will play the third of four in New Yorkthey will wrap the series tomorrow afternoon, then travel
to Boston to enjoy an off-day on Monday before playing three games against the Red Sox from
Tuesday-Thursdaythe Twins have gone 30-33 at home this season and 24-36 on the road.

**TWINS DROP GAME TWO IN THE BRONX:** The Twins lost to the Yankees last night by a score of 10-2, falling into a 6-0 deficit after the first two innings...Charlie Barnes (0-3) was the starter and loser, allowing seven runs on eight hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with five walks and two strikeouts...the offense recorded just four hits...Josh Donaldson and Luis Arraez had the club's only extra-base hits as Donaldson hit his 17th home run and Arraez hit his 14th double...Mitch Garver reached multiple times, going 1-for-2 with two walks.

TWINS AND YANKEES: The Twins and Yankees are playing the sixth of seven scheduled meetings

INITIAL SAND TARKEES: The living and Yankees are playing the sixth of seven scheduled meetings in 2021...in regular season games only, the Twins have gone just 5-16 in their last 21 vs. New York and 9-27 in their last 36.
 The Twins have gone 2-16 in their last 18 at Yankee Stadium and 1-11 in their last 12 here.
 Since the start of the 2019 season, the Twins lead baseball with 572 home runs, ahead of Los Angeles-NL (568) and New York-AL (554).
 Mitch Congretic hitting 355 (11 for 21) with any double, three home runs six PRI five walks.

The Mitch Garver is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with one double, three home runs, six RBI, five walks and a 1.110 OPS in 12 career regular season games against the Yankees.

Andrelton Simmons has reached safely in 19-consecutive games against the Yankees...in 35 career games against New York, he is hitting .289 (39-for-135) with a .322 on-base percentage...lifetime against Gerrit Cole, he is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with one triple and one walk.

**LUEY - CERTIFIED HITTER:** Luis Arraez has hit safely in 14 of his last 16 games and in 28 of his last 31...overall on the season, he is hitting .313 (95-for-304) while posting a .379 on-base percentage in 86 games...among all American League players with at least 300 at-bats, he ranks second in on-base percentage, trailing only Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.407)...additionally, he ranks third in batting average, trailing Houston's Michael Brantley (.322) and Toronto's Teoscar Hernández (.315).

over lowa...he allowed one run on one hit in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and nine strikeouts, fanning his first six batters-faced (4 swinging and 2 looking)...Ryan was most recently pitching for silver medal-winning Team USA at the Olympics in Tokyo...he was one of two pitchers acquired by the Twins via trade with Tampa Bay, in exchange for Nelson Cruz on July 22...Ryan is the club's number six prospect per MLB.com...the other pitcher was right-hander Drew Strotman, who will make the start for the Saints tomorrow at 2:05 p.m. (CT).

Outfielder Byron Buxton started for Triple-A St. Paul last night on rehab assignment and went 0-for-2 with one walk and one strikeout... Buck played five innings in centerfield...he has missed the Twins' last 51 games with a left hand fracture.

**DID YOU KNOW?:** Bally Sports North analyst Justin Morneau hit .433 (26-for-60) with six doubles, seven home runs, 11 RBI, 14 runs scored, nine walks, a .507 on-base percentage, an .883 slugging percentage and a 1.391 OPS in 16 career games at Yankee Stadium... his 1.391 OPS is second all-time at New York's ballpark among qualifiers, trailing José Ramírez (1.401) and ahead of Mike Trout (1.231).

**TARGET FIELD ROCKS:** On Monday night, Target Field will host the Hella Mega Tour, featuring Green Day, Fall Out Boy and Weezer... it will mark each band's first show at Target Field and mark the first concert at the Twins' ballpark since Down the Rabbit Hole Live: Zac Brown Band 2018 North American Tour with OneRepublic and Caroline Jones...Green Day will join Paul McCartney (2014), Billy Joel (2017), Journey (2018), Def Leppard (2018), Cheap Trick (2018) and The Eagles (2018) as members of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame to perform at Target Field.

LAST START: Maeda earned his second-straight win August 14 against Tampa Bay in the Twins' 12-0 shutout victory...marked Maeda's fifth quality start of the season and third in his last five starts... allowed three hits over 6.0 shutout innings of work, with just one walk and four strikeouts...Maeda did not give up any extra-base hits in this outing...marked his fourth start of the season in which he pitched at least 5.0 shutout innings.

### Maeda is 3-1, 2.98 ERA (45.1 IP, 15 ER), 11 walks and 54 strikeouts (10.72 K/9.0 IP) in his last eight starts dating back to July 4, after posting a 5.31 ERA (39.0 IP, 23 ER) in his eight starts prior to his current stretch.

START PRIOR: Maeda earned the win on August 8 in the series finale at Houston, besting Lance Mc-SIARI PRIOR: Maeda earned the win on August 8 in the series finale at Houston, besting Lance McCullers Jr. in a 7-5 Twins victory...yielded three runs on six hits, with three walks and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings pitched...allowed RBI singles in the first, fourth and fifth innings to Aledmys Diaz, Taylor Jones and Yordan Alvarez, respectively, accounting for all three Astros runs before departing with a 4-3 lead in the fifth...five different Twins relievers combined to limit Houston to two runs in the final 4.0 innings while the Twins offense added three more runs in the sixth, securing the victory and clinching the 3-1 series win at Minute Maid Park...tossed 100 pitches, his highest total of the season and most since throwing 115 on August 18, 2020 vs. Milwaukee, a game in which he carried a no-hitter through 8.0 innings.

ENTERING THE CONCRETE JUNGLE: This afternoon will be Maeda's first time facing New York-AL in his career...has faced the American League East just twice so far this season, going 1-1, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), with three walks and nine strikeouts in those two prior starts.

◆ Owns a career 2-3, 4.24 ERA (34.0 IP, 16 ER), with 13 walks and 38 strikeouts in eight career games (6 starts) vs. the AL East.

♦ In his career, Maeda stands at 17-12, 4.08 ERA (220.1 IP, 100 ER), with 65 walks and 239 strikeouts against the American League, while is 42-28, 3.74 ERA (537.1 IP, 223 ER), with 154 walks and 590 strikeouts against the National League.

♣ After today's game, Maeda will have faced 29 of the 30 MLB teams, with the only exception being Los Angeles-NL, his former team...the Twins are scheduled to face the Dodgers for a pair of two-game series in the 2022 regular season.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Maeda is making his 14th road start of the season, going 4-2, 5.77 ERA (64.0 IP, 41 ER), with 21 walks and 71 strikeouts away from Target Field...this compares to the 2-2, 2.13 ERA (38.0 IP, 9 ER), with 10 walks and 37 strikeouts in his seven starts at Target Field this season. 

◆ Is 4-1, 4.81 ERA (43.0 IP, 23 ER), with 12 walks and 44 strikeouts in nine day games, while is 2-3, 4.12 ERA (59.0 IP, 27 ER), with 19 walks and 64 strikeouts in 11 night games this season.

MILESTONE MAN: Maeda surpassed two career milestones in his start against the Mariners in Seattle on June 14...at the end of his second inning of work he reached 700 career MLB innings, becoming the 10th Japanese-born pitcher to hit that plateau in the majors...the others are: Hideo Nomo (1,976.1 IP), Hiroki Kuroda (1,319.0 IP), Yu Darvish (1,258.1 IP), Tomo Ohka (1,070.0 IP), Masahiro Tanaka (1,054.1 IP), Hisashi Iwakuma (883.2 IP), Daisuke Matsuzaka (790.1 IP), Masator Yoshii (757.1 IP) and Shigetoshi Hasegawa (720.1 IP)...additionally, Maeda's strikeout of Shed Long Jr. in the fourth inning on June 14 was the 2,000th of his career...he now has 2,057 strikeouts combined between Nippon Professional Baseball (1,233) and Major League Baseball (824).

### Maeda's final strikeout on July 17 was the 800th of his major league career...he became just the fifth Japanese-born pitcher in major league history to reach 800 career strikeouts, joining Nomo (1,918), Darvish (1,550), Tanaka (991) and Kuroda (986).

#### Maeda's seven career games with 10-plus strikeouts are fourth most among Japanese-born pitchers in major league history, behind Darvish (47), Nomo (31) and Tanaka (14).

2021 ARSENAL: Over the last two seasons, Maeda's slider has overtaken his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch in his five-pitch arsenal...here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:

MONTHLY MARKS: Maeda finished April with a 6.56 ERA, his second-highest single-month ERA in his career behind his 6.58 mark in April 2017...he tends to heat up with the weather, owning a 3.68 career ERA in May, 3.25 mark in June and 3.86 mark in July, before inching up to 3.98 in August, his second-highest career ERA in any month, behind only his 4.48 mark in April...here are his numbers by month in his career (full months only, excluding March and October).
