THE TWINS: After completing their nine-game homestand with a record of 6-3 (2-1 against the White Sox, 2-1 against the Rays and 2-1 against the Indians), the Twins began their eight-day, seven-game roadtrip with a loss to the Yankees last night...tonight they will play the second of four in New York...they will wrap the series on Sunday afternoon, then travel to Boston to enjoy an off-day on Monday before playing three games against the Red Sox from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 30-33 at home this season and 24-35 on the road.

BRONX BUMMER: The Twins lost to the Yankees last night at Yankee Stadium by a score of 7-5. John Gant (4-7) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on three hits in 3.1 innings pitched with one walk and four strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, three from Jorge Polanco and two from Andrelton Simmons...Miguel Sanó hit his 21st home run and Jake Cave hit his second...Luis Arraez went 0-for-4, snapping his on-base streak at 14 games...Andrew Albers made his return to the Twins, allowing one run on two hits in 4.0 innings of relief.
 ☞ Albers became the first player in Twins history (since 1961) to have three different stints with the club (also 2013 and 2016)...additionally, he joined Bobo Newsom (5 stints) and Hall-of-Famer Goose Goslin (3 stints) as the only three players in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901) with three-plus different stints. (*Elias Sports Bureau*).

CONGRATS, MIGGY!: The Twins announced today that they have placed infielder Miguel Sanó on the Paternity List, after the birth of his daughter Danea on Thursday morning in Minneapolis...Sanó has played in 98 games for the Twins this season, hitting .217 (73-for-337) with 18 doubles, 21 home runs, 53 RBI, 51 runs scored, 44 walks, a .308 on-base percentage and a .765 OPS...to replace Sanó on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Edgar Garcia from Triple-A St. Paul...Garcia, who was optioned to St. Paul yesterday, has appeared in four games for the Twins this season, allowing four runs on three hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with four walks and six strikeouts.

☞ Additionally, right-handed pitcher Nick Vincent has cleared waivers and has been assigned to Triple-A St. Paul...he was designated for release or assignment on Wednesday when the Twins recalled left-handed pitcher Lewis Thorpe.

TWINNING: Despite last night's loss to the Yankees, the Twins have gone 9-5 in their last 14 games, dating back to August 5...since that date, their nine wins are third-most in the American League, trailing New York (12-3) and Tampa Bay (10-3)...during that span, the pitchers have combined to post a 3.98 ERA (129.0 IP, 57 ER) with 41 walks, 110 strikeouts and a .228 opponent batting average.

TWINS AND YANKEES: The Twins and Yankees are playing the fifth of seven scheduled meetings in 2021...in regular season games only, the Twins have gone just 5-15 in their last 20 vs. New York and 9-26 in their last 35.

☞ The Twins have gone 2-15 in their last 17 at Yankee Stadium and 1-10 in their last 11 here. ☞ Since the start of the 2019 season, the Twins lead baseball with 571 home runs, ahead of Los Angeles-NL (568) and New York-AL (551).

☞ Mitch Garver is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with one double, three home runs, six RBI, three walks and a 1.084 OPS in 11 career regular season games against the Yankees.

☞ Andrelton Simmons has reached safely in 18-consecutive games against the Yankees...in 34 career games against New York, he is hitting .293 (39-for-133) with a .321 on-base percentage.

☞ Jake Cave was originally selected by the Yankees in the sixth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft and played seven seasons in New York's minor league system...he was acquired by Minnesota in a trade on March 16, 2018, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Luis Gil.

☞ Rob Refsnyder was originally selected by the Yankees in the fifth round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft...he made his debut with New York in 2015 and played parts of three seasons for the Yankees from 2015-17.

HIP HIP JORGE!: Jorge Polanco enters tonight 9-for-20 (.450) with seven RBI in his last four games...since July 1, he is hitting .314 (54-for-172) with eight doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 39 RBI, a .362 on-base percentage, a .581 slugging percentage and a .943 OPS...in that span, he leads the club in RBI, ahead of Miguel Sanó, who has 19...Polanco has accounted for 21% of the club's RBI during that time (39 of 190)...in that span (minimum of 135 at-bats), he ranks second in baseball in RBI (Joey Votto - 45), tied for fourth in hits, tied for seventh in home runs, 11th in batting average and 12th in slugging percentage.

LEFTY LOOSEY: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the 41st time this season, going 13-27 when facing a lefty...on the season, the Twins are hitting .248 (332-for-1338) with a .419 slugging percentage and a .735 OPS vs. lefties, compared to .242 (670-for-2769) with a .431 slugging and a .751 OPS against righties.

☞ Twins are tied with five other teams for fourth-most home runs against lefties in all of baseball this season. ☞ Rob Refsnyder is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with two doubles, one home run, five walks and a .444 on-base percentage against left-handed pitching.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1997, the Twins traded outfielder Roberto Kelly to Seattle for a player to be named later...the deal was finished on October 9, sending Joe Mays to the Twins...Mays eventually became an All-Star in 2001, going 17-13 with a 3.16 ERA in 34 starts...in 1989, the Twins traded Frank Viola for pitchers Rick Aguilera, David West and Kevin Tapani (plus two minor leaguers)...in 2017, the Twins inducted outfielder Michael Cuddyer into the club's Hall of Fame.

THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ Former Twins outfielder and hitting coach Tom Brunansky is celebrating his 61st birthday today...former Twins and Yankee third baseman Graig Nettles is celebrating his 77th birthday.
- ☞ Andrelton Simmons needs one double to reach 200 for his career...he has two doubles in his last six games.
- ☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .429 (21-for-49) with a 1.003 OPS in his last 16 road games...the .429 average leads baseball in that span.
- ☞ Twins catchers have combined to hit 27 home runs this season (Mitch Garver - 13, Ryan Jeffers - 11, Ben Rortvedt - 2, Willians Astudillo - 1), the second-most in baseball, trailing only Tampa Bay (31).
- ☞ Twins hitters have an average exit velocity of 89.8 mph, the second-highest mark in baseball, trailing only Toronto (90.1 mph)...the Yankees' mark ranks fifth at 89.6 mph.

LAST TIME OUT: Barnes did not factor into the decision in his last start on Sunday, August 15 vs. Tampa Bay at Target Field, a 5-4 Twins walk-off win...yielded just three base runners (single, double, home run) over a career-high 5.0 innings of work, with no walks and a career-high-tying three strikeouts...marked his first career outing in which he didn't record a walk...retired the first six batters he faced before running into trouble in the third inning, allowing a single by Mike Zunino and a double by Mike Brosseau to lead off the frame; maneuvered out of the jam by inducing a fielder's choice and fanning Randy Arozarena and Nelson Cruz to end the frame...pitched a one-two-three fourth before yielding a one-out solo homer to Zunino in the fifth, his only run allowed in the outing...departed with a 4-1 lead, but was denied his first major league win as the Rays rallied off Minnesota's bullpen to tie the game 4-4 in the seventh, setting the stage for Jorge Polanco's walk-off heroics.

In MLB.com's new prospect rankings released yesterday, Barnes was named the No. 30 prospect in the Twins' system.

TWO OUTINGS AGO: Barnes made his first career major league relief appearance on August 9 vs. Chicago-AL, as he worked the final 4.2 innings of the Twins' 11-1 loss to the White Sox...allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR), with a career-high-tying two walks and a career-high three strikeouts in a then-career-high-tying 4.2 innings of work.

SECOND START SUMMARY: Barnes started on August 4 at Cincinnati, taking the loss as the Twins fell to the Reds, 6-5...yielded a career-high five runs on seven hits, with two walks and two strikeouts in 4.0 innings...also tossed a career-high 80 pitches...maneuvered around a pair of singles in the first and second innings to complete two scoreless frames; ran into trouble in the third, allowing four runs on three-straight RBI hits by Kyle Farmer (single), Joey Votto (double) and Tyler Stephenson (single)...departed after completing four innings and permitting a fifth run on a Jonathan India RBI single.

DEBUT DEBRIEF: Barnes made his major league debut for the Twins in the first game of the July 17 doubleheader in Detroit; took the 1-0 loss as the Twins were shut out in seven innings...allowed a leadoff homer to Robbie Grossman before settling in to toss 4.2 shutout innings, with just four total hits allowed, one walk and one strikeout...marked the first Twins starting pitcher to allow a homer to the first batter he faced in his career since Hall-of-Famer Bert Blyleven did so against the Senators' Lee Maye on June 5, 1970.

Barnes became just the second pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) to make his major league debut as the starting pitcher in the first game of a doubleheader, joining Bert Cueto, who did so on June 18, 1961 at Chicago-AL (ND, 8.1 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 3 BB, 3 K).

Also became the second pitcher in Twins history to allow one-or-fewer runs in his debut and take the loss, joining Brad Havens on June 5, 1981 at Detroit (L, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 K).

THE ARSENAL: As a pitcher who relies primarily on finesse and pinpoint location rather than overpowering speed, Barnes' fastball averages between 88-90 MPH...as a result, MLB's Statcast has had trouble registering his fastball and has consistently labelled it as a changeup or sinker...with that caveat, here's a picture of the rookie's arsenal, per Baseball Savant.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT: When he debuted, Barnes became the seventh player to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of three pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF/OF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), RHP Bailey Ober (May 18), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2) and RHP Griffin Jax (June 8).

SPLITS ROUNDUP: Barnes did not face a left-handed batter in his major league debut and has held lefties to just 2-for-11 (.182) so far in his career, compared to the .305 (18-for-59) mark that righties have against him...six of the seven extra-base hits he's allowed so far in his major league career have come against righties...fared better against right-handed batters than left-handed batters across his 13 starts for St. Paul this season, holding righties to a .246 (43-for-175) batting average, compared to the .286 (20-for-70) average that lefties had against him...additionally, Barnes has been effective with runners on base - opponents are hitting .226 (14-for-62) off him with traffic on the bases in Triple-A and he held the Tigers to just 1-for-8 with runners on (0-for-3, 1 BB with RISP) in his major league debut...he's struggled in scoring situations since his debut, as opponents are 5-for-13 against him with RISP in his last three outings combined.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP KENTA MAEDA (2021 SEASON- 6-4, 4.41 ERA // CAREER- 59-40, 3.84 ERA)

Right-hander Maeda is due to start tomorrow afternoon's game at Yankee Stadium...earned his second-straight victory in his last outing on August 14 vs. Tampa Bay, pitching 6.0 shutout innings and yielding just three hits, one walk and one hit batter, with four strikeouts en route to a 12-0 Twins win...marked his fifth quality start of the season and third in his last five starts...also is 3-1, 2.98 ERA (45.1 IP, 15 ER), 11 walks and 54 strikeouts (10.72 K/9.0 IP) in his last eight starts dating back to July 4; posted a 5.31 ERA (39.0 IP, 23 ER) in his eight starts prior to his current stretch...will be facing New York-AL for the first time tomorrow and after the outing will have pitched against 29 of 30 MLB teams, with Los Angeles-NL the only remaining club he's yet to face in his career.

- Is in his fifth year in the Twins organization, after being selected in the fourth round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Clemson University.
- Was an invite to 2021 Twins spring training, second of career...went 0-1, 6.00 ERA (3.0 IP, 2 ER) with one walk, four strikeouts and a .182 opponent batting average.
- Participated in Twins Fall Instructional League during October 2020 in Fort Myers, FL.
- Added to 60-man Player Pool September 5, 2020 and spent the final month of season at alternate training site in St. Paul, MN.
