out eight-consecutive batters between the third and fifth innings, but did not factor into the decision...with a 3-0 lead in the ninth, he gave up a lead-off single to Eric Sogard on his 115th pitch of the game, the most of his career...he was replaced by Taylor Rogers, who allowed three runs to score...the Twins eventually won, 4-3, in 12 innings.

PURPLE RAIN: The Twins on Monday announced details for their fourth tribute to late Minneapolis icon Prince, which will include both a gate giveaway and a special "Theme Night" package for the club's 2021 regular season home finale on Thursday, September 30 against Detroit.

The first 10,000 fans in attendance on September 30 will receive an exclusive, co-branded Prince/Twins hat.

Fans who purchase a separate, Prince Theme Night ticket package will receive admission to the game, along with an exclusive, co-branded Prince/Twins bomber-style jacket.

- HEALTHY AGAIN, AND BACK IN THE BIGS: Thorpe was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul today, his fifth major league stint this season (also April 16-17 for a spot start, April 20 as the 27th man for a doubleheader, May 5 for a spot start and May 20 as the 27th man for a doubleheader).

  Thorpe spent nearly two months on the Saints' Injured List with a left shoulder strain...was initially placed on the IL June 5, made two rehab appearances with the Twins' rookie affiliate in the Florida Complex League (combined 5.2 IP with 2 ER in two starts July 27 and August 2), and was activated by the Saints on August 2.
- was activated by the Saints on August 8.

  Made two starts with St. Paul upon his activation, going 1-1, 2.16 ERA (8.1 IP, 2 ER), six hits, one walk and six strikeouts...tossed a season-high (any level) 5.2 innings in his last Triple-A start August 13 at Indianapolis, allowing just one run on two hits (including a solo HR), with a walk and five strikeouts...trew 78 pitches and earned his first professional victory, at any level. since September 19, 2019 (a relief win for the Twins in an 8-5 victory over Kansas City)

SEASON SUMMARY: Thorpe has made four appearances and three starts with the Twins this season

- SEASON SUMMARY: Ihorpe has made four appearances and three starts with the Iwins this season, going 0-2, 3.86 ERA (14.0 IP, 6 ER), four walks, five strikeouts, a 1.21 WHIP and a .241 opponent batting average (13-for-54)...has allowed just one home run (to LAA's Phil Gosselin on May 20).

  ♣ The Australian southpaw's three major league starts this season have all been spot appearances: April 16 at Los Angeles-AL (4.0 IP, 3 HR, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 2 K, ND in a 10-3 Twins loss), May 5 vs. Texas (5.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/ER, 1 BB, 2 K, L in a 3-1 Twins defeat) and May 20 in the first game of a doubleheader at Angel Stadium (4.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 0 K in a 7-1 Twins setback)... tossed one perfect inning of relief (1 K) in the first game of an April 20 doubleheader at Oakland.

  ♣ Thorpe is 1-2, 4.76 ERA (17.0 IP, 9 ER), seven walks, 12 strikeouts, a 1.12 WHIP and a .190 opponent batting average in six games (two starts) with Triple-A St. Paul.

LAST TIME OUT: Thorpe's last outing in a Twins uniform came May 20 in the first game of a double header at Los Angeles-AL...shouldered the 7-1 loss in that contest after allowing four runs (just one earned) on five hits over 4.0 innings of work...all four runs scored in the first two innings, before he settled down to toss a scoreles third and fourth frames...walked two, and did not record a strikeout for just the fourth time in 23 major league appearances.

VS. CLEVELAND: Today marks Thorpe's fourth career appearance and second start vs. Cleveland...is 0-1, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER), four walks and eight strikeouts over those first four efforts, including

0-1, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IF, 6 ER), four warks and eight strikeouts over those first four errorts, including 2.0 scoreless relief innings (2 H, 1 K) to finish up a 2-0 Twins loss on July 30, 2020 at Target Field.
 4 His lone career start against Cleveland came in the second game of a September 14, 2019 double-header at Progressive Field, in a memorable day for the Twins...Thorpe did not factor in the decision after getting touched for five runs on seven hits in 3.2 innings (4 BB, 6 K), but the first-place Twins rallied with a five-run eighth (capped by Miguel Sanó's grand slam) to win 8-5, complete a doubleheader sweep and move 5.5 games ahead of the Indians in the division standings.

STARTER AND RELIEVER: Thorpe has just 23 major league appearances under his belt entering today, including six starts...his starts have varied in length (5.0 IP, 3.2 IP, 4.0 IP, 4.0 IP, 5.0 IP and 4.0 IP), and he's 0-3, 5.61 ERA (25.2 IP, 16 ER), five homers allowed, 14 walks, 20 strikeouts and a .307 opponent batting average (31-for-101) in those six outings.

Thorpe's career relief appearances have lasted anywhere between 0.1 and 4.0 innings, and he's 3-2, 5.57 ERA, 10 walks, 26 strikeouts and a .331 opponent batting average (44-for-133) in 17 career appearances out of the hullnen.

TAKING A RISP: Has held opposing hitters to a .250 batting average (13-for-52) with runners in scoring position in his career, far below his career opponent batting average of .321 (75-for-234)... he's yielded multiple hits with RISP just twice, August 3, 2020 vs. Pittsburgh (2-for-5) and August 29, 2020 at Detroit (2-for-6).
